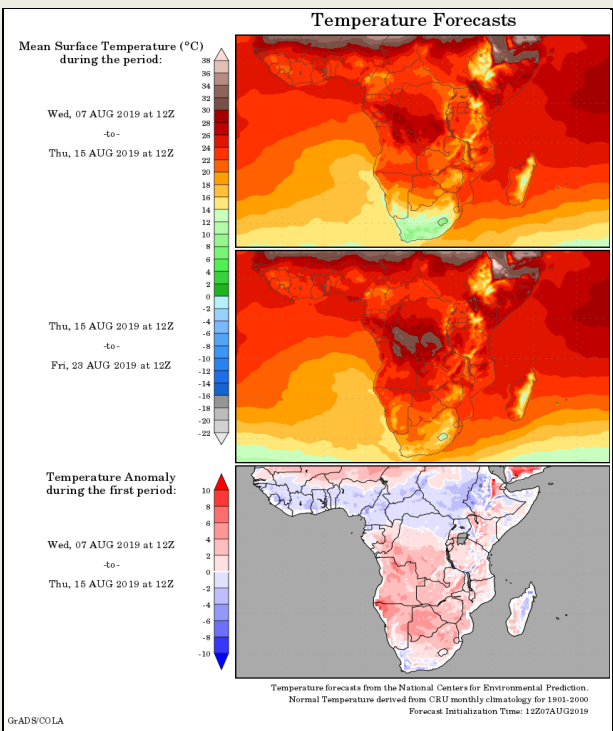
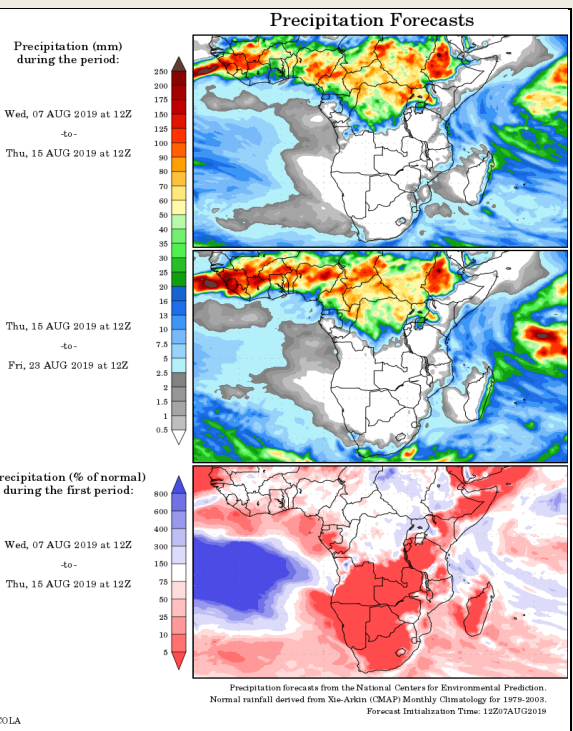
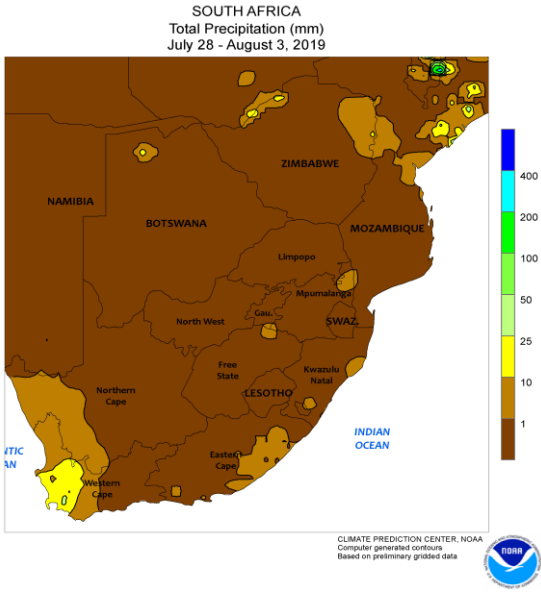
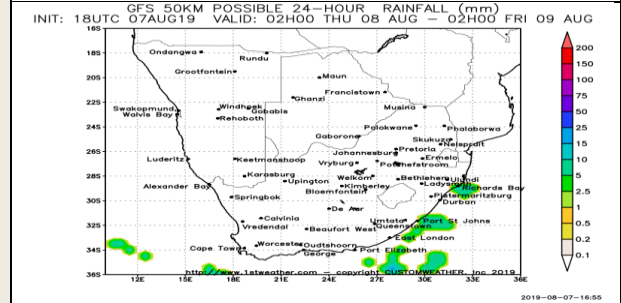
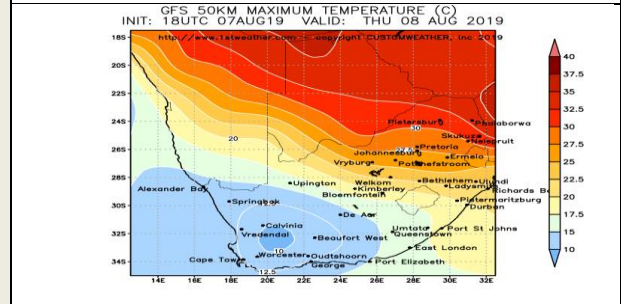
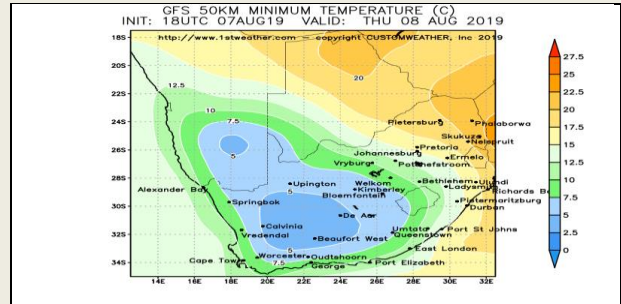




