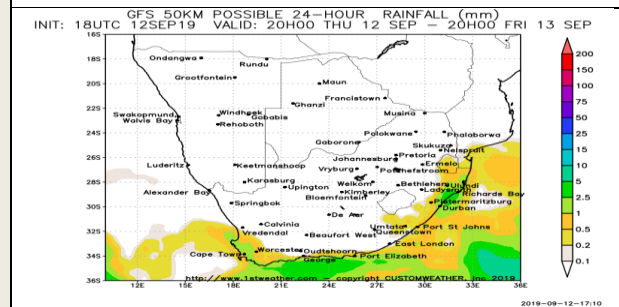
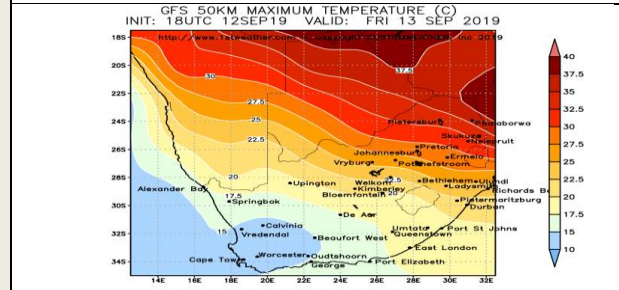
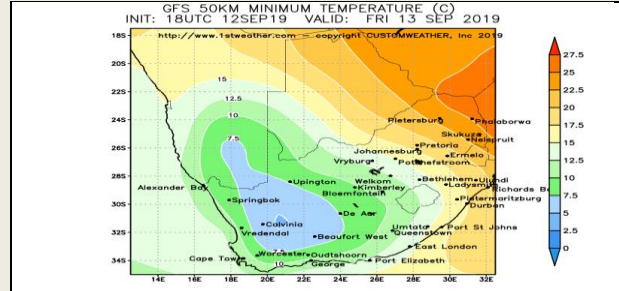
# South Africa - Weather

- South Africa will generally remain drier biased during the next two weeks
- o Brief periods of light precipitation will occur at times, mostly near and along the coasts
- o However, rainfall will generally be too light to counter evaporation or impact long-term soil conditions
- Free State and neighboring areas will remain critically dry in the coming weeks
- o Winter wheat will remain dormant or semi-dormant in most locations
- o Frequent rainfall will be needed in late September and October to support a better environment for the wheat
- Dryness will persist for Western Cape in the coming weeks as well
- o The main winter wheat areas also need to see more frequent rainfall to improve development prospects

