

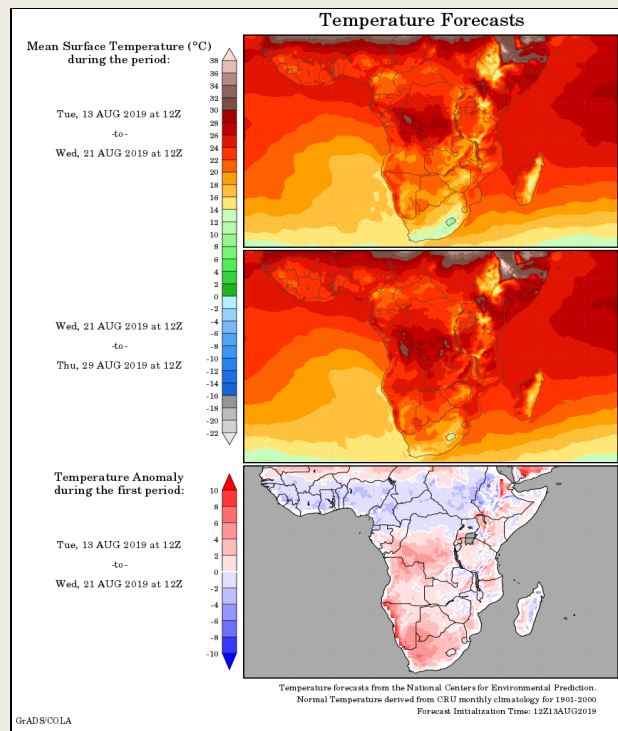
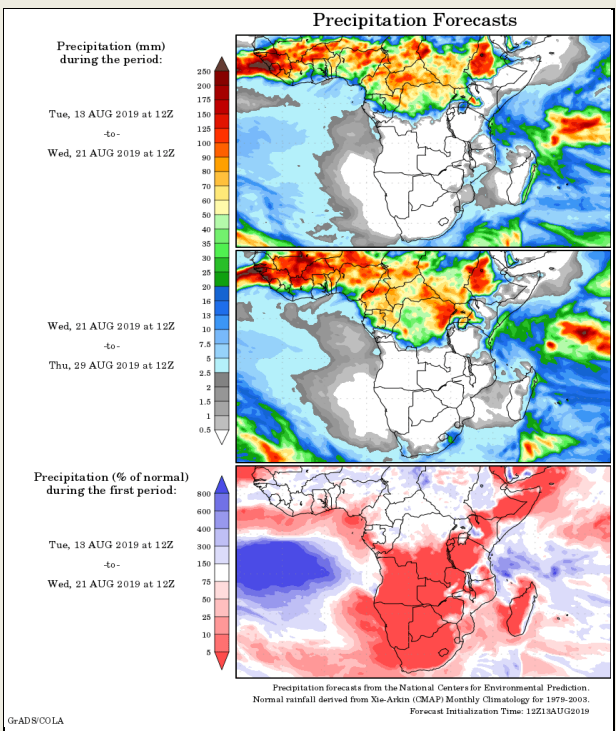
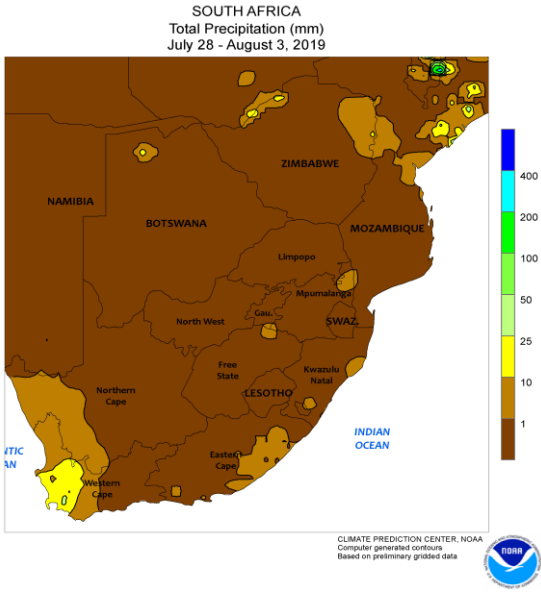
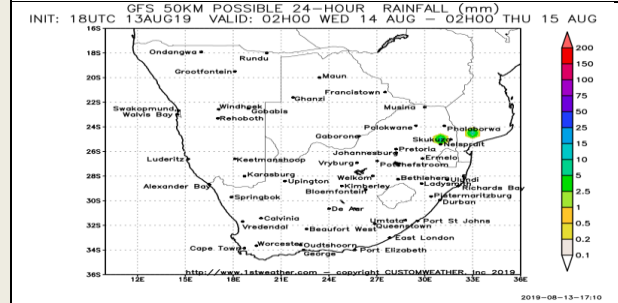
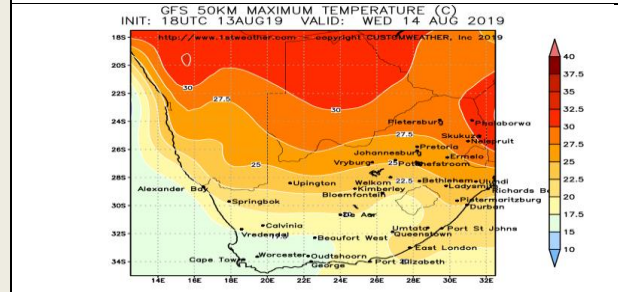
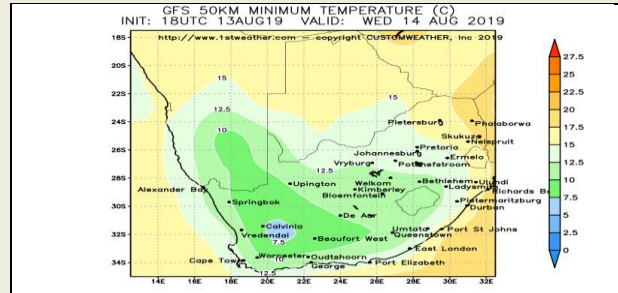


