

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## **United States of America - Weather**

U.S. MIDWEST: Much of the Midwest will continue to see favorable conditions for crops during the TODAY'S FORECAS next two-weeks, although many areas will dry down and will be left in need of greater rain later this nonth. Occasional rounds of timely rain will cross the Midwest during the next two weeks and with soll moisture adequate to support the needs of crops in most areas should avoid seeing serious crop stress as long as timely rain continues this month. U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Much of the Delta and the Southeast will see timely showers and thunderstorms during the next ten days that should bring enough rain to maintain favorable onditions for most crops. Most areas from the Delta through northern Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina will receive 0.50-2.0' of rain and locally more through Monday with a few pockets of lighter rain and lighter rain elsewhere in the Southeast. 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

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

# Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Another week of below average rainfall and mild to warm temperatures will impact west-central into north France

o Rainfall will increase from the southwest to southeast today into Wednesday return Friday into the weekend.

AUSTRALIA: Drying will continue over east-central Australia during the coming ten days to two weeks. The lack of precipitation will continue to maintain long term dryness concerns over the region and northern winter crop production areas still need a soaking of moisture. There is still plenty of time for moisture to increase for spring and summer crops, but moisture will be needed during the latter half of August into September or concerns over dryness will linger into spring. Winter crops in southern Australia will remain semi-dormant for the next week to ten days leaving plant moisture demand a bit low.



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