Weather Report

South Africa - Weather

- Any harvesting not yet complete will advance swiftly
- Free State and neighboring areas will continue to dry down
 - Winter wheat will generally remain dormant or semi-dormant
 - These areas will need several waves of rain this spring to support a better environment for the crops
- Western Cape will dry down in most areas as well
 - The rain that does occur will generally be too light to impact long-term soil conditions
 - Timely rain will also be needed this spring for the winter wheat
- Eastern South Africa will often be warmer biased through next Wednesday while the western half of the country see seasonable to seasonably cool weather



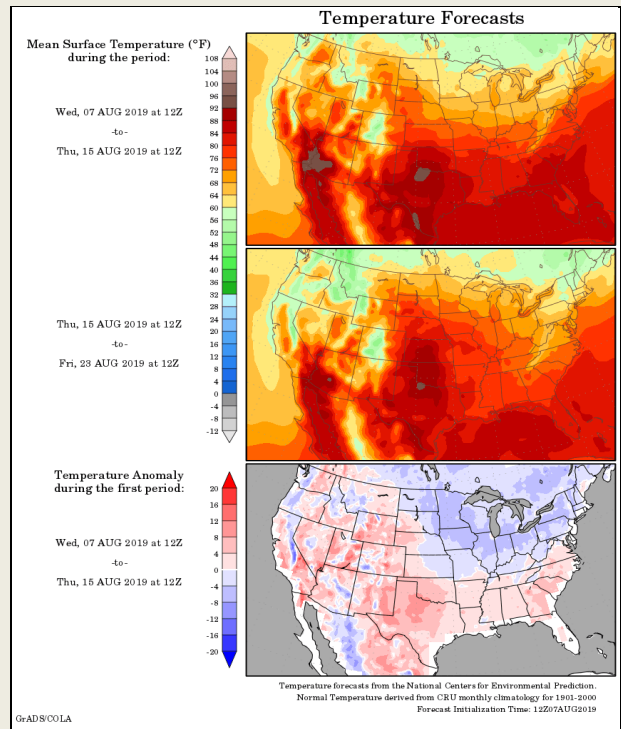
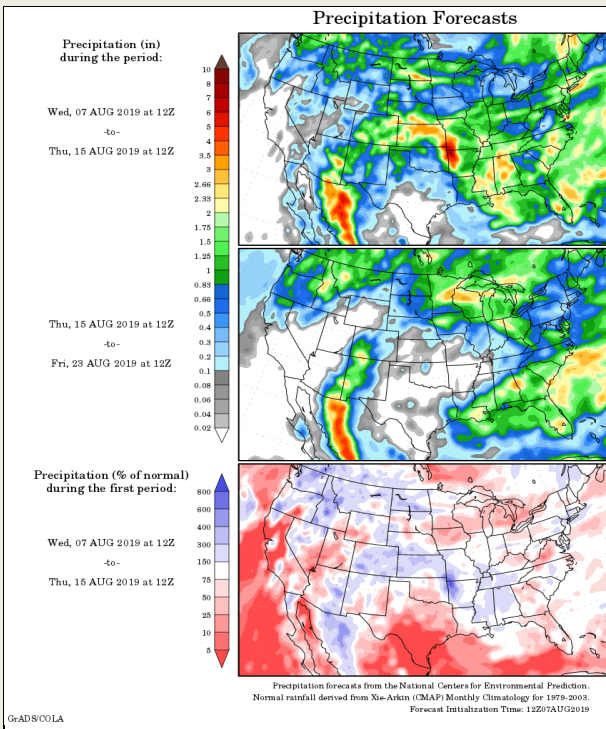
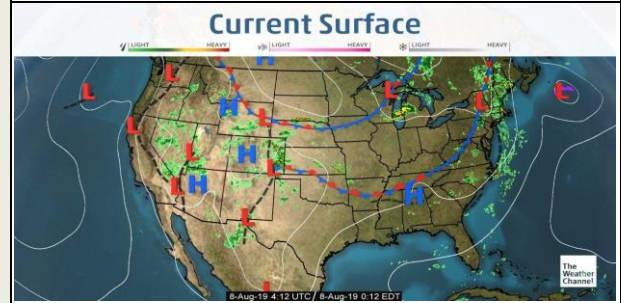
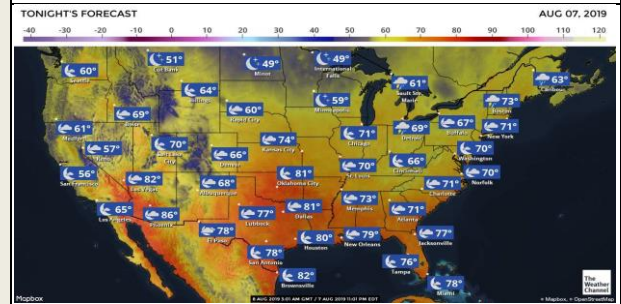
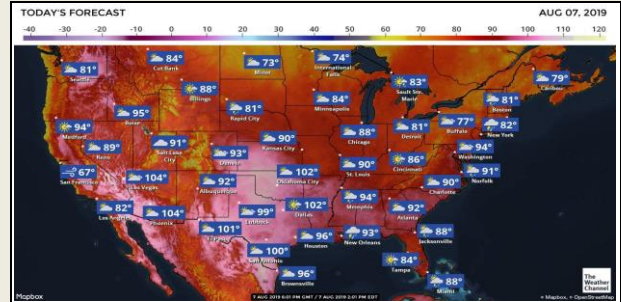
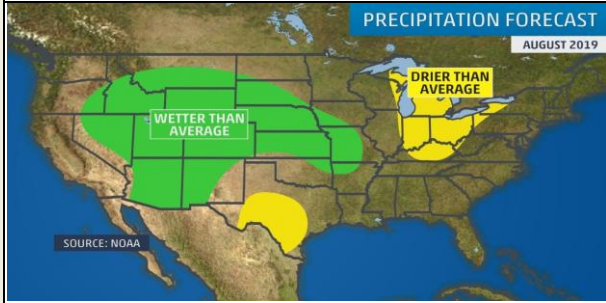

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Much of the Midwest will continue to see favorable conditions for crops during the next two-weeks, although many areas will dry down overall and will be left in need of greater rain later this month. Occasional rounds of timely rain will cross the Midwest during the next two weeks and with soil moisture adequate in most areas to support the needs of crops most of the region should avoid seeing serious crop stress as long as timely rain continues this month. East-central Iowa into central Illinois is still a notable exception and rain received earlier this week bought crops more time before more serious stress evolves, but with little additional rain of significance expected through Sunday that moisture will soon be lost to evaporation.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Much of the Delta and the Southeast will see timely showers and thunderstorms during the next ten days that should bring enough rain to maintain favorable conditions for most crops.

Most areas from the Delta through northern Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina will receive 0.50-2.0" of rain and locally more through Tuesday with a few pockets of lighter rain and lighter rain elsewhere in the Southeast.

