

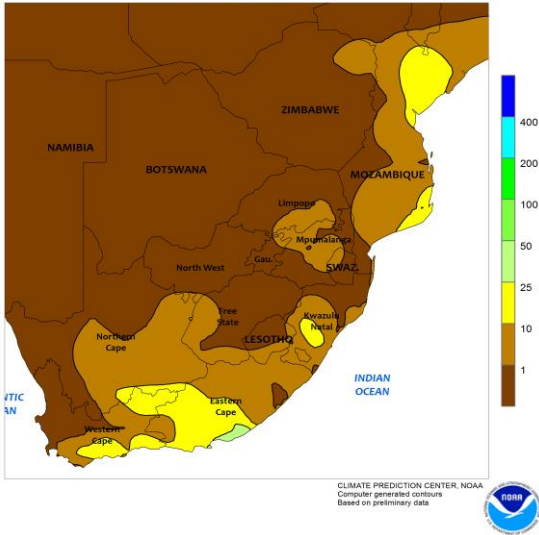

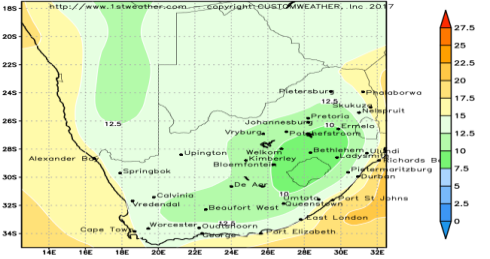
South Africa - Weather

- Harvesting will advance with few disruptions during the next two weeks
- Production losses still expected in Northern Cape and portions of Free State and North West due to dryness over the growing season
- o Cotton is mostly irrigated and yields should be closer to normal
- Eastern South Africa will see near normal yields
- Soil moisture will gradually decrease in the coming weeks across South Africa
- Although planting conditions were initially favorable for Free State and neighboring areas late in April and earlier this month, conditions have slightly deteriorated in recent weeks
- o Timely rain would be welcome to support a better environment for establishment and growth
- Western Cape would benefit from a general soaking of rain to support better winter wheat prospects as well
- o Most areas have been too dry to support aggressive planting and establishment

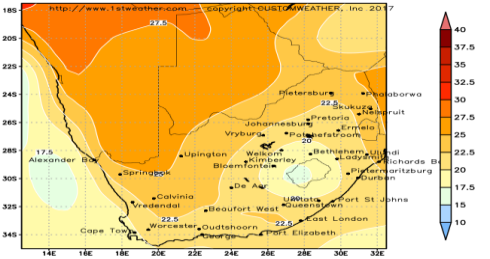
SOUTH AFRICA

MAY 26 - JUN 1, 2019



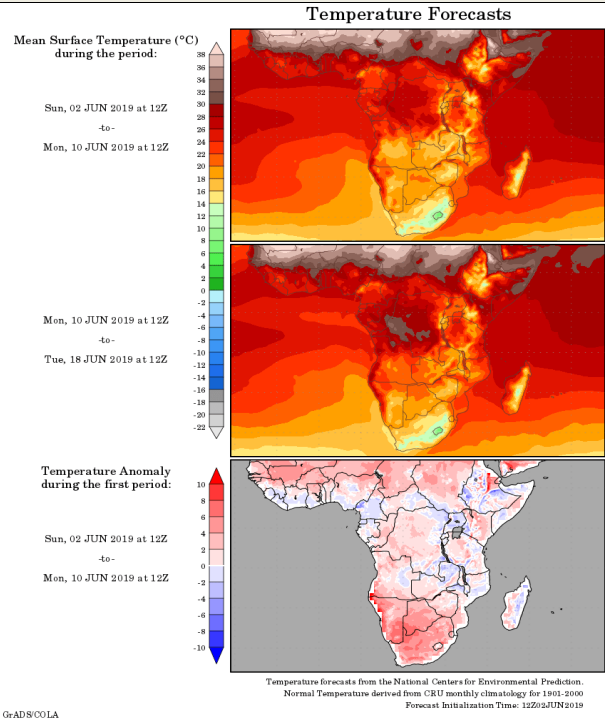
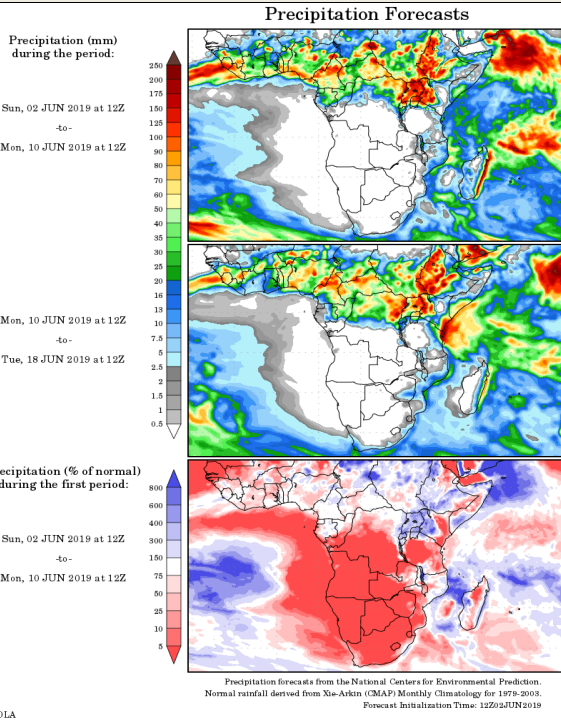
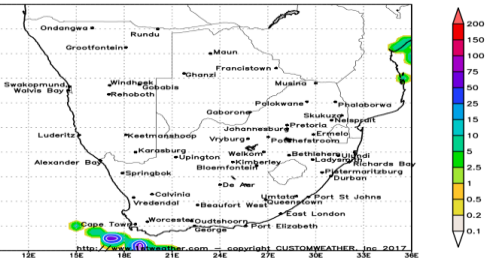
GFS 50KM MINIMUM TEMPERATURE (C)

