South Africa - Weather

Interior parts of Western Cape will generally be too dry to support ideal late season winter wheat growth o Maturation and harvesting will advance swiftly around the periods of rain
o Minor quality reductions possible this year due to dryness over the growing season
• Free State's winter wheat areas do not need significant amounts of rain
o Crops are generally maturing or ready for harvest, though some of the later planted crops may still be growing o Maturation and harvesting will likely be sluggish in the eastern half of the region during the next two weeks due to the periods of rain
o Minor quality reductions possible in the wettest areas o Western Free State harvesting will advance with few disruptions • Soil moisture still expected to gradually improve during the next two weeks for the eastern half of the country o Planting and establishment conditions will gradually improve o However, many areas will not receive enough rain to completely fix the moisture deficits o Timely rain will still be needed later in November to maintain good summer coarse grain, oilseed, and cotton prospects o Northern Cape and western sections of Free State and North West will need to see better rainfall later this month to support more aggressive planting and establishment

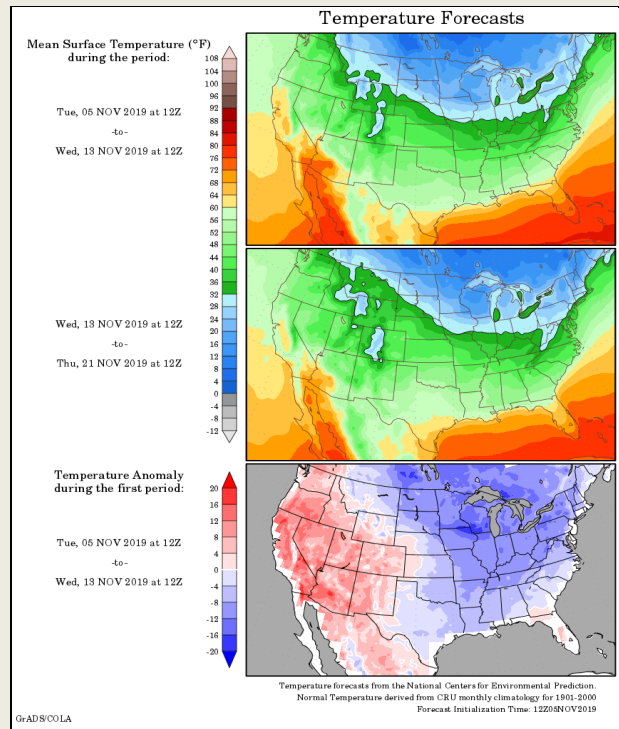
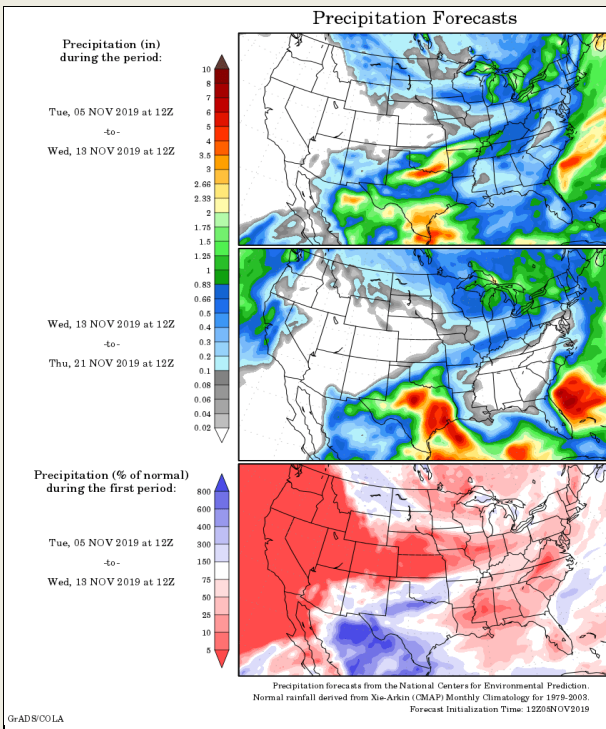
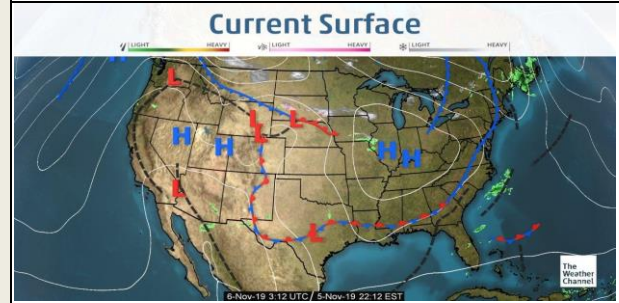
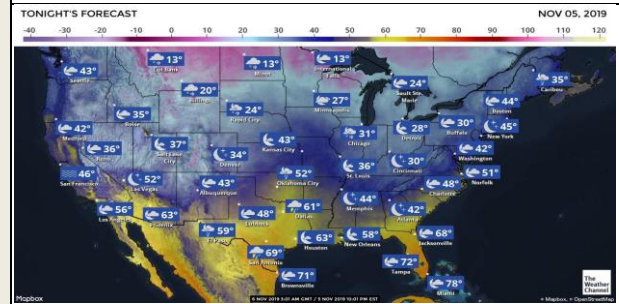
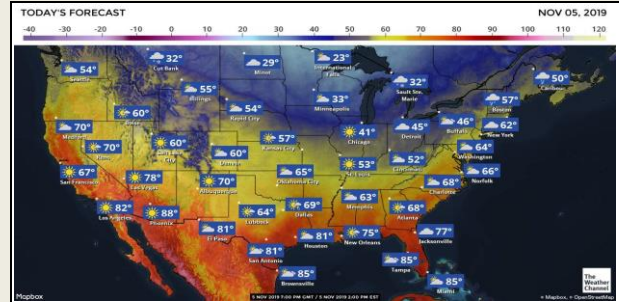
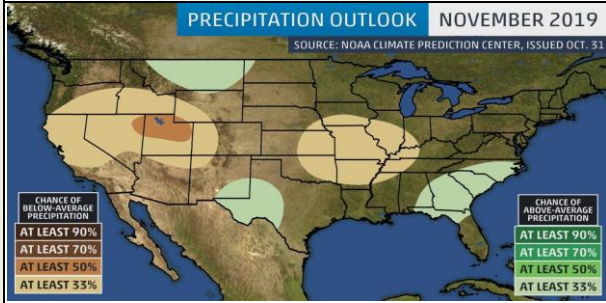
United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: No significant changes have been made to the two-week outlook for the Midwest since Monday and improvements in conditions for crop maturation and harvesting will continue as precipitation will be infrequent and mostly light.

