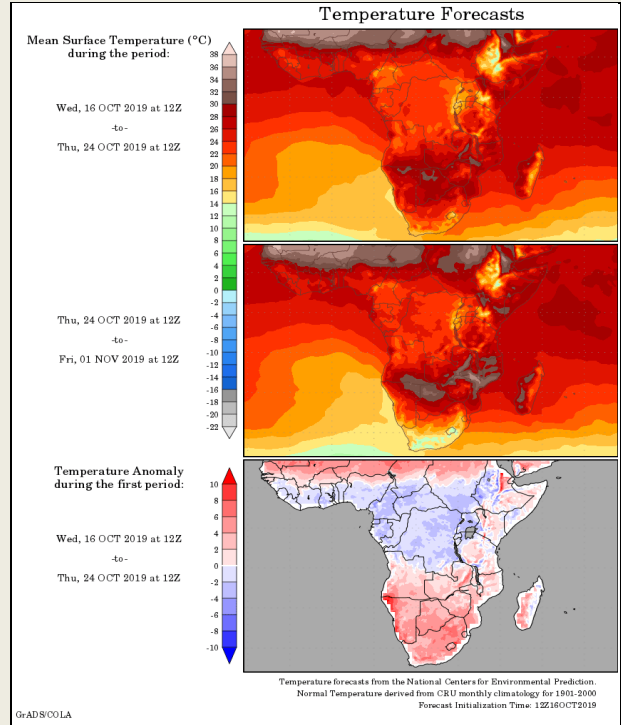
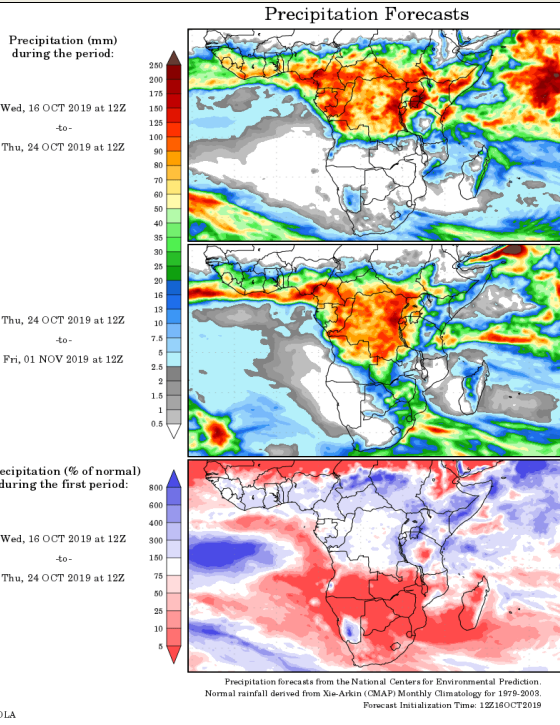
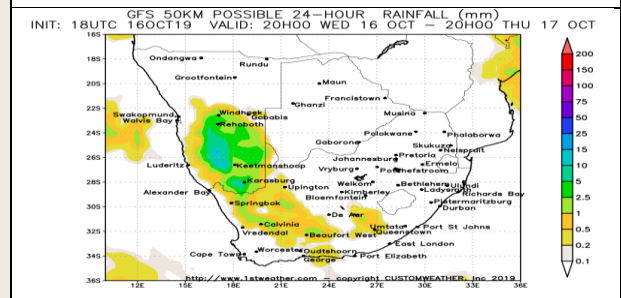
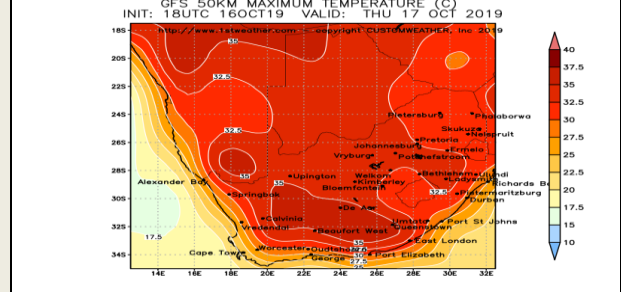
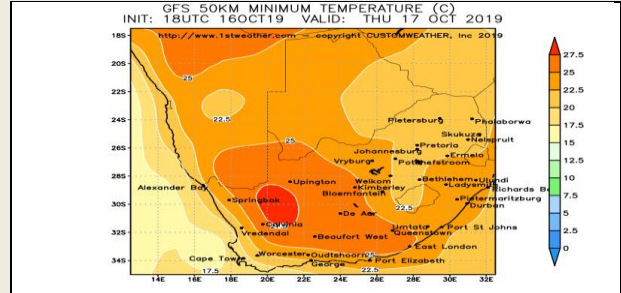
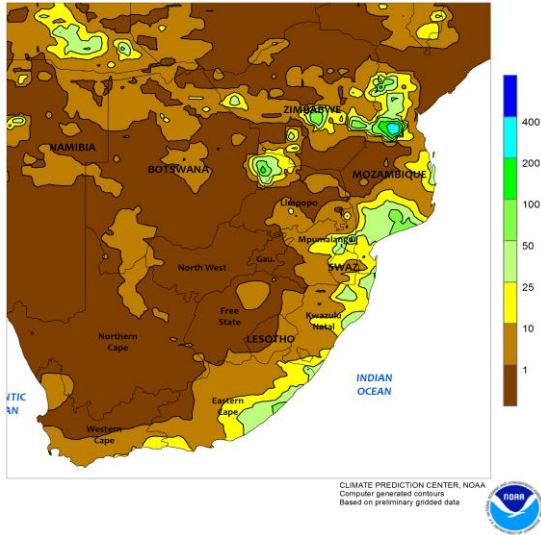
South Africa - Weather

