

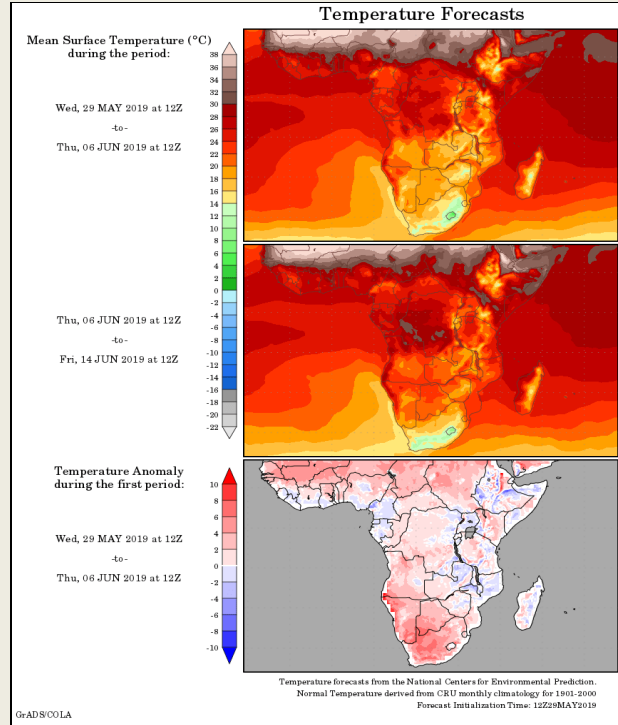
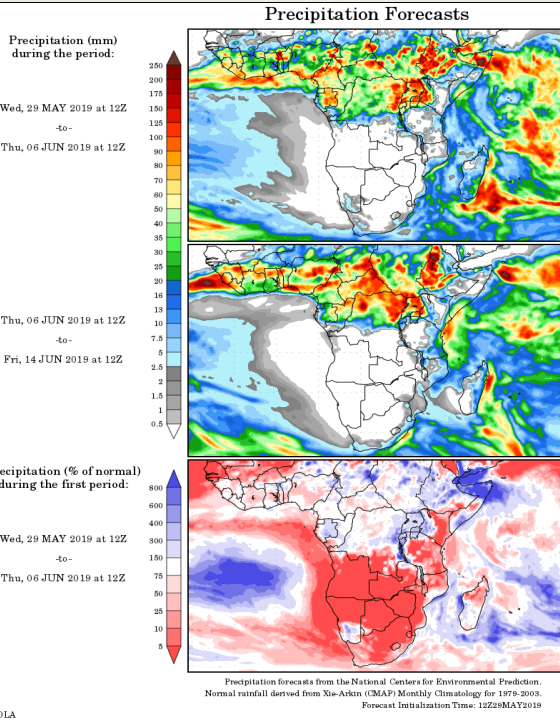
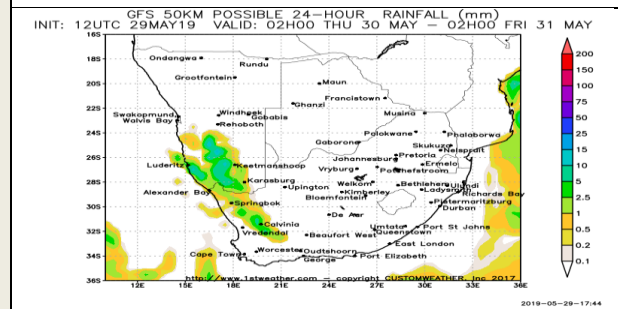
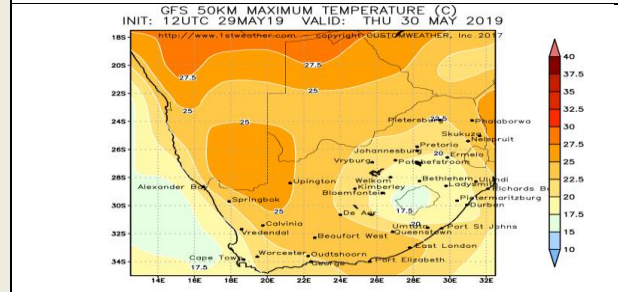
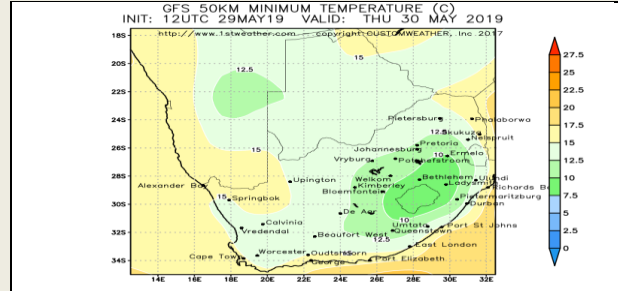
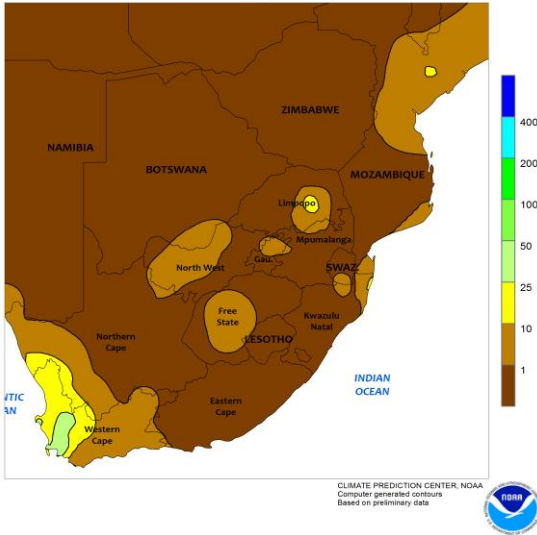


