South Africa - Weather

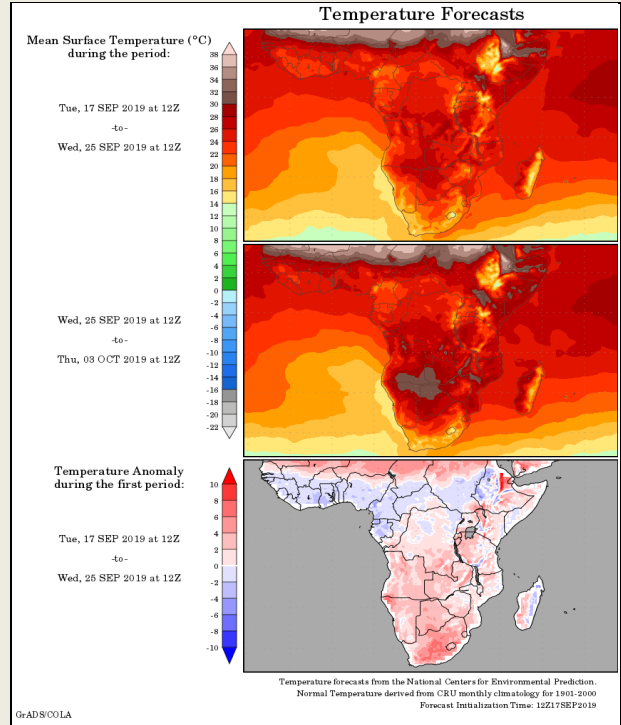
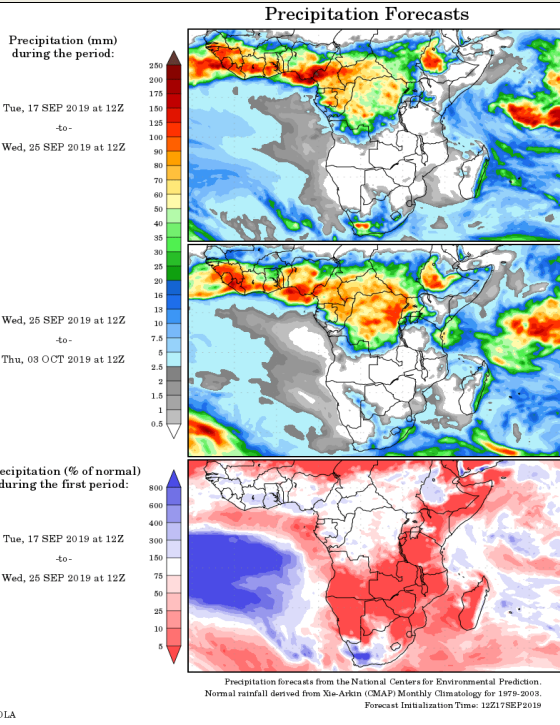
- Free State and neighboring areas will remain critically dry in the coming weeks
 - The main production areas will miss out on the most significant rain later in the forecast period
 - Winter wheat will remain dormant or semi-dormant in most locations
 - Better rainfall is still needed in October to improve crop prospects
 - Western Cape may see minor improvements to the moisture profile following the rain event this weekend and early next week
 - However, most areas will not receive enough rain to completely reverse the moisture deficits

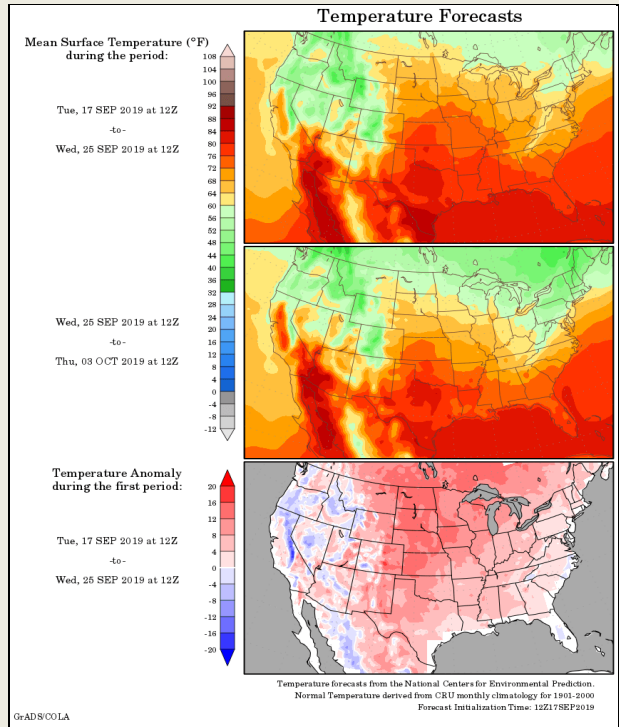
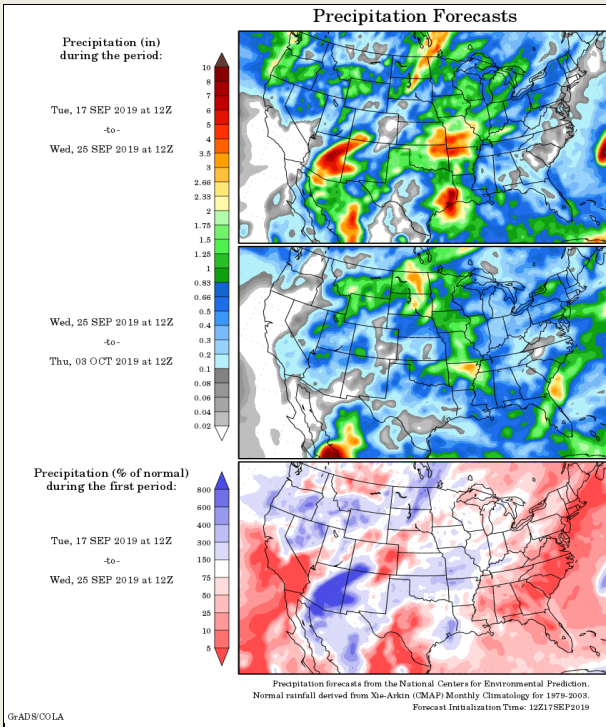
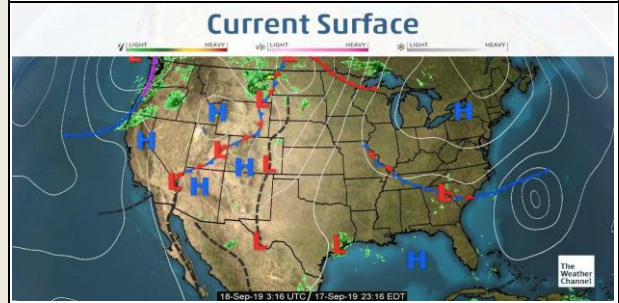
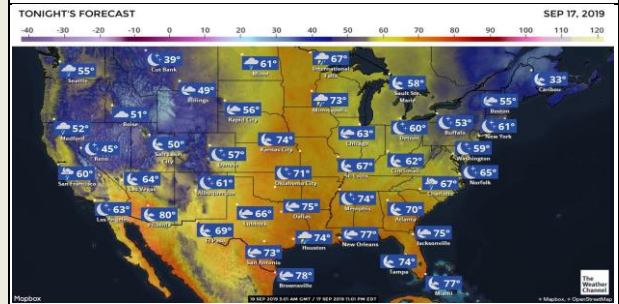
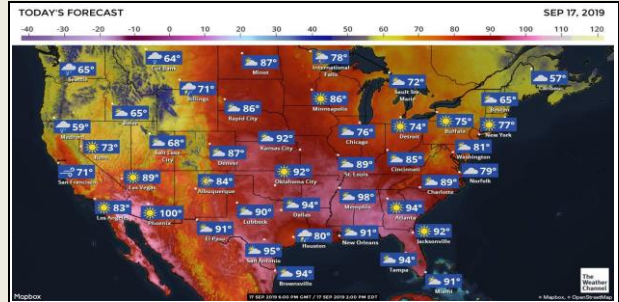
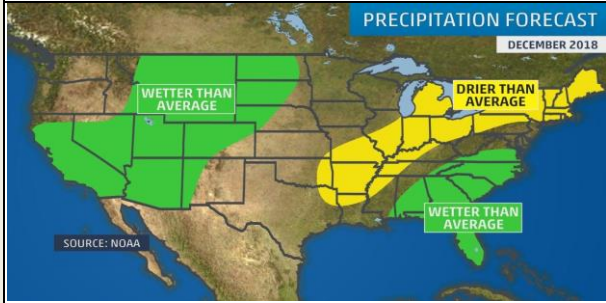
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United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Today's forecast is a little wetter overall than what was advertised Monday, but the advertised rain should not be great enough to cause serious interruptions to fieldwork. Showers will develop in at least a part of the Midwest each day through the next two weeks with the focus of rain shifting often and much of the rain likely to be light outside of a more significant rain event Friday through Sunday.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: No significant changes have been made to the two-week outlook for the Delta and the southeastern states since Monday and a restricted rainfall pattern will remain in place most often allowing for good harvest progress while some immature crops may be stressed by a lack of soil moisture.

