

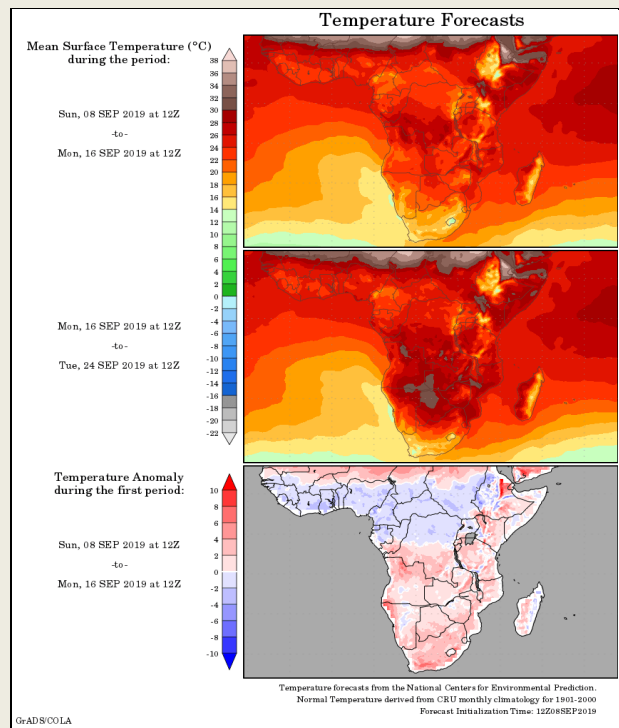
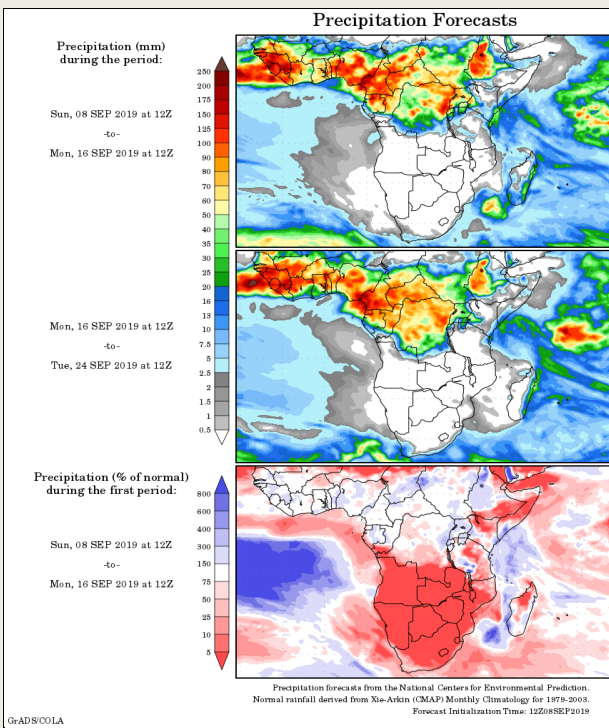
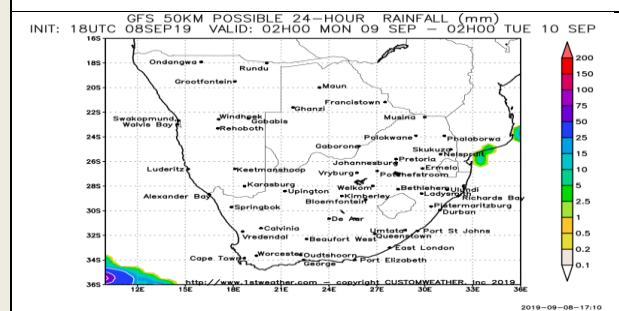
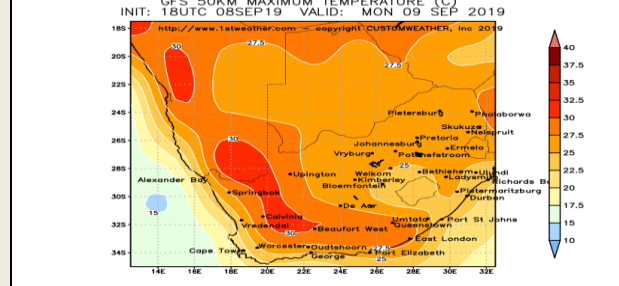
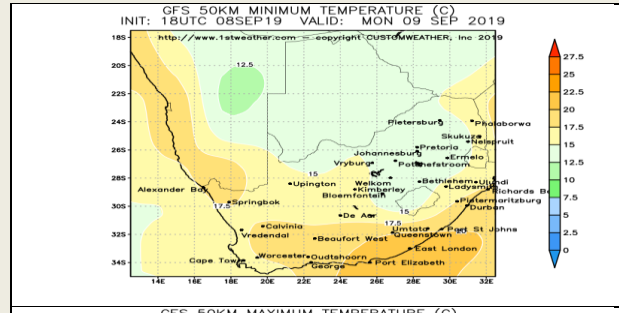
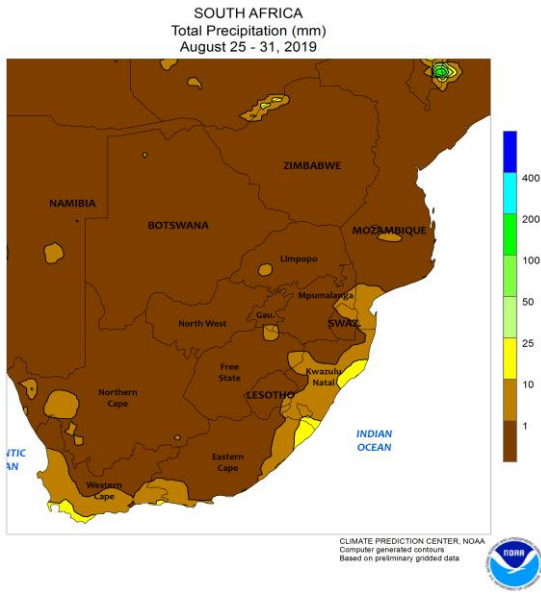