Weather Report
30 May 2019

South Africa - Weather

- Harvesting and general fieldwork will advance swiftly in the coming weeks
- Coarse grain and oilseed losses still expected in Northern Cape and portions of Free State and North West due to dryness over much of the growing season
- Cotton yields will be near normal
- Eastern South Africa will also see near normal crop yields
- Western Cape, Free State, and neighboring areas will need to see a good shot of rain later in June as the ground firms during the next two weeks
- Winter wheat planting and establishment conditions were initially favorable earlier this month for Free State and neighboring areas
- However a lack of rain and warm weather gradually firmed up the soil in more recent days
- Other than a few periods of light rain, Western Cape's winter wheat areas have been too dry to support ideal planting and establishment

MAY 19 - 25, 2019

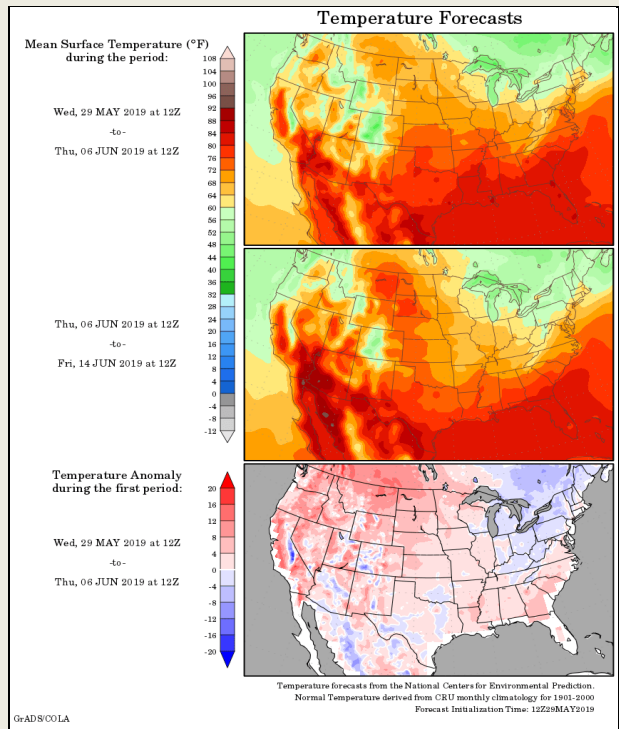
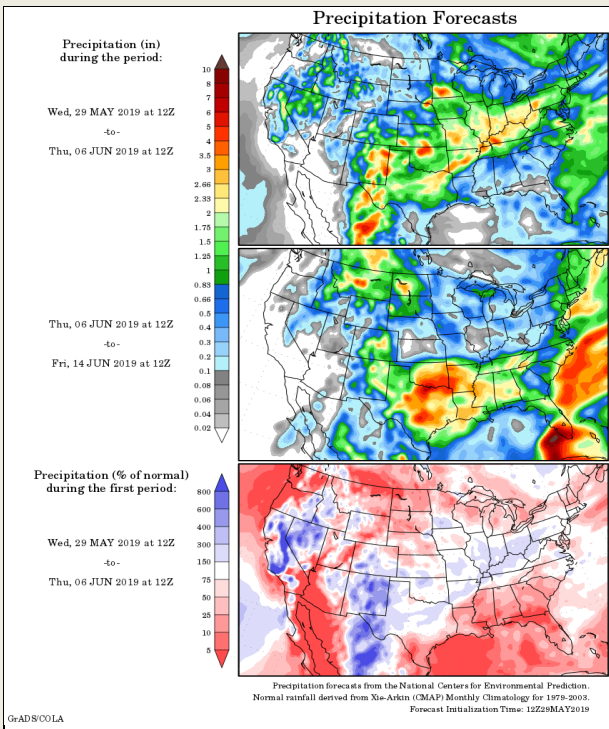
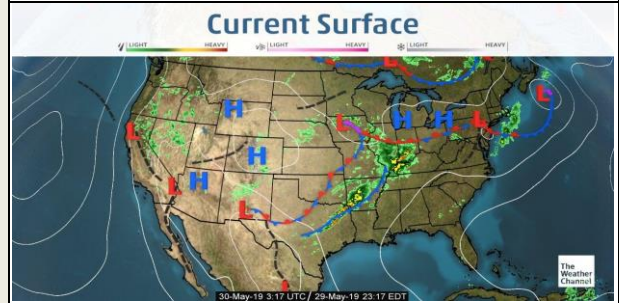
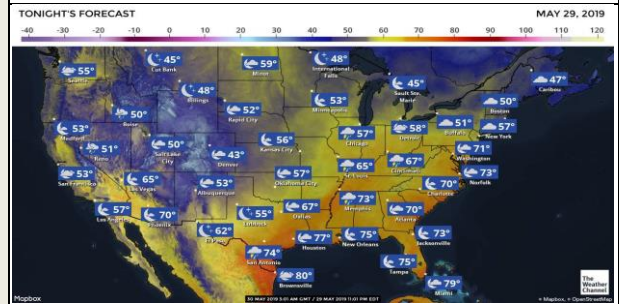
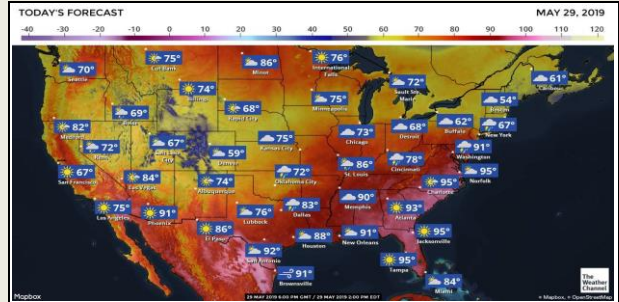
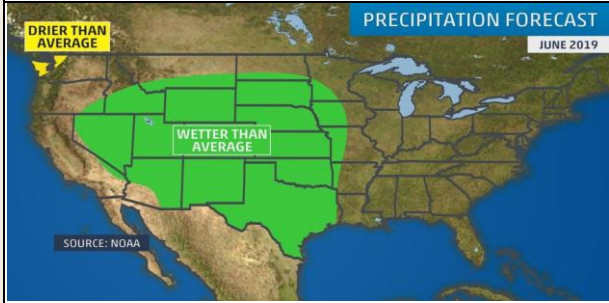
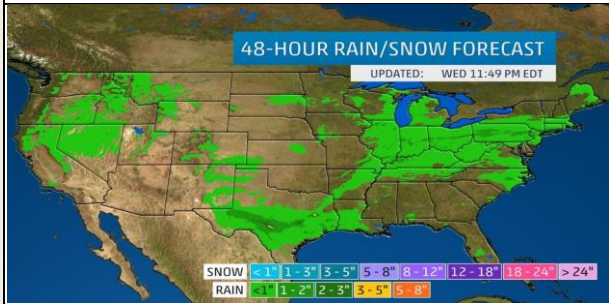