• Additional rainfall will continue to occur over France helping improve conditions for winter crop emergence and establishment and bolster soil moisture. Widespread moisture will continue over France, north Spain, north Portugal, north Italy, Switzerland, west and north Germany and the U.K. through Scandinavia and northern Poland this week.

The greatest precipitation will occur in the southeast France into northwest Italy and parts of Switzerland this coming week. Moisture totals will range from 1.00 to 3.50 inches and local totals exceeding 4.00 inches. Otherwise, moisture totals will vary from 0.50 to 1.50 inches and local totals exceeding 2.00 inches. In the meantime, restricted precipitation and drying will occur over the Hungarian Plain and into southeast Poland and the Czech Republic through the Balkan Nations this coming week. Any precipitation that does occur will be brief and erratic and have little lasting impact on the region.

o The drier conditions will allow for planting of winter crops to advance; however, many locations continue to experience long term dryness and a greater soaking of moisture is needed to provide the best environment for winter crop establishment. Conditions will be favorable for any unharvested summer crops.

October 6 - 12, 2019



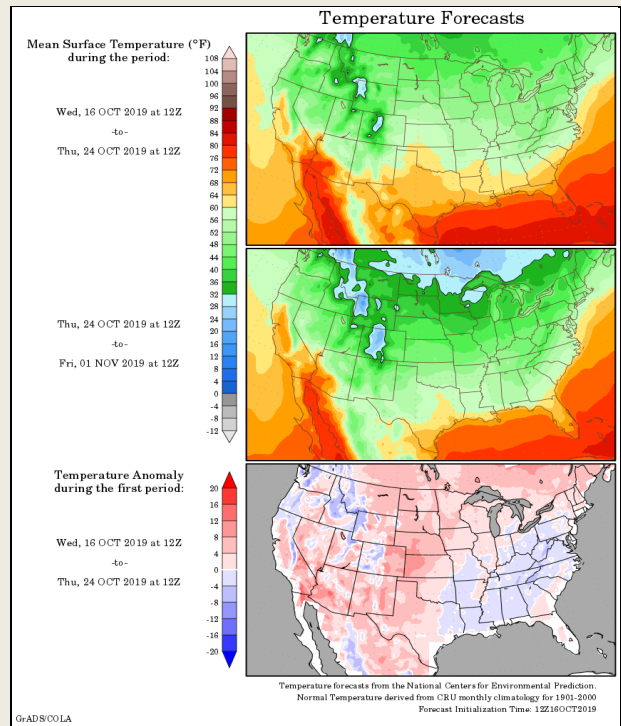
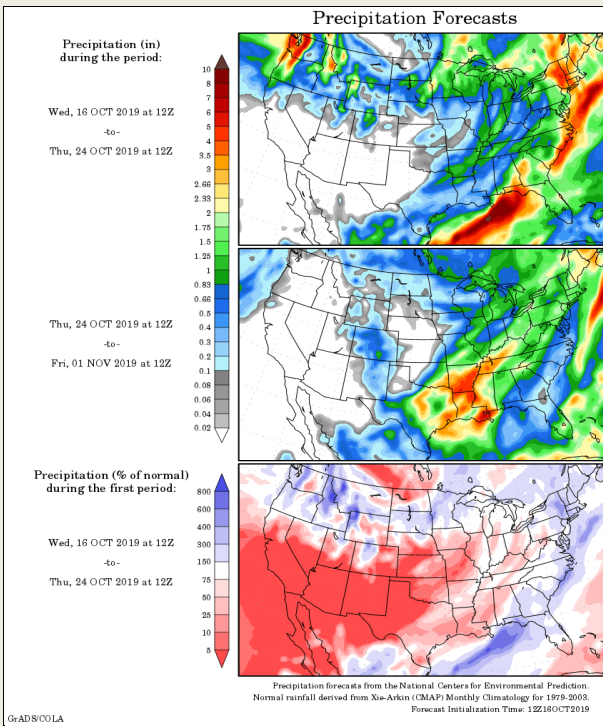
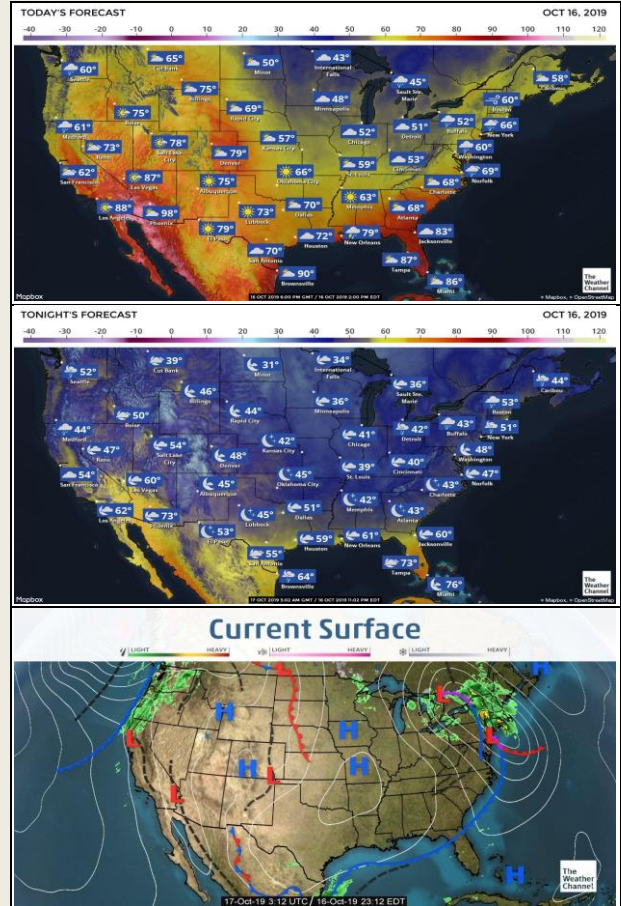
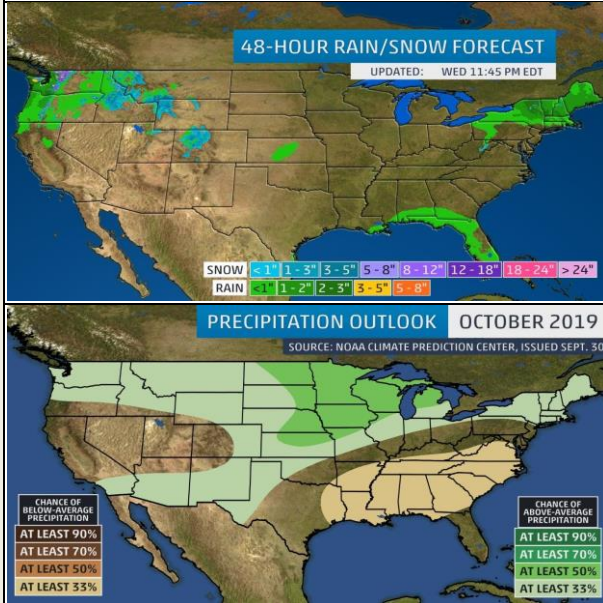
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United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Precipitation from the Sunday into Monday event has been increased for the far northwestern Corn Belt since Tuesday and the eastern Dakotas into northwestern Minnesota will see 0.75-2.0" of moisture and locally more. After last week's storm system left the region saturated an extended period of time will be needed before fieldwork can resume and some further declines to soybean quality may occur as well.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will see occasional rounds of rain during the next week that will slow fieldwork, but breaks between rounds of rain should allow for fieldwork to advance and should also limit quality declines to crops.

