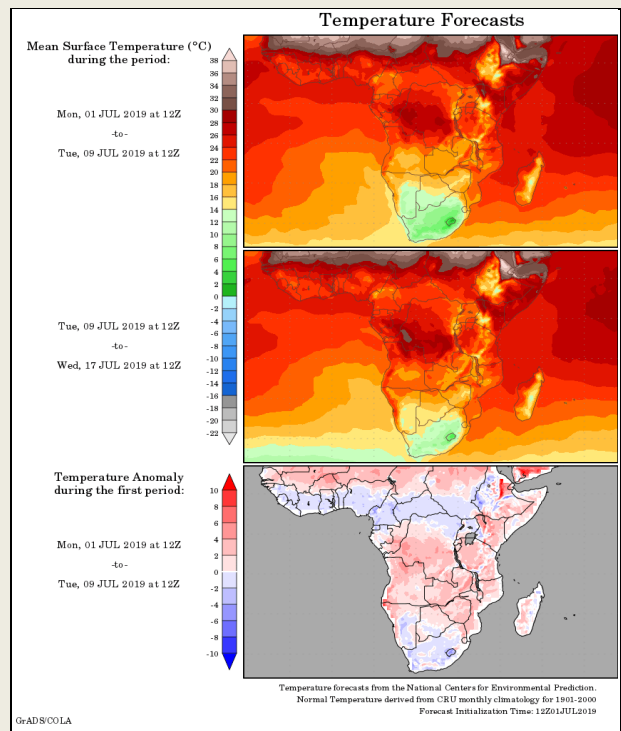
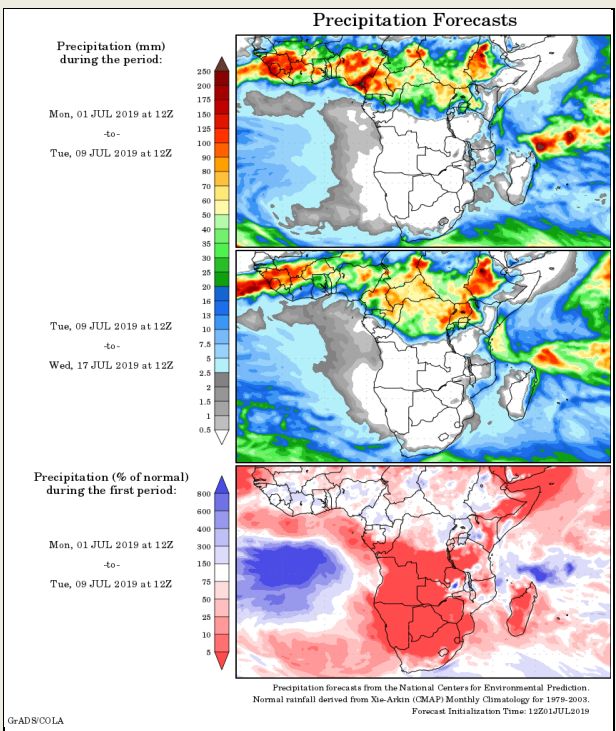
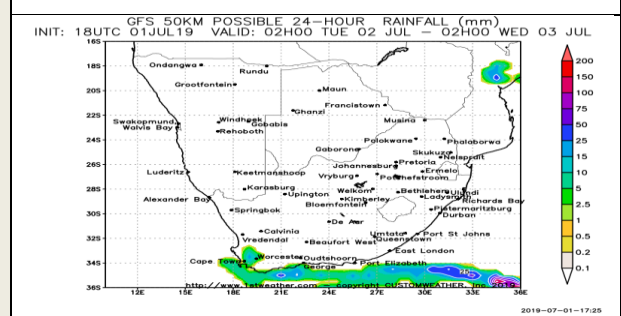
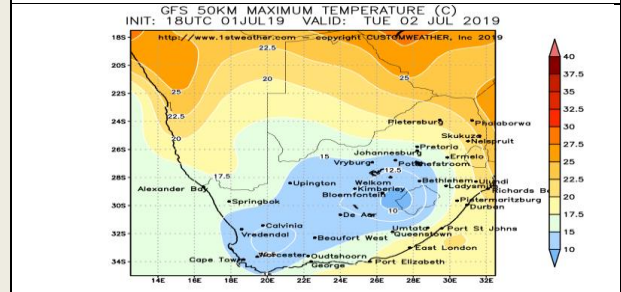
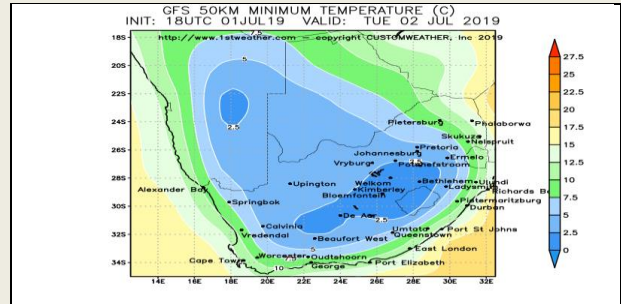
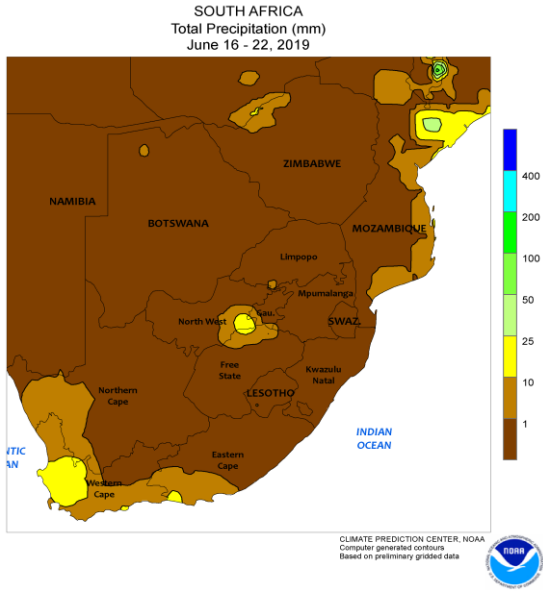




