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
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
United States of America - Weather


U.S. MIDWEST: Today's forecast is wetter for next week, but overall, the Midwest should continue to see good harvest progress before and after the period of wetter weather expected to begin Friday and continue through Thursday of next week.


o Two rounds of precipitation will occur by next Thursday with precipitation greatest in the Ohio River Basin which has been the warmest and driest region recently while the least precipitation is expected in the northwestern Corn Belt where the coolest and wettest conditions have occurred recently. U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Another increase in rain has been made for the Delta as well as the southeastern states since Wednesday's forecast with the Tuesday into next Thursday period advertised to be wetter and as a result harvesting will be slow once rain increases tonight into Friday and cotton quality declines may occur.

o Rain will increase tonight and will fall regularly into next Thursday before a drier weather pattern occurs during the first week of November and harvesting resumes.









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
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
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
South America - Weather


BRAZIL: Today's forecast includes less rain during the next week in Sao Paulo and Parana and this region as well as areas to the west from southern Mato Grosso into Mato Grosso do Sul and central Paraguay will need an increase in rain soon to reduce stress to crops that have been planted and to improve conditions for summer crop planting.

ARGENTINA: Rain will increase today into Tuesday and nearly all of Argentina will receive at least some rain with temporary improvements in conditions for winter wheat and planting of summer crops in most of the drier areas while the remainder of the country should receive enough rain to keep soil









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
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
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
Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather


EUROPE: Some flooding will linger over northwest Italy today as heavy rain occurs. Additional moisture totals will vary from 0.75 to 2.50 inches and local totals up to 4.00 inches in south-central to southeast France and northwest Italy. Otherwise, rounds of precipitation will occur from north France and the south U.K. through Scandinavia through the weekend

AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation will occur over east-central Australia including Queensland into northern New South Wales the next ten days to two weeks. Dryness concerns will prevail and a soaking of rain is needed to support sorghum, cotton and other crops in the region.









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
