# South Africa - Weather

- Other portions of South Africa will remain dry during the next two weeks
- Harvesting and general fieldwork will advance swiftly during the next two weeks
- Free State and neighboring areas will otherwise remain dry or critically dry
  - o Winter wheat will generally remain dormant or semi-dormant
  - o Timely rain will be needed this spring to support aggressive development
- Soil moisture will remain short in much of Western Cape during the next two weeks as well
  - o The rain that does occur will generally be too light to impact long-term soil conditions
  - o The winter wheat areas will also need to see timely rain this spring
- Eastern South Africa will often be warmer biased through next Tuesday while the western half of the country see seasonable to seasonably cool weather



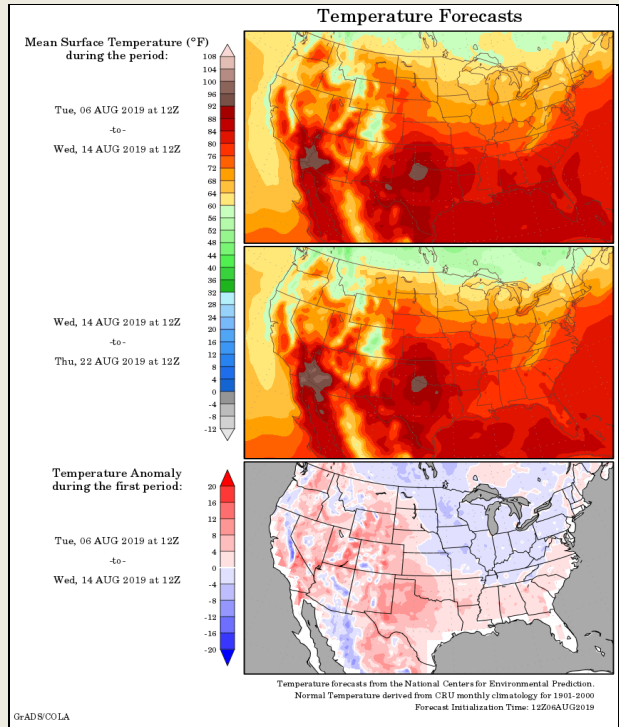
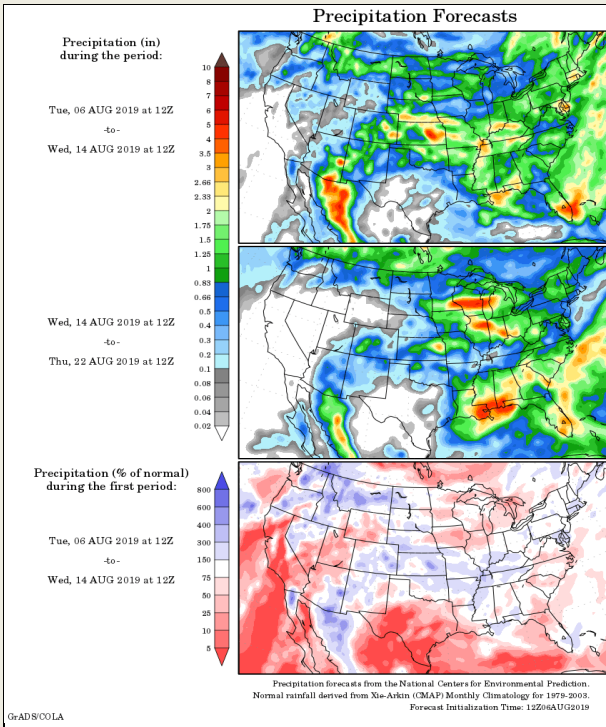
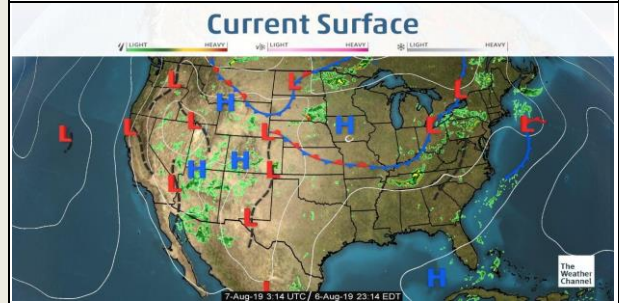
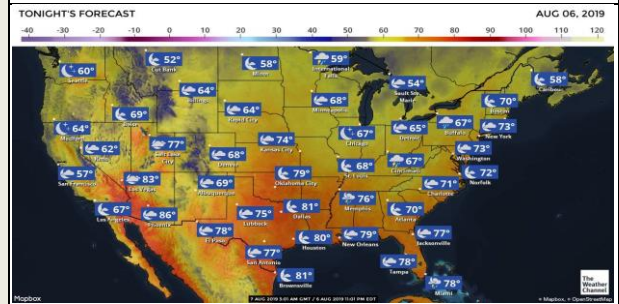
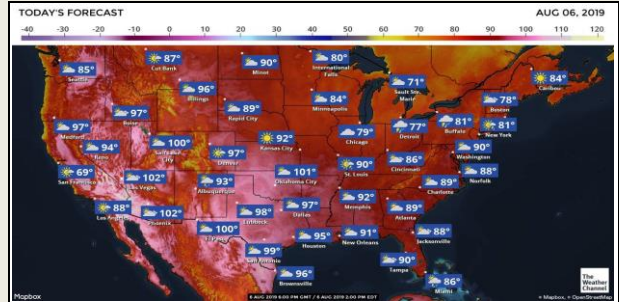
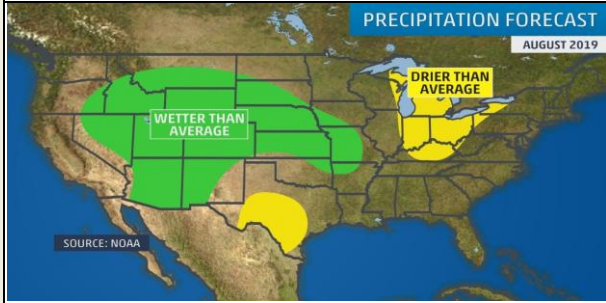
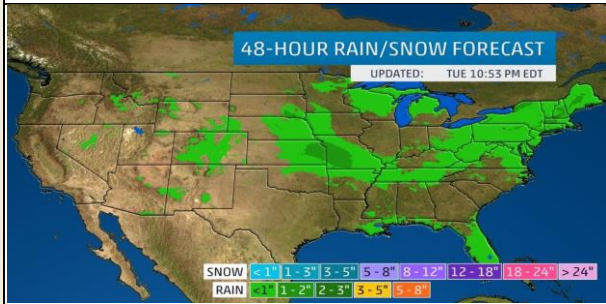
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# United States of America - Weather

