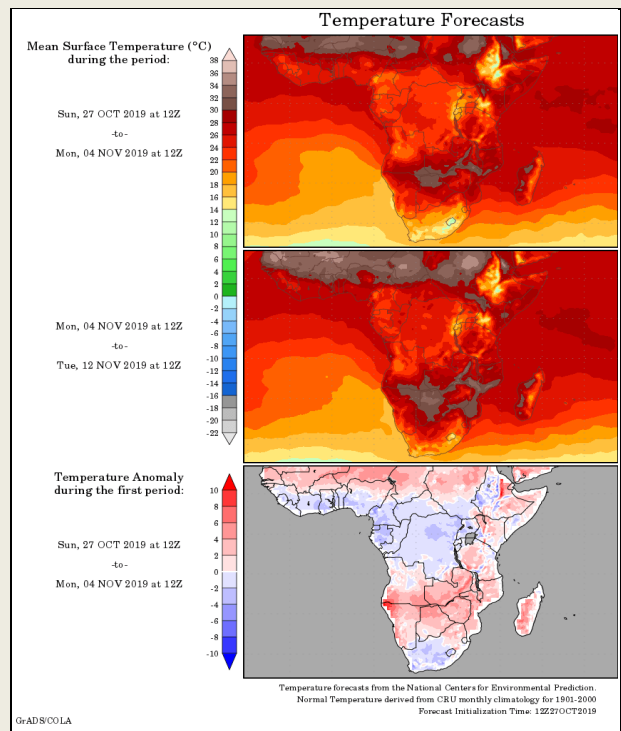
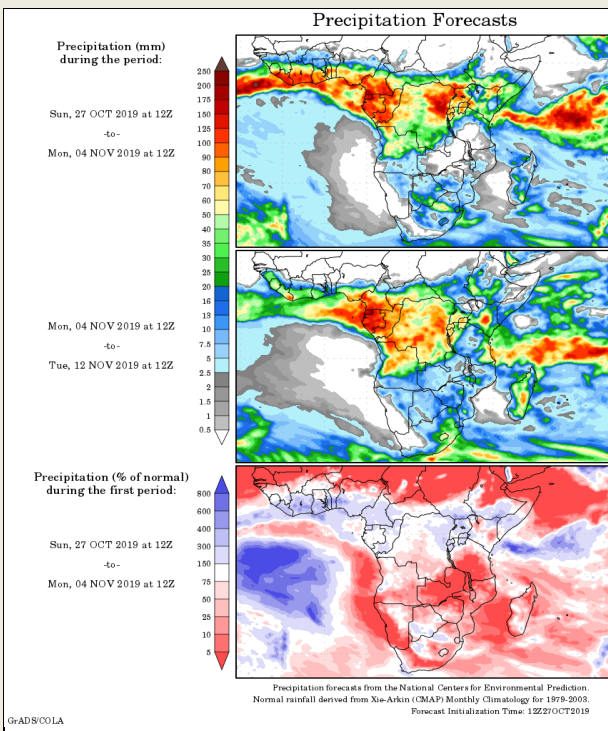
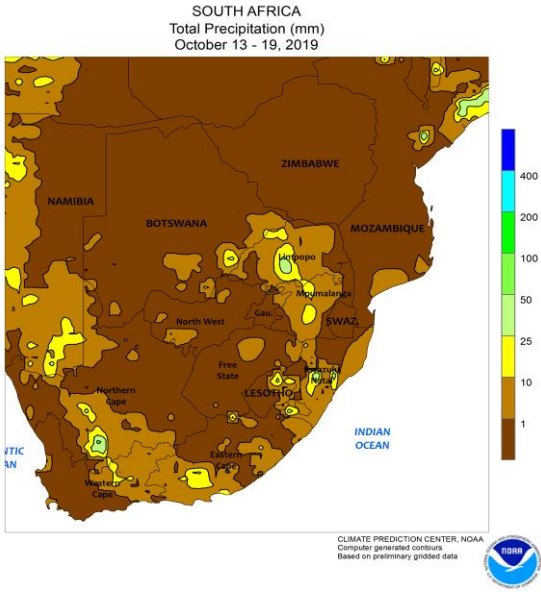
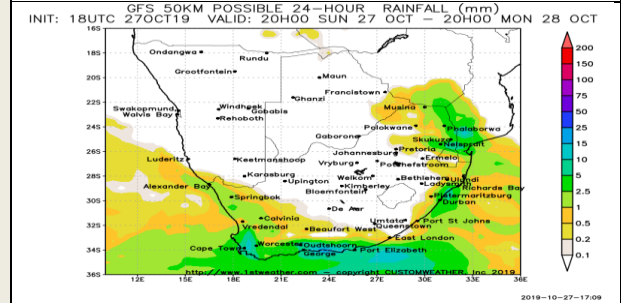
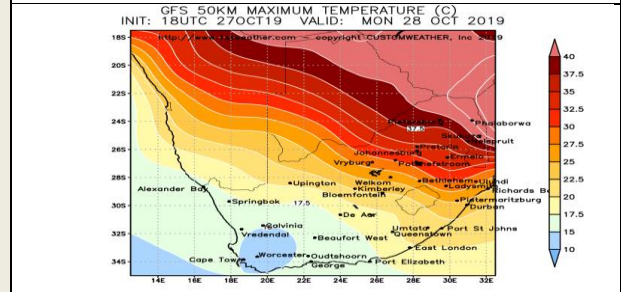
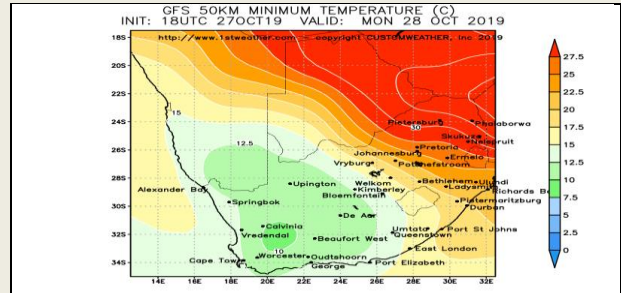




Weather Report

South Africa - Weather

- The main winter wheat areas in Free State, Western Cape, and neighboring locations will remain too dry to support aggressive growth in the coming weeks
- o Rainfall in the coming week will be unable to significantly bolster soil moisture outside southwest Western Cape
- o Development conditions will remain poor until rain potentials improve
- Portions of Limpopo, Mpumalanga, and neighboring areas will receive enough rain during the next two weeks to improve the soil moisture