INIT: 12UTC 02JUN19 VALID: 02H00 MON 03 JUN - 02H00 TUE 04 JUN

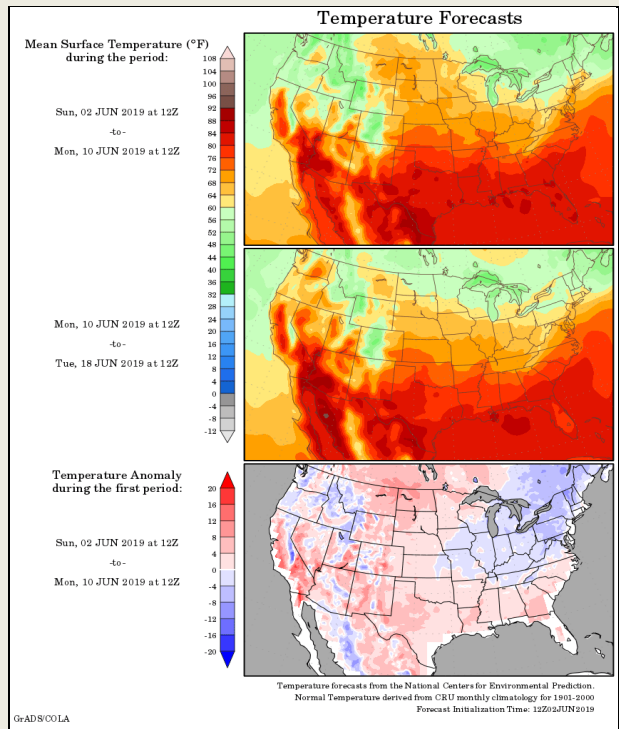
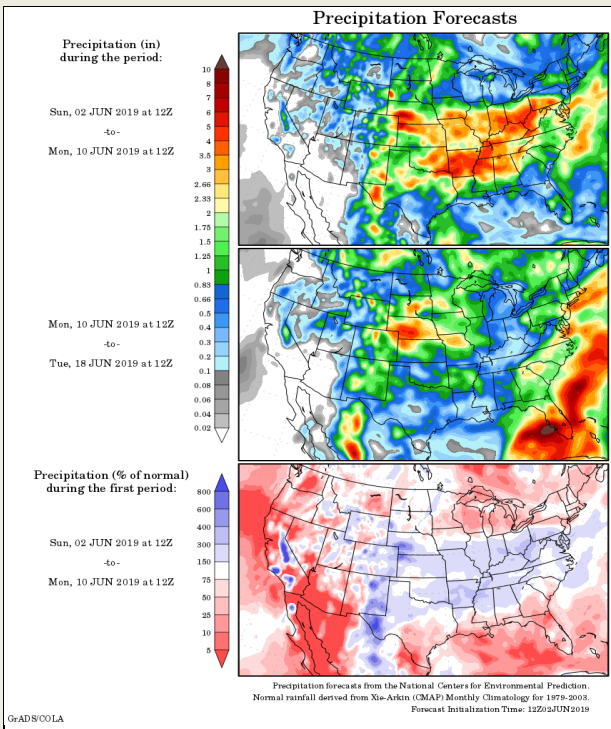
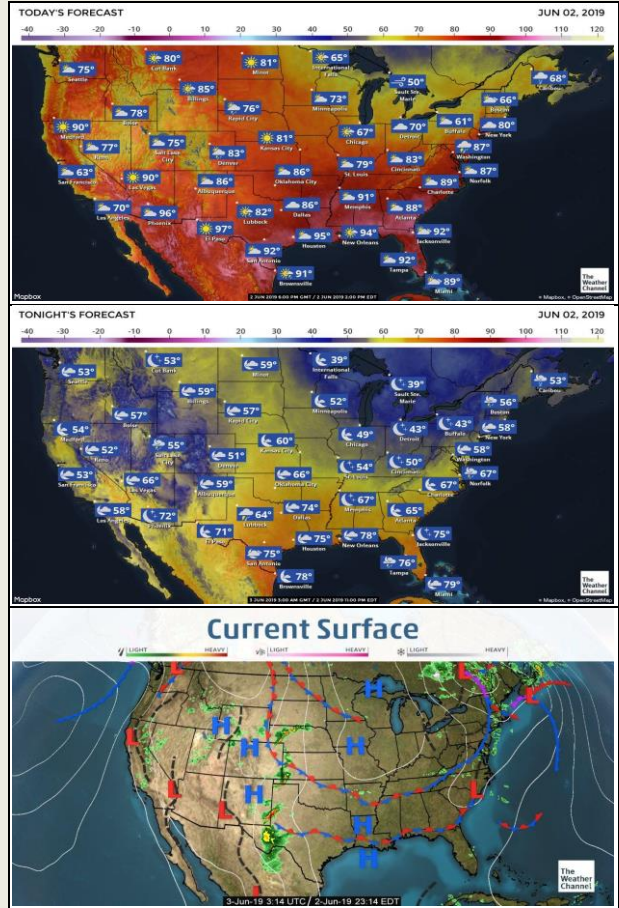
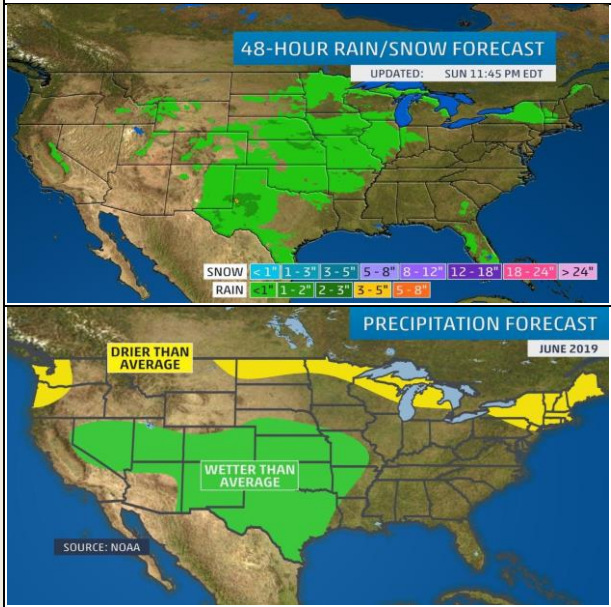


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United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Today's forecast is more clear regarding the regions that will struggle the most with planting before prevent plant dates arrive with the lower and eastern Midwest seeing the fewest opportunities for fieldwork after Tuesday while the northwestern Corn Belt sees the best conditions for fieldwork. Much of the Midwest will receive at least some rain today into Tuesday, but there will be breaks in the rain and most areas will see around 3 full days of dry weather from today into Tuesday and planting should accelerate in areas that are not completely saturated. Rain will increase Tuesday afternoon and another period of wet weather will occur in the lower and eastern Midwest Tuesday afternoon into Saturday, June 8.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will continue to dry down overall through the next two weeks and planting should advance swiftly while crop stress increases and expands in the Southeast. A timely increase in rain is advertised for the Delta and portions of the Southeast Thursday into Saturday, June 8 and that could buy crops more time before permanent losses occur, but follow up rain would be needed soon to maintain any improvements that occur.