**U.S. MIDWEST:** Much of the Midwest will continue to see favorable conditions for crops during the next two-weeks, although many areas will dry down and will be left in need of greater rain later this month. Occasional rounds of timely rain will cross the Midwest during the next two weeks and with soil moisture adequate to support the needs of crops in most areas should avoid seeing serious crop stress as long as timely rain continues this month.

**U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST:** Much of the Delta and the Southeast will see timely showers and thunderstorms during the next ten days that should bring enough rain to maintain favorable conditions for most crops.

Most areas from the Delta through northern Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina will receive 0.50-2.0" of rain and locally more through Monday with a few pockets of lighter rain and lighter rain elsewhere in the Southeast.



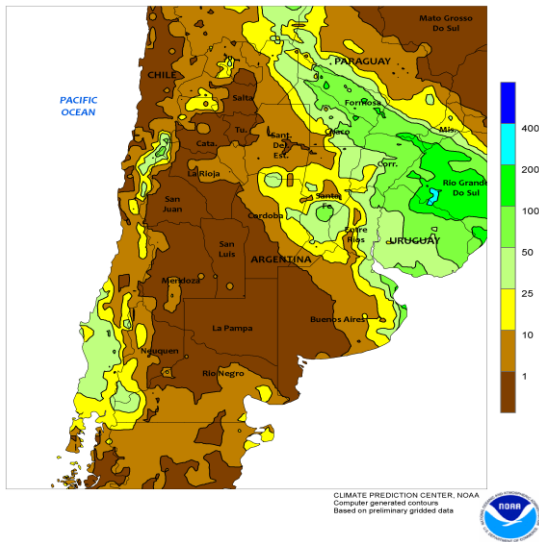
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# South America - Weather