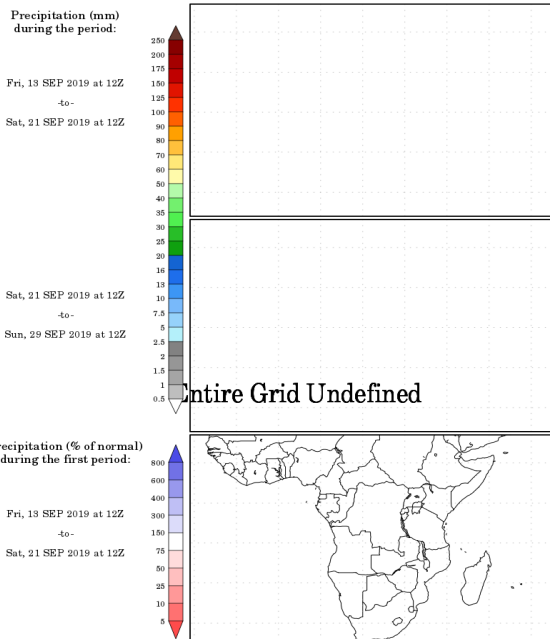
SOUTH AFRICA

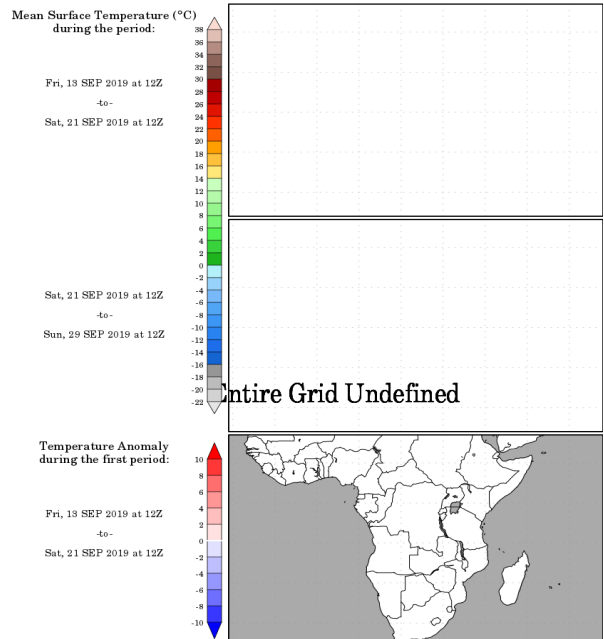


## Precipitation Forecasts

Forecast Initialization Time: 12Z13SEP2019

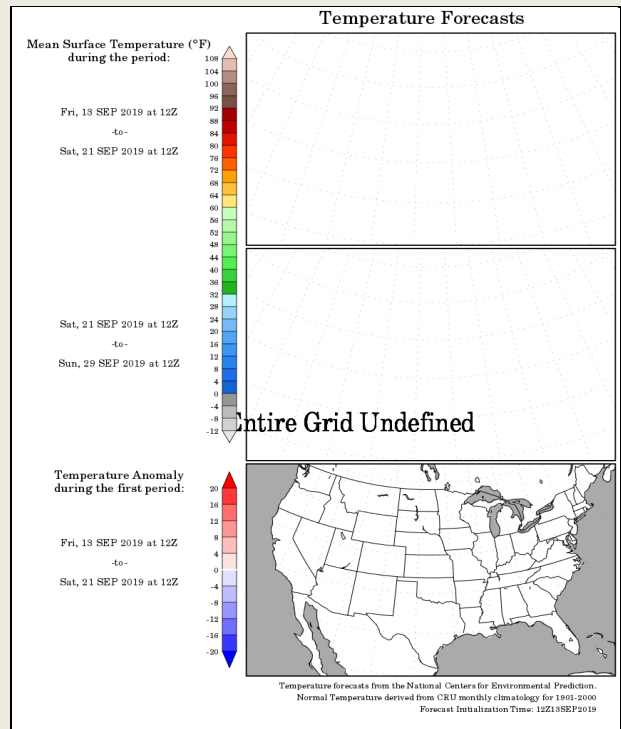
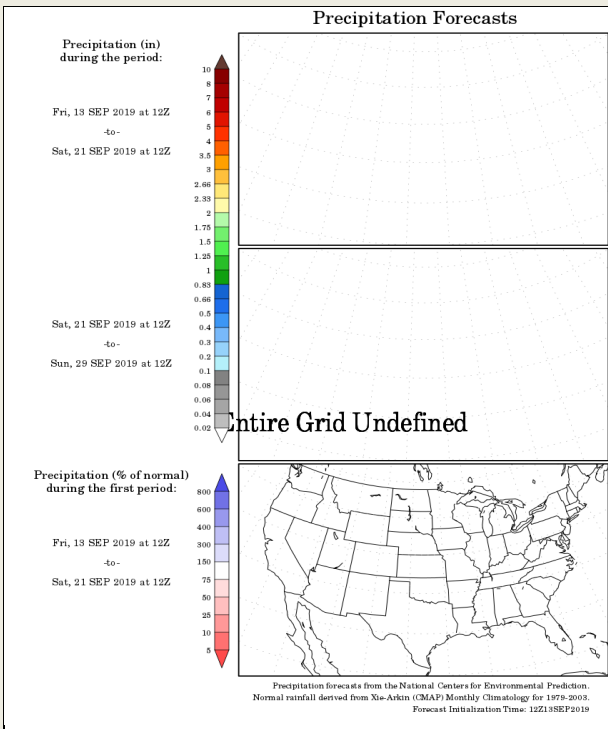
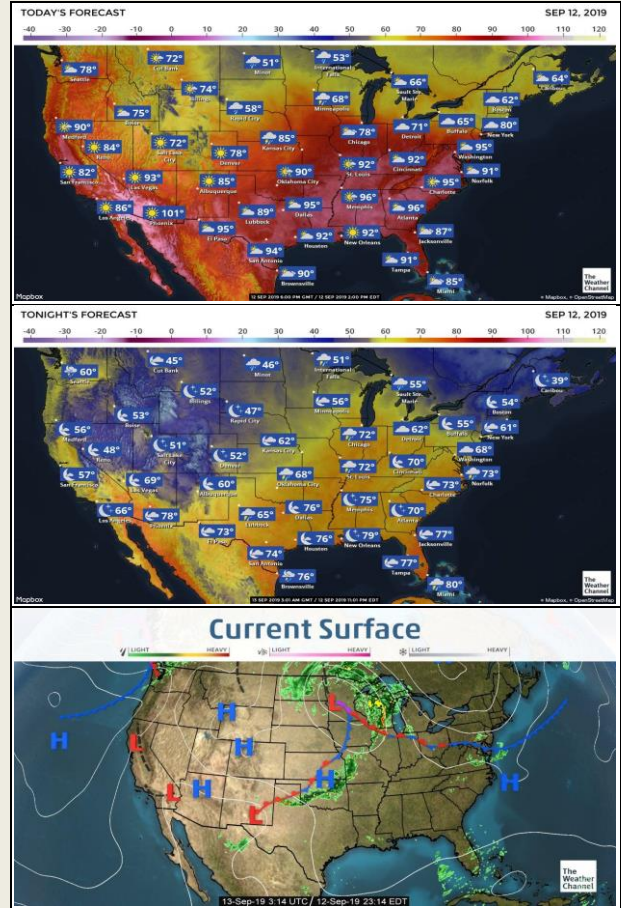
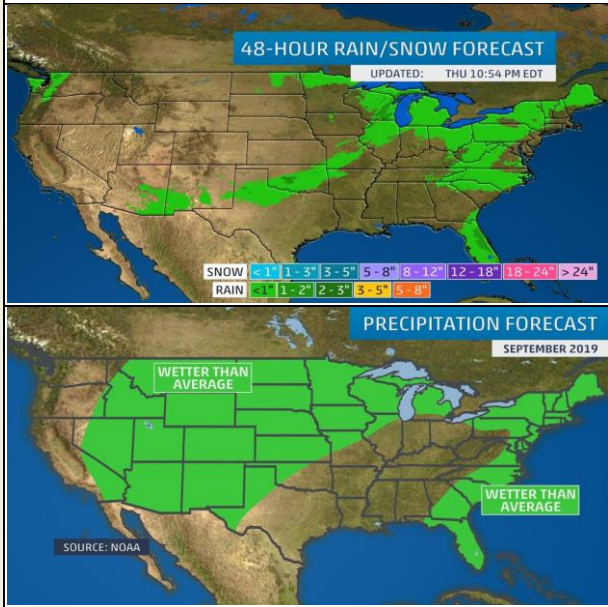

# United States of America - Weather

**U.S. MIDWEST:** Much of the Midwest will see favorable conditions for crop maturation and harvesting through the middle of next week as only one round of rain is expected and temperatures will be warm. o That rain event will occur today into Friday with the far northwestern Corn Belt as well as eastern Kansas to eastern Iowa, southern Wisconsin, and northern Illinois wettest where most areas will receive 0.30-1.30" and locally more.

**U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST:** A tropical disturbance near the Bahamas this morning will need to be closely monitored as it moves towards the southeastern states during the next several days and possibly becomes a tropical cyclone.

o Confidence is low for the track and potential intensity of this disturbance as the various computer forecast models are suggesting a wide variety of solutions.

