

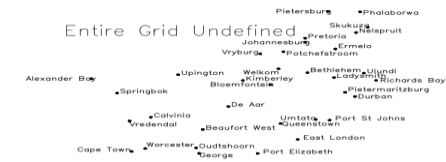

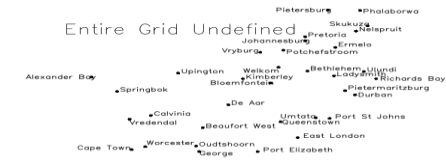
South Africa - Weather

- Seasonably dry weather will dominate South Africa over the next week to ten days. Rain will occur infrequently and will mostly impact coastal areas
- Net drying is expected in most crop areas favoring cotton and other late season crop maturation and harvesting
- Greater rain is needed in wheat, barley and canola areas especially in the west
- Temperatures will be warmer than usual with highs in the 60s and 70s west and 70s and 80s east. A few extremes over 90 will be possible, but not common. Low temperatures will be in the 30s and 40s most often in interior parts of the nation while in the 40s and 50s in coastal areas.

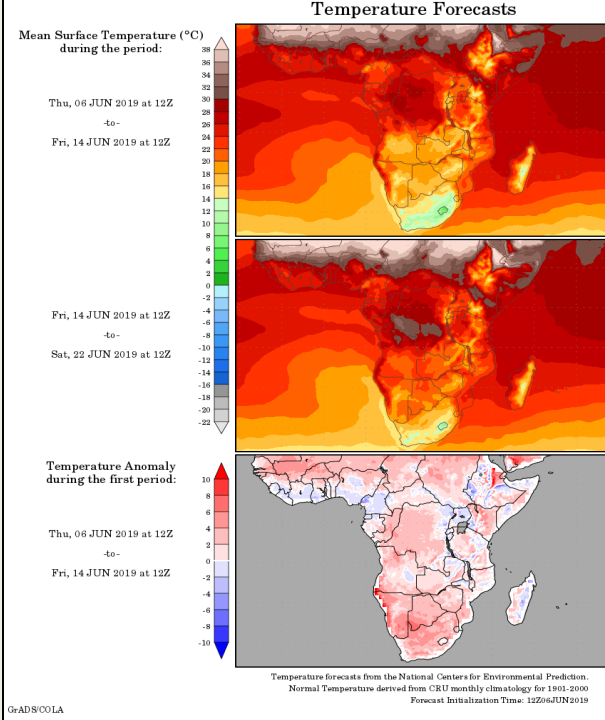
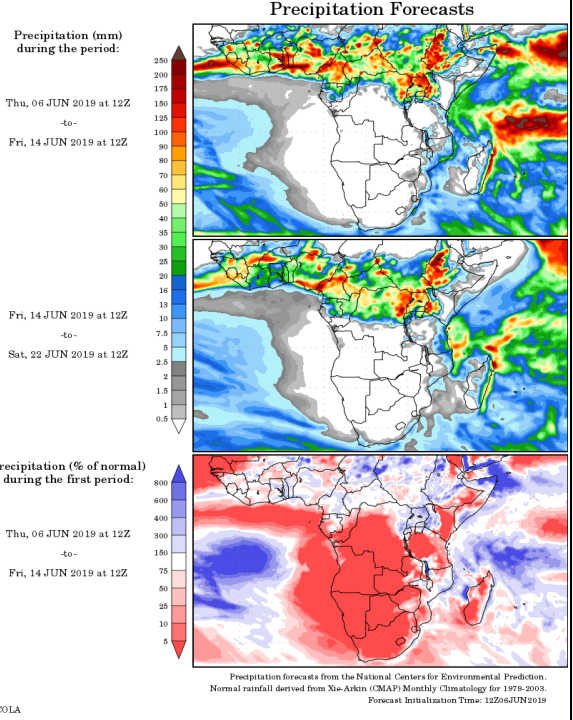
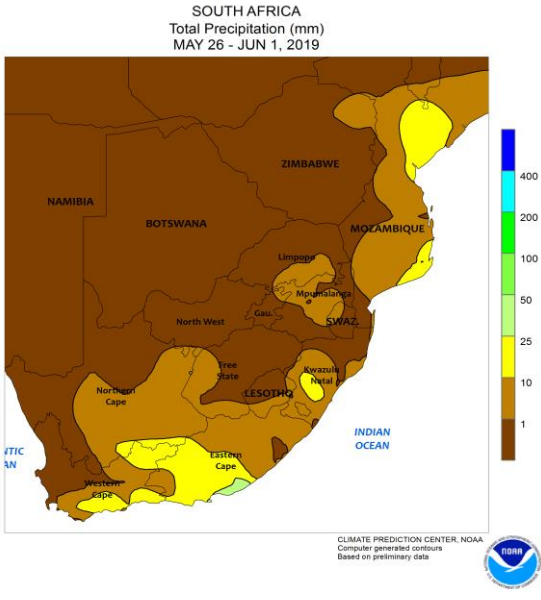
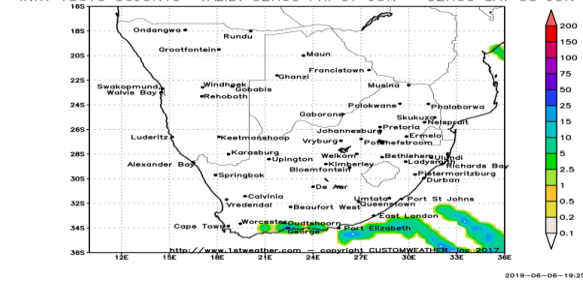
GFS 50KM MINIMUM TEMPERATURE (C)