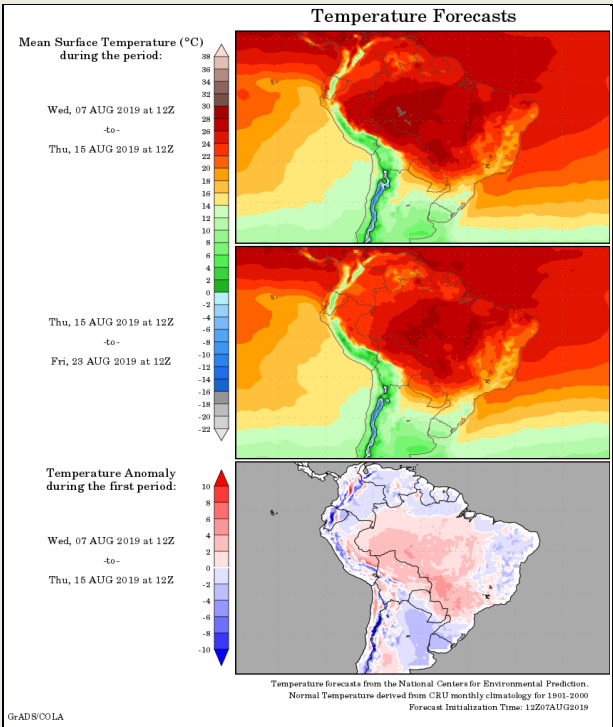
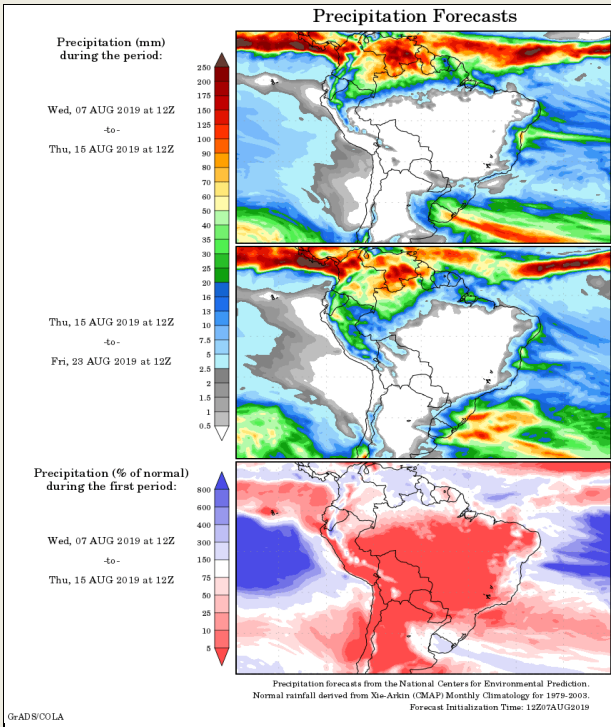
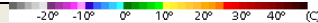
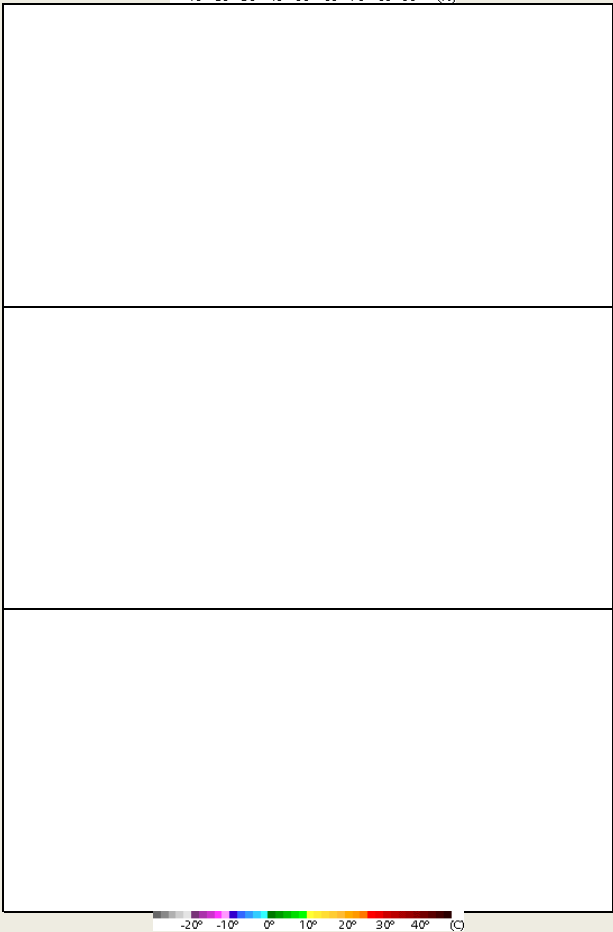
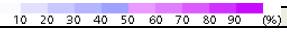
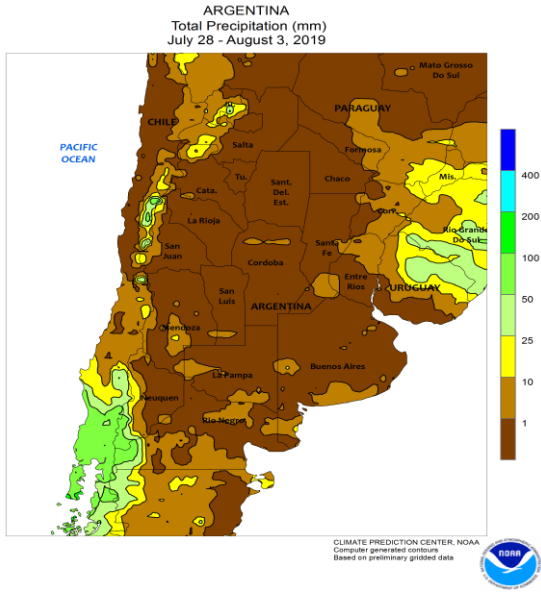

