



United States of America - Weather


U.S. MIDWEST: Much of the Midwest outside of the Ohio River Basin will receive rain by Wednesday with rain in much of the Midwest Friday into Monday before a period of drier weather and improving conditions for fieldwork occurs in the west Sunday into Oct. 15 and in the east Oct. 8-15. o Some heavy rain flooding is expected today into Wednesday from northeastern Kansas and the southern two-thirds of eastern Nebraska to central and southern Wisconsin to western and central Michigan.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will continue to see mostly favorable conditions for crop maturation and harvesting during the next two weeks, although the region will be wetter during the next week than what has occurred recently.

 Rain during the next week will be beneficial for winter wheat planting, but most of the rain will not be great enough to induce a lasting increase in soil moisture and rain is expected to be restricted again Oct. 8-15.





Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Rounds of precipitation will bolster soil moisture conditions throughout the European Continent during the next week to ten days. The greatest moisture will occur over east France, Germany and northeast Italy into east Adriatic Sea Nations the remainder of this work week. Significant moisture will return to most other locations this weekend into early next week. The only exception will be the Iberian Peninsula as well as parts of Scandinavia.

o The moisture will be beneficial and will bolster soil moisture conditions, especially in the western and southern Balkan Nations and northern and eastern France. Improvements will continue to be slow in France and the Balkan Nations

AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation and drought will continue over New South Wales into Queensland the next ten days to two weeks. Winter crop development will remain poor and stress will continue to grow and production potentials of cotton, sorghum, corn and other crops are declining in some areas.