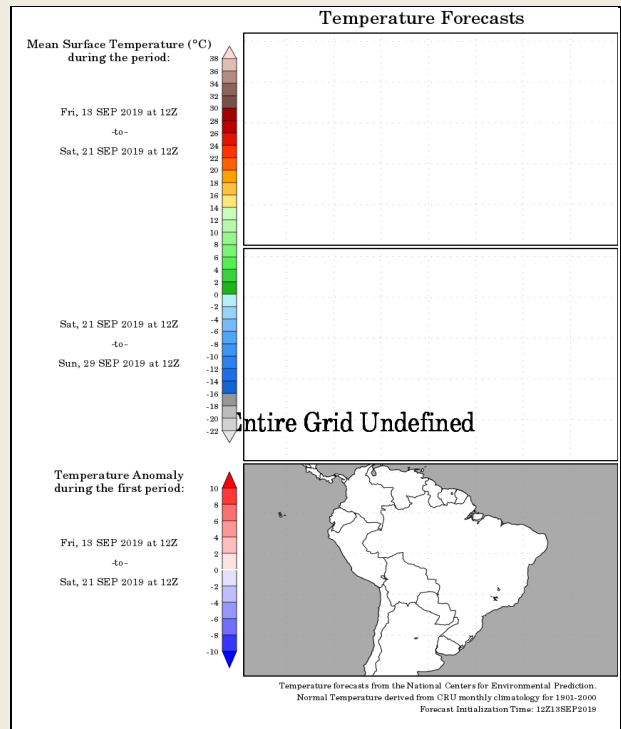
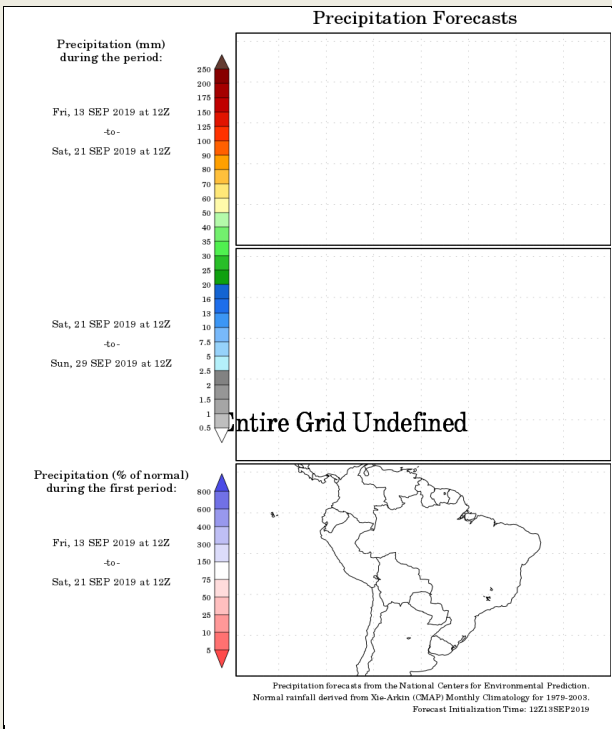
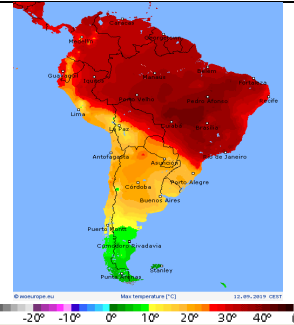
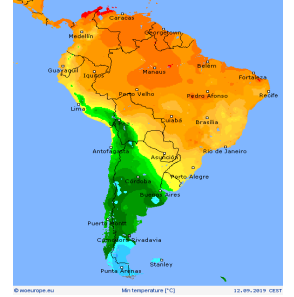
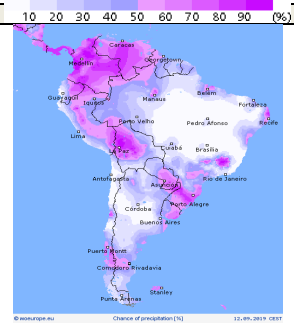
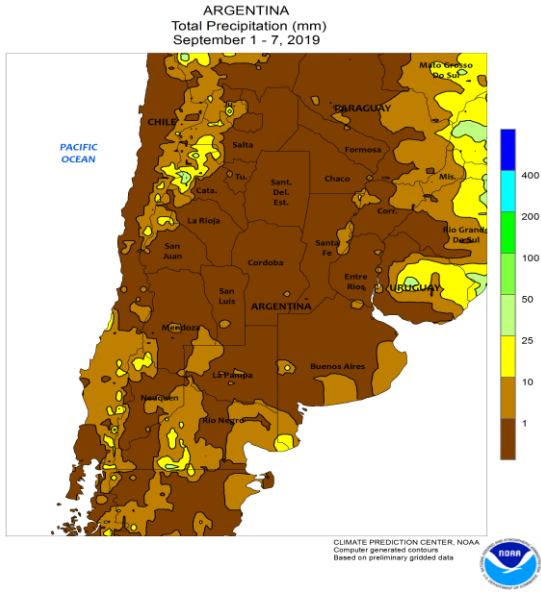
# South America - Weather