o Rain will linger in the Carolinas and southern Virginia today while other areas are mostly dry today into Thursday before a tropical disturbance moves from the Gulf of Mexico into the southeastern states Friday into Saturday.

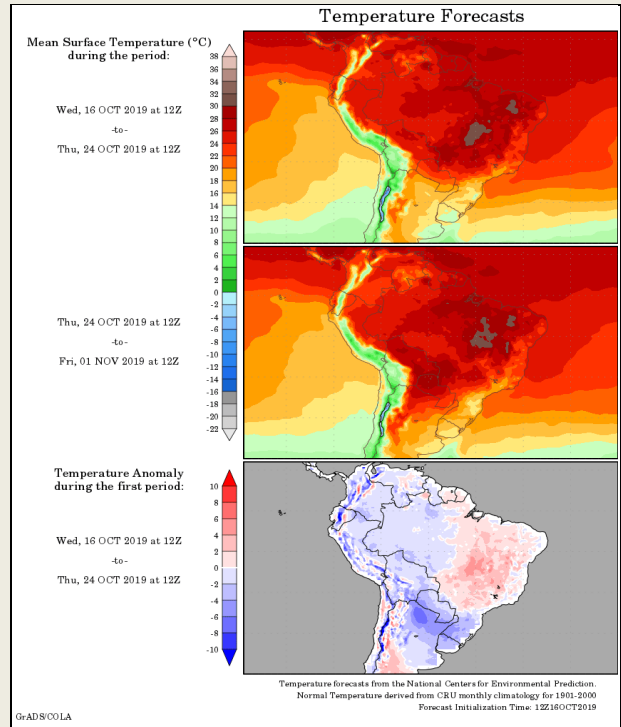
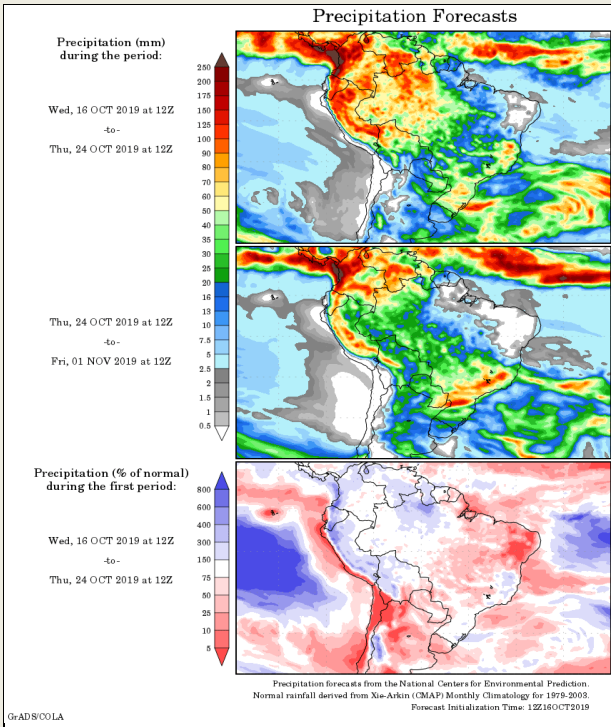
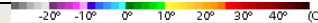
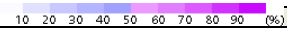
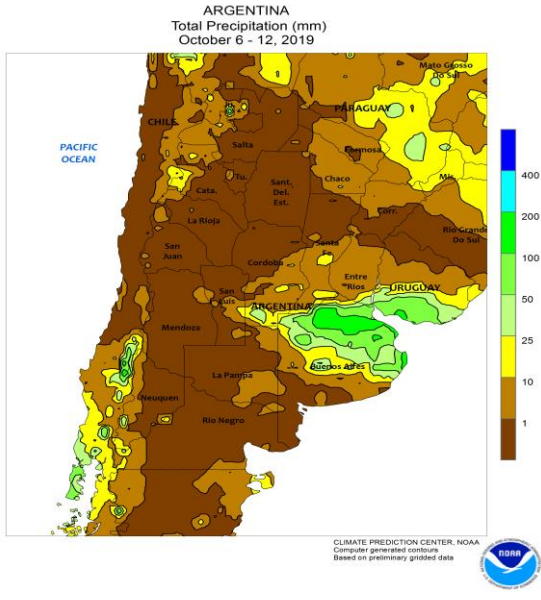


