



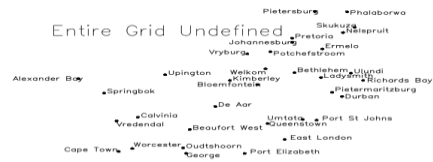

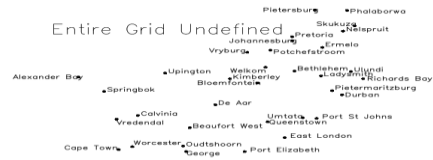
South Africa - Weather

- Seasonably dry conditions will continue for at least the next seven to ten days
- The dry conditions will still be favorable for maturation and harvesting of cotton and other late season crops
- A few occasional and mostly insignificant rain showers will occur near the southern tip of the region
- Greater rainfall would still be welcome in the west for what, barley, and canola
- A similar precipitation pattern is likely Jun. 17 – 21
- Some showers may occur near the southern tip of the region

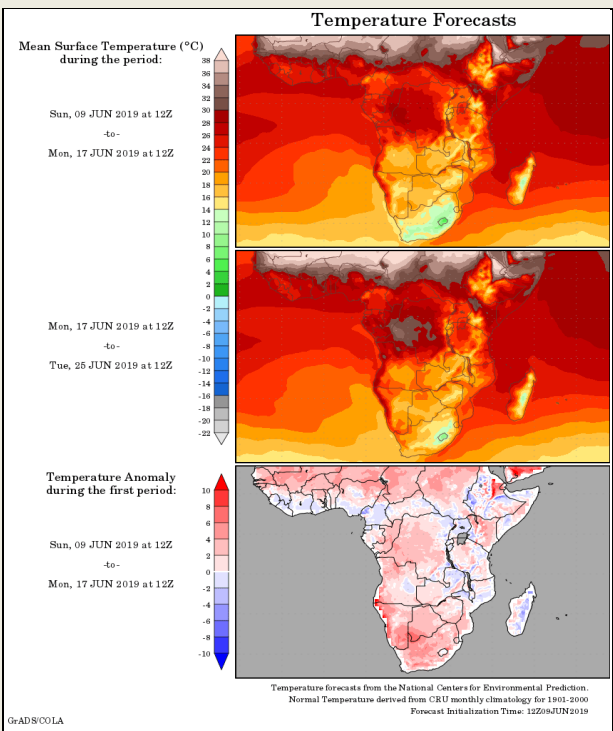
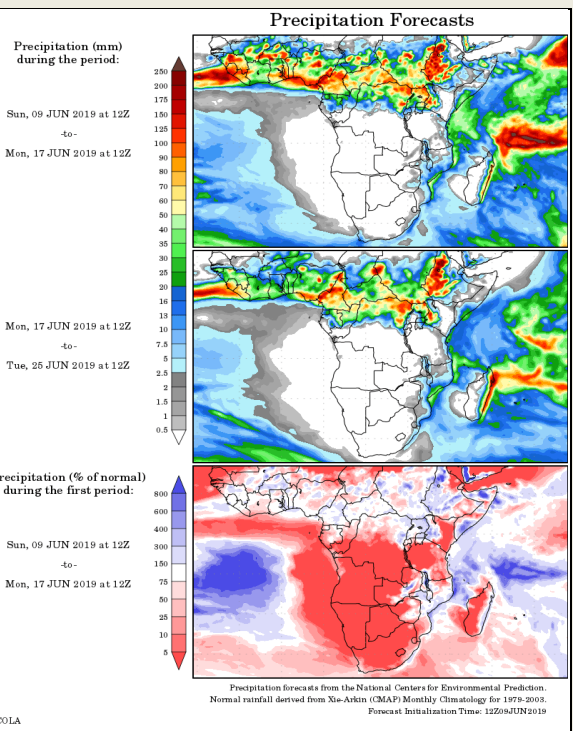
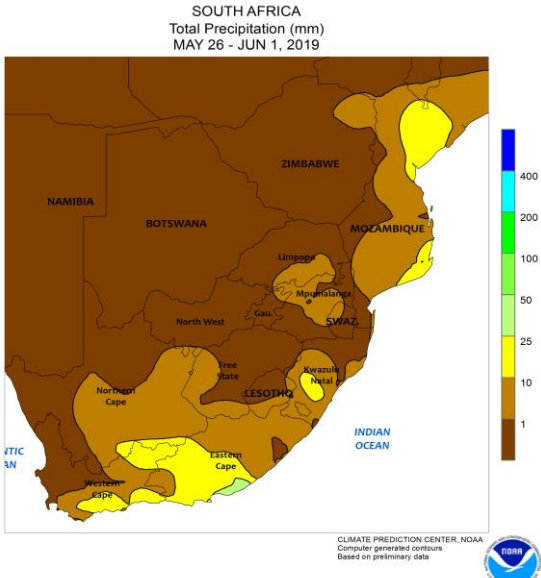
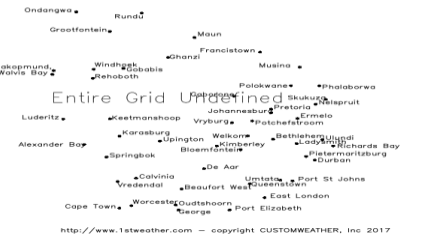
GFS_50KM MINIMUM TEMPERATURE (C)