INIT: 18UTC 06JUN19 VALID: 02H00 FRI 07 JUN - 02H00 SAT 08 JUN

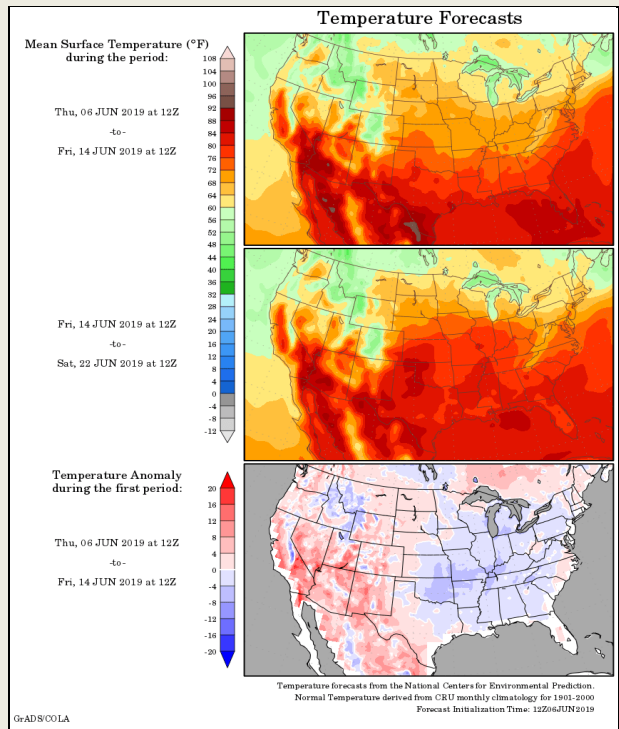
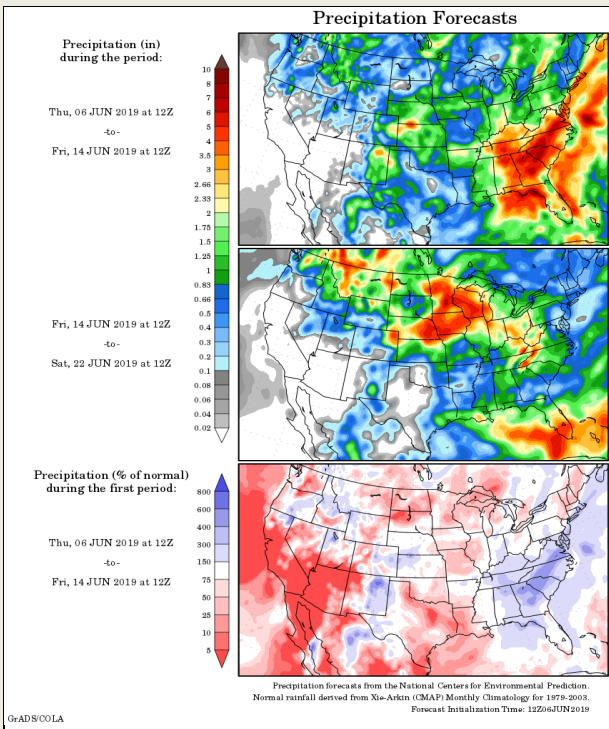
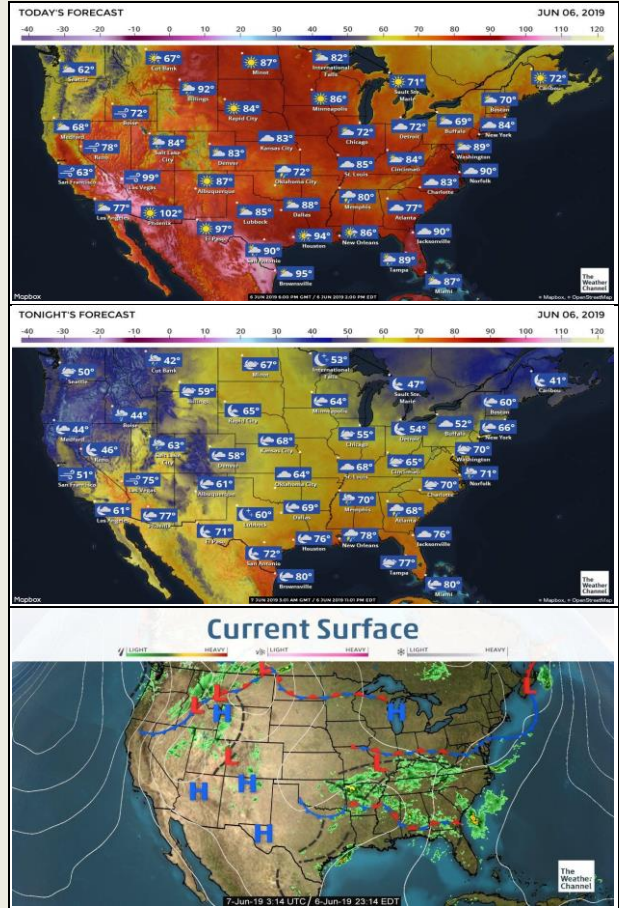
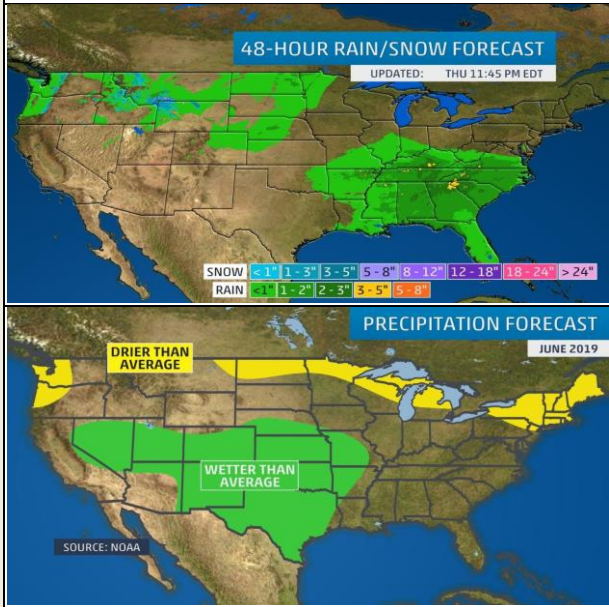

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Much of the Midwest will see little to no rain and good planting progress into Saturday before rain increases Saturday afternoon and evening causing mostly temporary interruptions to fieldwork. An exception will be from most of eastern Kansas to west-central and southern Indiana and Kentucky where regular rounds of showers will occur. Isolated to scattered showers will occur Monday into next Thursday and with the recent drying and drying expected through Saturday most areas should see fieldwork advance well around the showers.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The rain will provide a critical boost in soil moisture in the drier areas of the Southeast while portions of the Delta that have dried down recently will also benefit, but planting delays and an increase in flooding will result as well. The driest areas in the Southeast will see notable improvements in soil moisture and crop conditions and as long as timely rain continues late this month and July conditions for crops will be favorable.