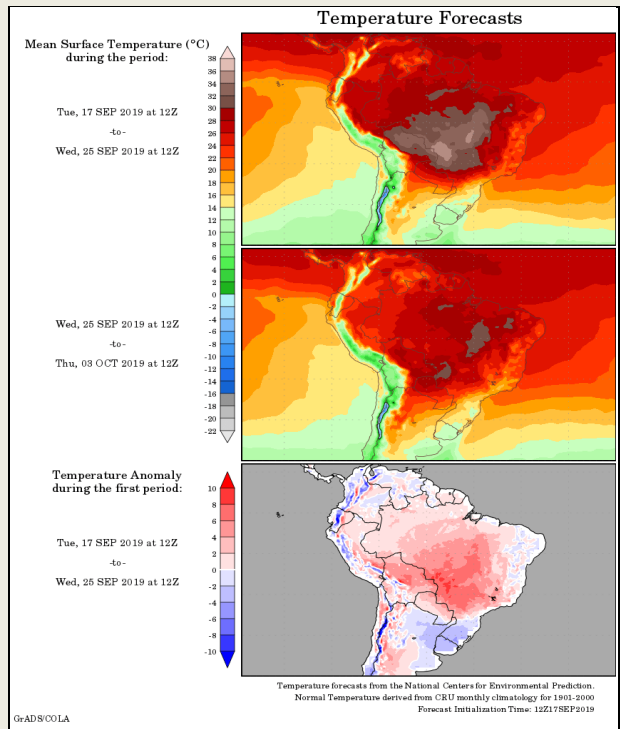
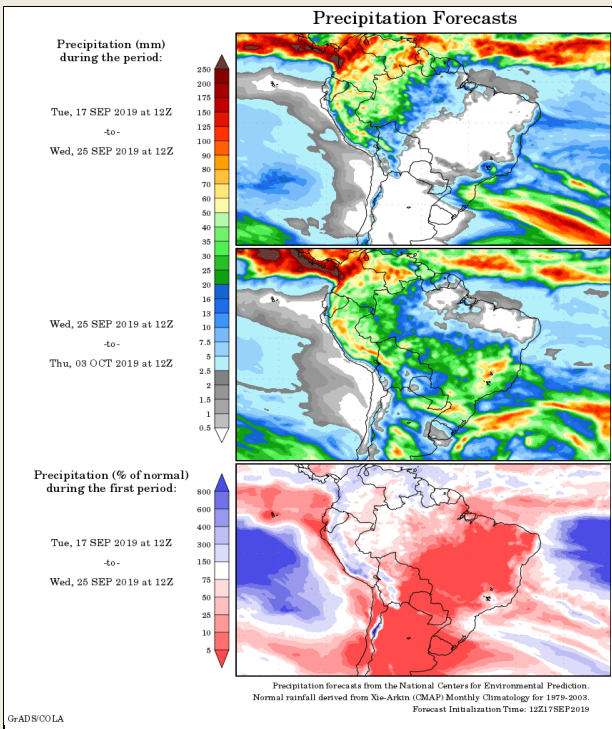
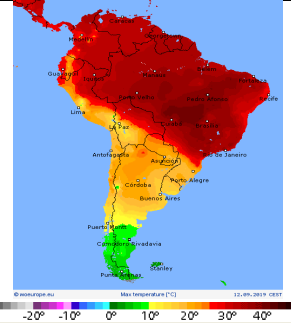
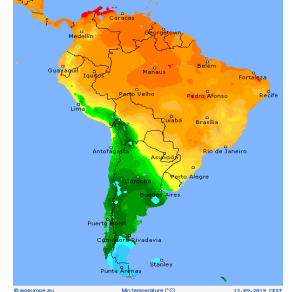
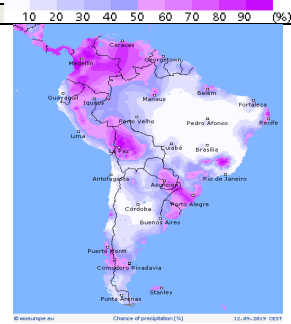
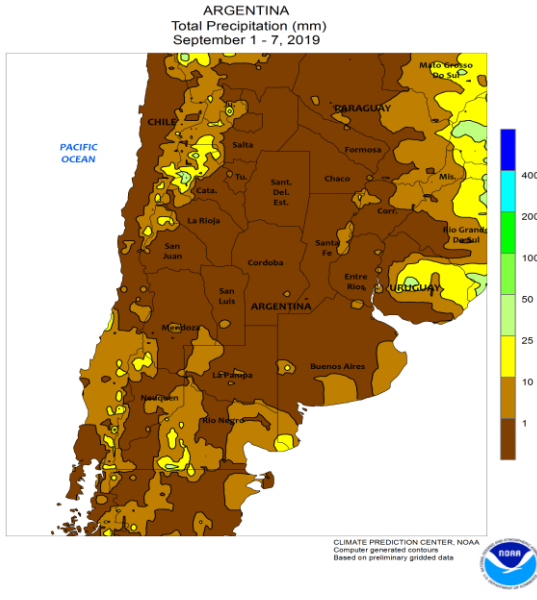
A few showers will occur on occasion and the resulting rain will be welcome where crops are immature, but many areas will not receive enough rain to have a significant impact on soil conditions.



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South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Few changes have been made to the two-week outlook since late last week and most of the shower activity of significance during the next week to ten days will occur in the south leaving most areas in need of greater rain to improve conditions for summer crop planting.