# **Weather Report**

## **14 August 2019**

South Africa - Weather

- South Africa will remain in a mostly dry bias during the next two weeks
- o Areas near and along the coasts will have a few opportunities for light rain, though much of the precipitation will be too light to counter evaporation
- Free State and neighboring areas will remain critically dry during the next two weeks
- o Winter wheat will mostly remain dormant or semi-dormant
- ▣ These areas still need to see improved rainfall in the spring to support better crop prospects
- Western Cape will also have short to very short soil moisture in the coming weeks
- o Timely rain will be needed this spring for the winter wheat as well
- Temperatures will trend above normal through next Tuesday
- o Highs will often be in the 60s and 70s Fahrenheit

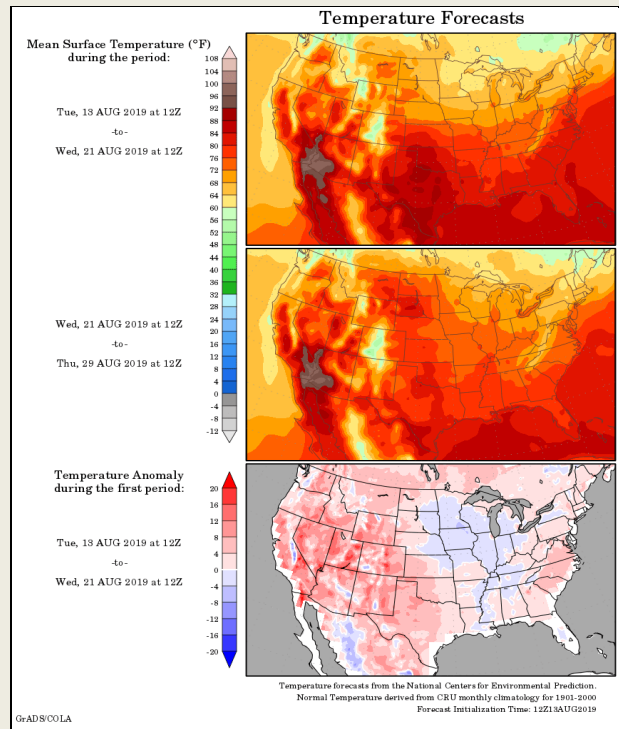
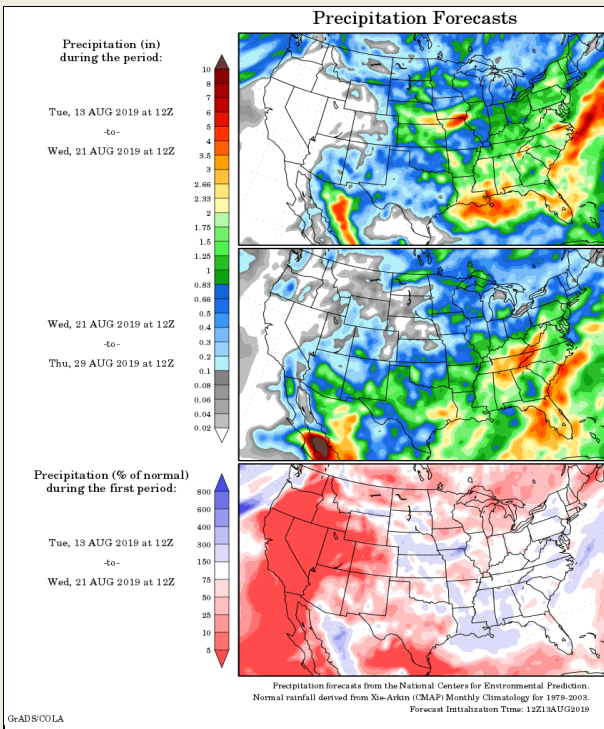
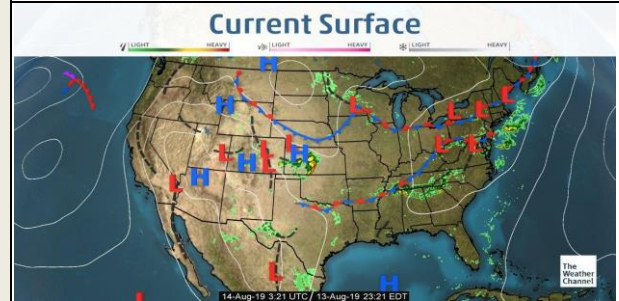
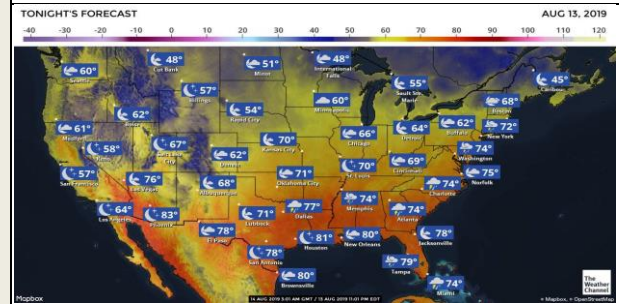
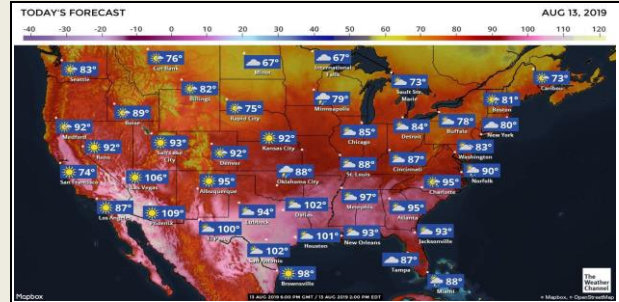
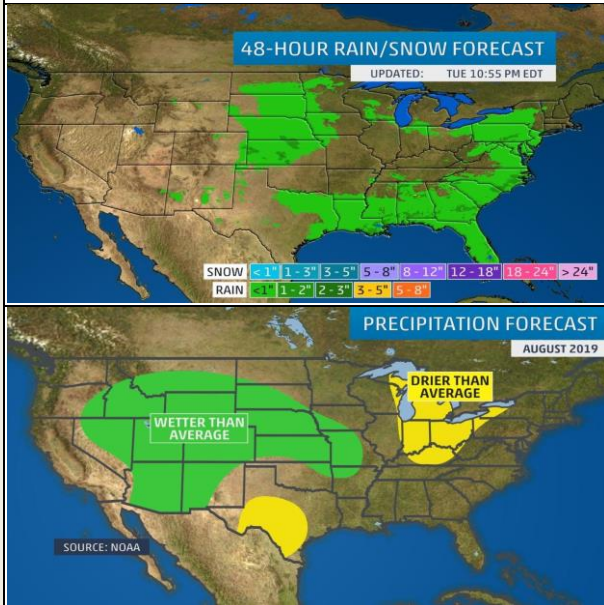

# United States of America - Weather

**U.S. MIDWEST:** Conditions for crops will remain mostly favorable through the next two weeks as multiple rounds of timely rain and a lack of excessive heat are expected to help maintain soil moisture to adequately support the needs of most crops.  
 o Some areas will receive more rain than others and several areas will dry down overall, but existing soil moisture and the timely rain expected should prevent excessive dryness from evolving.