Weather Report
09 September 2019

South Africa - Weather

Portions of eastern South Africa will receive light rain today while a frontal boundary brings light rain to western and southern Africa toward the end of next week

- o Moisture totals by next Friday morning will range from a trace to 0.50 inch most often for these areas
- o Dry or mostly dry weather is expected most other days during the coming week
- o Any precipitation that does occur will be too light to counter evaporation
- o Southern South Africa will have opportunities for rain September 14 – 20 while areas further north remain in a mostly dry mode
- Free State and neighboring areas will remain critically dry during the next two weeks
- o Winter wheat will remain dormant or semi-dormant in most locations
- o Significant rain is still needed to improve winter wheat growth prospects
- Western Cape will also remain dry or critically dry in the coming weeks
- o The periods of rain that occur next week will generally be too light to impact long-term soil conditions
- o Significant rain will also be needed in the main winter wheat areas later in September and early October to improve the outlook for the crops.

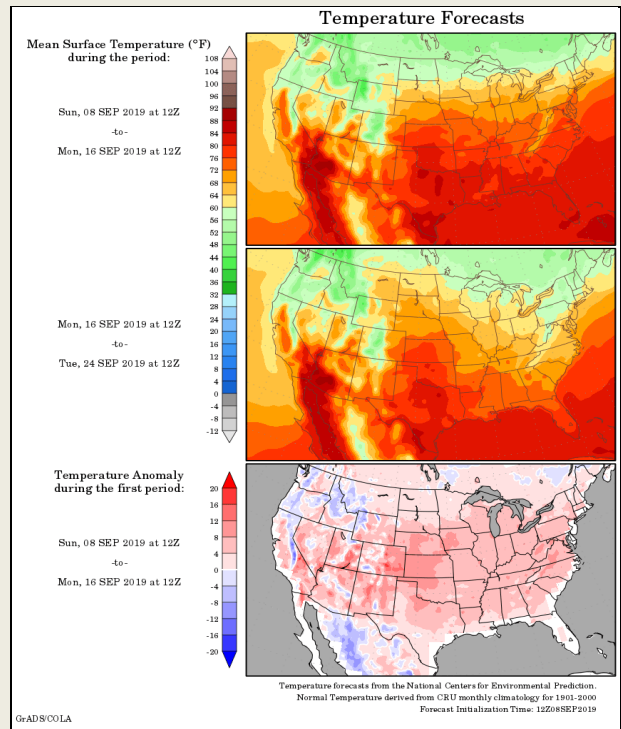
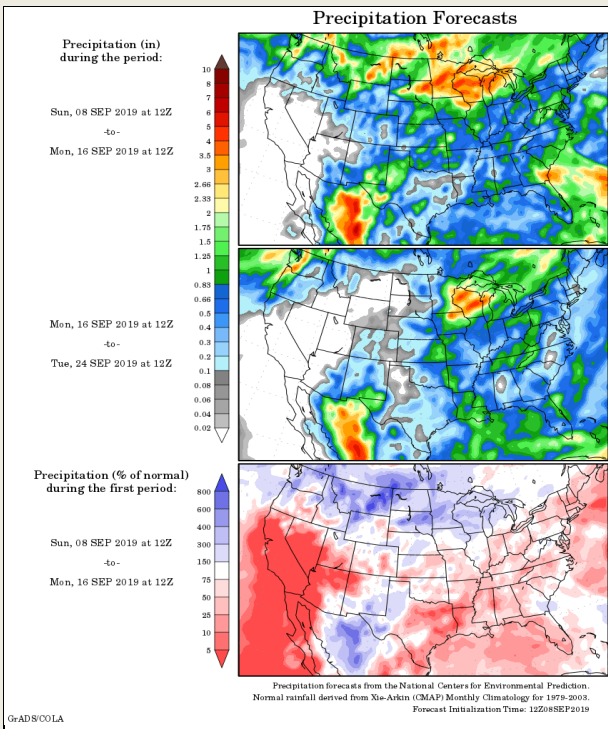
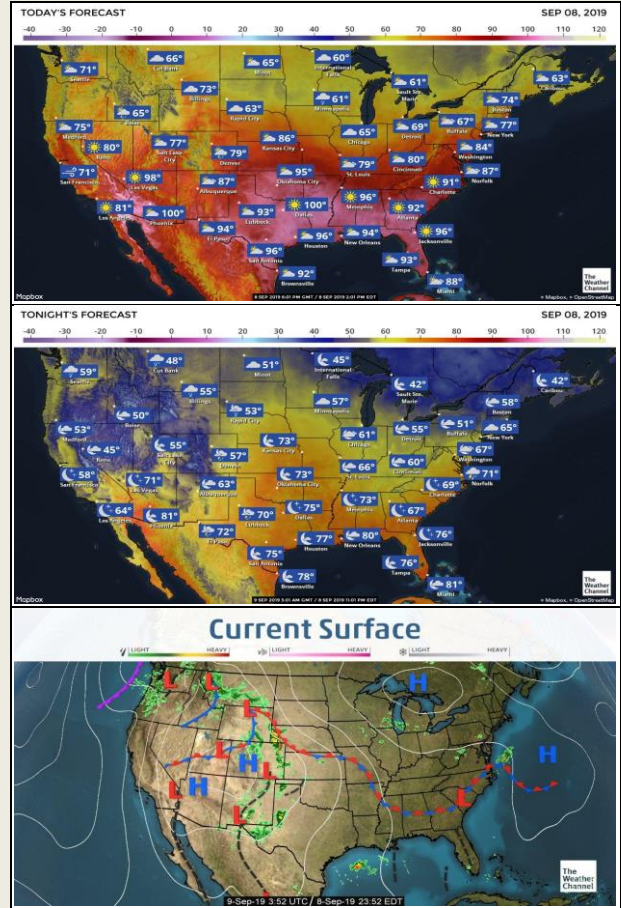
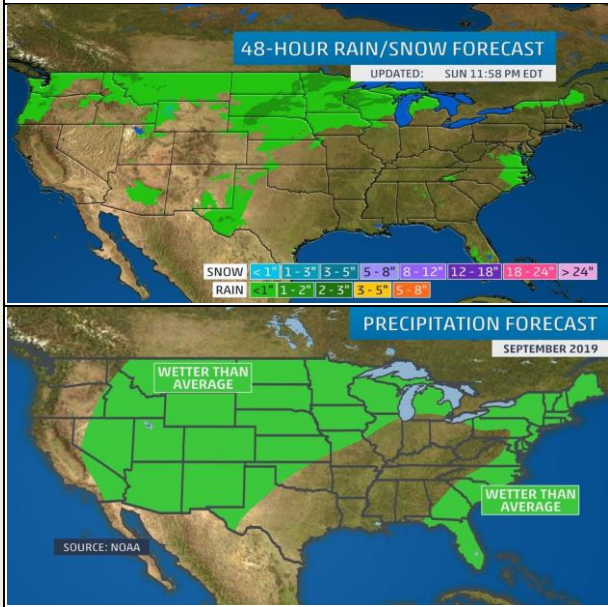