**Weather Report**

South Africa - Weather

- Late season harvesting will advance swiftly
- Net drying is expected for most locations despite the periods of light rain
  - o Winter wheat will remain dormant or semi-dormant in much of Free State and neighboring production areas
  - o Conditions were mostly favorable earlier this year as the crop was being planted and establishing
  - o Timely rain will otherwise be needed later this year
  - o Western Cape has seen several waves of light rain in recent weeks that has helped alleviate some of the dryness and support a better environment for the winter wheat
  - o Additional rainfall is still needed

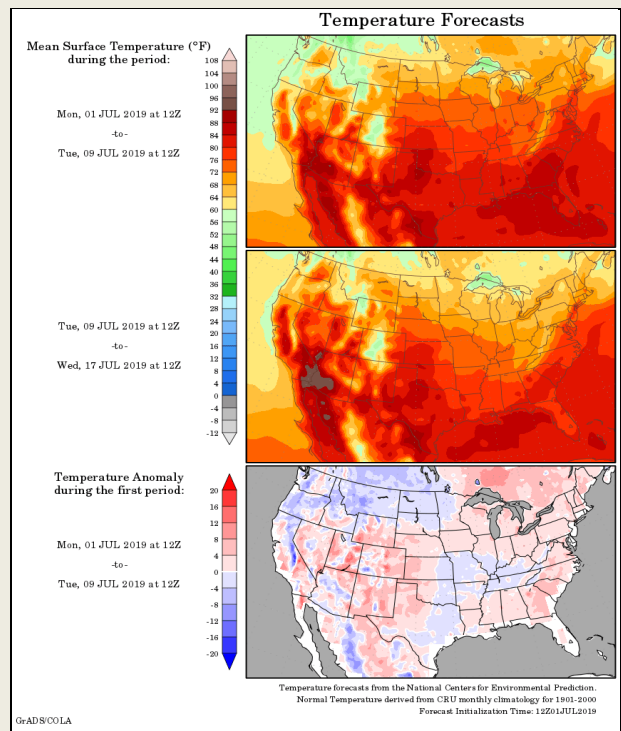
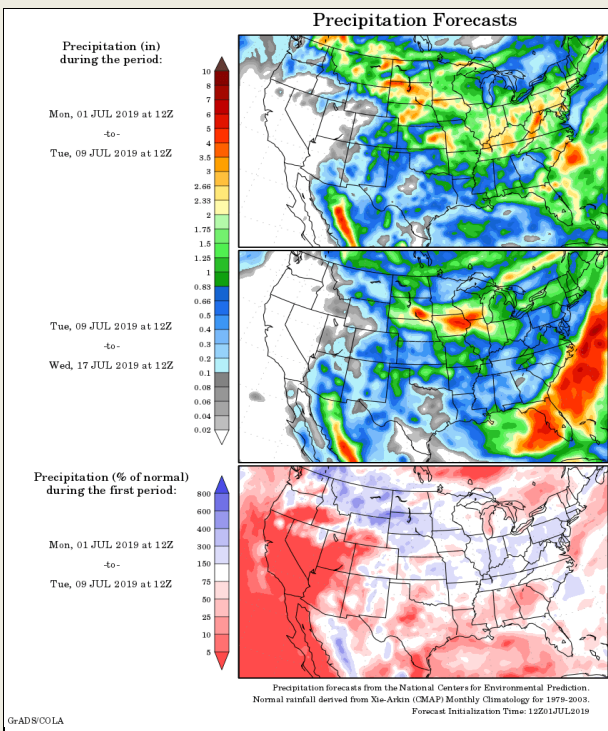
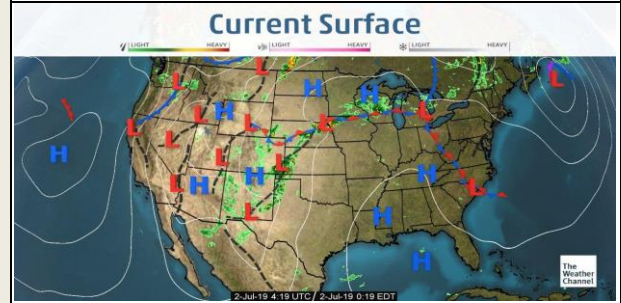
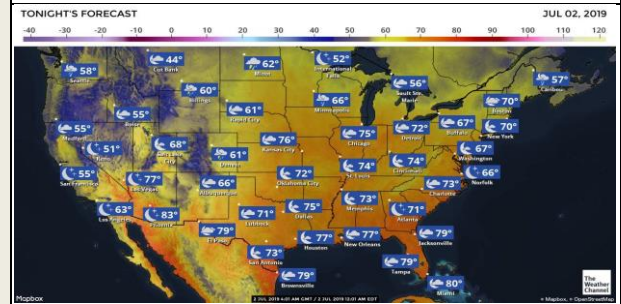
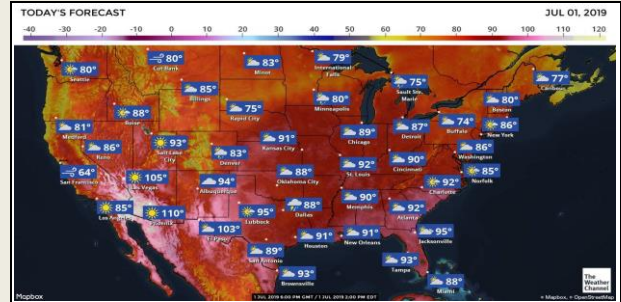
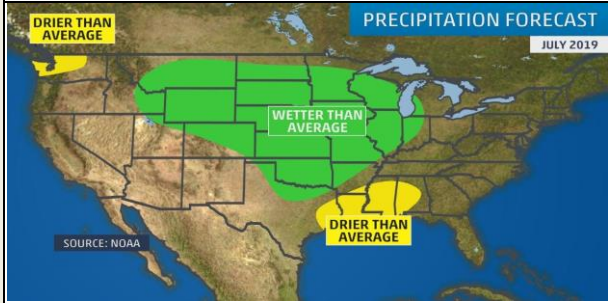

# United States of America - Weather

**U.S. MIDWEST:** The bottom line of highly favorable conditions for crop development through the next two weeks remains in place for the Midwest. A good mix of rain and sunshine will occur and most areas that are still excessively wet will see enough drying time for the soil to dry down and come closer to more normal levels for this time of year. Showers and thunderstorms will develop in at least a part of the Midwest each day through the next ten days with most of the resulting likely to be light with some exceptions from the stronger storms. Although many areas will dry down overall, soil moisture in place today and expected rain will maintain favorable soil conditions.

**U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST:** The Delta and the Southeast will see a seasonable pattern of isolated to scattered showers each day during the next two weeks that will slow drying rates and maintain favorable conditions for crops in most areas. A close watch will continue on the erratic rainfall distribution expected as some areas will receive much more rain than others and the drier areas in southern Alabama and southern Georgia will need follow-up rain soon to prevent significant increases in crop stress.