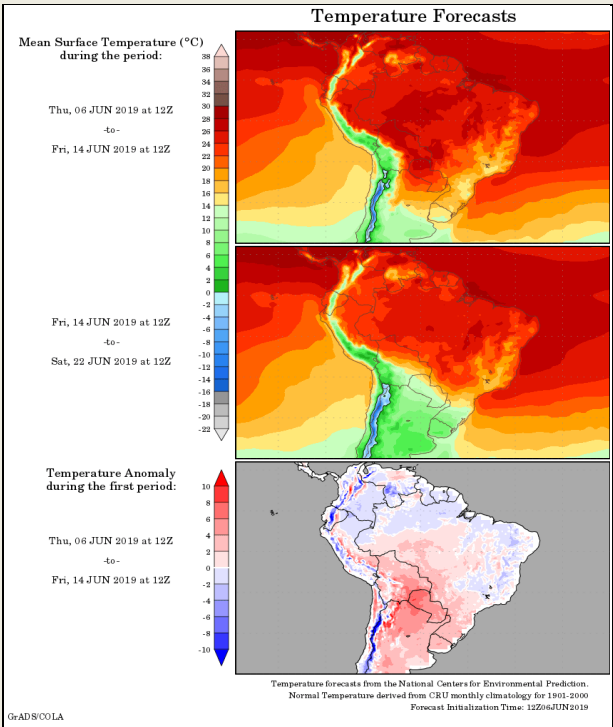
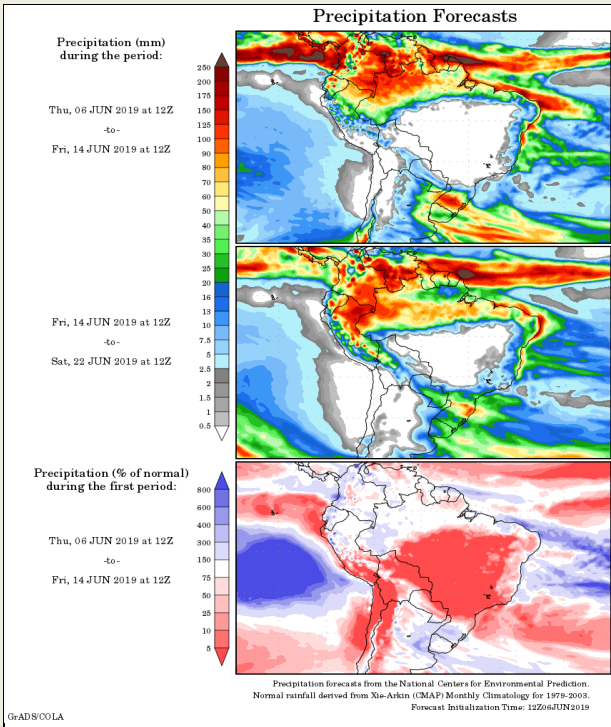
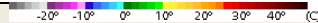
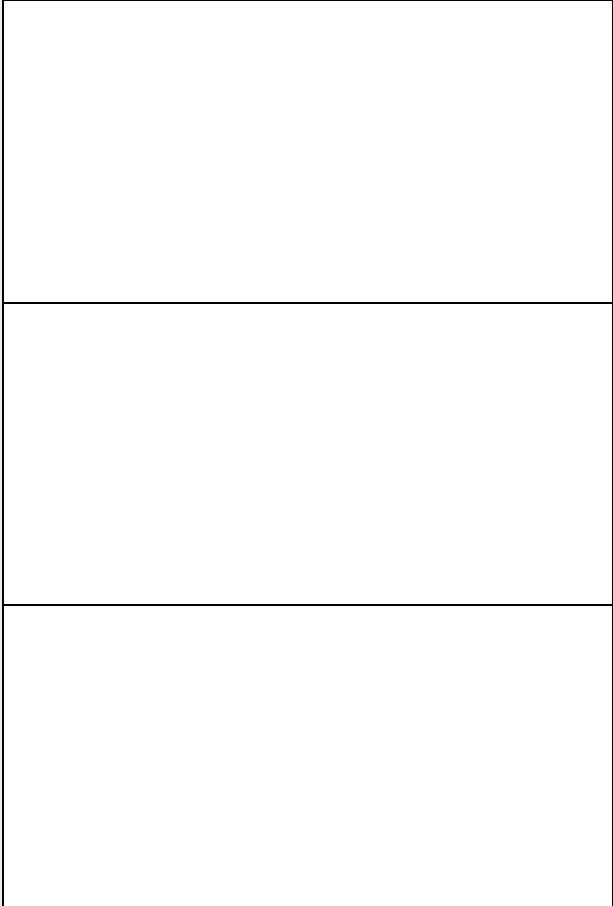
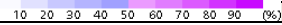
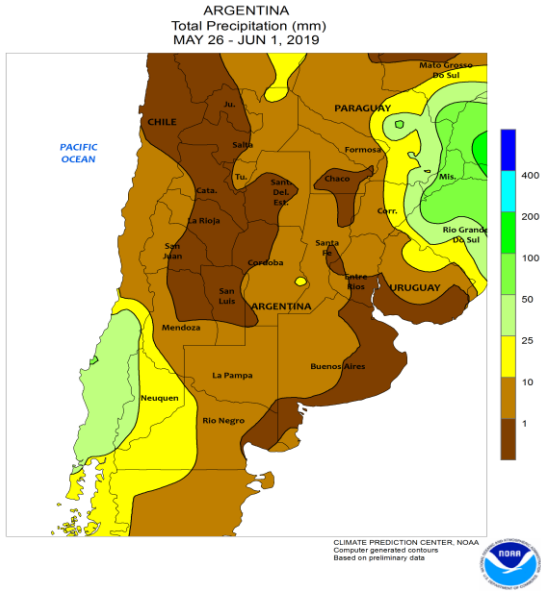

