South Africa - Weather

Dry or critically dry conditions will persist for Free State and neighboring areas during the next two

Winter wheat will remain dormant or semi-dormant in most locations

A significant boost in rain is still needed to support better wheat growthWestern Cape will also remain dry in the coming weeks

The main winter wheat areas also need to see more frequent rainfall to improve development prospects

Seasonable to seasonably warm weather will continue through next Wednesday


o Highs will peak to the 70s and 80s most often


Several areas will warm to the 90s today and again early next week


2 Portions of western, central, and southern South Africa will also only warm to the 50s and 60s later his week and this weekend


Overnight lows will be in the 40s and 50s with portions of interior South Africa cooling to the upper 20s and 30s

■ Several areas near and along the coasts will also only cool to the 60s at times









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
United States of America - Weather


U.S. MIDWEST: Soil moisture and weather conditions will remain largely favorable for the late developing corn and soybean crops throughout the Midwest. There is need for warm temperatures over the next few weeks and some timely rainfall to ensure crops finish development as quickly as possible prior to any frost or freeze threat. There is no viable risk of frost damage in the next ten days Temperatures will be warm during the coming week which should help to stimulate faster crop development.


U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: A tropical wave near the southern Bahamas today will move through or near Florida and into the southeastern states this weekend and early next week. The moisture from this disturbance will bring rain to many areas and end the period of net drying that is under way now and will continue into Friday. Cooling will also occur as the rainy weather begins. Some rain from the disturbance will also impact the Delta.

Most crop conditions are expected to remain favorably rated over the next couple of weeks, although expected rain this weekend will delay fieldwork.









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
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
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
South America - Weather


BRAZIL: Concern about limited rainfall in center west and center south crop areas will slowly grow as the next two weeks pass and little rain of significance occurs in key crop areas. Some delay in early season planting of corn and soybeans will be possible, although there will still be plenty of time for better weather to evolve later this month. Rain in far southern Brazil will be good for winter wheat. Excessive pre-monsoonal heat in the north will draw greater attention to the region until significant rain falls. Some early planting of corn and soybeans has begun in Parana and Sap Paulo, but those areas will need significant rain soon replenish soil moisture.

ARGENTINA: Rain is still needed throughout western Argentina where soil moisture is too low to support wheat development when consistently warm temperatures begin to occur. The region needs moisture to induce better crop establishment prior to aggressive spring growth. Moisture is also needed to support early corn and sunseed planting and establishment. Fieldwork will be left on hold until significant rain falls from Buenos Aires and La Pampa northward to Santiago del Estero. Some relief to dryness will occur late this month with October conditions looking better









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
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
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
Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather


EUROPE: Restricted precipitation and drying will occur over most of Europe the next ten days to two weeks. Drying will promote fieldwork throughout the southern U.K., France, Germany, Poland through Italy and the Balkan Nations this week. However, concern over dryness will delay winter planting and establishment in France as well as the Balkan Nations where conditions have been quite dry.

AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation will occur throughout Australia the next week to ten days. Interior south-central into East-central Australia drought is not likely to change and winter crop development will remain poor and a reduction in cotton, sorghum, corn, sunseed and other crops will be possible if drought prevails into October.









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