**BRAZIL:** Little rain of significance is expected through the next ten days to two weeks outside of Rio Grande do Sul and Santa Catarina and greater rain is needed to improve conditions for summer crop planting.

o Regular rounds of mostly light showers will occur through the next two weeks in Rio Grande do Sul and Santa Catarina with the next round of rain to the north of this region possible Sep. 24-26.

**ARGENTINA:** A restricted rainfall pattern will be in place during the next ten days to two weeks and greater rain is needed in many areas to improve conditions for eventual summer crop planting while wheat in western Argentina remains in need of rain to improve conditions for development.

o A few showers will occur on occasion with eastern Argentina seeing rain most often and most of that rain likely to be light.



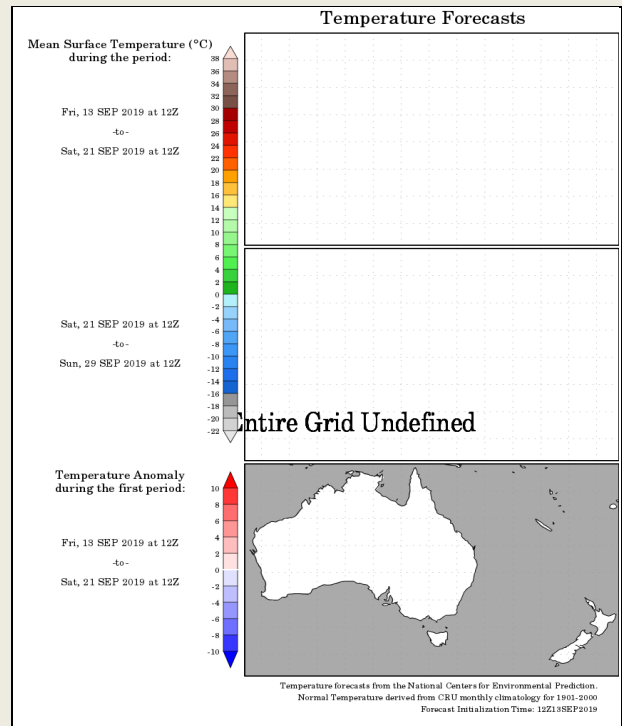
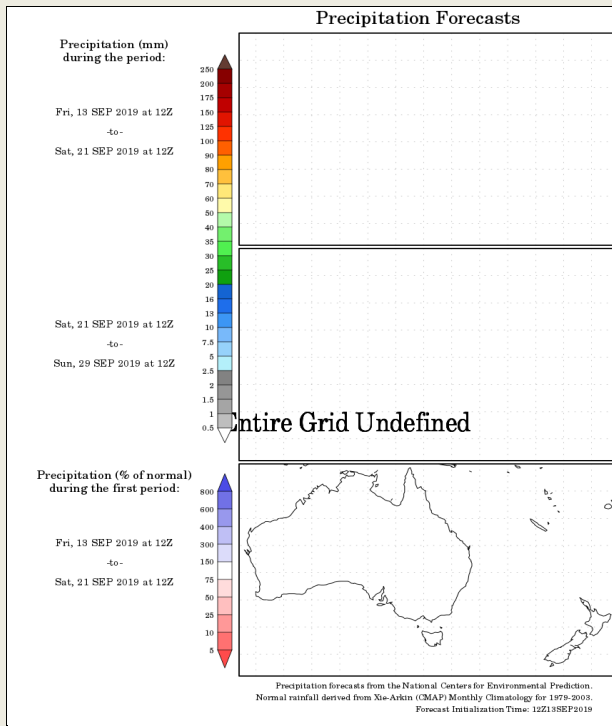
