
United States of America - Weather


U.S. MIDWEST: Heavy rain and some flooding occurred in the southwestern Corn Belt during the weekend with moderate to heavy rain and local flooding from central lowa to central and southern Illinois, southwestern Indiana, and western through interior eastern Kentucky. Large parts of Michigan and much of Ohio were dry during the weekend and some planting likely occurred while rain fell on most of the remainder of the Midwest and some planting likely occurred around the precipitation. Many areas will have opportunities for planting today before rain increases this weekend into next week and slows fieldwork in much of the region.


U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The southern Delta into the southern half of Alabama and northern


Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather


EUROPE: Restricted precipitation and hot temperatures will occur from Spain into France into the U.K. Italy, Germany, Denmark, the Czech Republic and Poland this week. Drying will occur this week and firming of soil conditions will occur throughout the region and some crop stress may evolve later this week. Daily highs will vary in the upper 80s and 90s most often with extremes just exceeding 100 Fahrenheit this week. The hottest conditions will occur over west-central France Tuesday into Saturday when highs will vary in the 90s and exceed 100 Fahrenheit most often. Any moisture that occurs will be brief and erratic and lost quickly to evanoration.

AUSTRALIA: Precipitation will continue to impact Western Australia and the southeast corner of the nation this week. The moisture will continue to support improvements in soil moisture and crop conditions in Western Australia, but the best conditions will continue in the southeast corner of the nation.