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: The two-week outlook has not changed much since Thursday and much of the Midwest will continue to dry down overall while soil moisture remains favorable in most areas with no risk of crop-threatening cold for at least another week.
 o Enough soil moisture is in place to support crop development in much of the region while drying occurs and with timely rain expected Wednesday into next Friday, nearly all locations should have enough soil moisture to support the needs of crops to maturity.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Hurricane Dorian was near Cape Hatteras, North Carolina this morning and will begin to quickly move away from the region later today.
 o The storm's winds are still not expected to be strong enough outside of areas near the coast to threaten many crops.

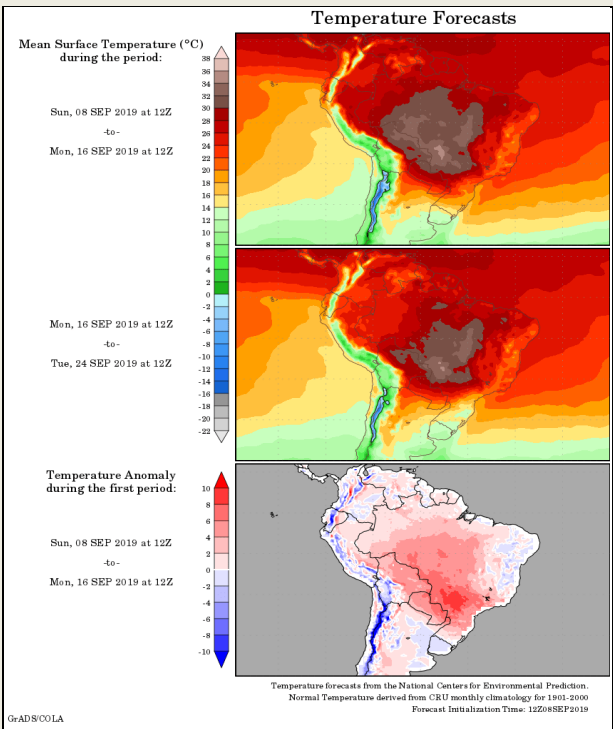
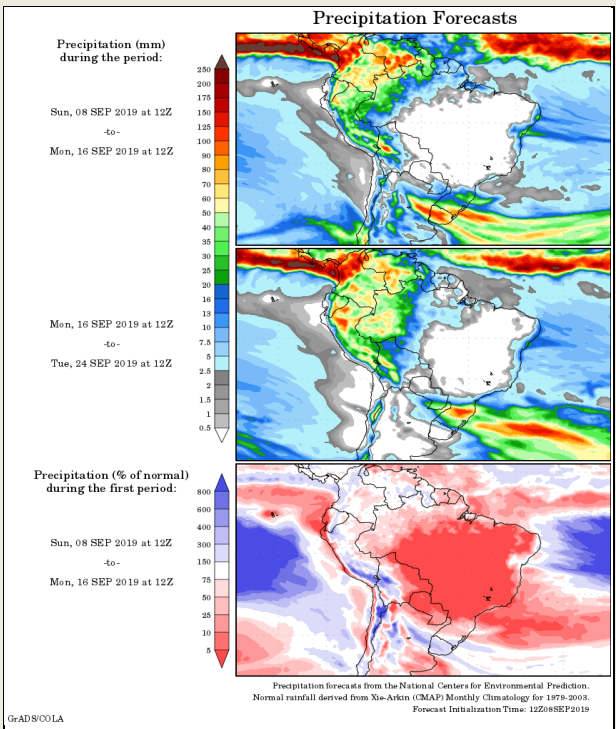
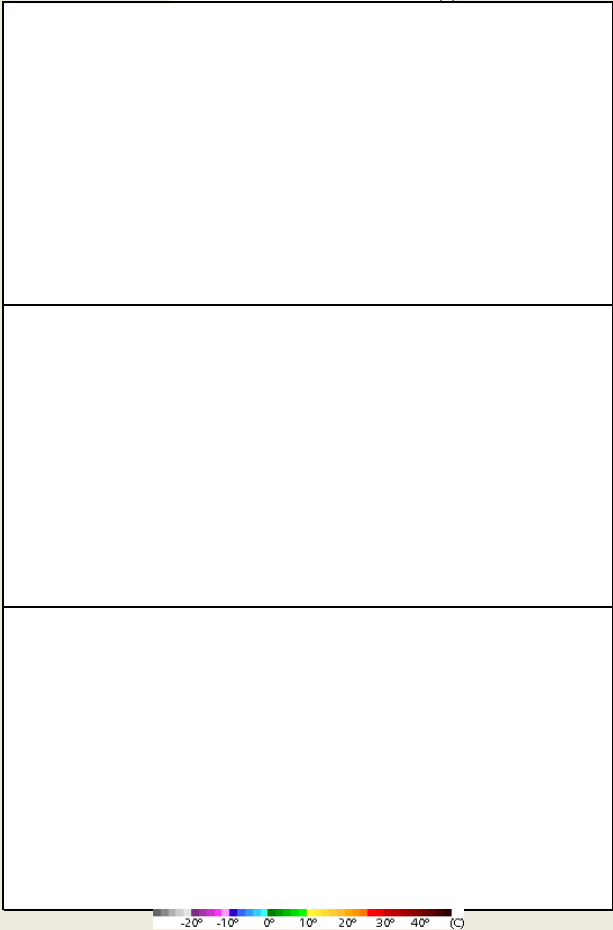
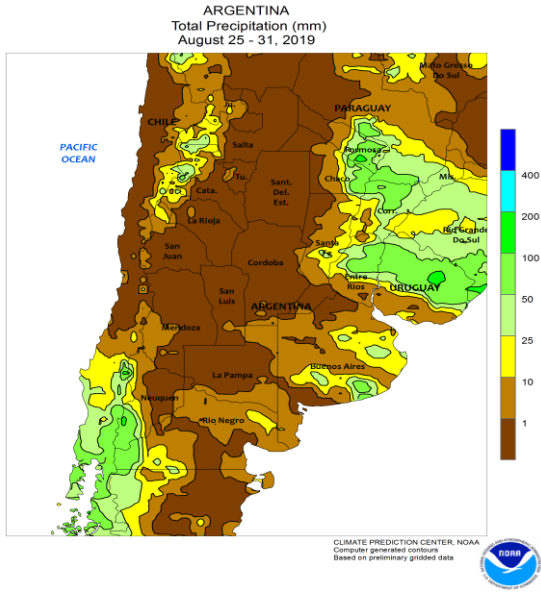
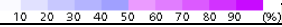