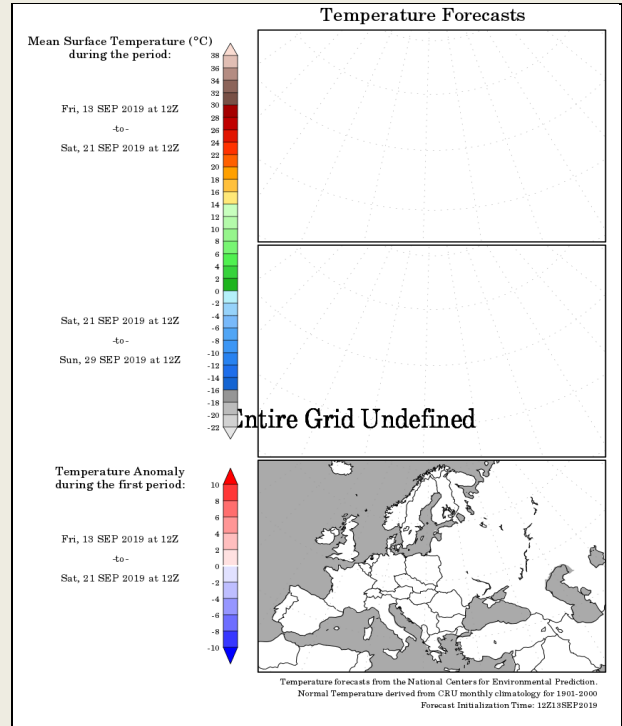
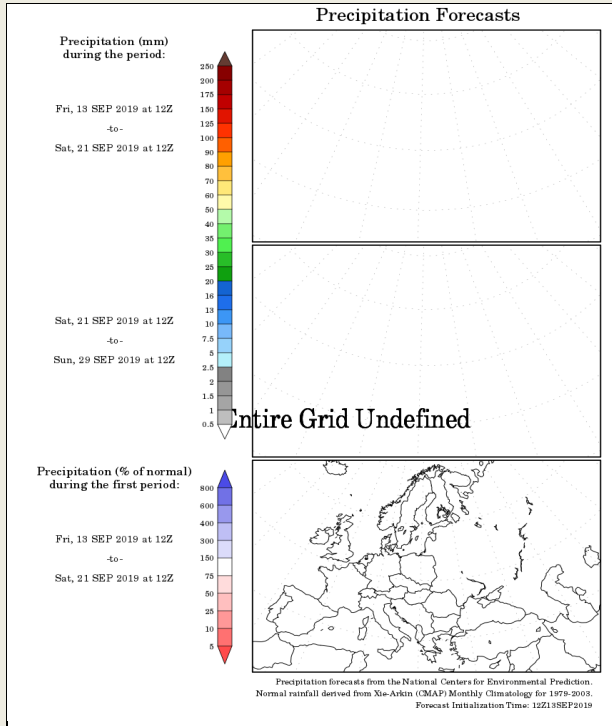

## Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

**EUROPE:** Restricted precipitation and drying will occur over most of Europe the next ten days to two weeks. Drying will promote fieldwork throughout the southern U.K., France, Germany, Poland through Italy and the Balkan Nations this week. However, concern over dryness will delay winter planting and establishment in France as well as the Balkan Nations where conditions have been quite dry.

**AUSTRALIA:** Restricted precipitation and drying will occur throughout most of Australia this coming week. Interior south-central into East-central Australia drought is not likely to change and winter crop development will remain poor and a reduction in cotton, sorghum, corn, sunseed and other crops will be possible if drought prevails into October.