INIT: 12UTC 09JUN19 VALID: 02H00 MON 10 JUN - 02H00 TUE 11 JUN

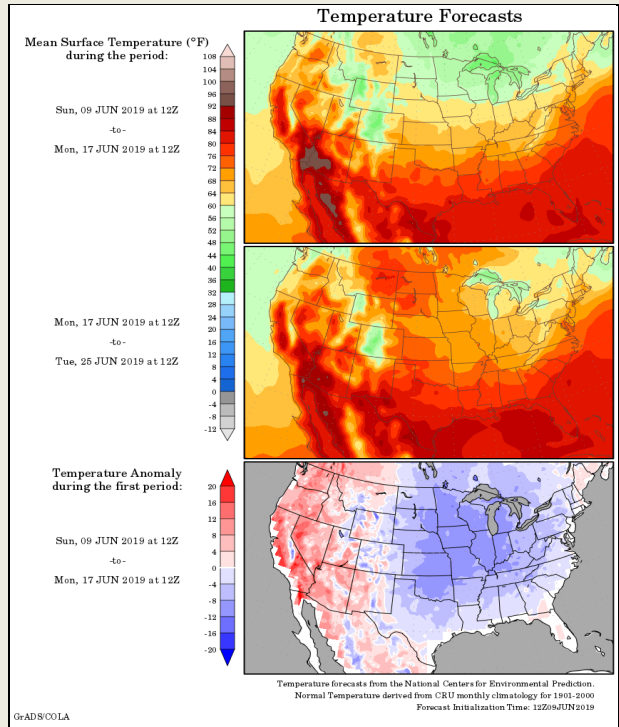
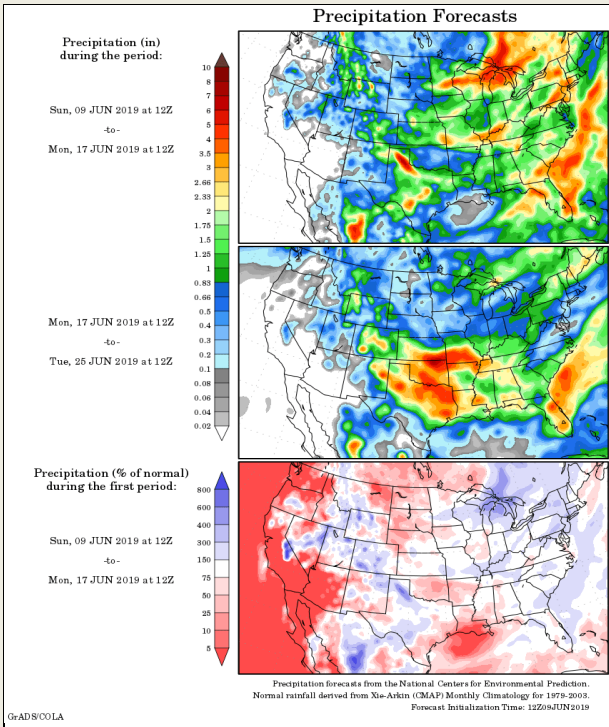
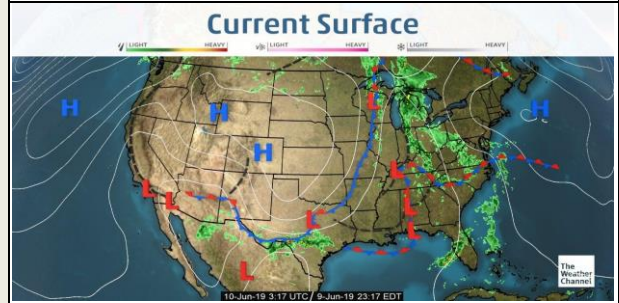
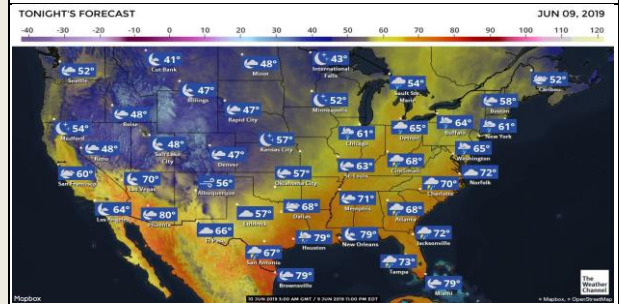
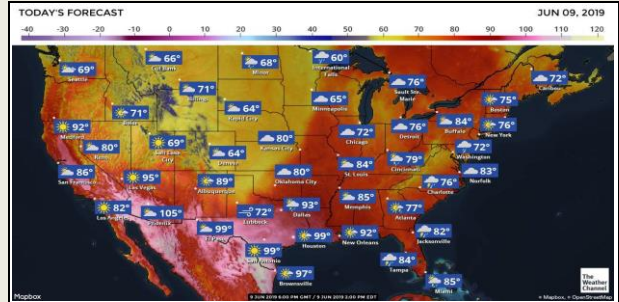
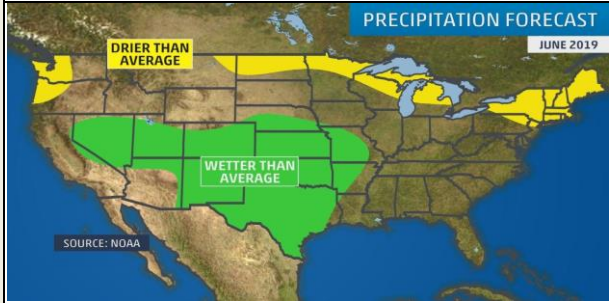