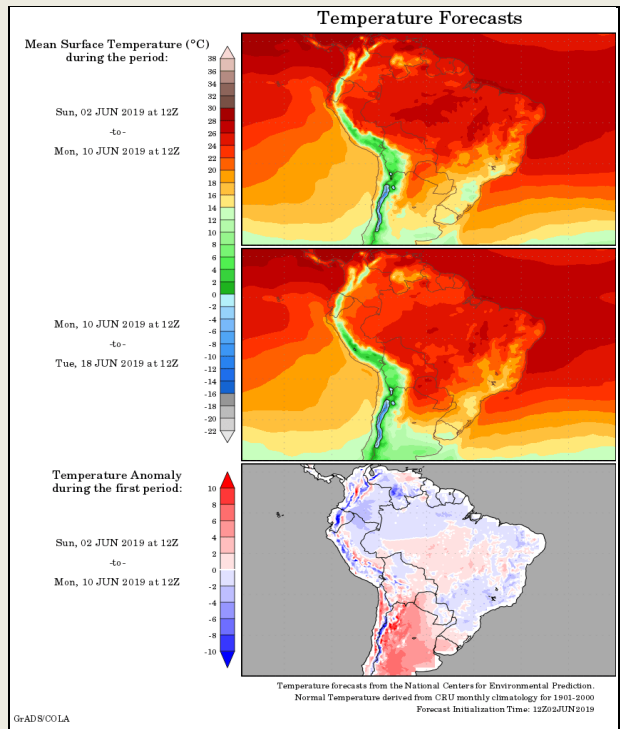
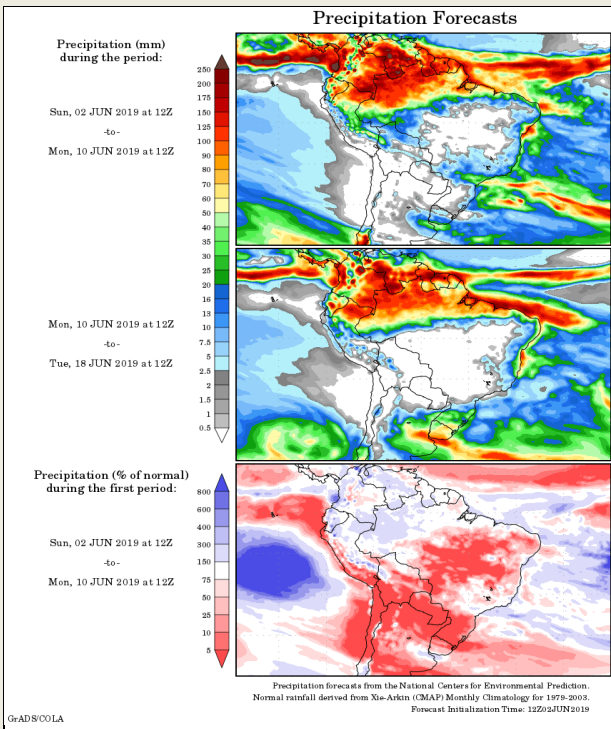
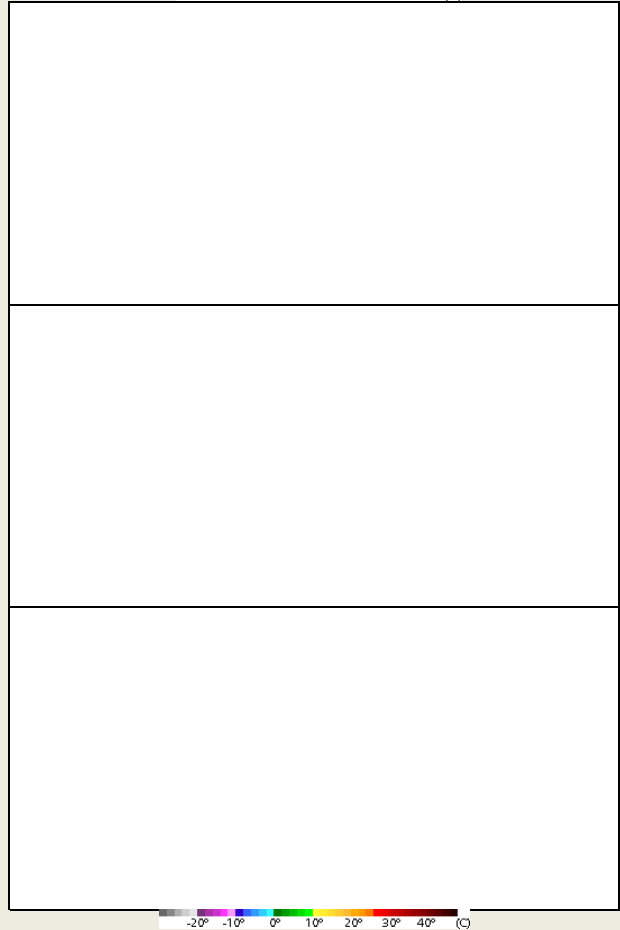
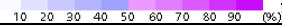
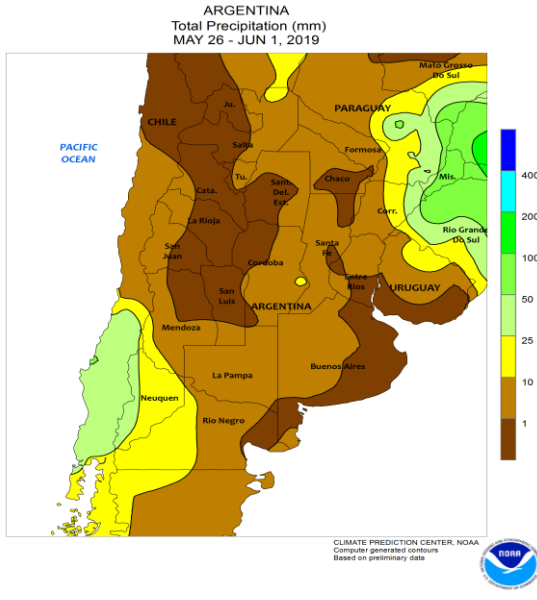