- o However, most areas will not receive enough precipitation to completely fix the moisture deficits
- o Early season planting may get underway in some of the wettest areas
- o Establishment conditions will be generally favorable, though timely rain will still be needed later in November
- Greater rain is possible in central South Africa in early November

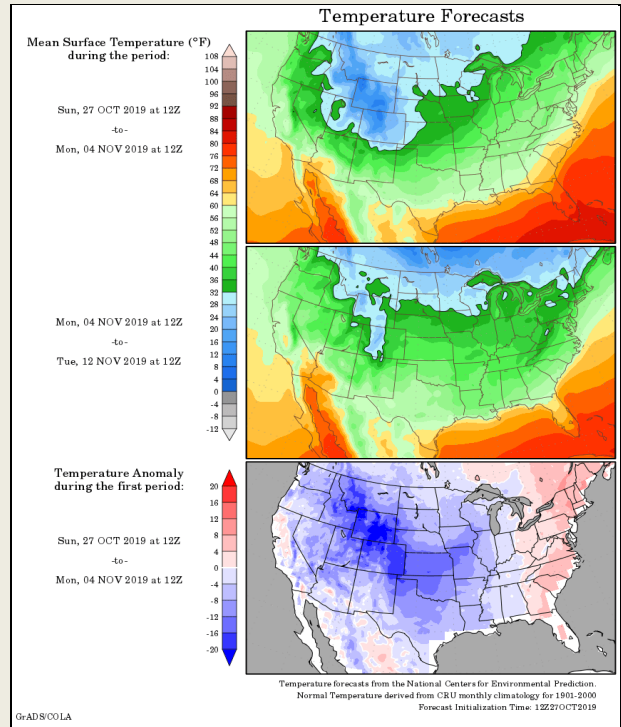
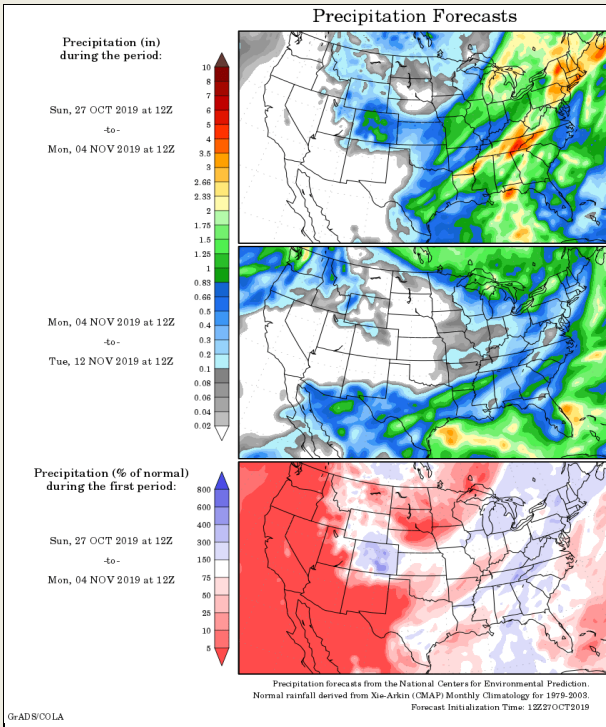
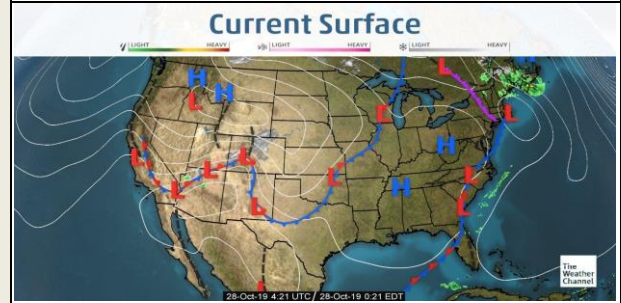
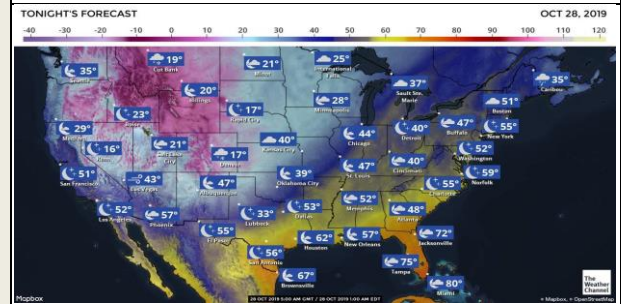
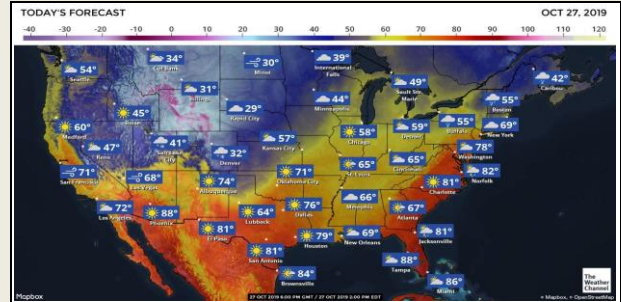
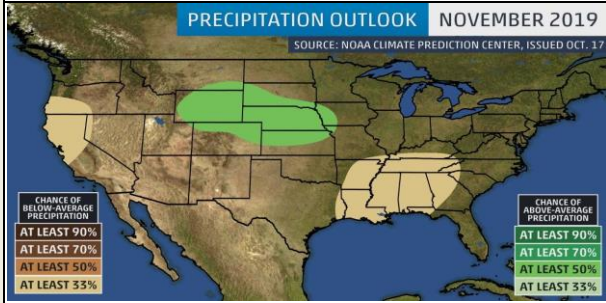

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: The bottom line to the two-week outlook has not changed since Thursday and good harvest progress should occur overall with some notable interruptions in from east-central and southeastern Missouri into the eastern Corn Belt where two rounds of significant rain will occur during the next week.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will see two rounds of rain during the next week and harvesting will be slowed with some declines in cotton quality as well. Rain today will be greatest from the Delta through Mississippi where totals will be 1.50-3.0" most often and locally more while Alabama into western Georgia sees 0.20-1.20" and locally more with little rain to the east.