South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Little rain of significance is expected through the next ten days to two weeks outside of Rio Grande do Sul and Santa Catarina and much of the moisture from rain during the past weekend will soon be lost to evaporation.
o Greater rain is needed to induce a more lasting increase in soil moisture to improve conditions for planting.

ARGENTINA: PA few locations in western Argentina will benefit from rain Sunday into Tuesday while most of western Argentina will not receive enough rain to have a significant impact on soil moisture leaving much of the region in need of greater rain to improve conditions for winter wheat.
o Some light showers will occur in northeastern Argentina today into Saturday before rain increases Sunday into Tuesday.



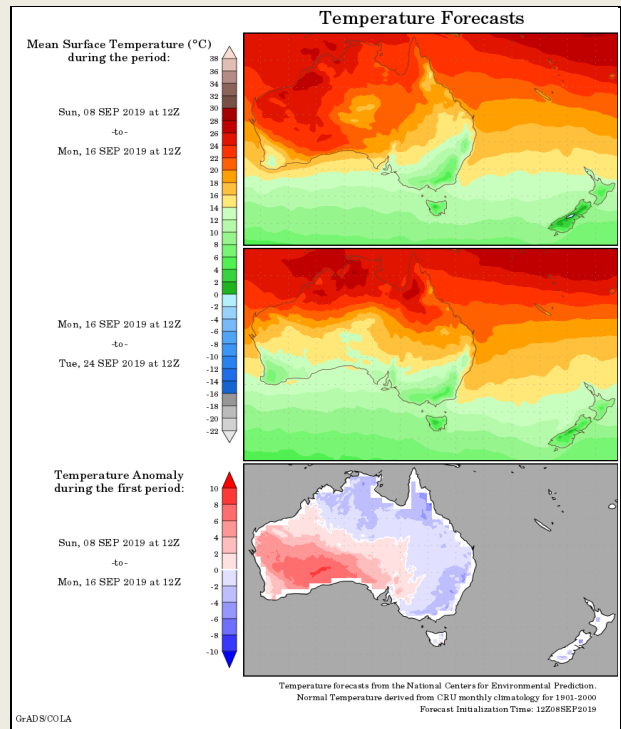
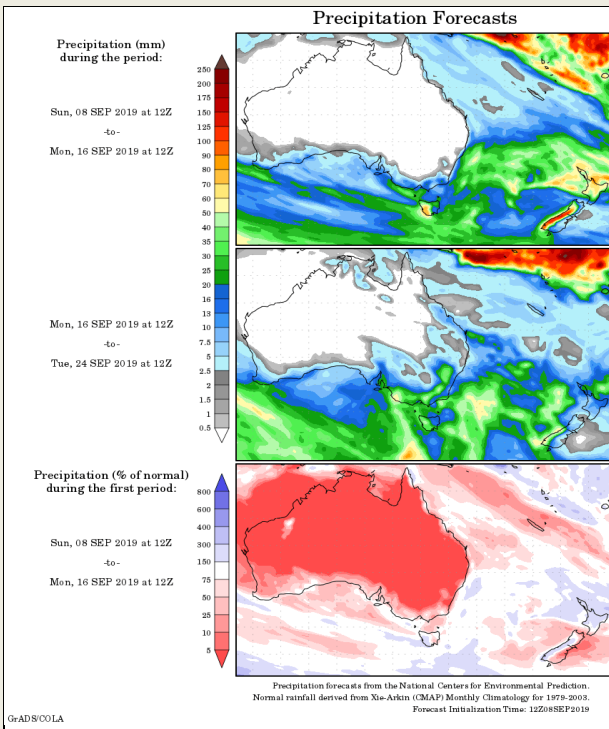