**U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST:** The two-week outlook is wetter again from the central and northern Delta into northern Alabama and much of the Delta and the Southeast should see enough rain to favorably support the needs of crops through the period.  
 o A few pockets of dryness may evolve, but there should be enough timely rain and existing soil moisture to prevent excessive dryness during the next two weeks.

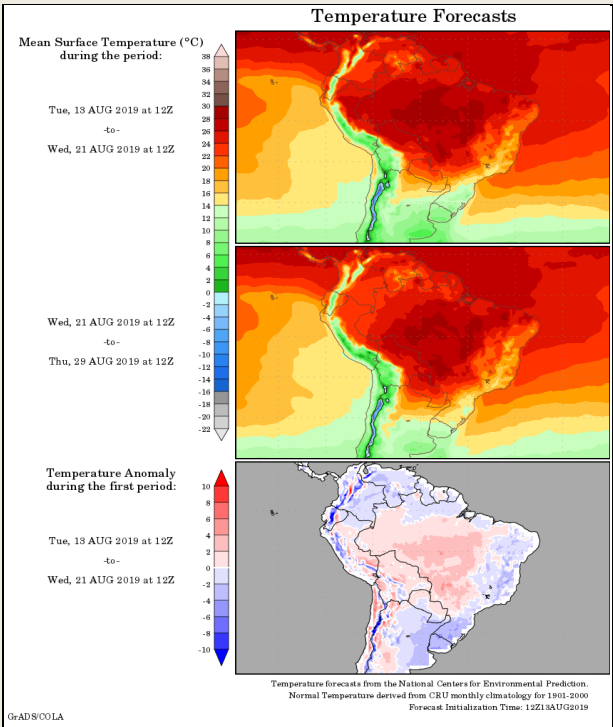
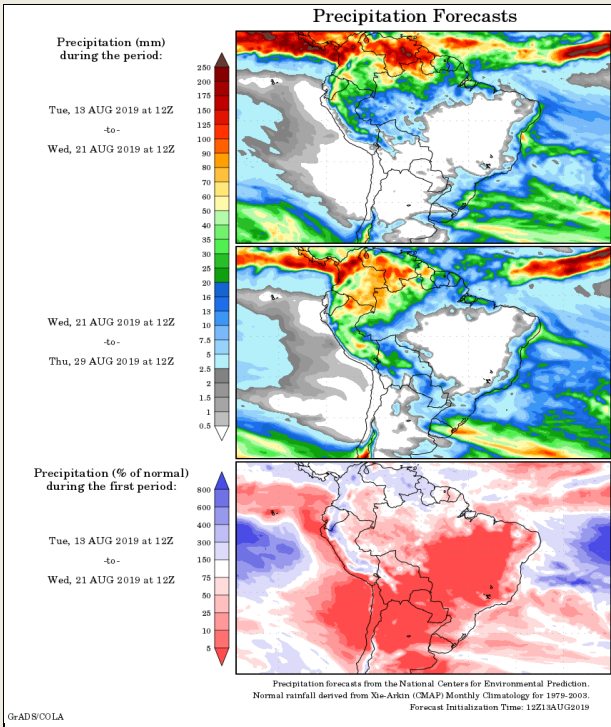
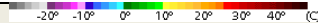
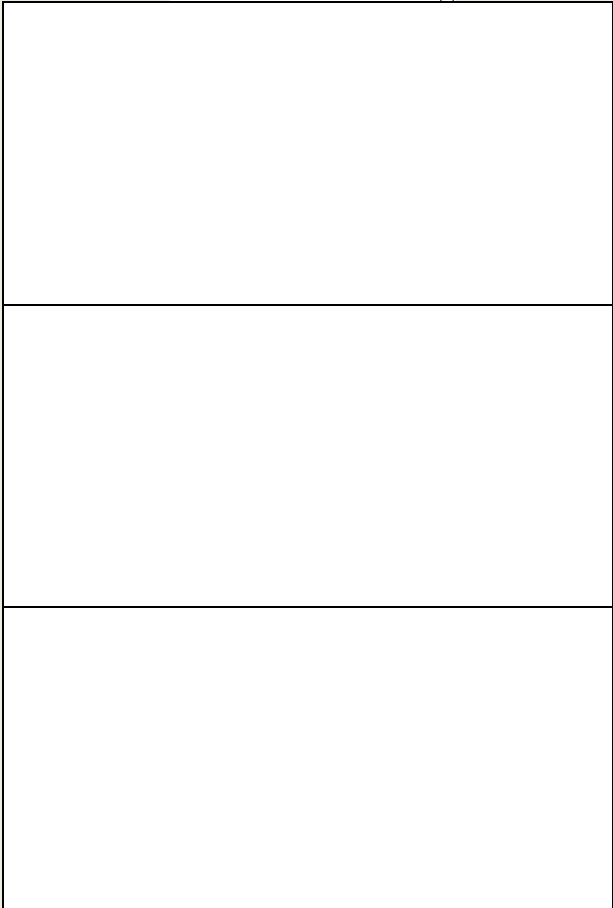
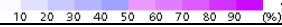
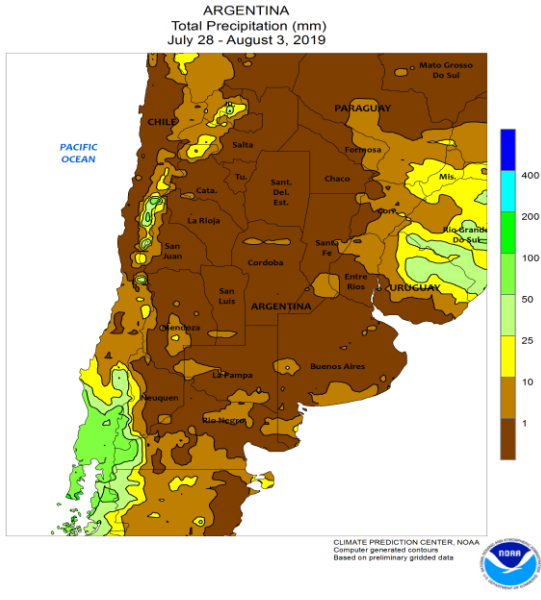