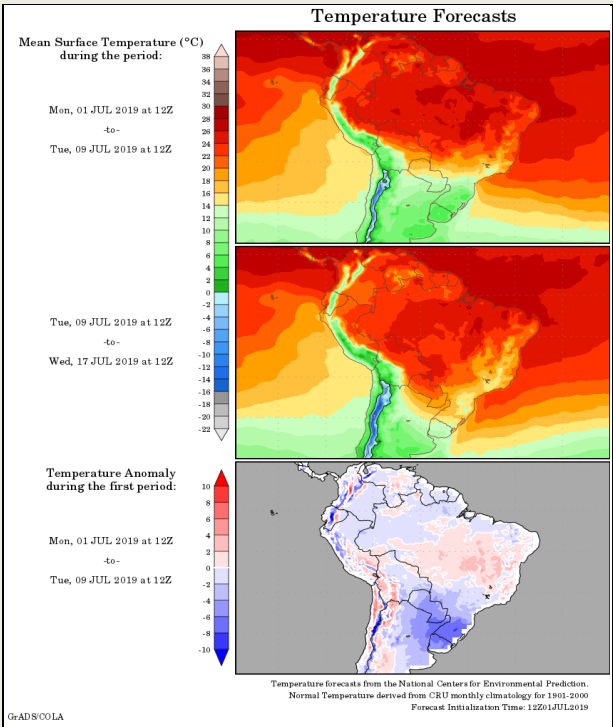
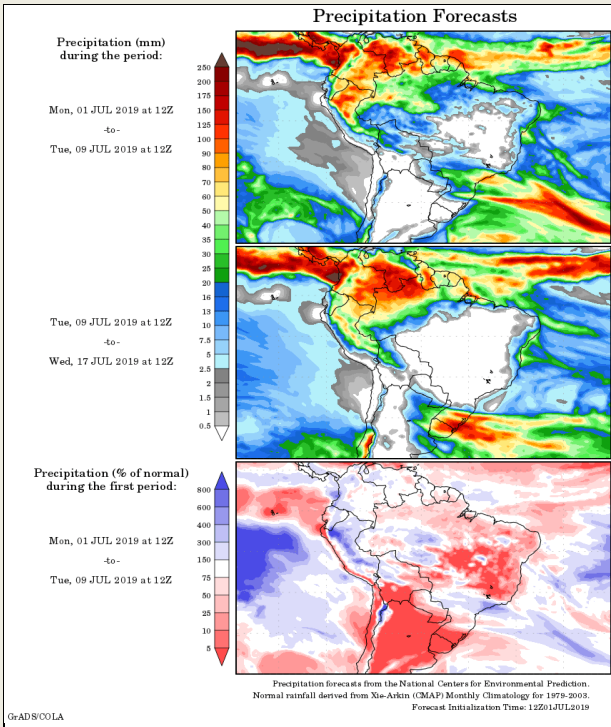
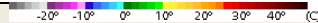
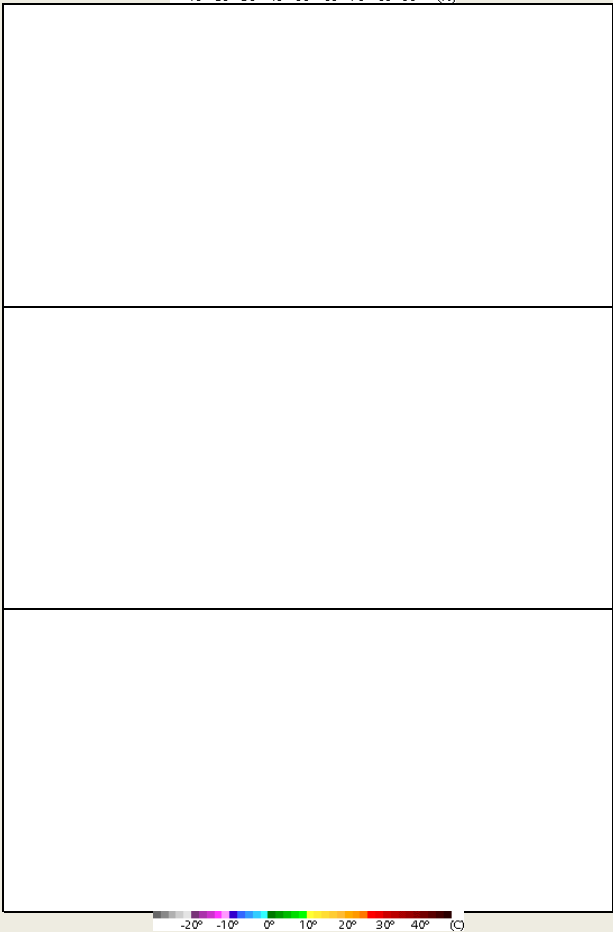
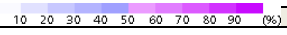
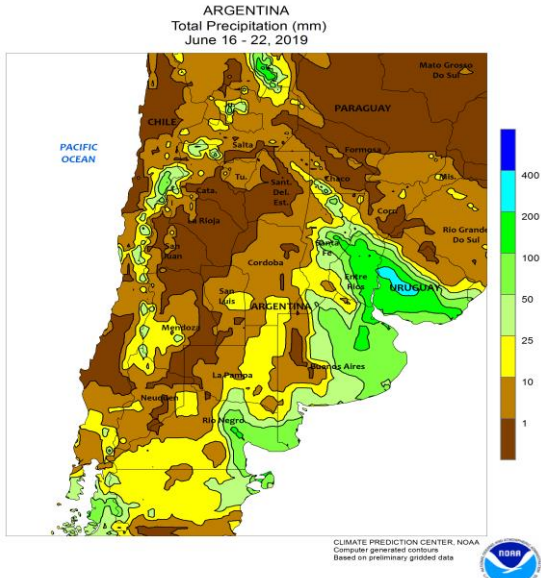

