
United States of America - Weather


U.S. MIDWEST: Today's forecast is not as wet through Saturday and most of the Midwest will be dry during 3 of those 4 days allowing for good planting progress by Saturday and for the remainder of the next two weeks as less time will be needed to dry down fields before planting can occur . An exception will be from most of eastern Kansas to northcentral and central to eastern Missouri to southern Indiana and Kentucky where rain will be most frequent.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: A period of wet weather will begin today and will continue through Monday in the Delta and Tuesday in the Southeast. o The rain will provide a critical boost in soil moisture in the drier areas of the Southeast while portions of the Delta that have dried down recently will also benefit, but planting delays and an increase in flooding will result as well. The driest areas in the Southeast will see notable improvements in crop conditions and as long as follow up rain occurs soon conditions for crops should be favorable.

South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Brazil and Paraguay will see a restricted rainfall pattern most often during the next two weeks with some exceptions in the south starting next week. Showers will return to far southern Brazil Tuesday and will continue through the following Tuesday causing interruptions to fieldwork. Rain will be light to moderate most often.

ARGENTINA. Argentina will see little rain of significance through Saturday and fieldwork should advance well before rain increases Sunday into next week. The rain will interrupt fieldwork in many areas while keeping soil conditions favorable for many winter wheat areas. Showers will increase in the southeast Sunday and will expand across the region next week and much of the country will see multiple rounds of rain and will be left with favorable soil conditions by June 17. The southwest will be driest and parts of this region will miss out on rain and would benefit from a boost in soil moisture.


Total Precipitation (mm)




Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather


EUROPE: Moist conditions will continue over southeast Europe the next couple of days. Rain showers and thunderstorms will linger over Romania and Bulgaria into west Ukraine and Belarus the remainder of the week through the weekend and concern over flooding will continue.

AUSTRALIA: Precipitation will return to Western Australia, central Queensland and eventually southeast Australia this week. The moisture will bolster soil moisture conditions in Western Australia, and the upper east coast into the central coast of Queensland a few surrounding interior northern production areas of Queensland. The return of precipitation later this week in the southeast will maintain moist conditions.
