South Africa - Weather

Late season winter wheat development may improve next week for portions of Western Cape o However, much of the crop is mature or ready for harvest o Minor quality reductions possible in the wettest areas o Dryness earlier in the growing season has already reduced crop quality in a few locations, though yields should be near normal

- Free State's winter wheat areas do not need significant amounts of rain
- Crops are generally maturing or ready for harvest o Eastern Free State will likely receive enough rain in the coming days to slow or delay maturation and harvesting o Minor quality reductions also possible in the wettest areas o Western Free State harvesting will advance with few disruptions
- Eastern South Africa will receive enough rain during the next two weeks to significantly bolster soil moisture o Planting and establishment conditions will improve in most areas o Many areas are already behind normal planting dates due to drier biased conditions in recent weeks o Aggressive fieldwork is expected in the coming days
- Overall, summer coarse grain, oilseed, and cotton establishment and growth conditions will be favorable or improve o Northern Cape and western sections of Free State and North West will other remain too dry to support favorable planting and establishment

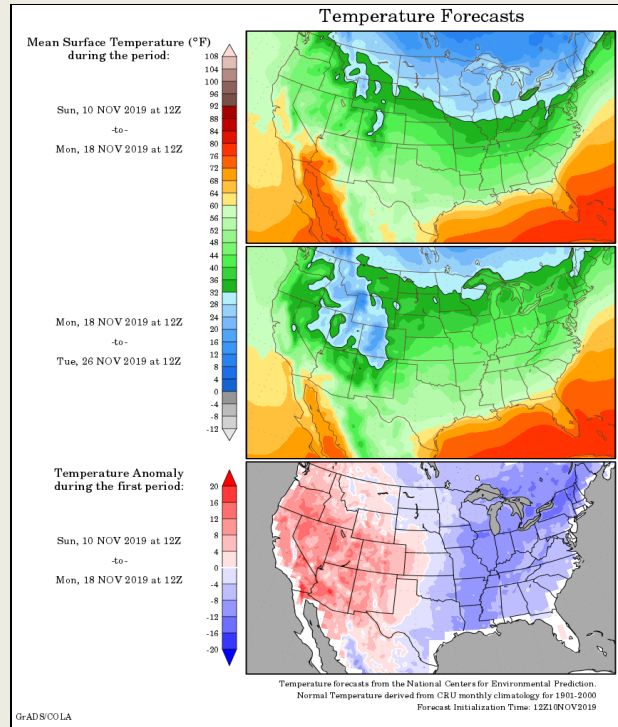
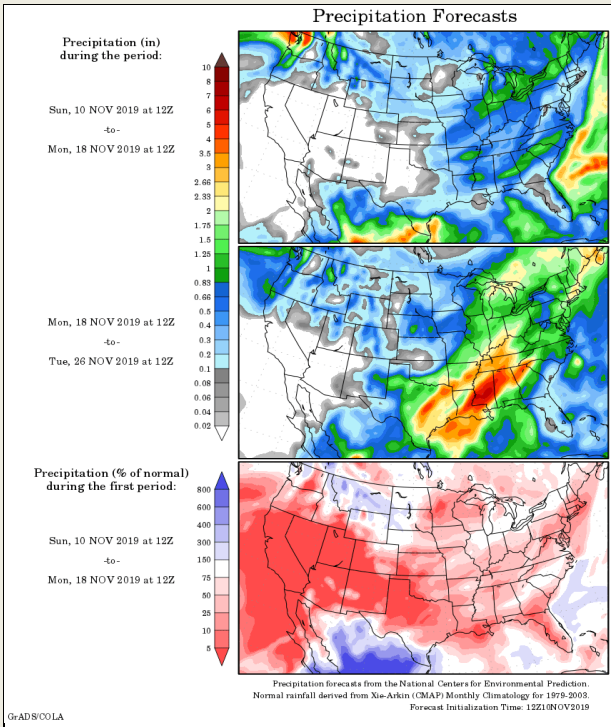
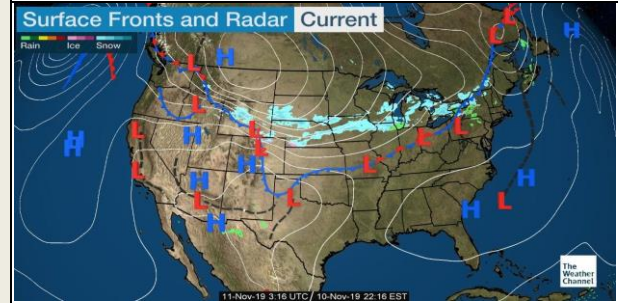
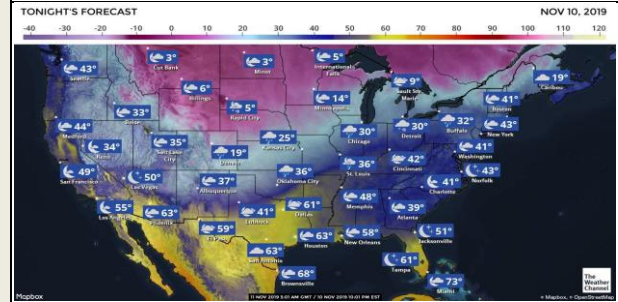
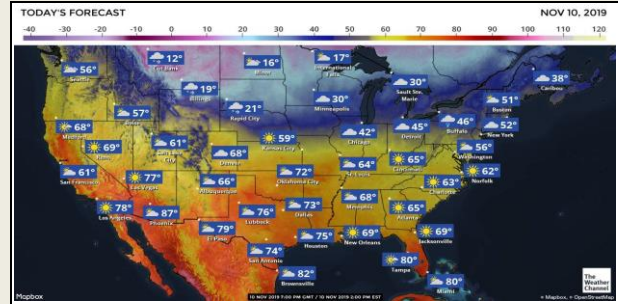
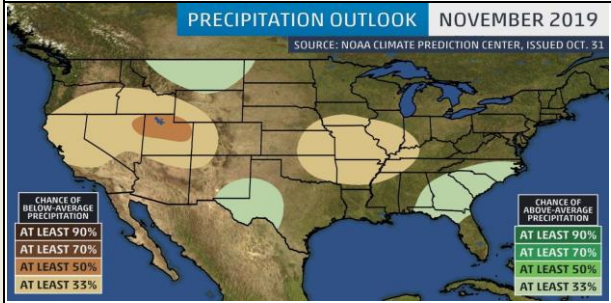