BRAZIL: Brazil and Paraguay will see a restricted rainfall pattern most often during the next two weeks and good harvest progress should be made with some exceptions in the south starting next week. Showers will return to far southern Brazil Tuesday and will continue through the following Saturday causing interruptions to fieldwork.

ARGENTINA: Argentina will see little rain of significance through Saturday and fieldwork should advance well before rain increases Sunday into next Thursday. The rain will interrupt fieldwork while keeping soil conditions favorable in many winter wheat areas.

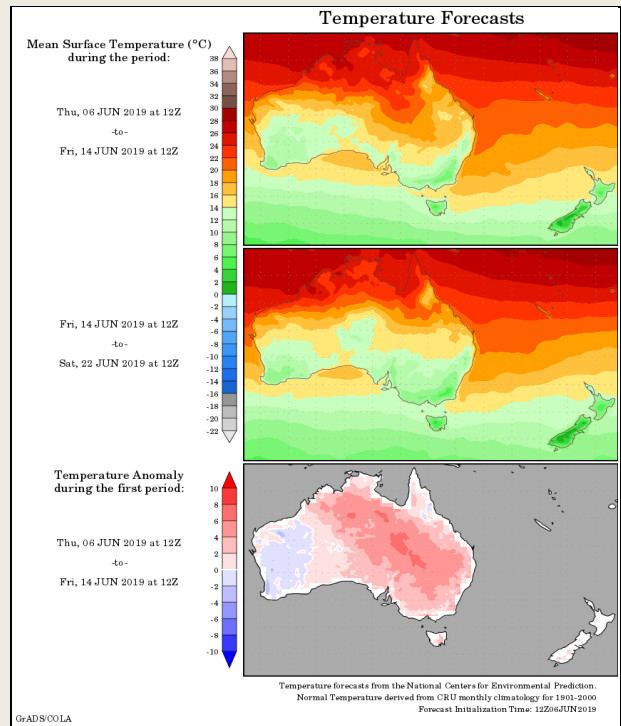
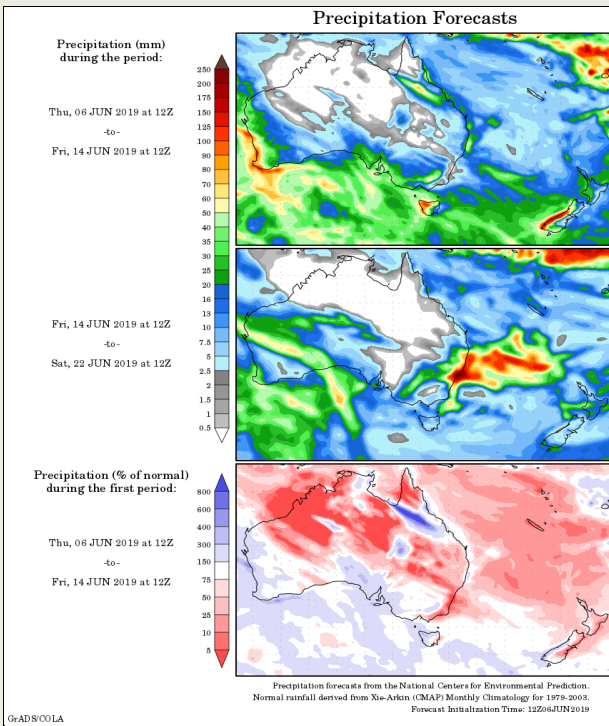
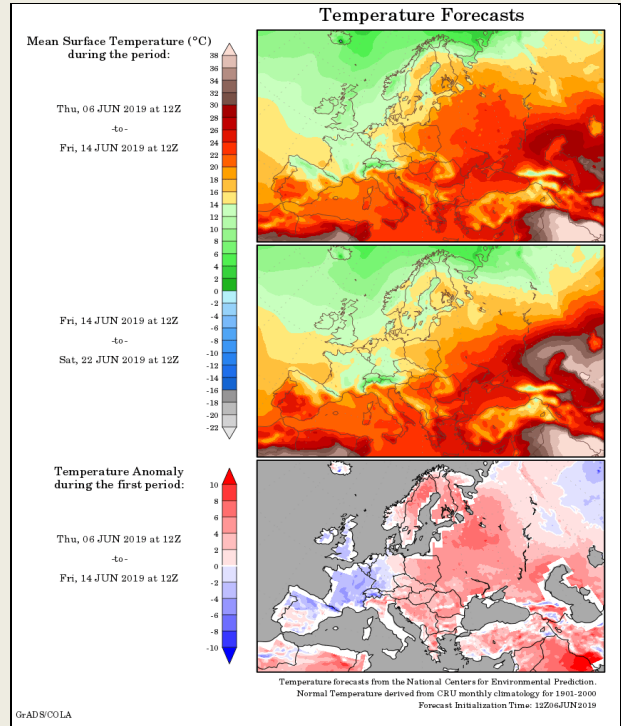
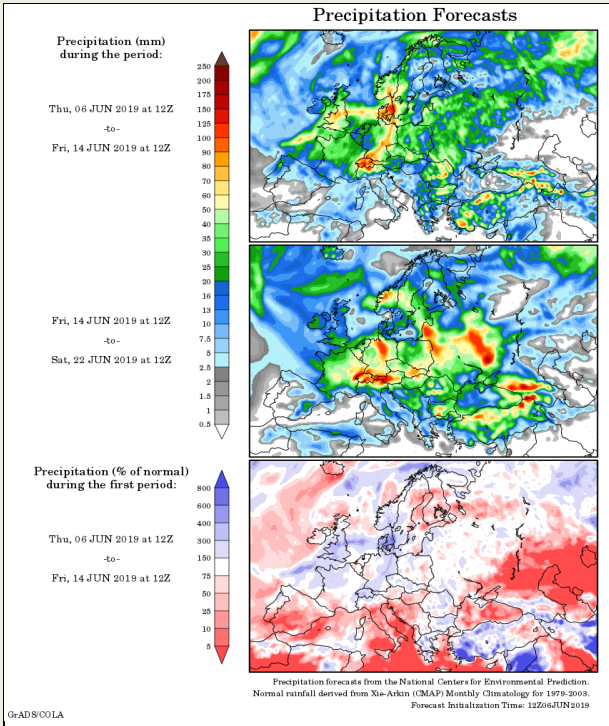

EUROPE: Rain will be frequent over the U.K., France through Germany into Scandinavia and Poland. Frequent rounds of precipitation will occur. Heavy rain will occur in parts of France through Belgium, the Netherlands and northwest Germany today as well as northwest. France into the south U.K. late Thursday into Friday and return to central Europe including Germany during the middle of next week. Otherwise, most of the precipitation will be light.

AUSTRALIA: Precipitation will return to most of Australia during the coming week. However, dryness will prevail over northern New South Wales and south Queensland and concern over crop stress will continue. Rain will be greatest over Western Australia today through early next week as well as northern Queensland into the central coast today into Saturday. Several rounds of precipitation will occur in Western Australia. Precipitation will increase today into Friday with lingering showers this weekend. Another increase in precipitation will occur early next week.