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South America - Weather

BRAZIL: The two-week outlook has not changed much since late last week and many areas from eastern Mato Grosso and northeastern Mato Grosso do Sul into Minas Gerais and Bahia will see little to no rain through Saturday before a timely increase in rain occurs Sunday into next week.

ARGENTINA: Argentina will see regular rounds of showers and thunderstorms through the next ten days with a mix of light to moderate rain most days that will leave some areas with improvements in soil moisture while other areas do not receive enough rain to prevent continued drying. West-central Argentina will be driest overall while the driest areas in southwestern Argentina will have at least some opportunities for rain with Sunday wettest in the southwest.

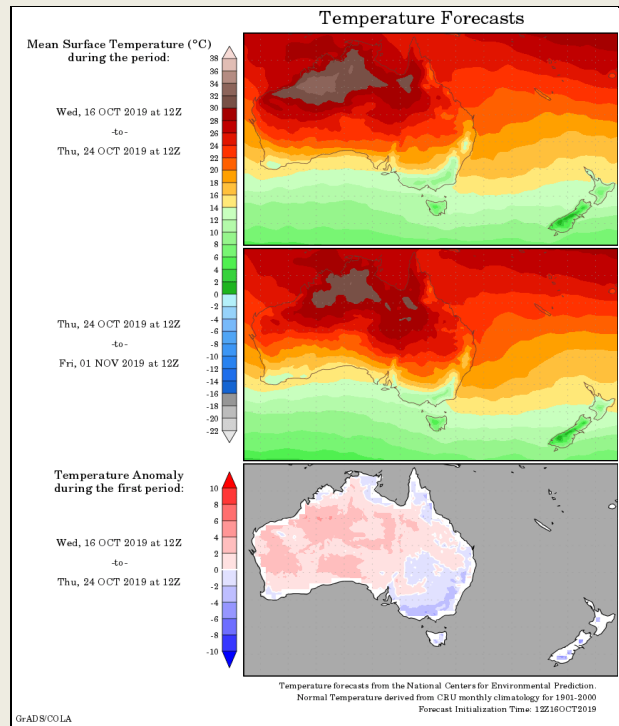
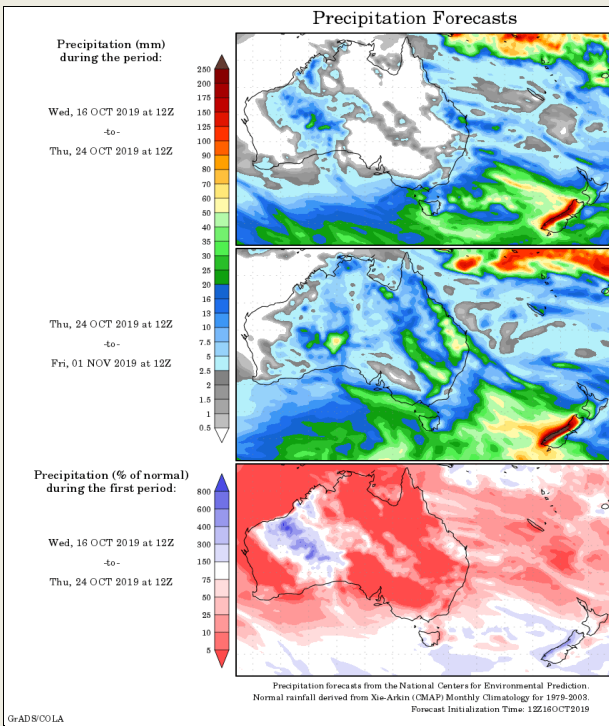
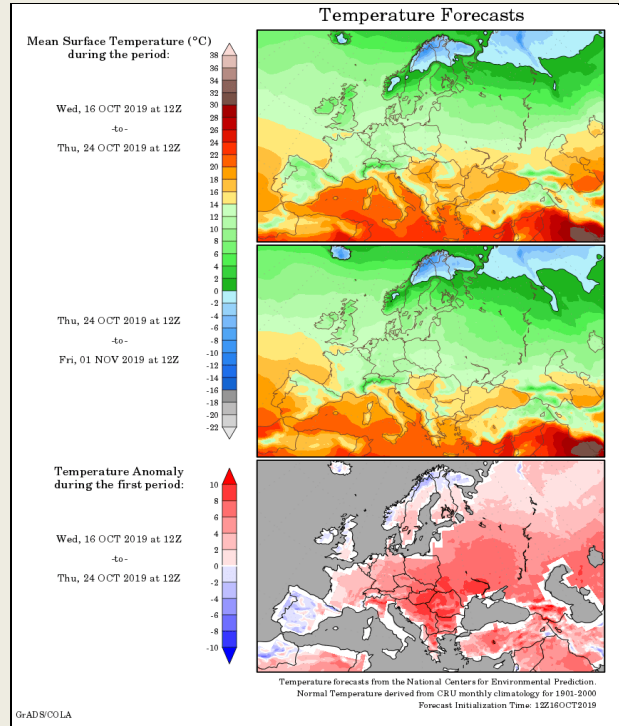
