South Africa - Weather

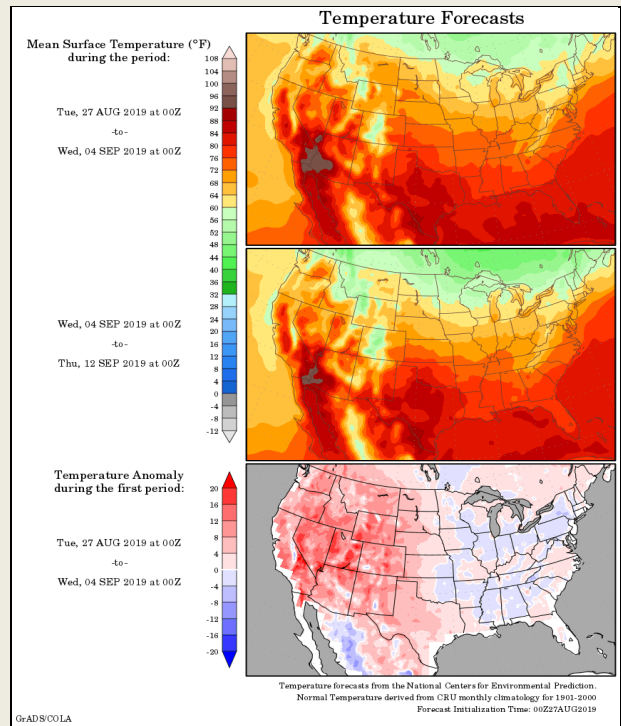
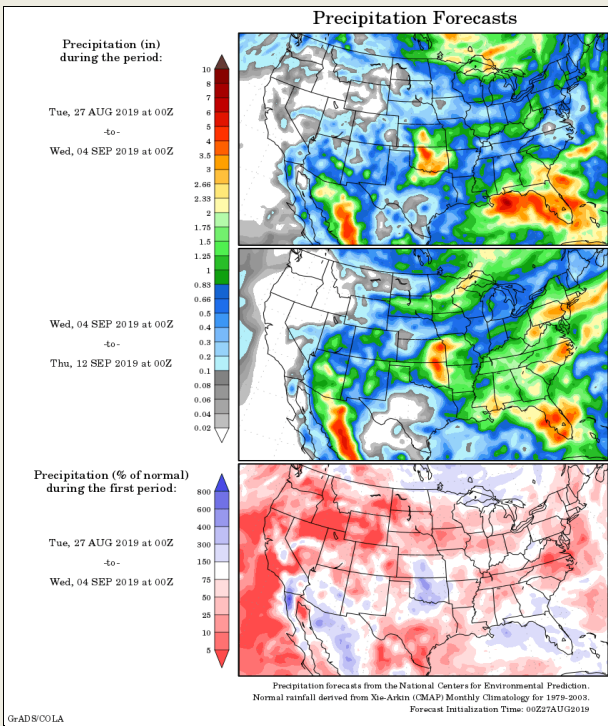
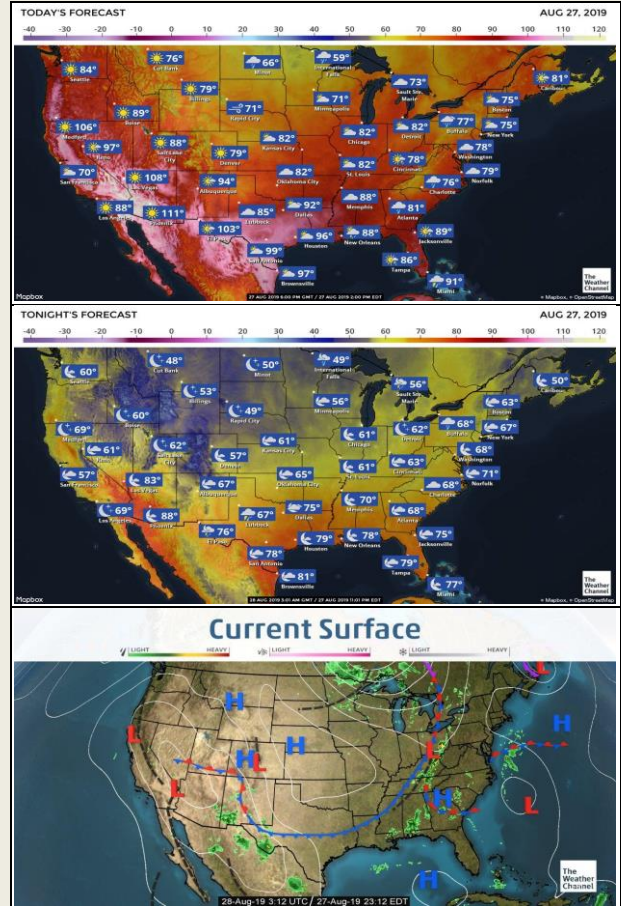
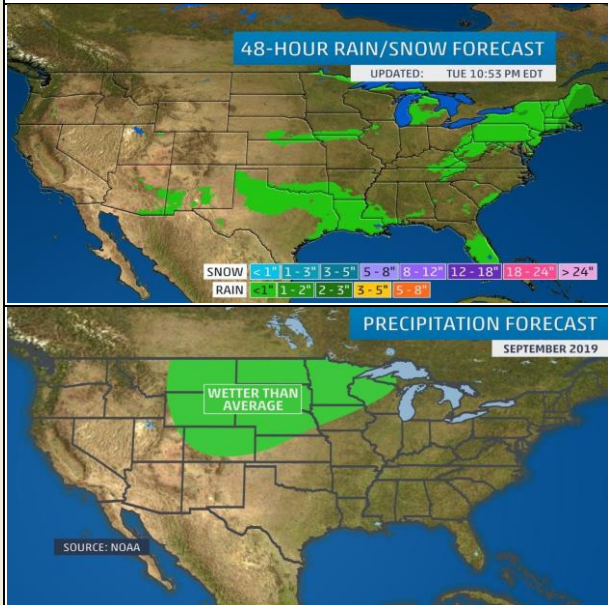
- Free State and neighboring areas will remain dry during the next two weeks
- Winter wheat will remain dormant or semi-dormant in most locations
- Significant rain will be needed later in September to improve winter wheat prospects
- Western Cape will remain dry as well
- The region will need to see significant rain later in September to support better winter wheat conditions
- Temperatures will be near to below normal in the western half of South Africa through next Tuesday while areas further east warm to near or above average levels