**BRAZIL:** The weather pattern in Brazil and Paraguay not change much through the next two weeks and a restricted rainfall pattern will be in place most often with a few rounds of showers and thunderstorms in the south and regular rounds of light showers in the northeast near the coast. Harvesting should advance well overall

**ARGENTINA:** Argentina will see a restricted rainfall pattern most often through the next two weeks and planting of winter wheat and harvesting of summer crops should advance well overall. The drier areas in southwestern Argentina remain in need of greater rain to improve conditions for winter wheat and little to no rain of significance is expected there for at least the next ten days.

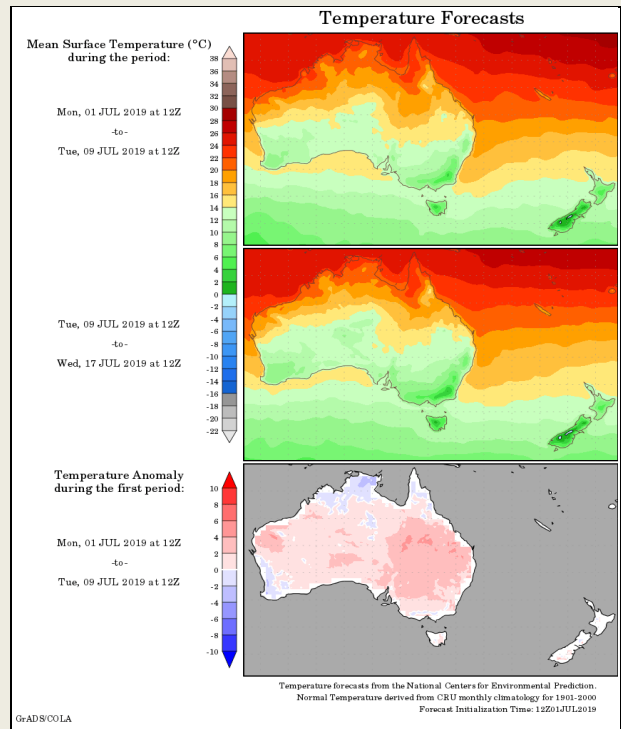
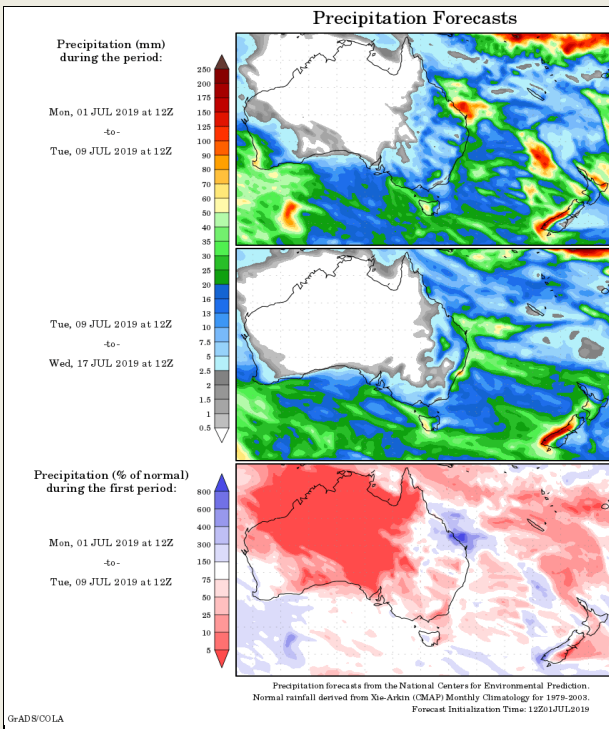
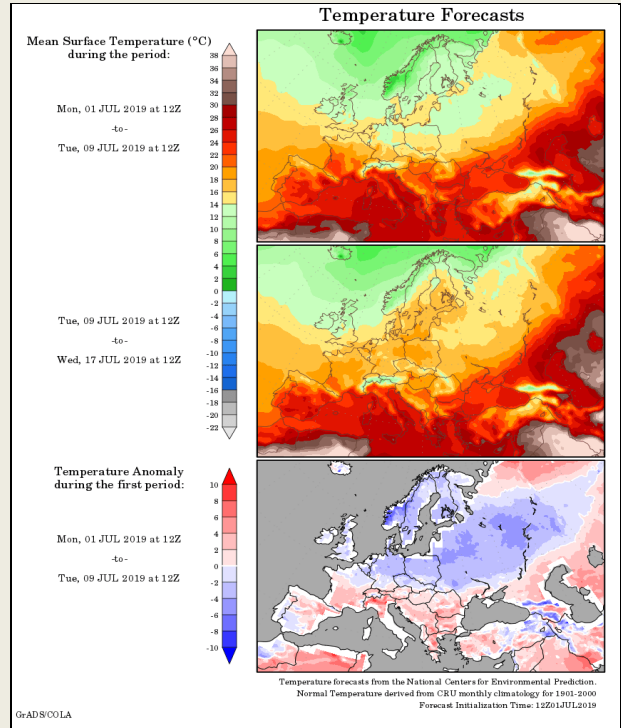
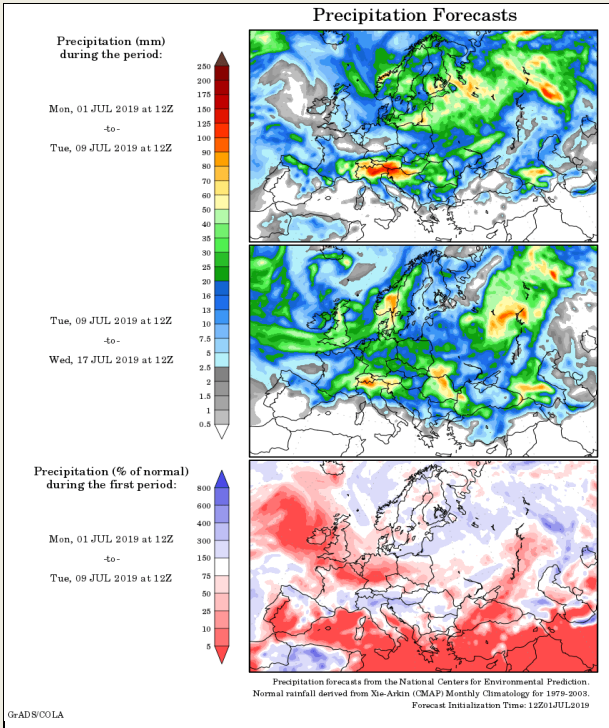

**EUROPE:** Relief to hot temperatures will return to the U.K., France into central north Germany, Poland, the Czech Republic and Scandinavia this week. Daily highs will return to the 70s and lower 80s northwest and 60s and 70s northeast this week most often. However, a lack of rain will continue to maintain crop moisture stress on crops in the south U.K., north France into central Germany where little to no rainfall will occur this week and rain will need to return.

**AUSTRALIA:** Precipitation will continue to improve soil moisture conditions and the outlook for winter crops during the coming week. Rounds of precipitation will continue to impact Western Australia maintaining improvements while precipitation will return to eastern Australia later this week. Moisture will reach into northeast New South Wales and southeast Queensland late this week providing relief to some of the driest areas.
