

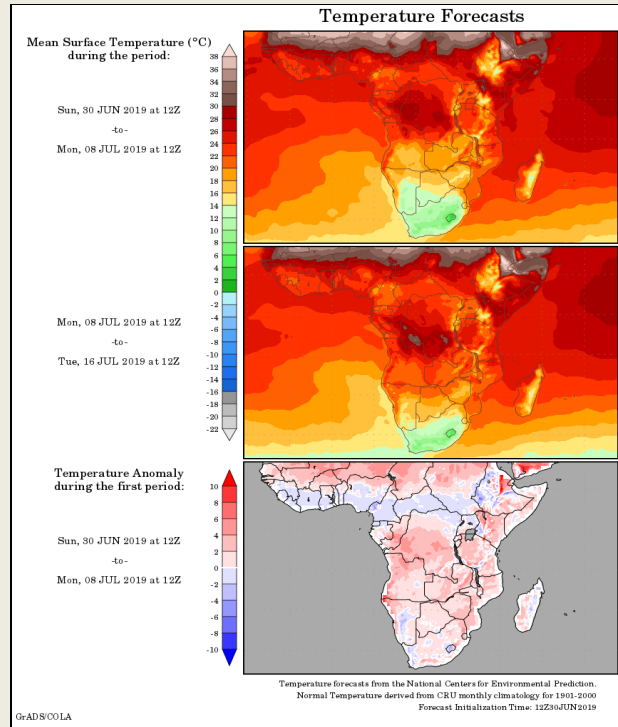
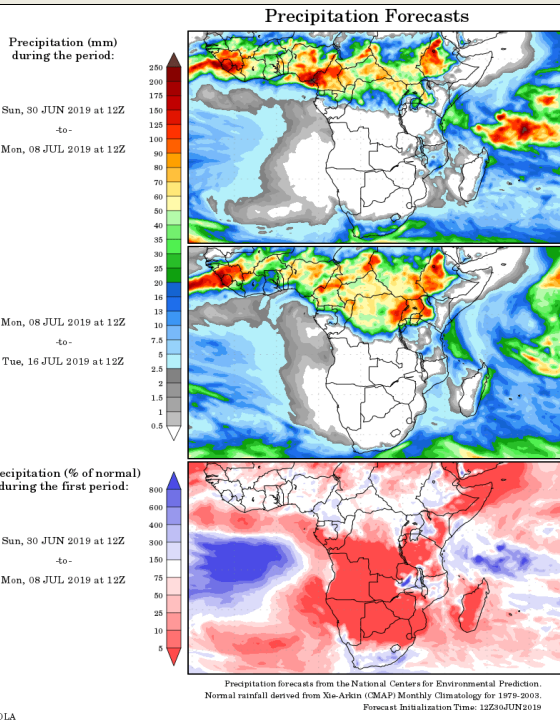
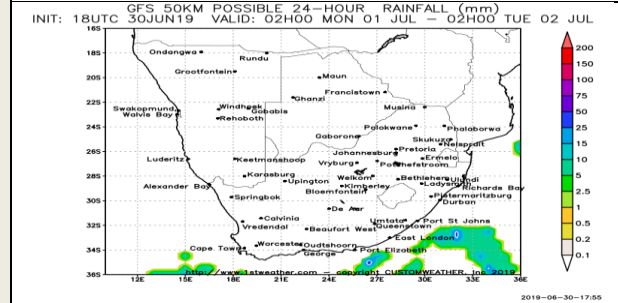
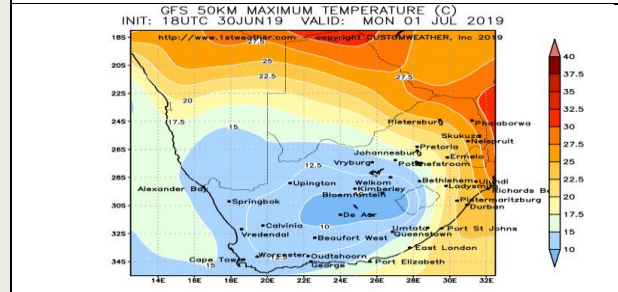
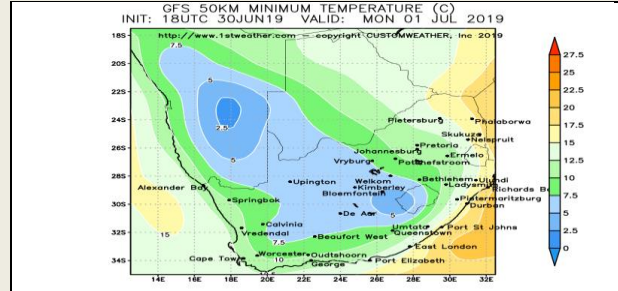
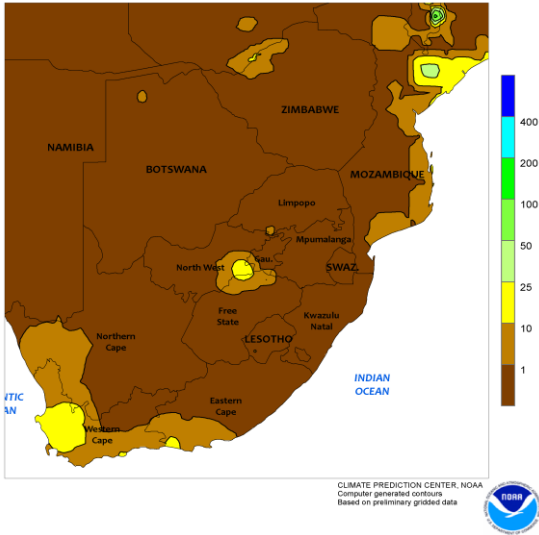