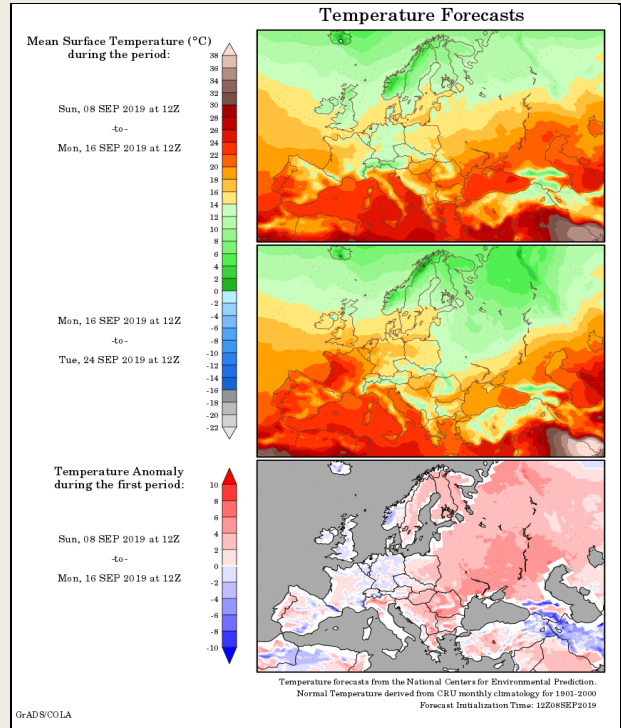
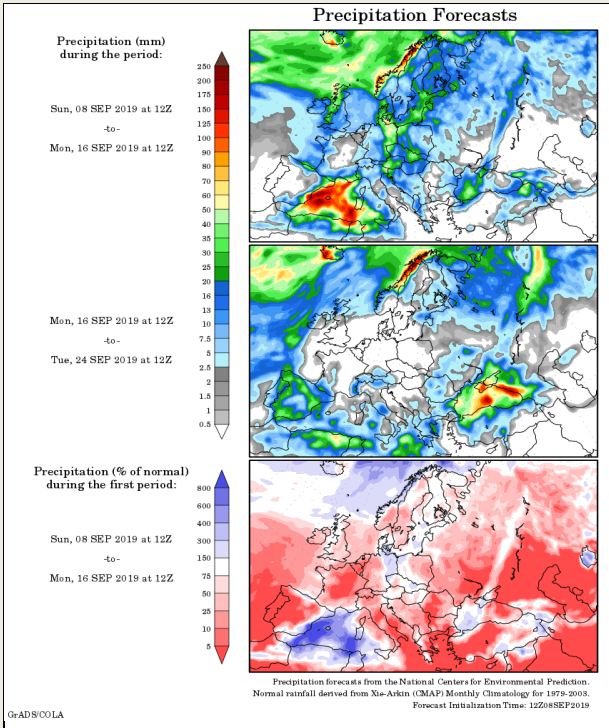

EUROPE: Restricted precipitation and drying will continue to impact portions of Europe this week.

- Little to no rainfall will occur over Spain and France as well as Greece into east Bulgaria and southeast Romania and dryness concerns will prevail
- Meanwhile, rounds of precipitation will eventually occur elsewhere in Europe this week.

AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation and drying will impact Western Australia as well as south-central to east-central Australia the next ten days to two weeks. Interior south-central into East-central Australia drought is not likely to change and winter crop development will remain poor and a reduction in cotton, sorghum, corn, sensed and other crops will be possible if drought prevails into October.