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Much of the Midwest will see little to no rain and good planting progress into Saturday before rain increases Saturday afternoon and evening causing mostly temporary interruptions to fieldwork. An exception will occur from southeastern Missouri into Kentucky where rain is expected today into Saturday while a few light showers occur from elsewhere in eastern Missouri to western Ohio.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta will see one more day of rain while rain continues in the Southeast through Wednesday. The rain will provide a critical boost in soil moisture in the drier areas of the Southeast while portions of the Delta that have dried down recently will also benefit, but planting delays and an increase in flooding will result as well in the Southeast. The driest areas in the Southeast will see notable improvements in soil moisture and crop conditions and as long as timely rain continues late this month and July conditions for crops will be favorable.

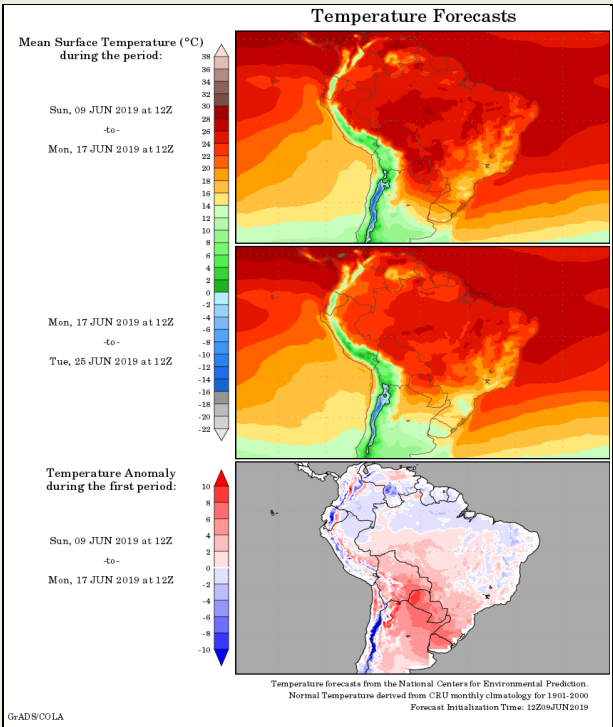
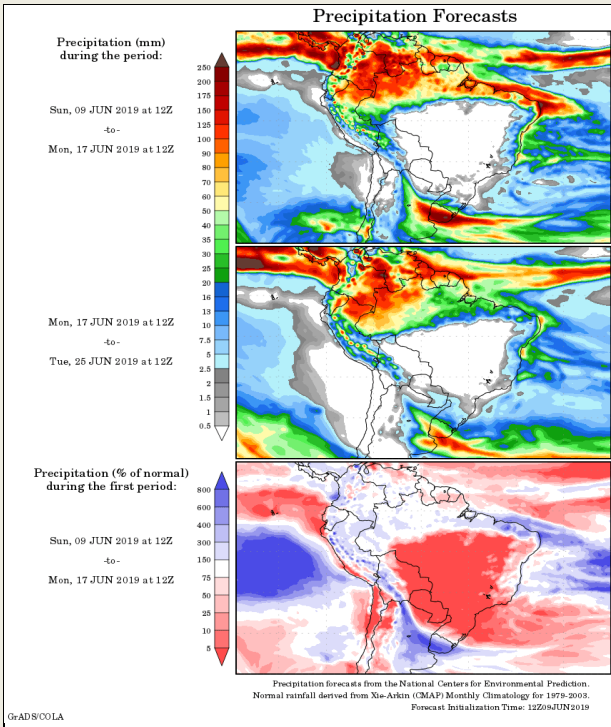
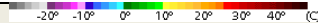
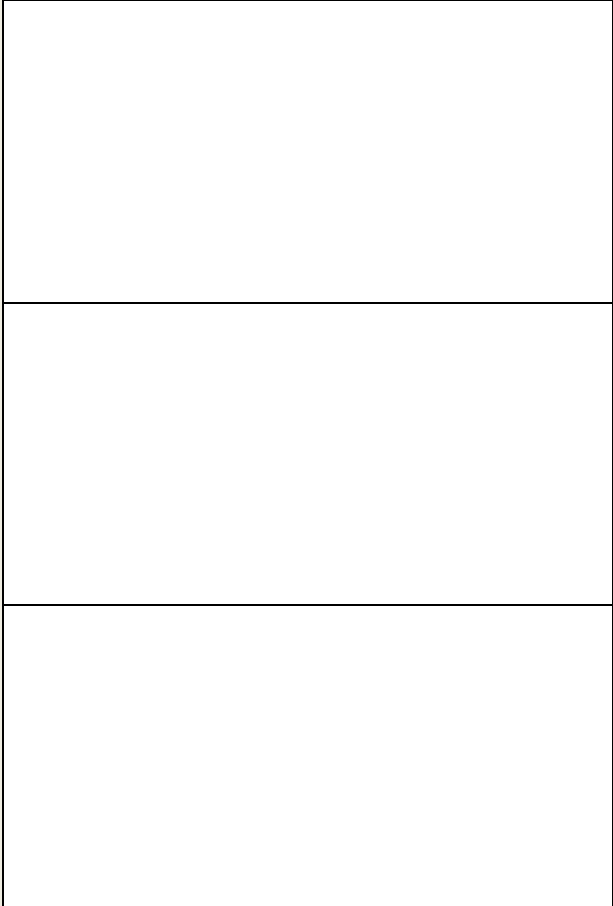
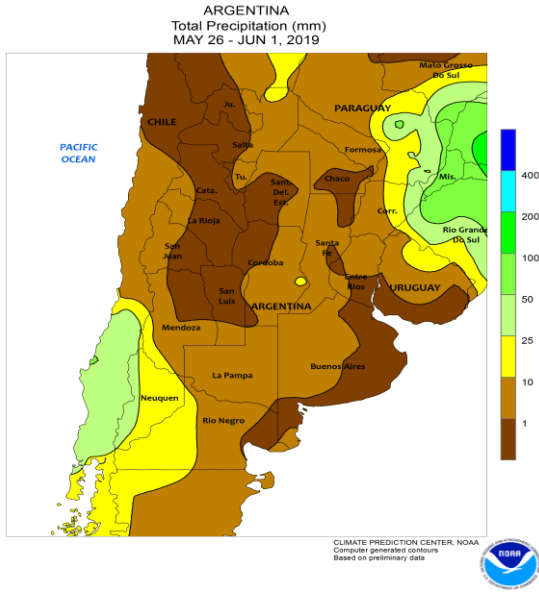
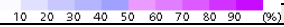