ARGENTINA: A restricted rainfall pattern will remain in place through at least the next ten days and greater rain is needed in many areas to improve conditions for summer crop planting while wheat in western Argentina remains in need of rain to improve conditions for development.
 o A few light showers will occur in northeastern Argentina today with little additional rain into the middle of next week.



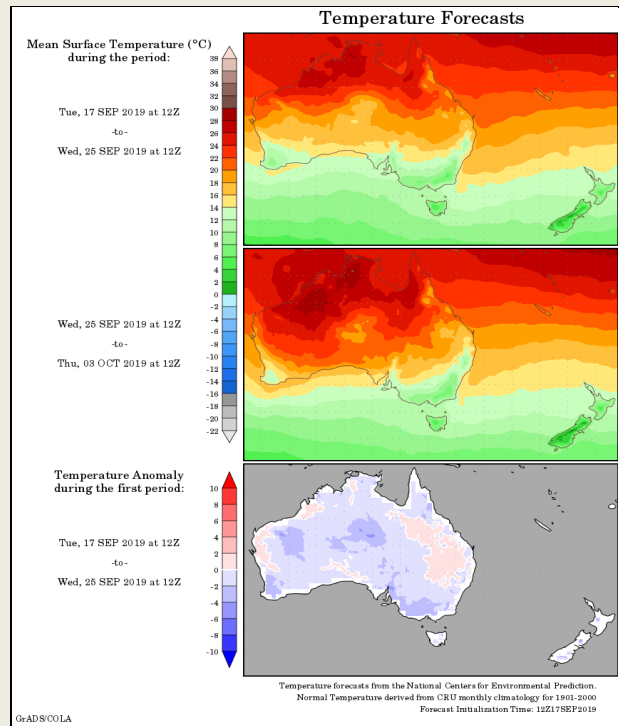
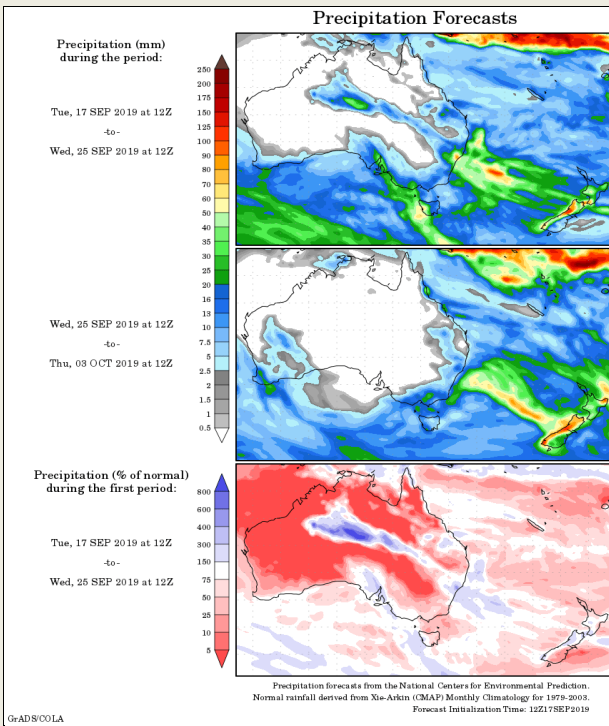
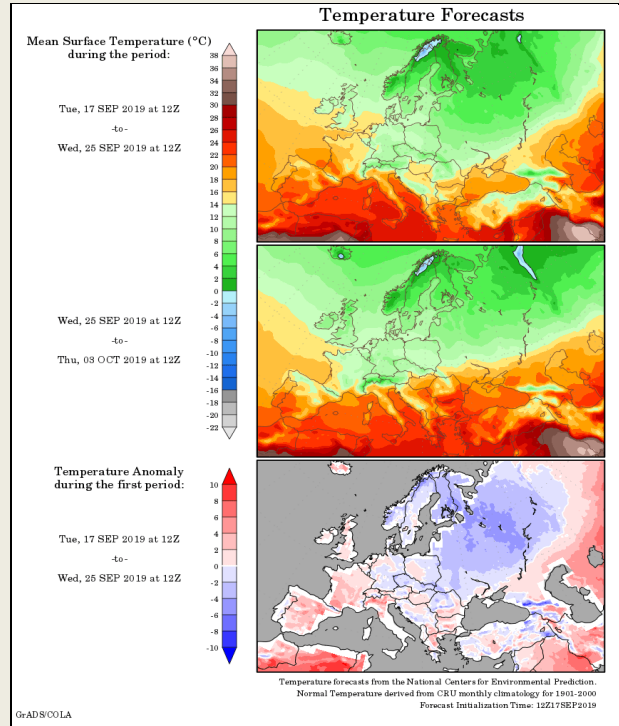
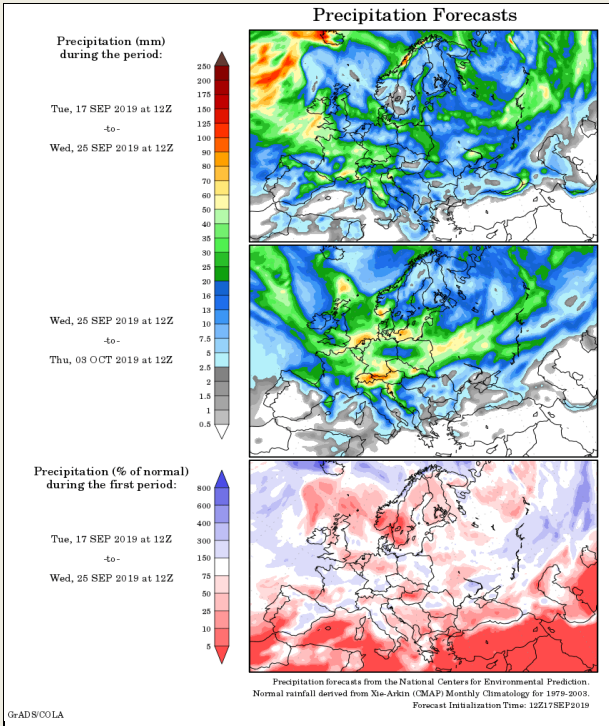
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Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: • Restricted precipitation and drying will occur over most of Europe this week. Drying will promote fieldwork most often. However, concern over dryness will delay winter planting and establishment in France as well as the Balkan Nations where conditions have been quite dry.

AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation and drought will continue over western and central New South Wales into Queensland this week. Winter crop development will remain poor and a reduction in cotton, sorghum, corn and other crops will be possible if drought prevails into October.

o With that said, a few significant production areas, in the western slopes of east-central to northeast New South Wales, will receive increased moisture this weekend.



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