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United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Rain will be less frequent and lighter during the next two weeks than what has occurred recently and many areas will dry down overall, but soil moisture should be high enough to support the needs of crops in nearly all of the Midwest. Alternating periods of warmer and cooler than usual conditions will occur during the next two weeks with some showers of mostly light intensity most days during the period and the only round of well-organized rain expected Sep. 3-5.
U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Daily rounds of showers and thunderstorms will continue during the next two weeks in the Delta and the Southeast and enough rain should fall to maintain mostly favorable soil conditions across the region.

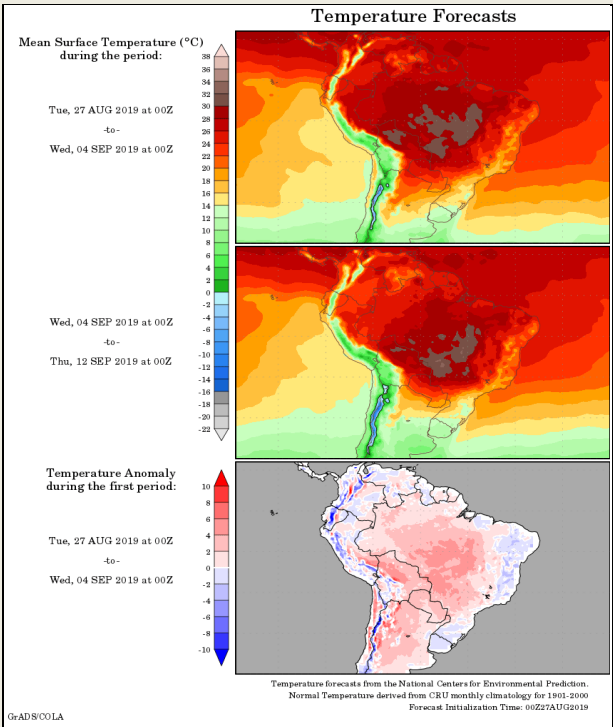
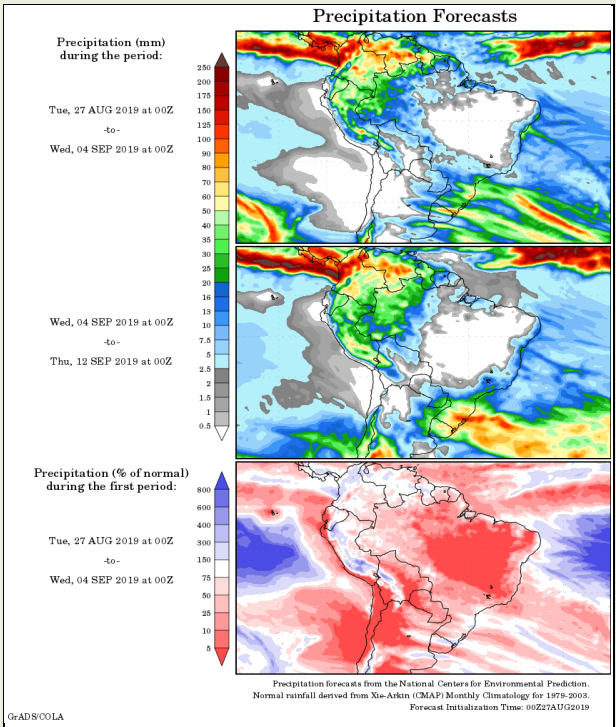
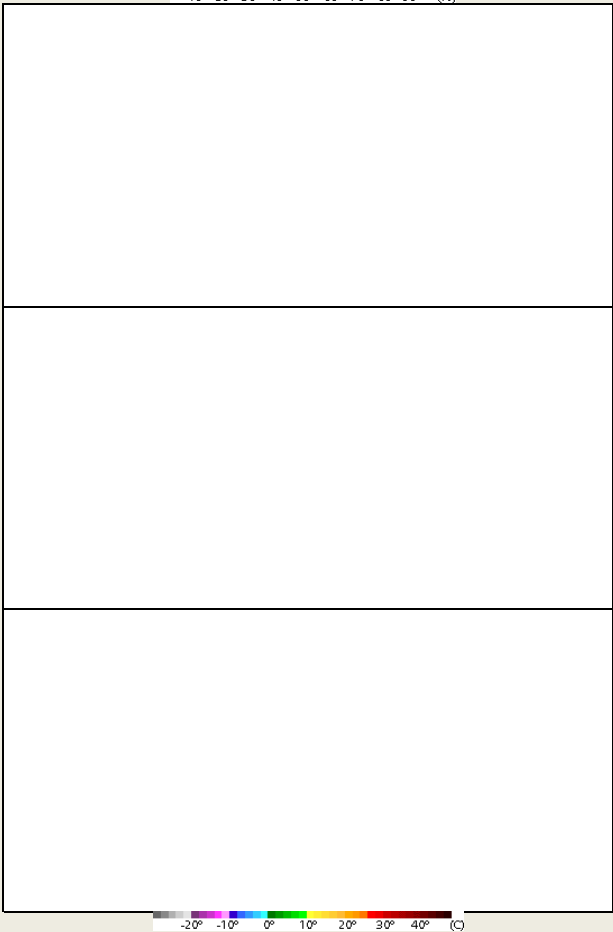
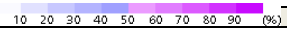
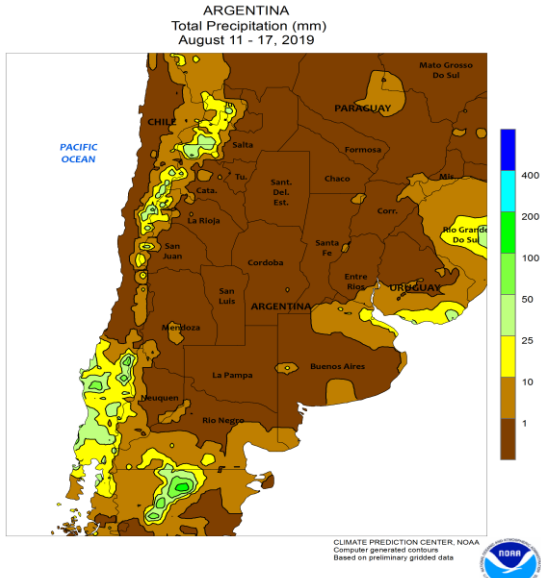