Weather Report

South Africa - Weather

- Any harvesting not yet complete will advance swiftly
- The lack of rain and warm weather will continue to dry down the soil during the next two weeks
- o Winter wheat will remain dormant or semi-dormant in much of Free State and neighboring production areas
- Conditions were mostly favorable earlier this year as the crop was being planted and establishing
- A good shot of rain will otherwise be needed to support better development later this year
- o Recent rainfall and periods of light rain in the coming days will slightly bolster soil moisture in portions of Western Cape
- o Additional rainfall will still be needed to support ideal growth

June 16 - 22, 2019

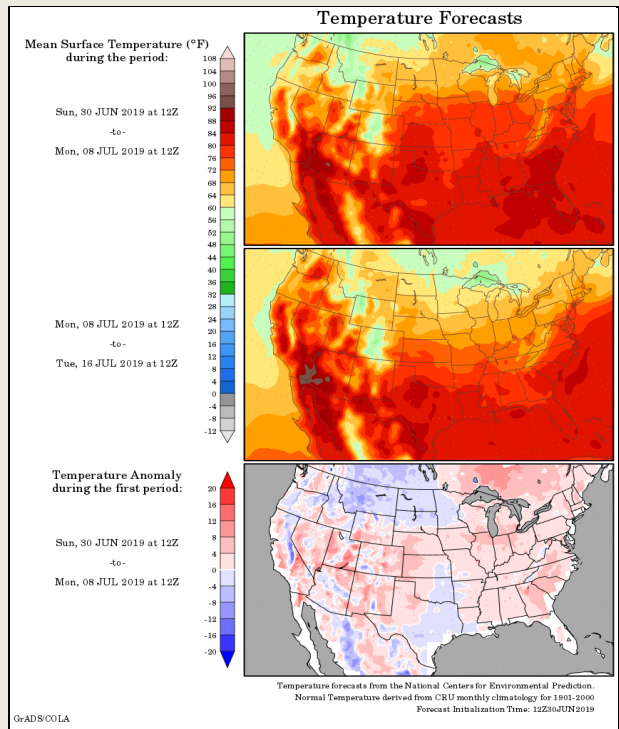
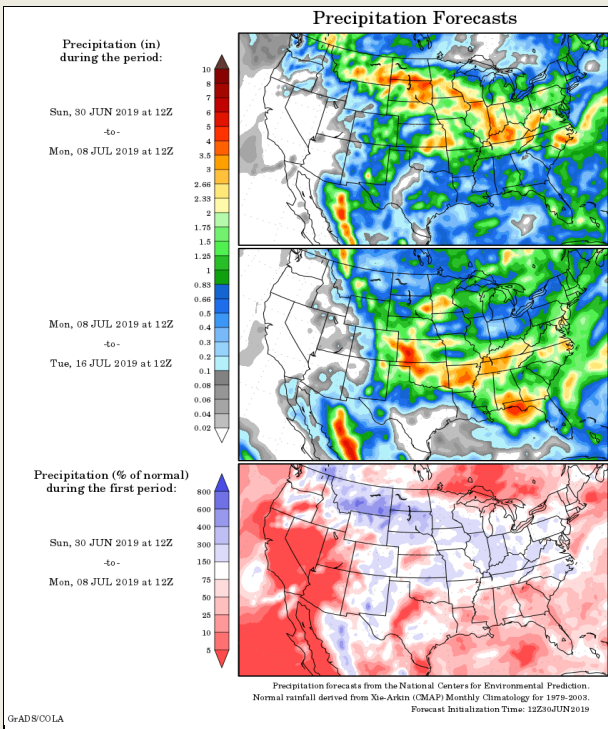
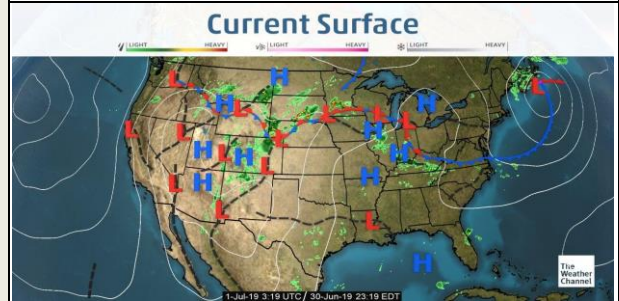
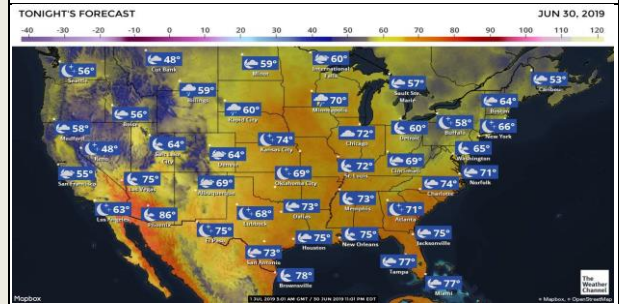
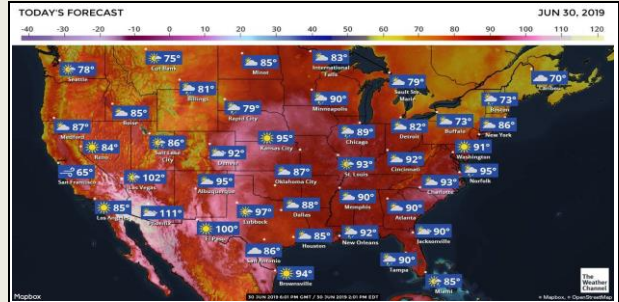
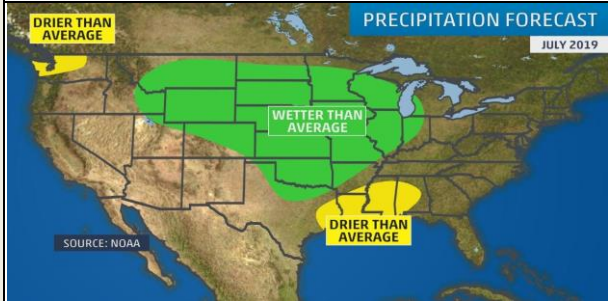