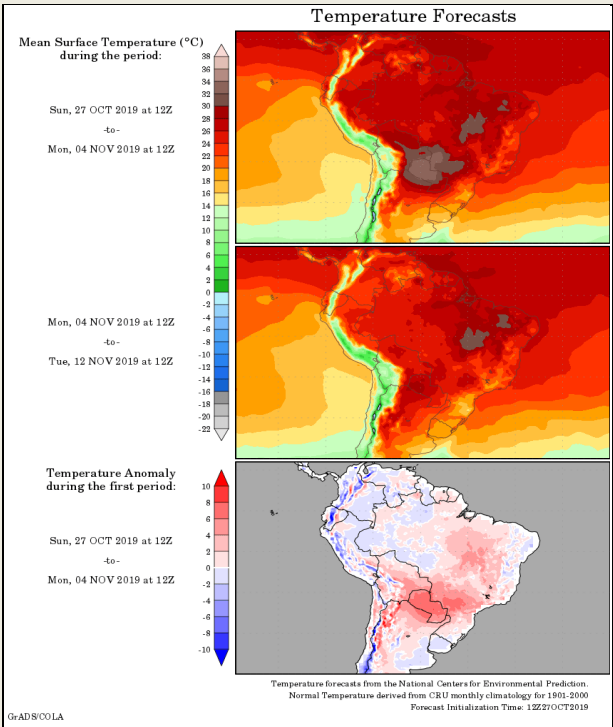
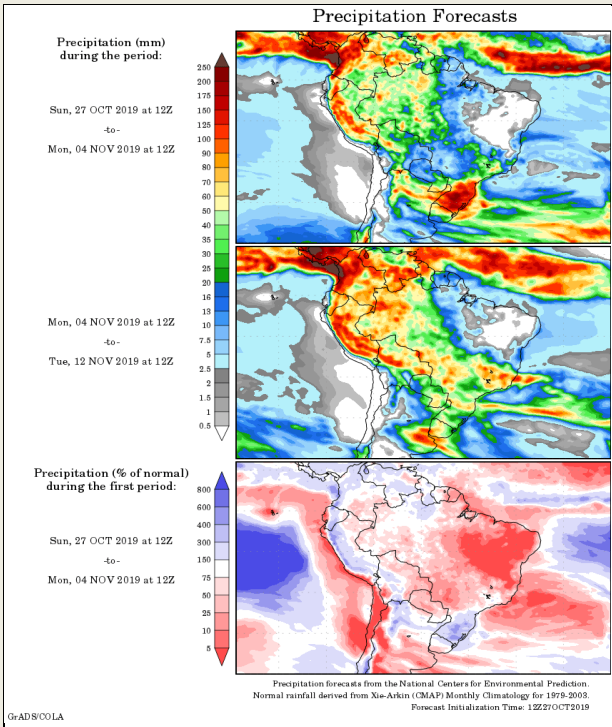
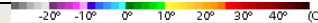
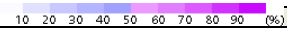
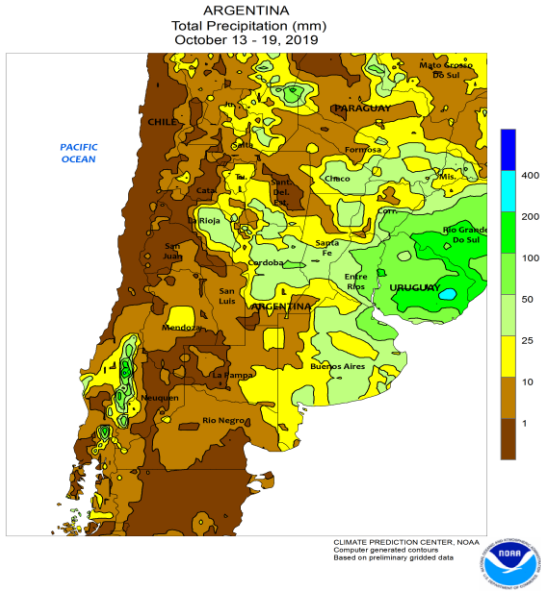

BRAZIL: Rain is still expected to be restricted through the next week from central and western Sao Paulo and central and western Parana through southern Mato Grosso and Mato Grosso do Sul to Paraguay where an increase in rain will be needed soon to reduce stress to crops that have been planted and to improve conditions for summer crop planting.