South America - Weather

BRAZIL: A restricted rainfall pattern remains in place most often during the next two weeks with a few exceptions. Fieldwork will advance well overall and interruptions from rain should be temporary. Rio Grande do Sul and Santa Catarina will see rain today into Friday with central and southern Rio Grande do Sul seeing 0.50-1.35" of rain and locally more and lighter rain elsewhere.

ARGENTINA: Argentina will continue to see a restricted rainfall pattern most often through the next two weeks and planting of winter wheat and harvesting of summer crops should advance well overall. Much of western Argentina has short soil moisture and needs rain to improve conditions for winter wheat and little to no rain of significance is expected there for at least the next ten days.

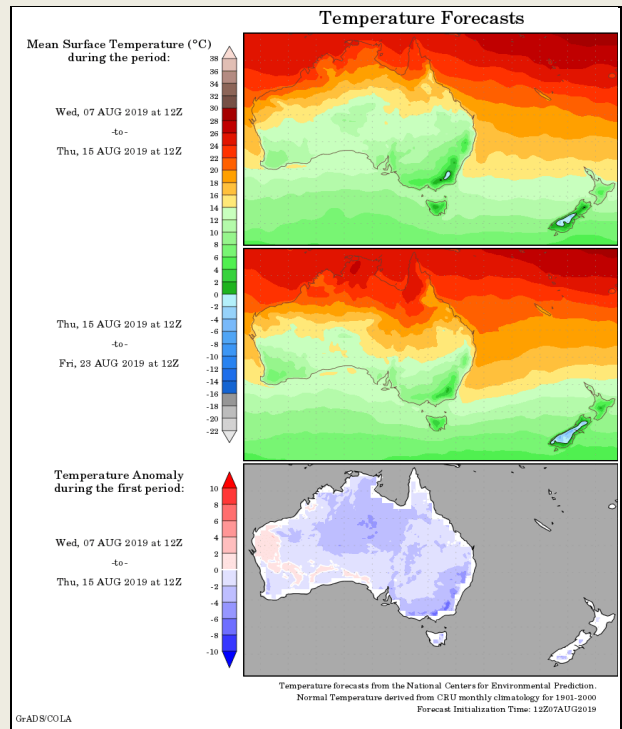
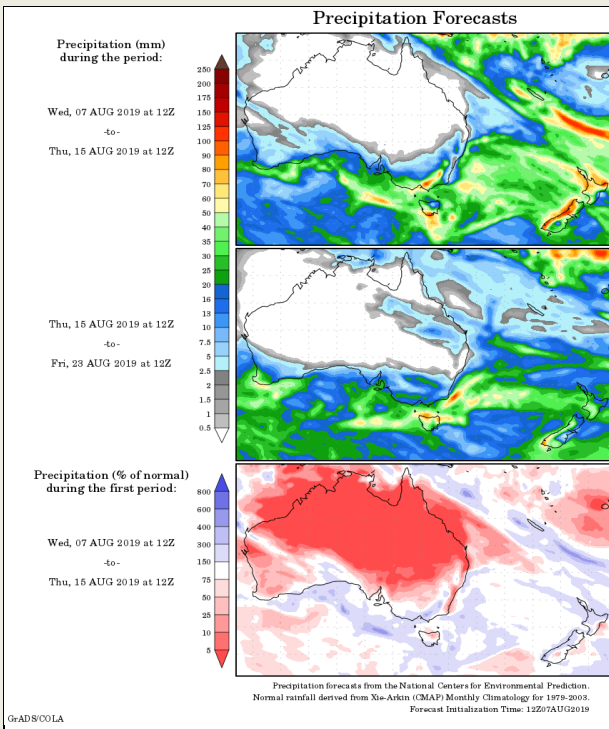
