




# South Africa - Weather

- Late season harvesting will advance swiftly between the periods of rain
- Net drying is still expected for much of the country
- Rainfall through early next week will generally be too light to significantly impact winter wheat in Western Cape, Free State, and neighboring production areas
- o Other than brief periods of light rain, Western Cape has been too dry to support aggressive establishment and growth this season
- o Free State initially saw timely rain as the crops were getting into the ground before drying down in more recent weeks
- o There is still time for better rain to improve crop prospects, though most areas will need a good shot of rain to support better development
- Some of the eastern crop is becoming semi-dormant


SOUTH AFRICA

June 9 - 15, 2019




GFS 50KM MINIMUM TEMPERATURE (C)  
INIT: 18UTC 25JUN19 VALID: WED 26 JUN 2019




GFS 50KM MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE (C)  
INIT: 18UTC 25JUN19 VALID: WED 26 JUN 2019




GFS 50KM POSSIBLE 24-HOUR RAINFALL (mm)









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# United States of America - Weather

**U.S. MIDWEST:** Warmer temperatures along with less frequent and lighter rain will occur across the Midwest during the next two weeks inducing beneficial drying and better conditions for crop development. Enough rain should fall to prevent significant drying with the rain also likely great enough to limit late planting in the wetter areas. Although temperatures will warm, excessive heat is not expected through at least the next ten days; high humidity will keep nighttime temperatures above normal

**U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST:** The Delta and the Southeast will see a good mix of rain and sunshine during the next two weeks with enough rain likely to maintain favorable conditions for most crops. Some exceptions may occur in portions of southern Georgia where soil moisture has not been completely restored. Water levels and flooding along the Mississippi River will gradually increase in the north through early next week while the south sees gradual improvements in flood conditions during the next week.




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## South America - Weather

**BRAZIL:** The weather pattern in Brazil and Paraguay not change much through the next two weeks and a restricted rainfall pattern will be in place most often with a few rounds of showers and thunderstorms in the south and regular rounds of showers in the northeast near the coast. Winter wheat will benefit from the moisture

**ARGENTINA:** Argentina will see a restricted rainfall pattern most often through the next two weeks and planting of winter wheat and harvesting of summer crops should advance well overall. The drier areas in southwestern Argentina remain in need of greater rain to improve conditions for winter wheat.


ARGENTINA

June 9 - 15, 2019











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## Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

**EUROPE:** Cooler temperatures and increased rainfall will progress through western Russia this week. The greatest rainfall will eventually reach into the middle and upper Volga Basin and help provide relief to drying that has been impacting the region.

**AUSTRALIA:** Precipitation will continue to impact Western Australia and the southeast corner of the nation this week. The moisture will continue to support improvements in soil moisture and crop conditions in Western Australia, but the best conditions will continue in the southeast corner of the nation. Warmer than usual temperatures will occur this week excepting the southwest and southeast corners of the nation.



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