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South America - Weather

BRAZIL: The two-week outlook is not quite as wet for far southern Brazil than was advertised Monday while rain has been increased for Parana where at least temporary increases in soil moisture and conditions for planting will occur in parts of the region later this week. Light showers will occur into Thursday in portions of southern and northeastern Brazil before rain increases Friday in the far south.

ARGENTINA: Argentina will continue to see a restricted rainfall pattern most often through the next two weeks and western Argentina will remain in need of greater rain to improve conditions for winter wheat. Some showers will occur on occasion with most of those showers occurring outside of western Argentina where a further depletion of soil moisture is expected.

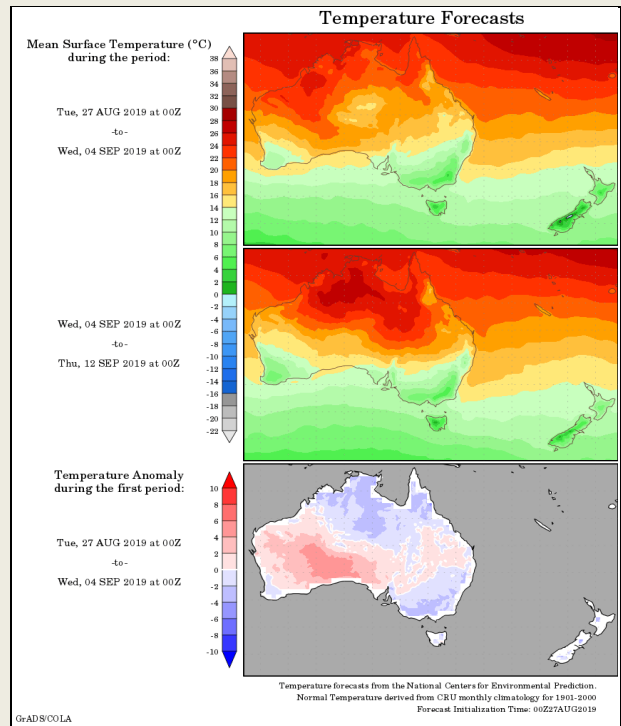
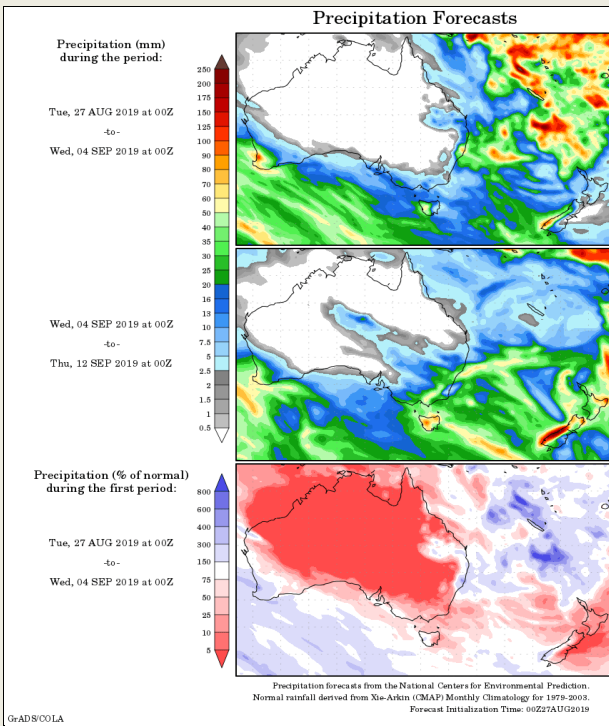
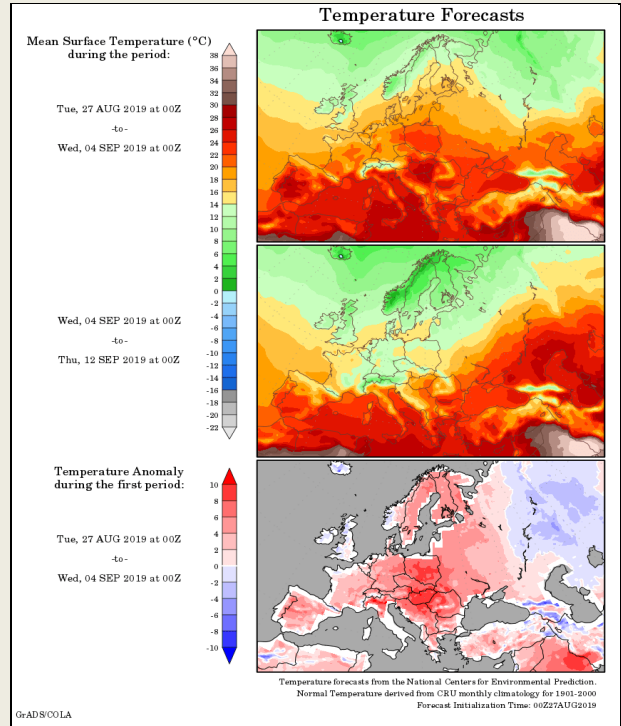
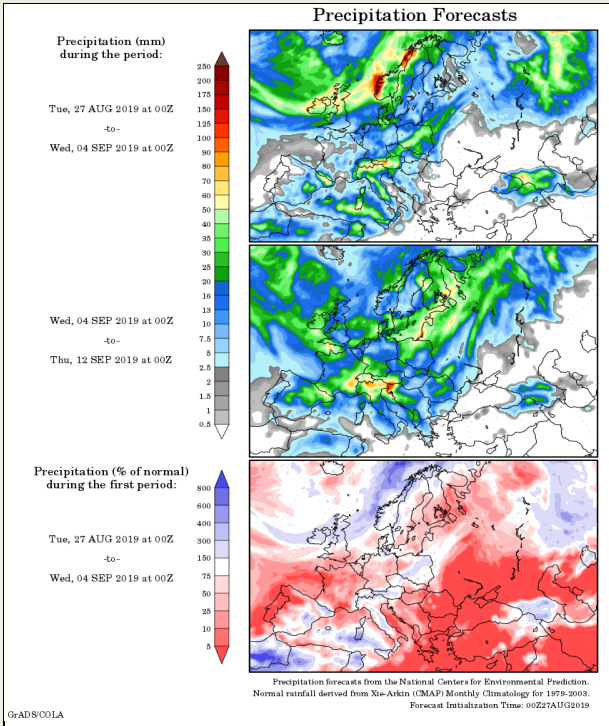


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Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Two areas of precipitation will be significant during the coming week. The first region is from northeast Spain, Italy, Switzerland, south Germany, Austria, Slovenia and Croatia through Slovakia, the Czech Republic and Poland. The second region is southwest and central to northern portions of the U.K. and Scandinavia.

AUSTRALIA: Drying will continue over east-central Australia through interior New South Wales and interior South Australia and a small portion of northwest Victoria for at least the next ten days to two weeks. Northern winter crop production areas have struggled due to dryness. Concern over serious deficits in long term water supply will prevail. Isolated to scattered rain showers will occur from the central coast of New South Wales into southeast Queensland through Friday. Most of the significant rain will occur close to the coast, but a few greater totals may occur back into Darling Downs, Queensland where amounts may exceed 1.00 inches. The greatest rainfall will be erratic. Otherwise, moisture totals will be brief and erratic and moisture totals will be no more than 0.40 inch most often.



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
