



United States of America - Weather


U.S. MIDWEST: Crop maturation and harvesting should continue to occur in a mostly favorable environment through the next two weeks, although rain will be more frequent and temperatures will become cooler than what has occurred recently.


o Showers will develop in at least a part of the Midwest each day through the next two weeks with the focus of rain shifting often and much of the rain likely to be light outside of a more significant rain event Friday through Sunday.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Today's forecast is wetter through Friday for the Delta as the remnants of Tropical Storm Imelda will bring rain to the region with the remainder of the next two weeks still expected to feature a rainfall pattern most often allowing for good harvest progress while some immature crops should be stressed by a lack of soil moisture.





However, concern over dryness will delay winter planting and establishment in France as well as the Balkan Nations where conditions have been quite dry. AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation and drought will continue over western and central New South Wales into Queensland through Monday.