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South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Regular rounds of showers and thunderstorms will occur through early next week from southern Paraguay into portions of southern Brazil and fieldwork will be slowed while little rain falls elsewhere.

ARGENTINA: Argentina will see a restricted rainfall pattern most often through the next two weeks allowing for good harvest progress to be made. Light rain will continue today in portions of southern and eastern Argentina with northwestern Buenos Aires wettest where totals will be up to 0.30" and locally more.

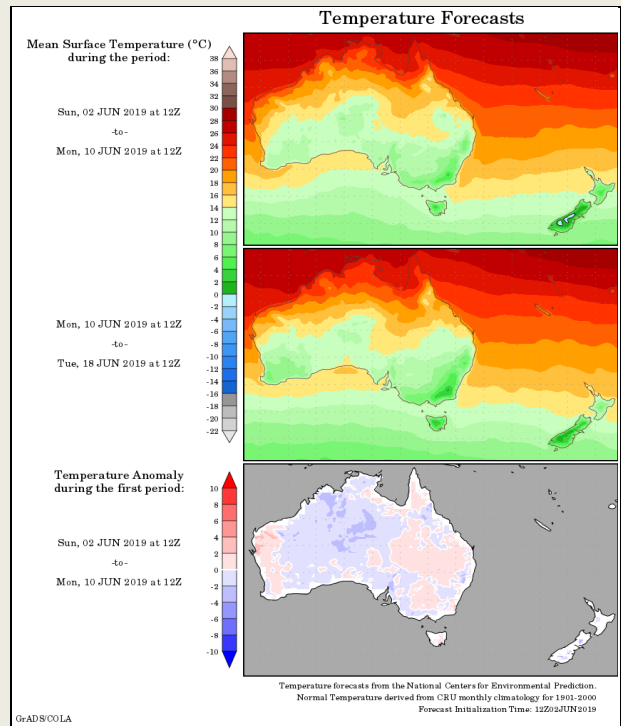
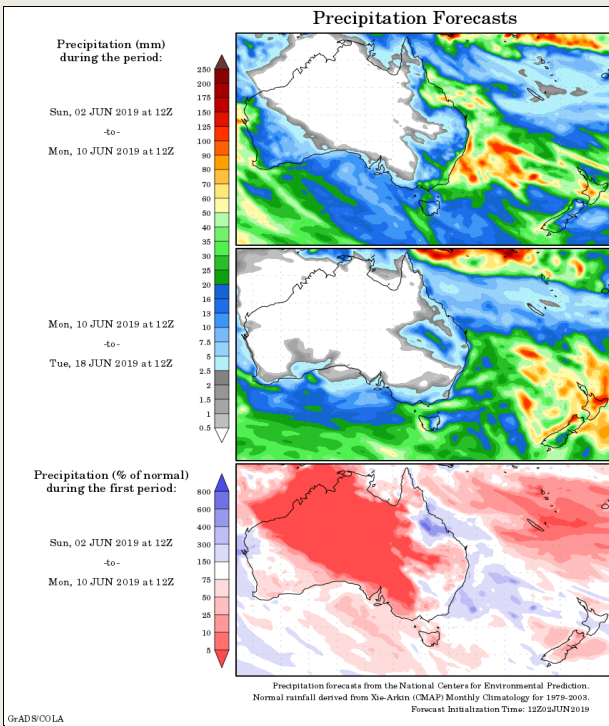
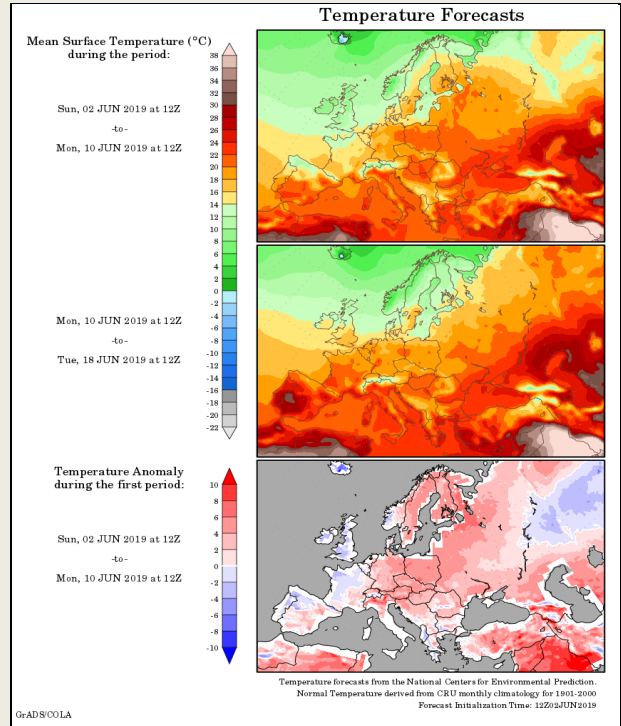
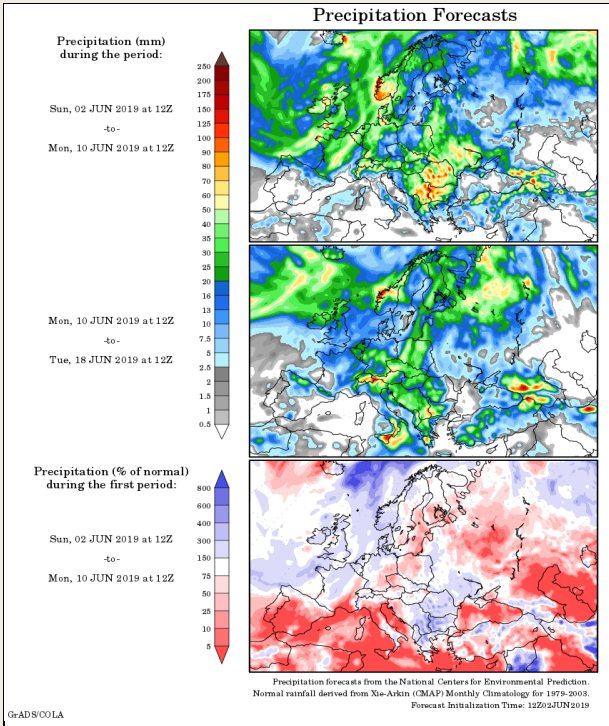


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Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Moist conditions will continue over southeast Europe as well as the northern U.K. into Scandinavia this week. Moisture will be greatest over the Balkan Nations this week. Meanwhile, net drying will occur in much of the south U.K., France through Germany, and Poland o Conditions will not be completely dry, but rain that does occur will be erratic and light, especially through the weekend and combined with warming temperatures soil conditions will firm up.

AUSTRALIA: Net drying will occur in most locations this week and greater rainfall will still be needed to support planting and establishment of winter crops. The driest conditions will occur over interior east-central Australia and interior Western Australia



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