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: The Midwest will see highly favorable conditions for crop development through the next two weeks as a good mix of rain and sunshine is expected while temperatures are seasonable most often. Many areas will dry down overall, but with abundant soil moisture in place the drying will be beneficial in most areas. Although net drying will be common, rain will be well-distributed preventing significant drying in much of the region.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will see a seasonable pattern of isolated to scattered showers each day during the next two weeks that will slow drying rates and maintain favorable conditions for crops in most areas while the remaining dry pockets in southern Alabama and southern Georgia may see rising levels of crop stress. Water levels and flooding along the Mississippi River will not change much in the north through early next week before improvements occur during the middle to late part of the week while the south sees gradual improvements in flood conditions during the next week.

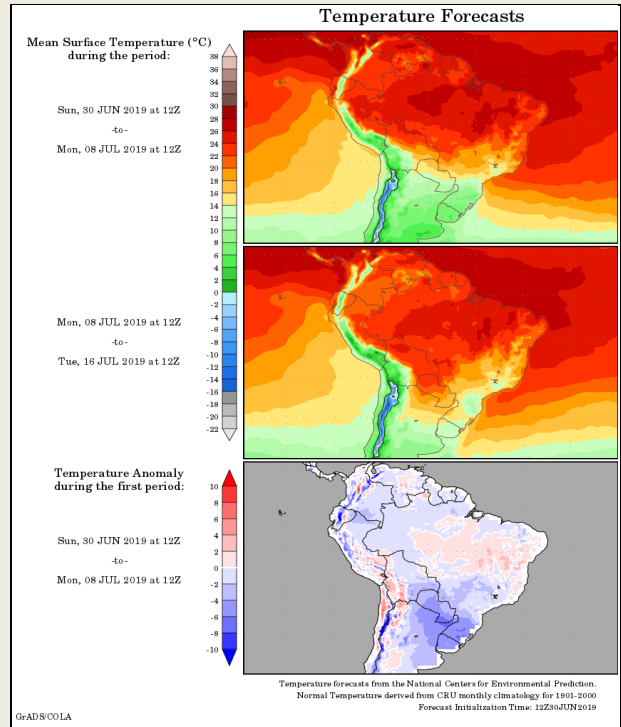
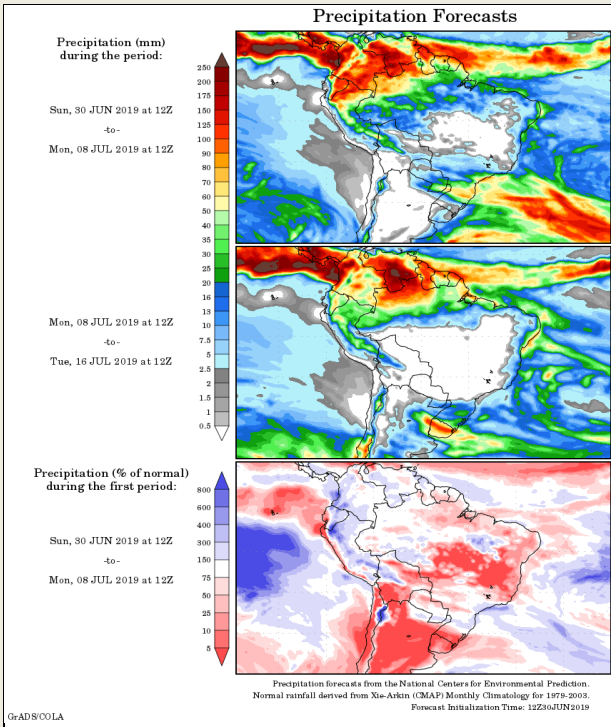
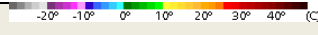
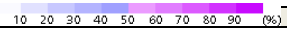
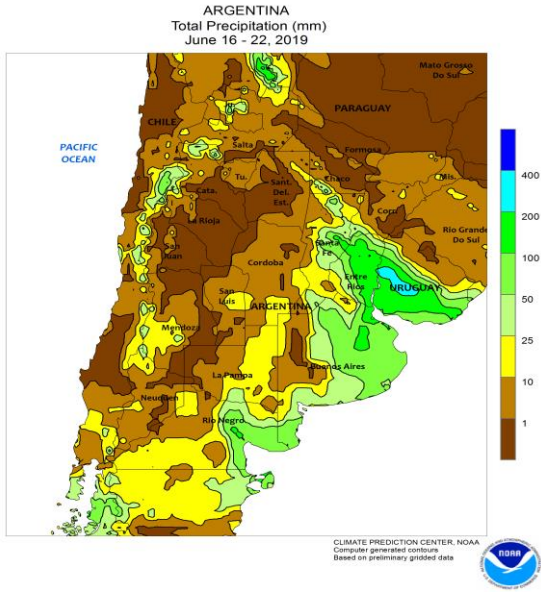