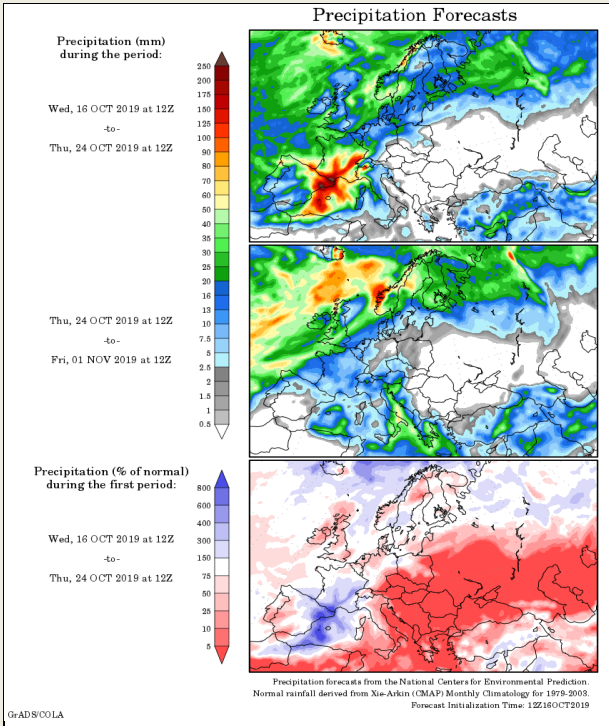


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Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: The drier conditions will allow for planting of winter crops to advance; however, many locations continue to experience long term dryness and a greater soaking of moisture is needed to provide the best environment for winter crop establishment. Conditions will be favorable for any unharvested summer crops.

AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation will occur over most of Australia during the next seven to ten days. Conditions will not be completely dry, but moisture that does occur will be brief and overall net-drying will occur in most locations. Dryness concerns will be greatest over east-central Australia where a soaking of rain is needed to support sorghum, cotton and other crops in the region.



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