U.S. MIDWEST: The Midwest will continue to see steady improvements in conditions for crop maturation and fieldwork through the next two weeks and good harvest progress should be made. o Conditions for fieldwork will be slow to improve in the wettest areas as colder than normal temperatures will remain in place most often and drying rates will be slowed.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will see good harvest progress overall through the next two weeks with some temporary interruptions from rain. o Most areas will be dry through Sunday and good harvest progress should occur in many areas before mostly light rain impacts many areas Monday into Tuesday.



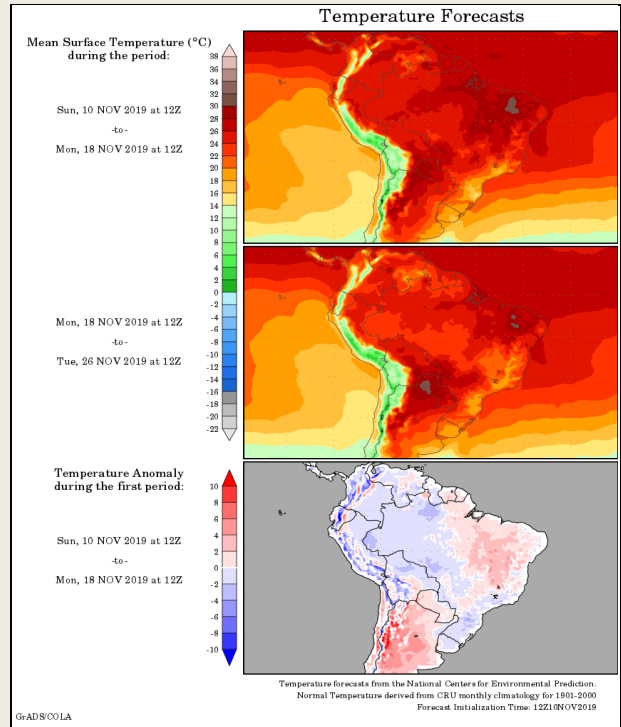
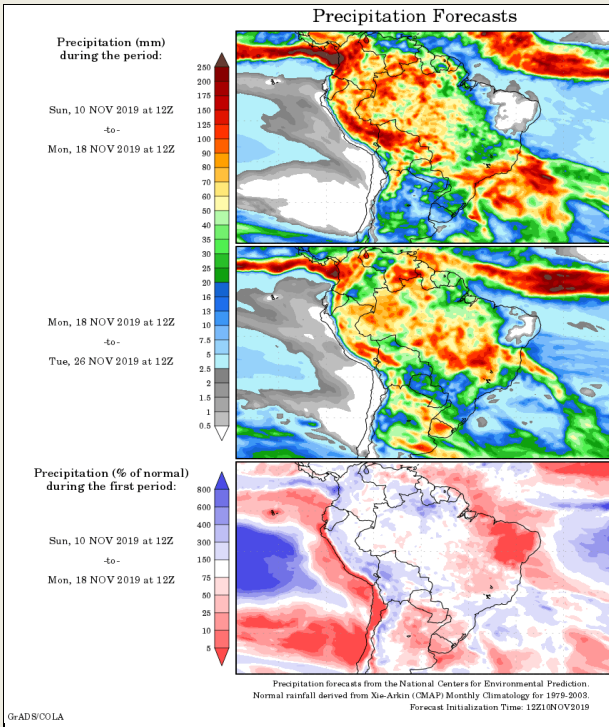
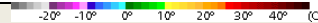
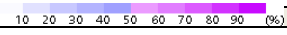
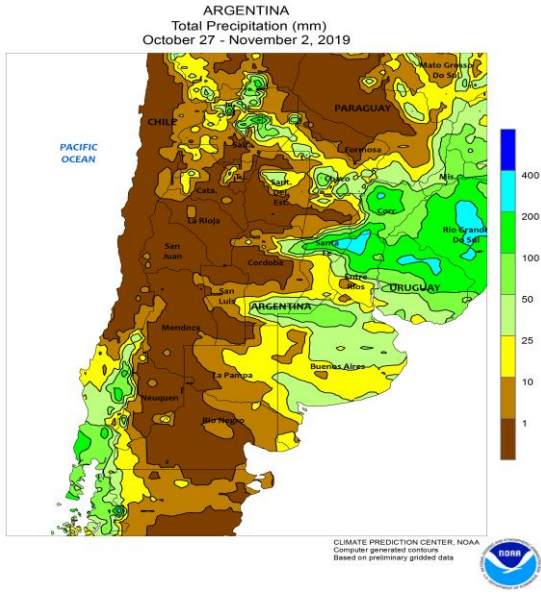