South America - Weather

BRAZIL: The weather pattern in Brazil and Paraguay not change much through the next two weeks and a restricted rainfall pattern will be in place most often with a few rounds of showers and thunderstorms in the south and regular rounds of light showers in the northeast near the coast.

ARGENTINA: Argentina will see a restricted rainfall pattern most often through the next two weeks and planting of winter wheat and harvesting of summer crops should advance well overall. The drier areas in southwestern Argentina remain in need of greater rain to improve conditions for winter wheat and little to no rain of significance is expected there for at least the next ten days.

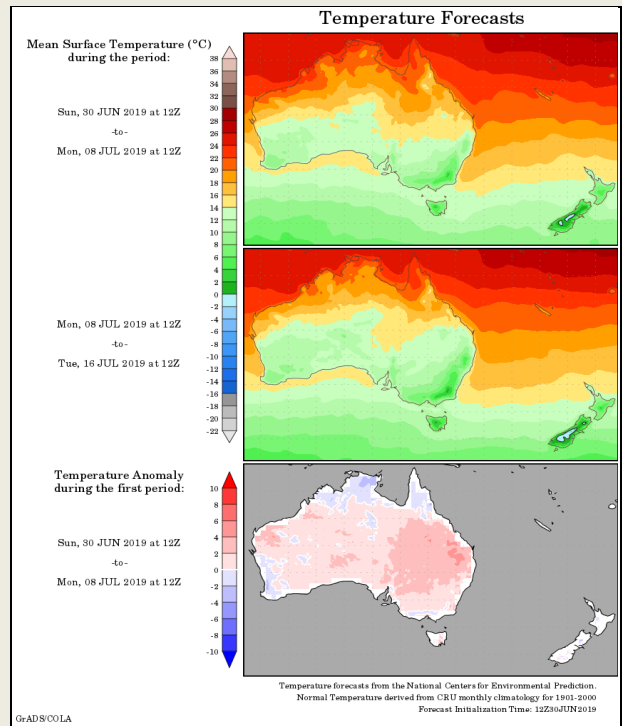
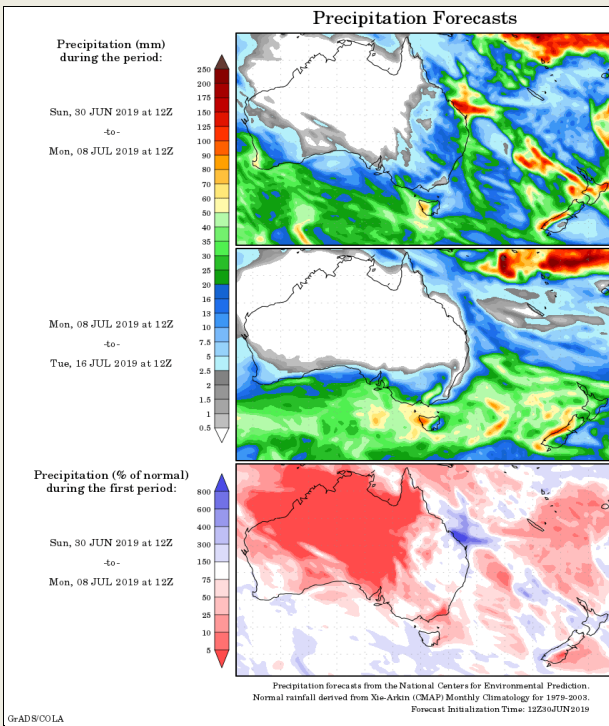
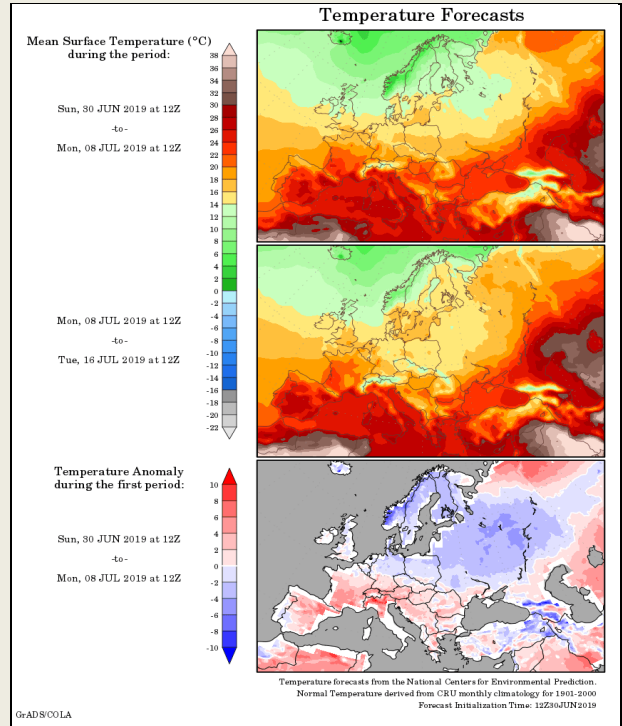
