Minor winter wheat maturation and harvest delays expected for Free State and neighboring areas due to the rain o Quality impacts should be minimal

More significant harvest delays will be possible during the second week if the increased rainfall verifies • Many areas from eastern Free State and North West into eastern South Africa will see eceive enough rain to support generally favorable crop conditions

Several locations will still have moisture shortages during this time, most notably in portions of eastern Free State and North West

Establishment and growth will still remain favorable or continue to improve in most locations due to

Late season planting will advance swiftly between rain events as well


Overall, summer coarse grain, oilseed, and cotton prospects will be favorable







United States of America - Weather


U.S. MIDWEST: The Midwest will see periodic rounds of precipitation during the next two weeks with good harvest progress likely to occur between precipitation events.


o Showers will occur into Saturday from Wisconsin through the eastern Corn Belt with most areas seeing up to 0.40" of moisture and locally more while southeastern Missouri to central and southern Indiana, Kentucky, and southern Ohio receive 0.40-1.30" and locally more.


U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The outlook for the Delta and the Southeast remains wet enough during the next two weeks that harvesting will be slowed into the first week of December.


o Each round of rain will slow fieldwork with most of the rain not heavy enough to cause prolonged

Today into Saturday's rain will be greatest from the Delta through northern Alabama and far northern Georgia where most areas will see 0.60-2.0" of rain and locally more.





November 10 - 16, 2019




EUROPE: The increase in moisture will impact Albania, Macedonia, south Serbia, Greece, Bulgari


and into south Romania. The moisture will be welcome and will help improve conditions for winter crop establishment, but follow up moisture will still be needed to relieve long term dryness.

AUSTRALIA: The moisture will be welcome this coming week. With that said the best rainfall will occur in areas too far east for many crops in the Great Dividing Range into coastal areas excepting a few of the easternmost production areas of cotton, corn, sorghum and other crops.