## South America - Weather

**BRAZIL:** Rain fell on some southern and northeastern parts of Brazil Thursday while most areas were dry. restricted rainfall pattern remains in place most often during the next two weeks with a few exceptions.

**ARGENTINA:** Argentina will continue to see a restricted rainfall pattern most often through the next two weeks and rain is needed in western Argentina to improve conditions for winter wheat.

o Eastern Argentina will see a few light showers on occasion during the next two weeks while western Argentina stays mostly dry and sees a further depletion of soil moisture.

## Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

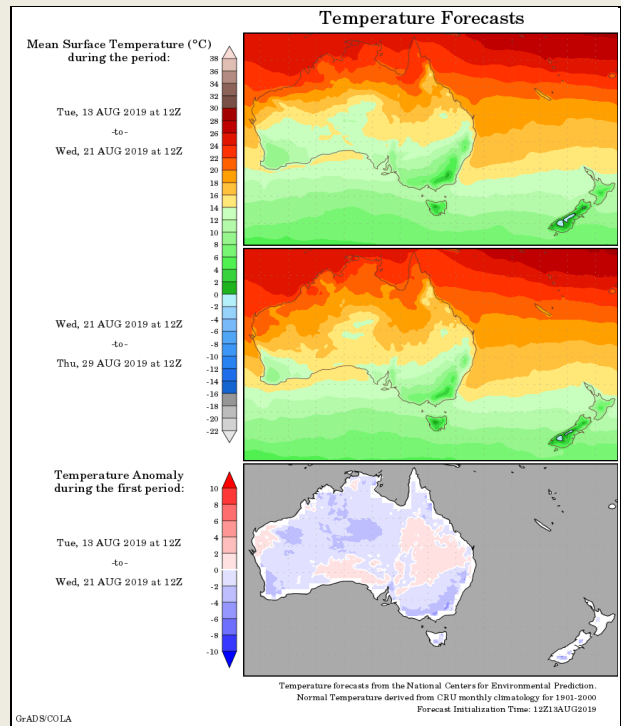
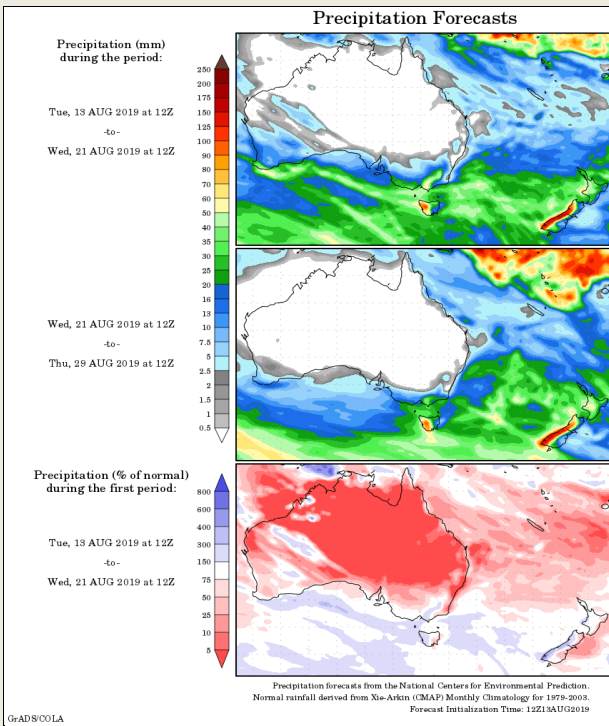
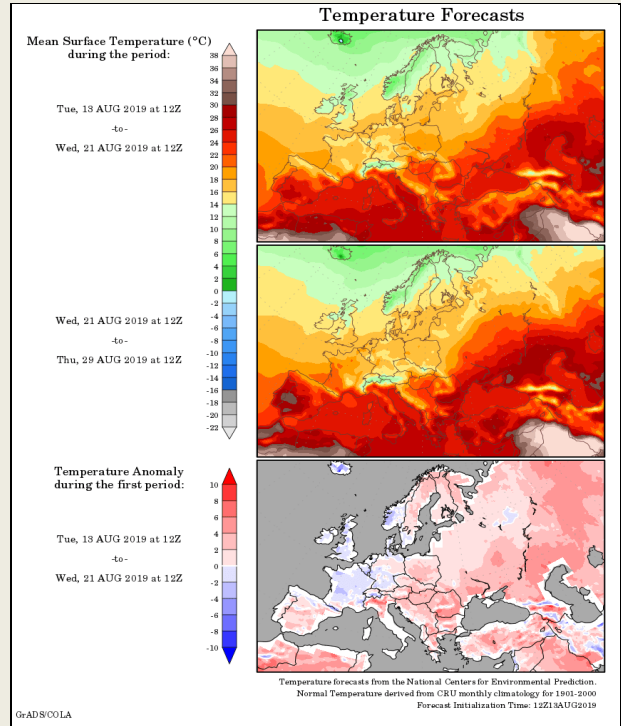
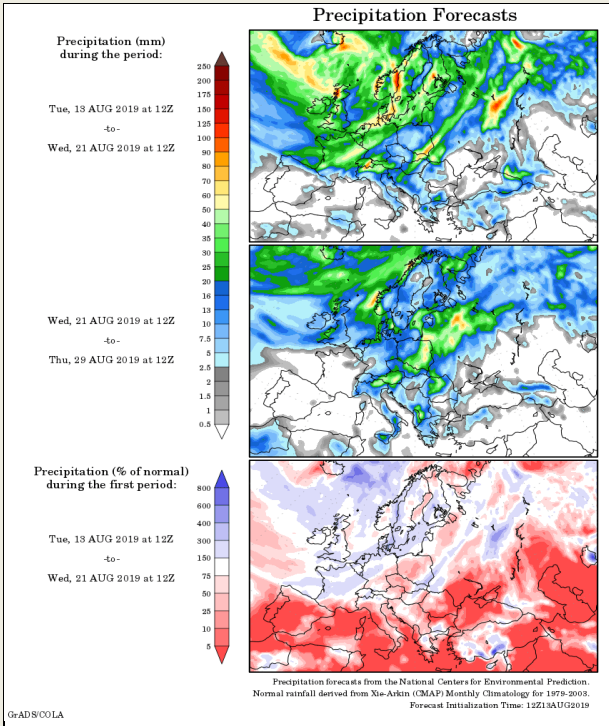
**EUROPE:** The most frequent and greatest precipitation will occur over the U.K., northern France, Belgium, the Netherlands into Scandinavia this week. A near daily chance of showers will occur.

o The greatest moisture will occur over north France and south U.K. into Scandinavia Saturday into Sunday as another cold front pushes through the region.

o Moisture totals by this time next week will range from 0.30 to 1.00 inch and local totals varying from 1.00 to 2.50 inches

**AUSTRALIA:** Drying will continue over east-central Australia during the coming ten days to two weeks.

o The lack of moisture will maintain long term dryness and unirrigated northern winter crop production areas have struggled due to the dryness. Any relief in northeast New South Wales from recent precipitation this past weekend will not be long lived as drying will return for at least the next ten days.