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Frequent rain will continue through Wednesday of next week and planting will be sluggish in many areas, especially from northeastern Kansas into southern Iowa and northern Missouri into northern Illinois where recent rain has left the ground wet enough that an extended period of drying will be needed before fieldwork can resume. Some planting will occur around the rain, but planting will not be aggressive in many locations due to high frequency of rain expected.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will continue to dry down overall through the next two weeks and planting should advance swiftly while crop stress increases and expands in the Southeast. Water levels and flooding along the Mississippi River will not change much in the north during the next week while the south see an increase in flooding.

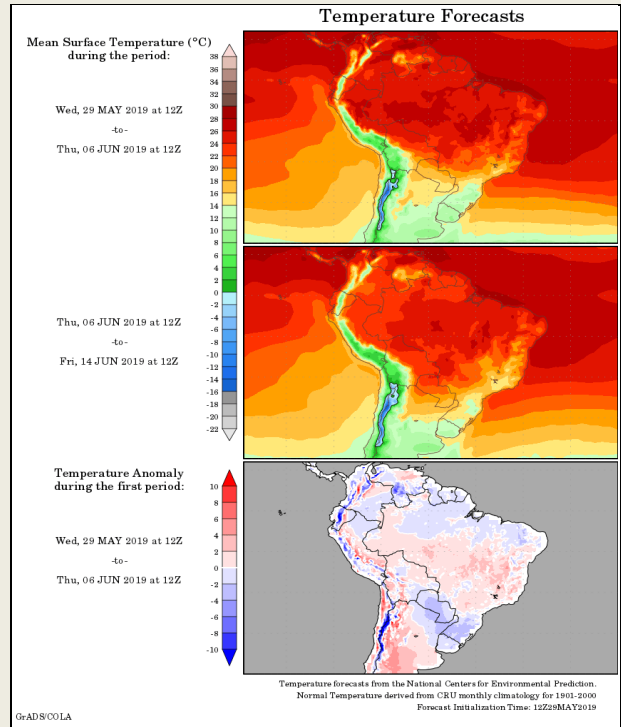
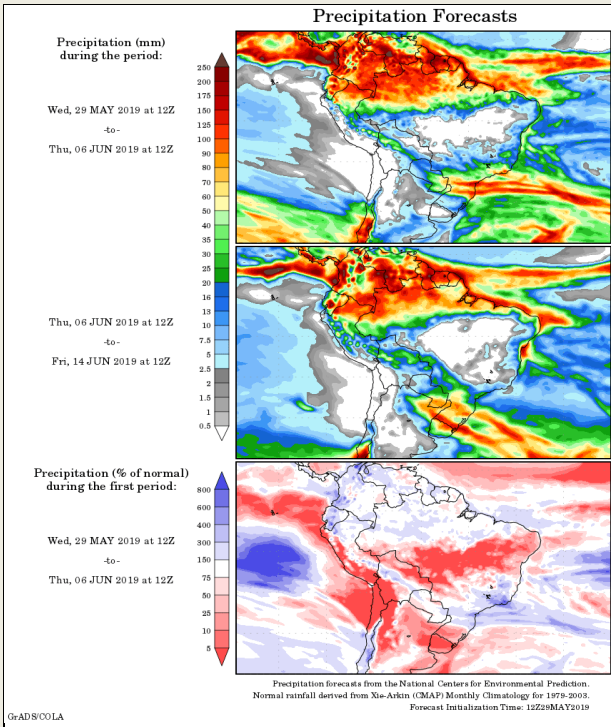
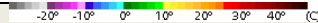
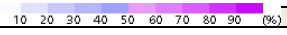
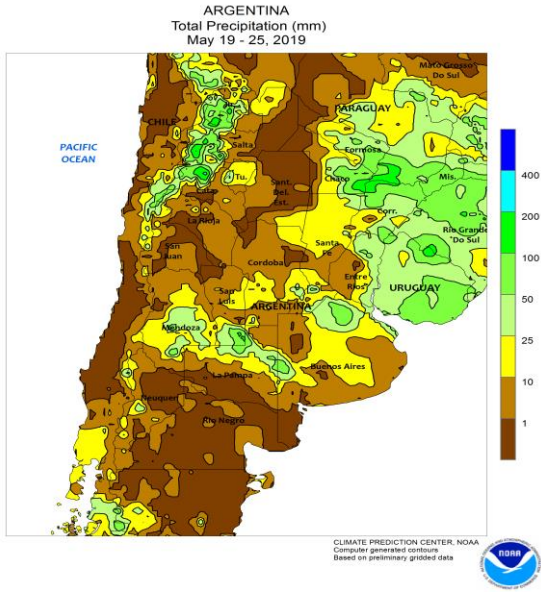