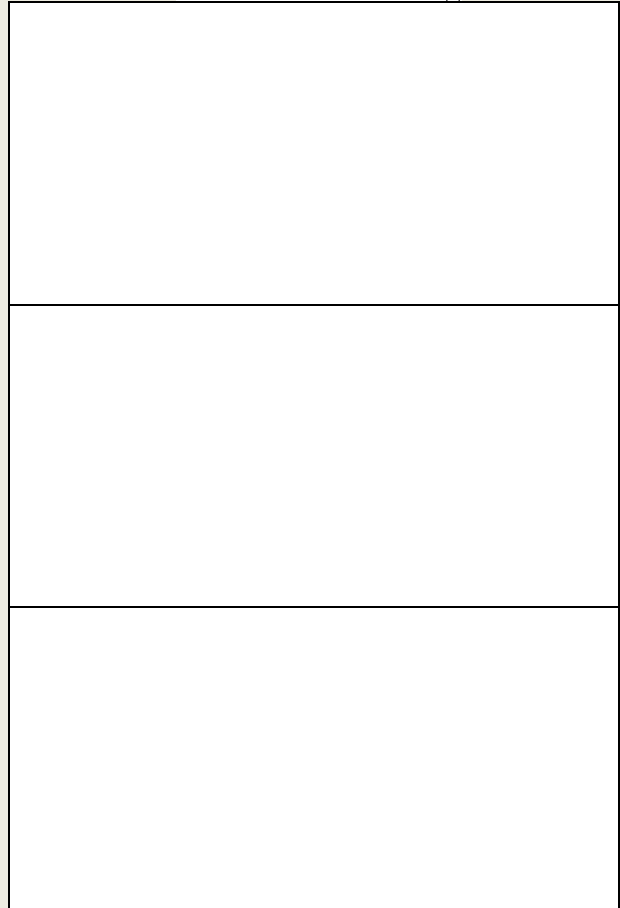
**BRAZIL:** A restricted rainfall pattern remains in place most often during the next two weeks with a few exceptions. Fieldwork will advance well overall and interruptions from rain should be temporary. A few showers will occur today with northeastern Mato Grosso do Sul and nearby areas as well as Espirito Santo and nearby Minas Gerais wettest where some areas will see up to 0.35" of rain and locally more. **ARGENTINA:** Argentina will continue to see a restricted rainfall pattern most often through the next two weeks and planting of winter wheat and harvesting of summer crops should advance well overall. o Much of western Argentina has short soil moisture and needs rain to improve conditions for winter wheat and little to no rain of significance is expected there for at least the next ten days.

July 21 - 27, 2019



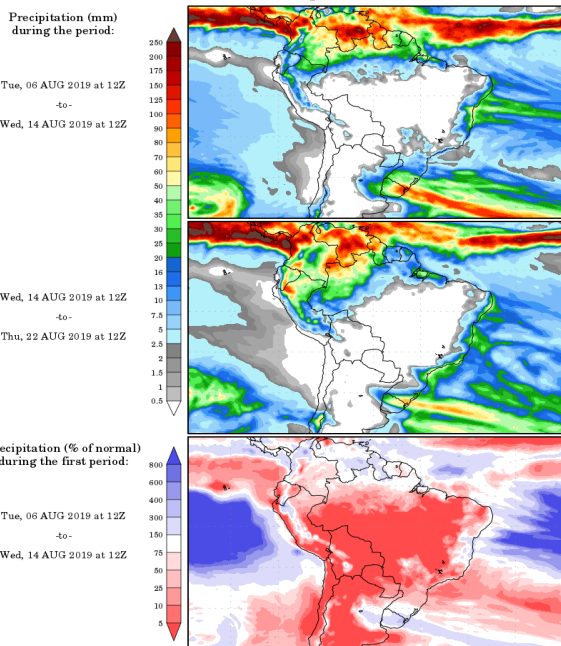

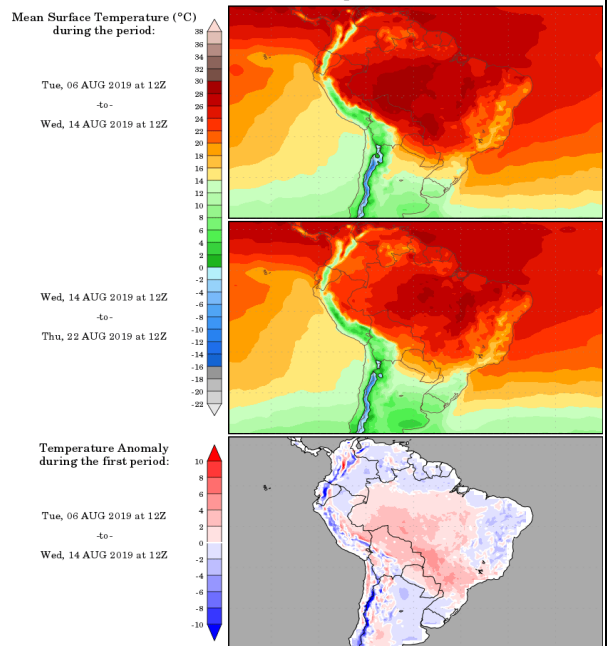
### Precipitation Forecasts

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## Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

**EUROPE:** Another week of below average rainfall and mild to warm temperatures will impact west-central into north France. Rainfall will increase from the southwest to southeast today into Wednesday return Friday into the weekend.

**AUSTRALIA:** Drying will continue over east-central Australia during the coming ten days to two weeks. The lack of precipitation will continue to maintain long term dryness concerns over the region and northern winter crop production areas still need a soaking of moisture. There is still plenty of time for moisture to increase for spring and summer crops, but moisture will be needed during the latter half of August into September or concerns over dryness will linger into spring. Winter crops in southern Australia will remain semi-dormant for the next week to ten days leaving plant moisture demand a bit low.



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