South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Brazil and Paraguay will see a restricted rainfall pattern most often during the next two weeks and good harvest progress should be made with some exceptions in the south starting Tuesday. Showers will return to far southern Brazil Tuesday and will continue through June 19 causing interruptions to fieldwork. Rain will be light to moderate most often with a few clusters of heavy rain.

ARGENTINA: Argentina will see little rain of significance through Saturday and fieldwork should advance well before rain increases Sunday into next Thursday. The rain will interrupt fieldwork while keeping soil conditions favorable in many winter wheat areas. Showers will increase in the southeast Sunday and shower activity will expand next week leaving much of the country with favorable soil conditions.

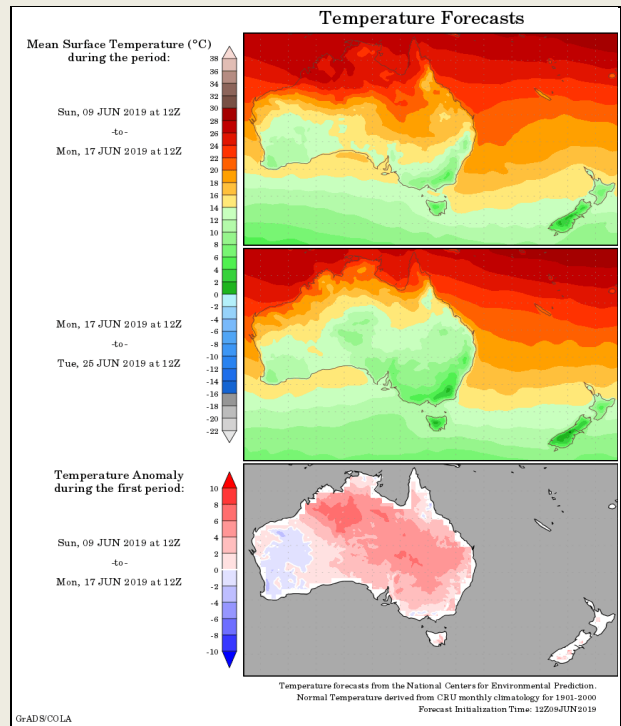
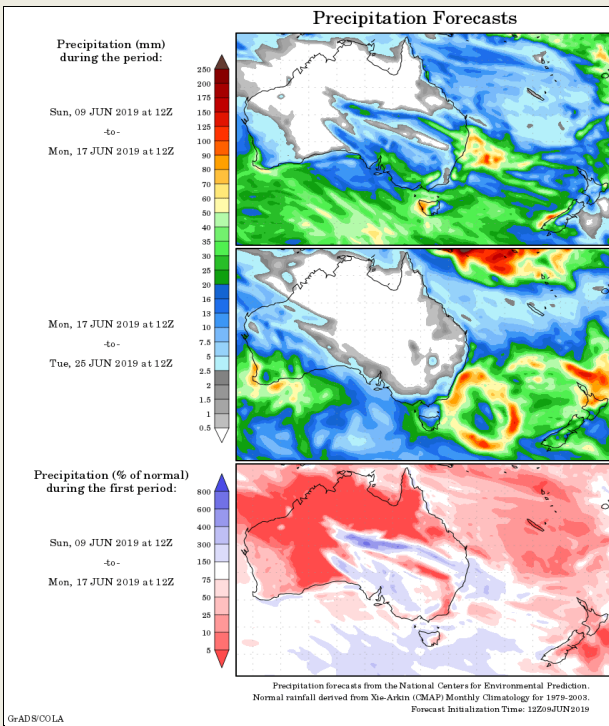