ARGENTINA: Argentina will see a restricted rainfall pattern most often through the next two weeks allowing for good harvest progress to be made.

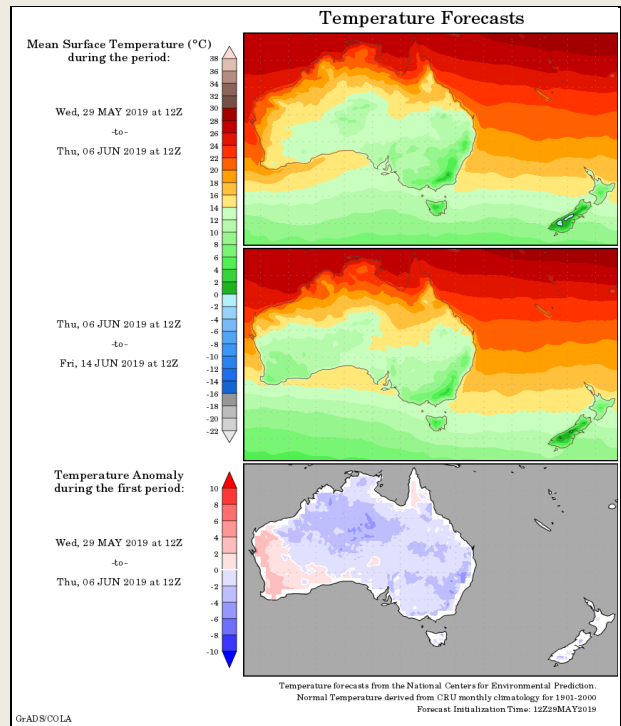
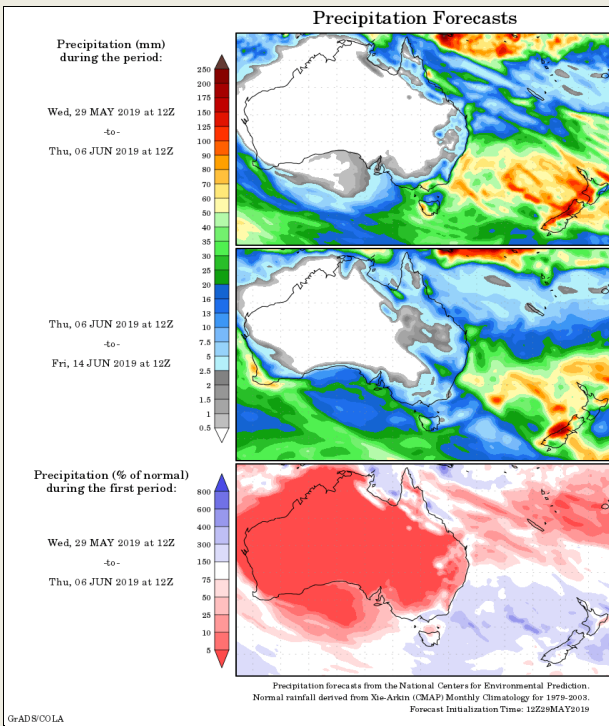
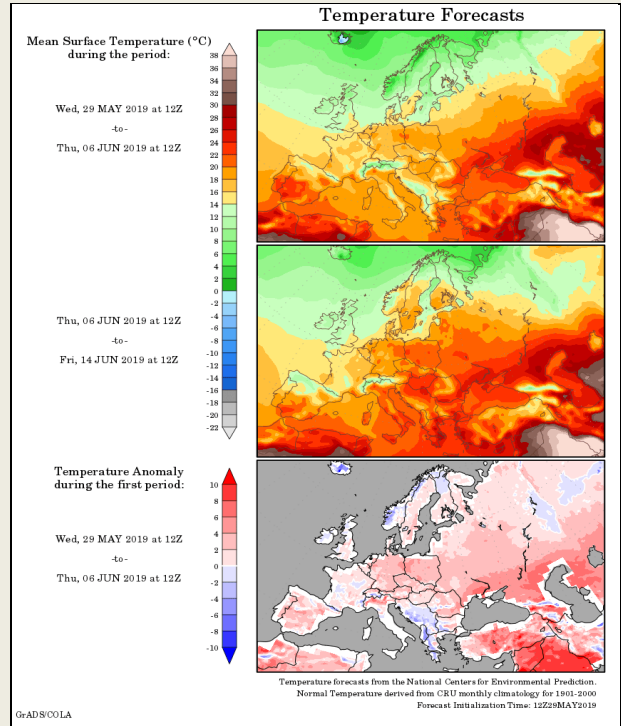
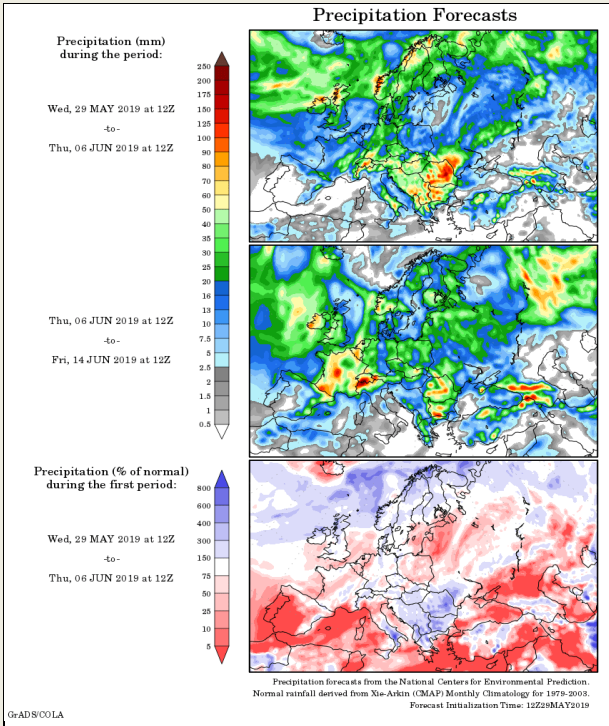

EUROPE: Moist conditions will continue over southeast Europe this week. Moisture will be greatest over the Hungarian Plain and Balkan Countries where frequent rainfall will occur.

AUSTRALIA: Greater and more frequent precipitation will be needed to bolster soil moisture and support planting and establishment of winter crops. The one exception will be rounds of light rain over southeast South Australia into Victoria and southeast New South Wales. Rain will be greatest in Victoria which will help support planting and establishment of winter crops. Greater rainfall will still be needed over interior South Australia and interior south New South Wales