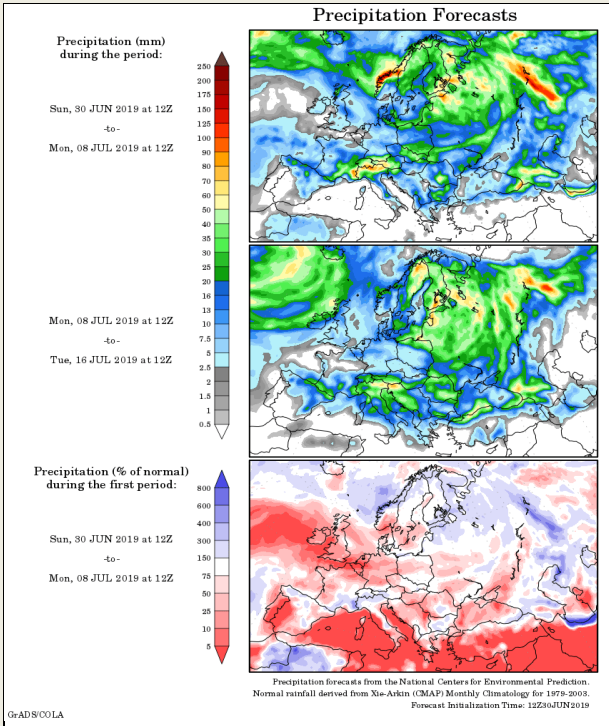

EUROPE: Hot temperatures continued over central Spain through France into north Italy and Austria through Slovakia and the Balkan Region. Near to record breaking heat occurred in portions of northeast Spain into south France, north Italy and into the Balkan Nations.

AUSTRALIA: Precipitation will impact Western Australia as well as southeast Australia this week. Soil moisture conditions will continue to be best over the southeast corner of the nation, especially in Victoria, but precipitation will return to Western Australia Wednesdays into next Friday which will continue to improve conditions. Areas in central to northeast New South Wales into southeast Queensland will remain too dry the coming week to ten days and concerns of additional declines in production will increase in the region.
