South Africa - Weather

The rain in Free State and neighboring areas will only offer a minor amount of relief from the dryness in the coming weeks

- o Most areas will still have a shortage of moisture
- o Precipitation could also bring some of the winter wheat out of dormancy if more significant rainfall evolves late next week
- o However, the environment will remain far from ideal for winter wheat growth
- o A significant boost is still needed to support better winter wheat prospects
- o Western Cape will remain dry or critically dry during the next two weeks
- o A significant boost in rain is still needed for the winter wheat







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United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Three rounds of well-organized rain are still expected during the next two weeks and although most of the rain should not be heavy, fieldwork will be sluggish in areas that have become wet this week while harvesting should advance well in most other areas. East-central and southeastern Missouri to central and southern Ohio and Kentucky will remain mostly dry until Saturday evening and good harvest progress should continue.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will see a few rounds of rain during the next week that will slow harvesting but the region has become dry enough that the soil should absorb the rain without becoming saturated and fieldwork should advance well around the precipitation. Rain during the next two weeks will be beneficial for winter wheat planting and as long as timely rain continues later this month planting conditions should be mostly favorable while some cotton quality declines may result from the rain as well.



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South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Much of Brazil remains in need of rain to improve conditions for summer crop planting and western areas will see an improving trend through late next week while more significant rain falls on the south with Goias into Bahia missing much of the rain.


ARGENTINA: Much of Argentina will see little rain of significance through Thursday leaving many areas in need of rain to improve conditions for summer crop planting and winter wheat development.

o Some light shower activity will occur across Argentina and the moisture will be welcome, but likely too light and poorly distributed to have much of an impact on soil conditions.

▣ Portions of Buenos Aires will benefit from rain Thursday.




ARGENTINA


Precipitation Forecasts





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Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Frequent rounds of precipitation will bolster soil moisture conditions throughout the European Continent during the next week to ten days. The only exceptions will be southwest into west-central Europe as well as pockets of southeast Europe. Some dryness concerns will continue in parts of west and central France as well as Hungary into parts of Serbia.

AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation and drought will continue over interior southeast South Australia, interior New South Wales into interior Queensland the next ten days to two weeks. Winter crop development will remain poor and stress will continue to grow and production potentials of cotton, sorghum, corn and other crops are declining in some areas.



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