o Conditions for fieldwork will be slow to improve in the wettest areas as colder than normal temperatures will remain in place most often and drying rates will be slowed.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast are still expected to see a mostly restricted precipitation pattern during the next two weeks and conditions for crop maturation and harvesting will continue to improve.

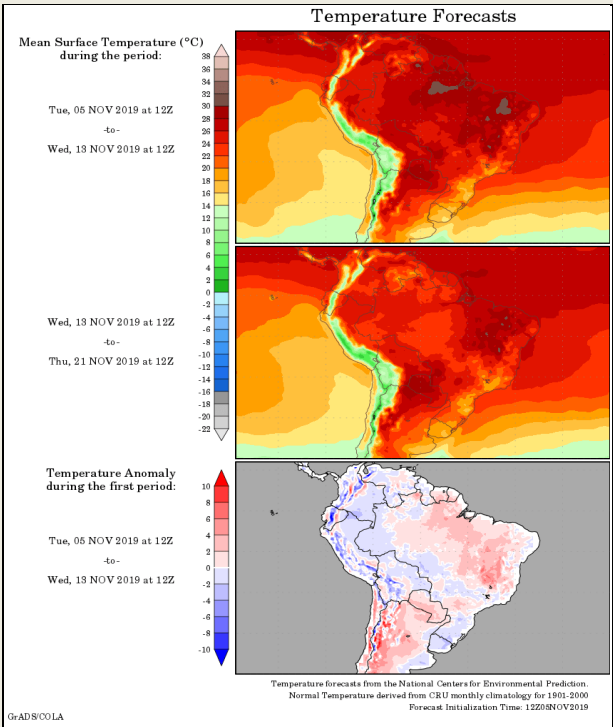
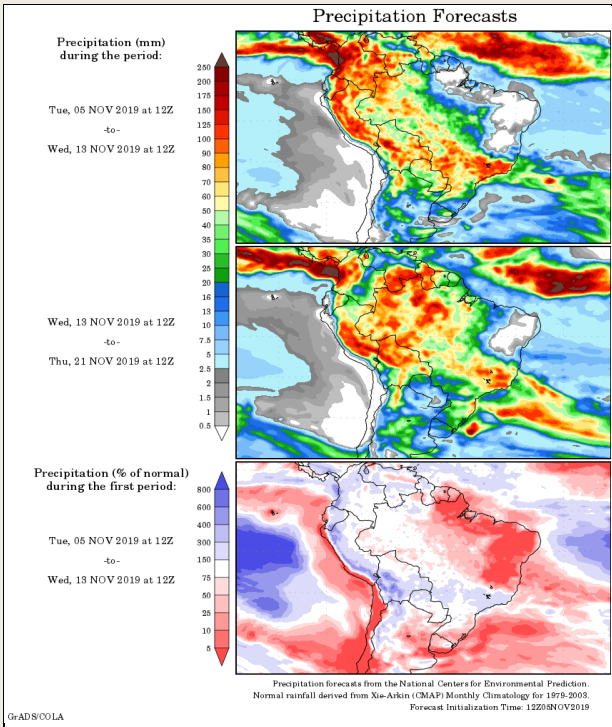
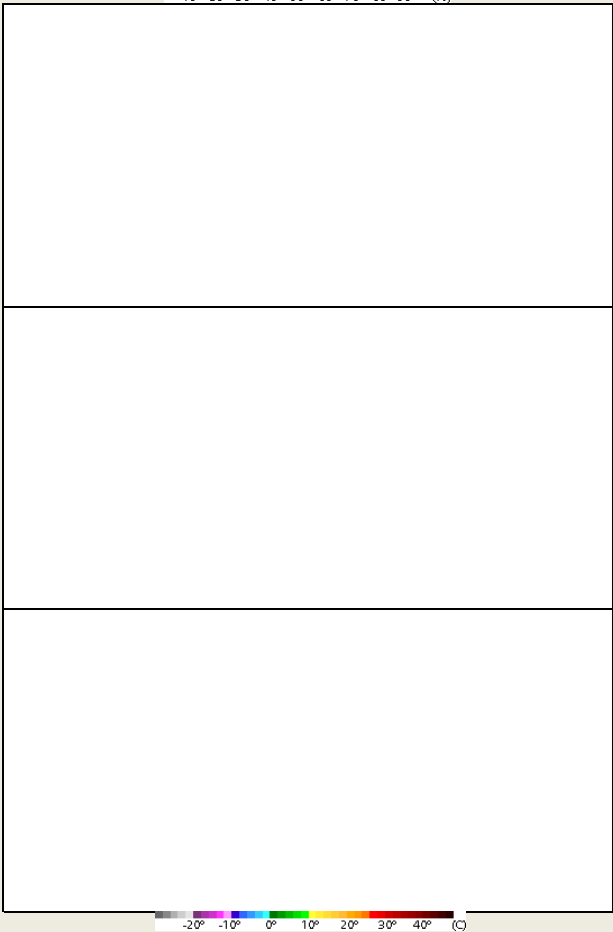
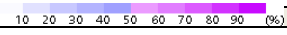
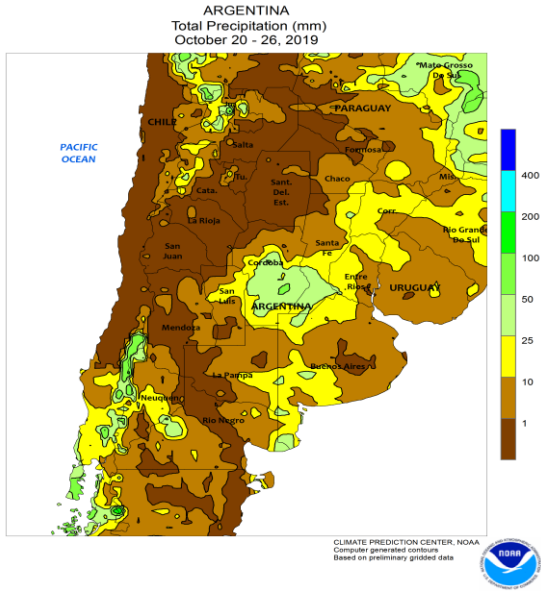
o Dry weather will be most common with a few light showers on occasion and the only round of organized precipitation during the next week will occur Wednesday night into Friday.