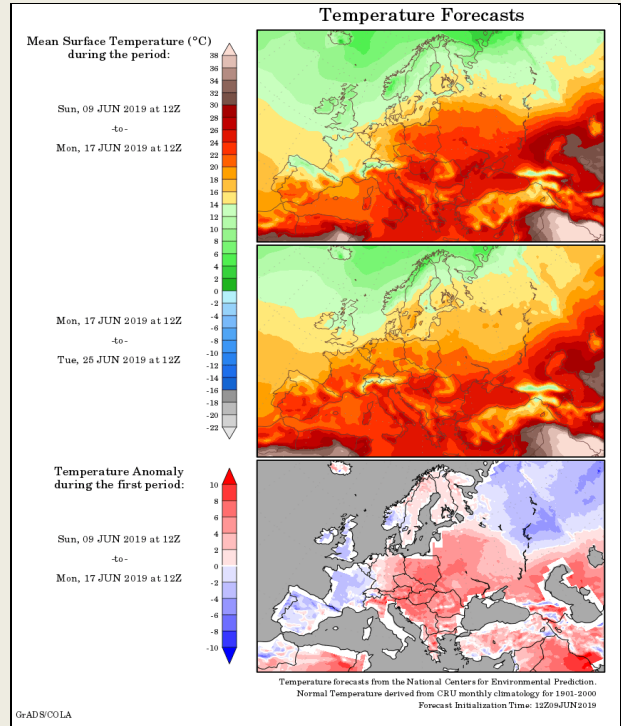
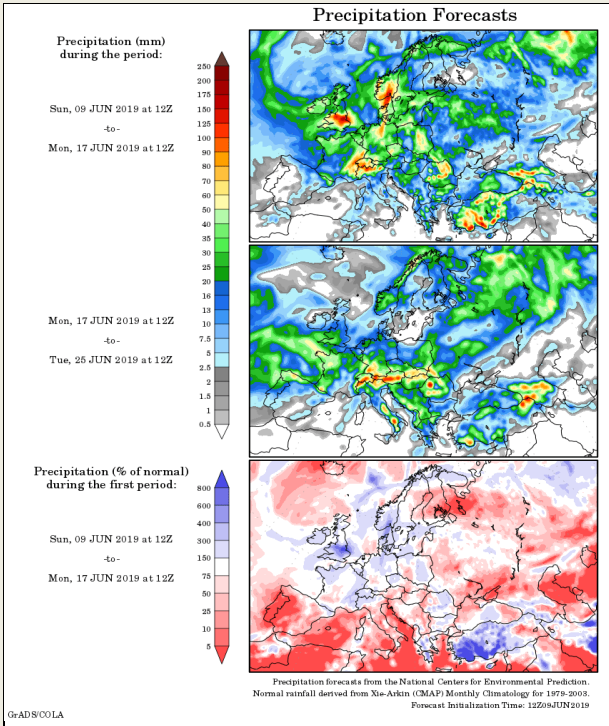

EUROPE: Rain will be frequent over the U.K., France, Switzerland and north Italy through Germany into Scandinavia and Poland. Frequent rounds of precipitation will occur. Strong to severe thunderstorms and some heavy rain at times throughout the region, but should move around throughout the week. Otherwise, most of the precipitation will be light.

AUSTRALIA: Precipitation will return to most of Australia during the coming week. However, dry weather will prevail over northern New South Wales and south Queensland and concern over dryness crop stress will continue. Rain will be greatest over Western Australia as well as northern Queensland and the southeast corner of the nation. Several rounds of precipitation will occur in Western Australia. Precipitation will continue today with lingering showers into this weekend. Another increase in precipitation will occur Monday.