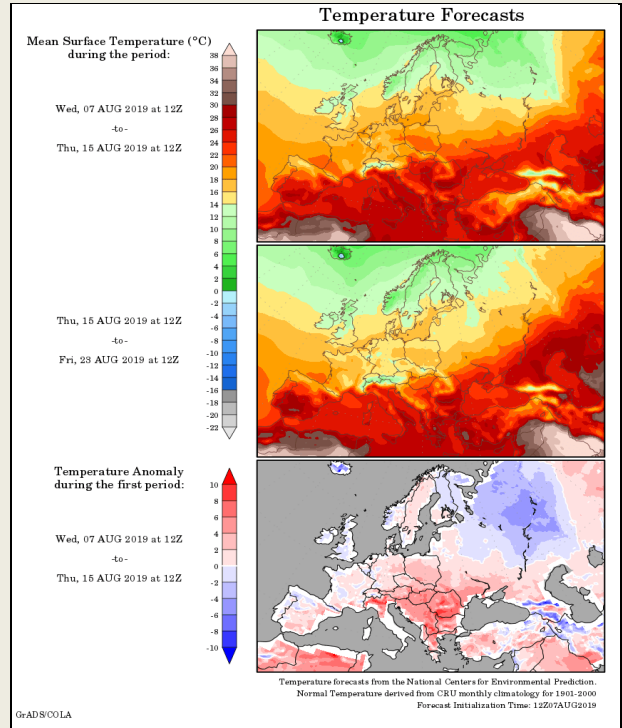
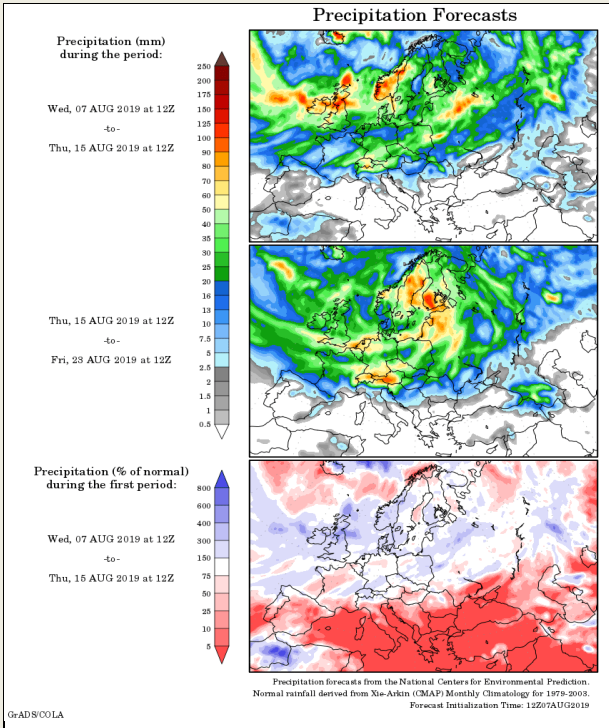
Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Restricted rainfall and drying will continue to impact a large portion of France through the remainder of the week.

o Scattered rainfall will occur over the nation the remainder of the week, but moisture will be light in most locations. Some isolated locations will receive greater rainfall

AUSTRALIA: Drying will continue over east-central Australia during the coming ten days to two weeks.

o The lack of moisture will maintain long term dryness and unirrigated northern winter crop production areas have struggled due to the dryness. There is still time for moisture to increase for spring and summer crops, but moisture will be needed during the latter half of August into September or concerns over dryness will linger into spring.