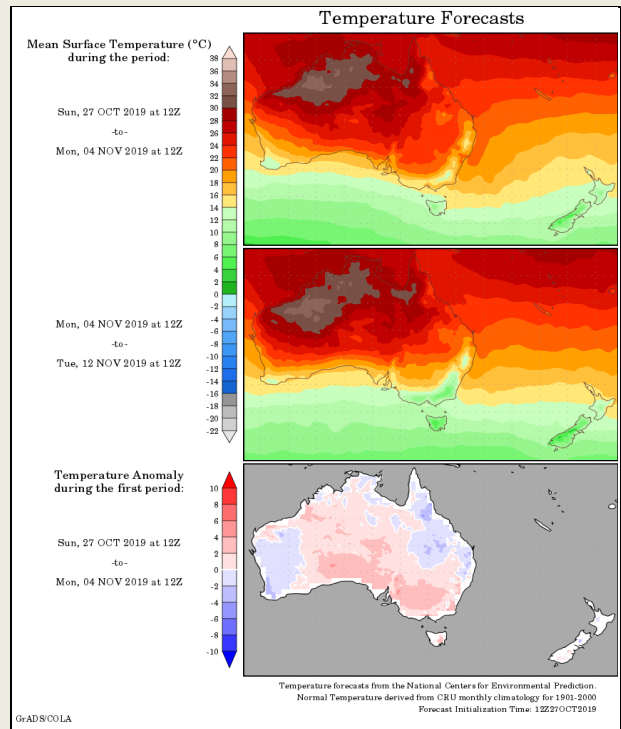
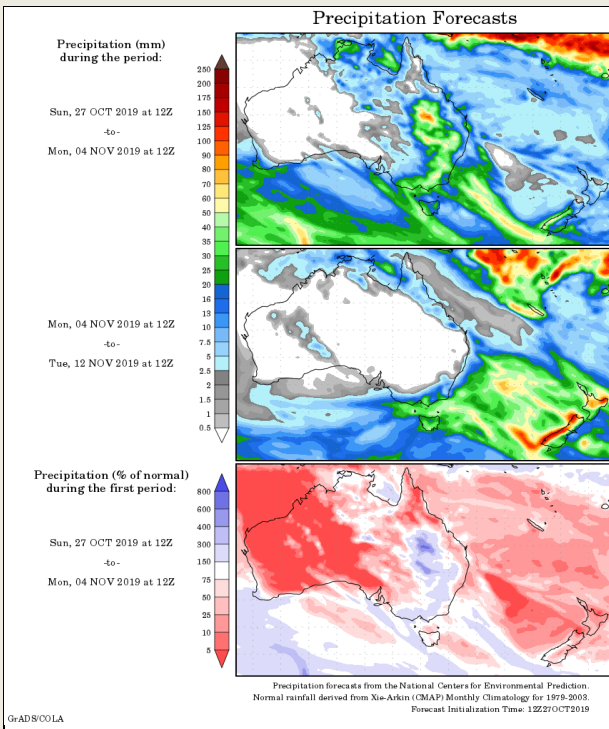
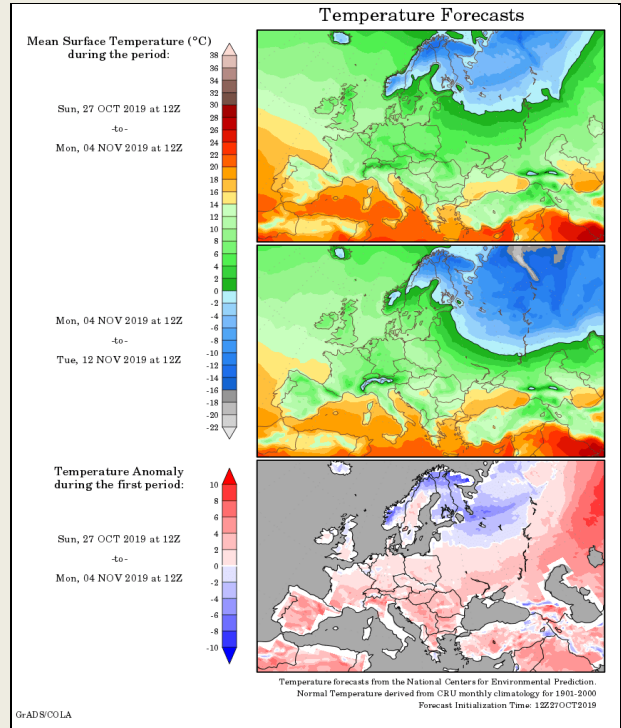
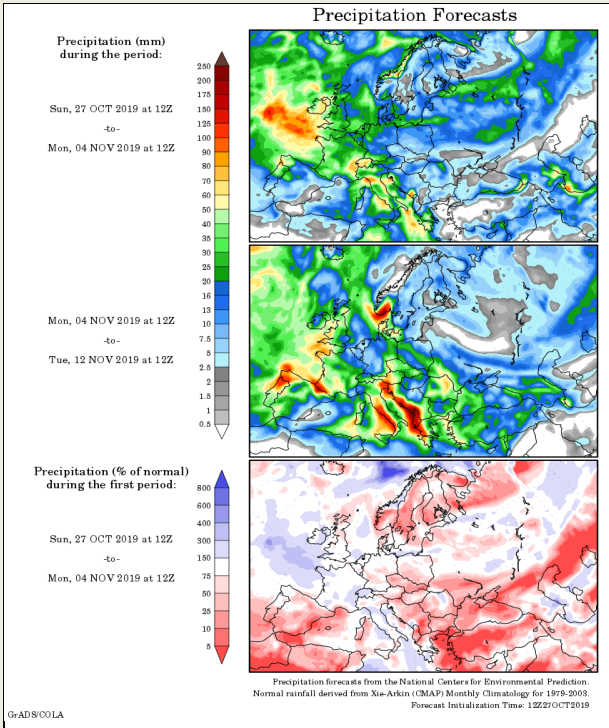
ARGENTINA: Some of the driest areas in southwestern Argentina received beneficial rain Thursday that at least temporarily improved soil moisture in parts of the region with satellite imagery suggesting some heavier rain fell on key crop areas from southeastern Cordoba and northwestern Buenos Aires to southwestern Entre Rios.

EUROPE: Some flooding will linger over northwest Italy today as heavy rain occurs. Additional moisture totals will vary from 0.75 to 2.50 inches and local totals up to 4.00 inches in south-central to southeast France and northwest Italy. Otherwise, rounds of precipitation will occur from north France and the south U.K. through Scandinavia through the weekend
AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation will occur over east-central Australia including Queensland into northern New South Wales the next ten days to two weeks. With that said, completely dry weather will not occur and at least some temporary relief to dryness will occur at times. Dryness concerns will prevail and a soaking of rain is needed to support sorghum, cotton and other crops in the region.