South America - Weather

BRAZIL: The driest areas from Paraguay into central, western, and north-central Brazil will continue to see regular rounds of showers and thunderstorms each day through late next week. Enough rain is expected through Friday of next week to induce increases in soil moisture from Paraguay through Mato Grosso do Sul, Mato Grosso, Goiás, Paraná, São Paulo, southern Espírito Santo, and west-central and southern Minas Gerais and conditions for planting of summer crops and crop development should become favorable.

ARGENTINA: Rain will fall on portions of southern Argentina today before an increase in showers and thunderstorms occurs Saturday through Thursday.

o Showers and thunderstorms from Saturday through Thursday will bring rain to nearly all of the country at one time or another with a wide range of rainfall totals varying from 0.35-1.50" most often and local amounts near 3.0".

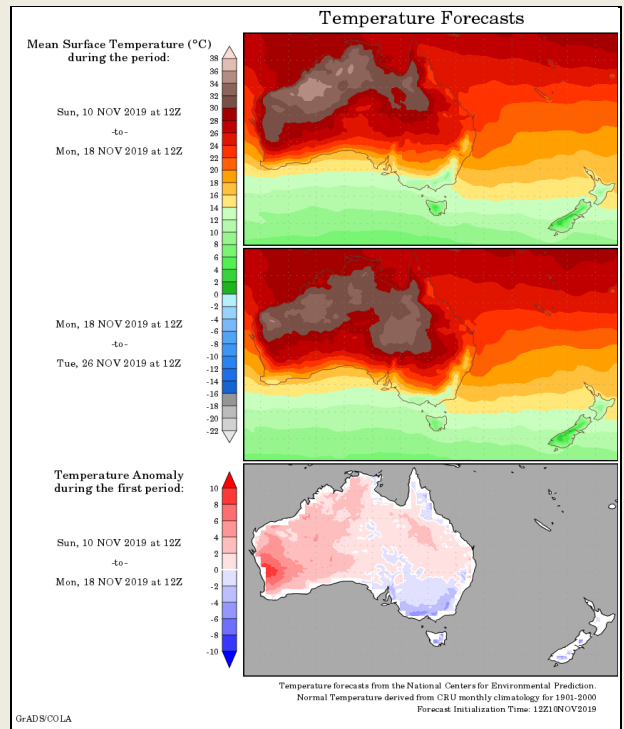
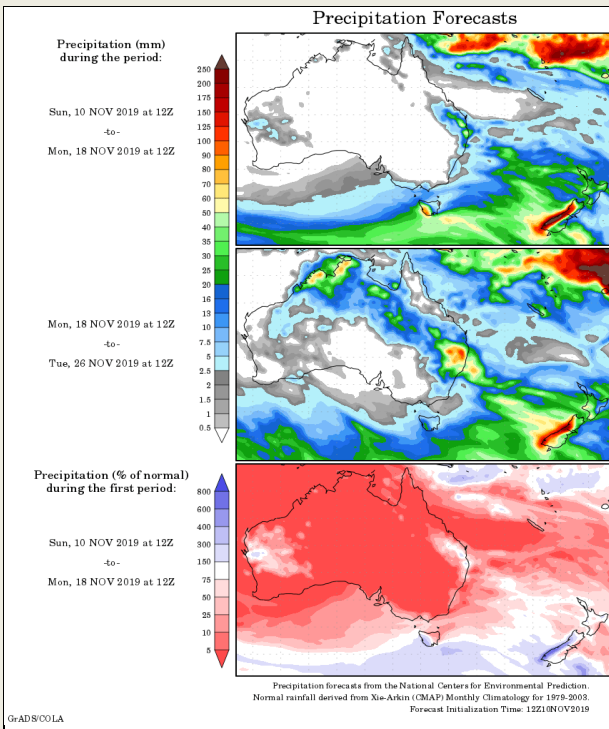
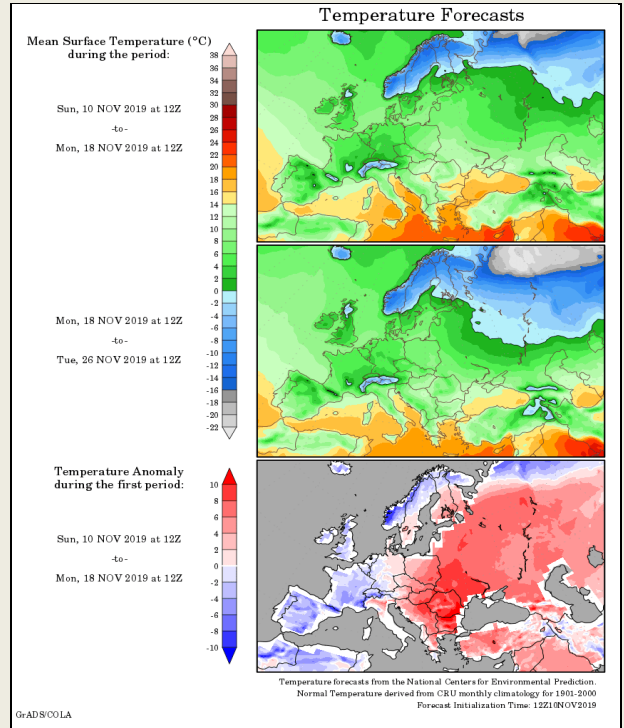
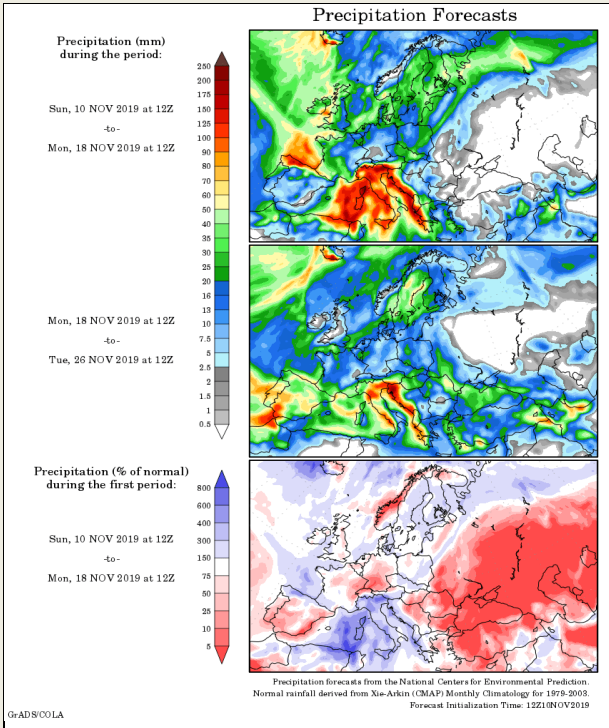

EUROPE: Further improvements in moisture will continue to occur over western Europe from northern Spain and west France into the U.K. as well as the Italian Peninsula into Austria and eastern Adriatic Sea Nations. The moisture will be greatest and most beneficial in portions of the Italian and Balkan Peninsula where dryness concerns have prevailed most of the fall although flooding may evolve from the heavy rainfall.

AUSTRALIA: Mostly dry weather will occur over east-central Australia this coming week providing favorable conditions for fieldwork and planting. With that said, follow up rain and greater moisture will be needed to relieve drought conditions and provide the best environment for crops.