BRAZIL: Light showers will increase today in the driest areas of Paraguay and central and western Brazil before more than a week of wetter weather begins Wednesday.
 o Enough rain is expected Wednesday through next Tuesday to induce notable increases in soil moisture from Paraguay through Mato Grosso do Sul, Mato Grosso, Goias, Parana, and Sao Paulo and conditions for planting of summer crops and crop development should become favorable.
ARGENTINA: Today's forecast is drier overall than what was advertised Monday for Argentina through the next two weeks with poorly distributed showers and thunderstorms advertised in the driest areas in and western Argentina Saturday into next week.

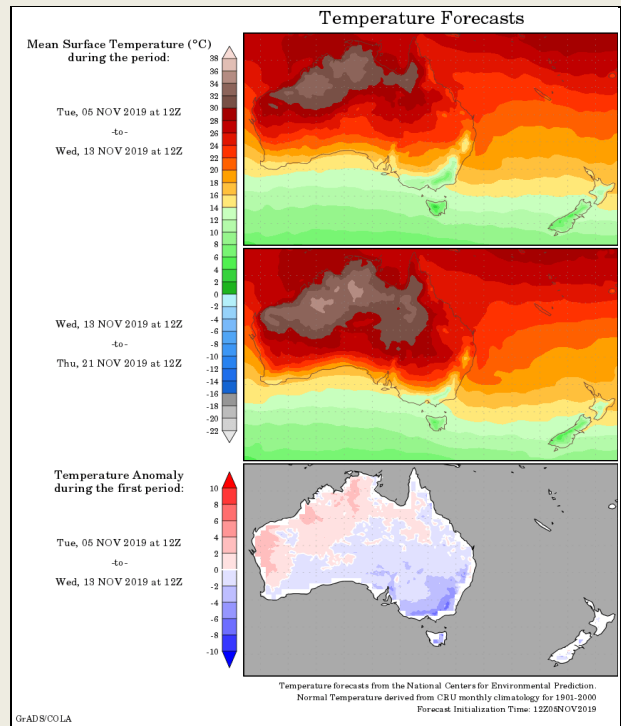
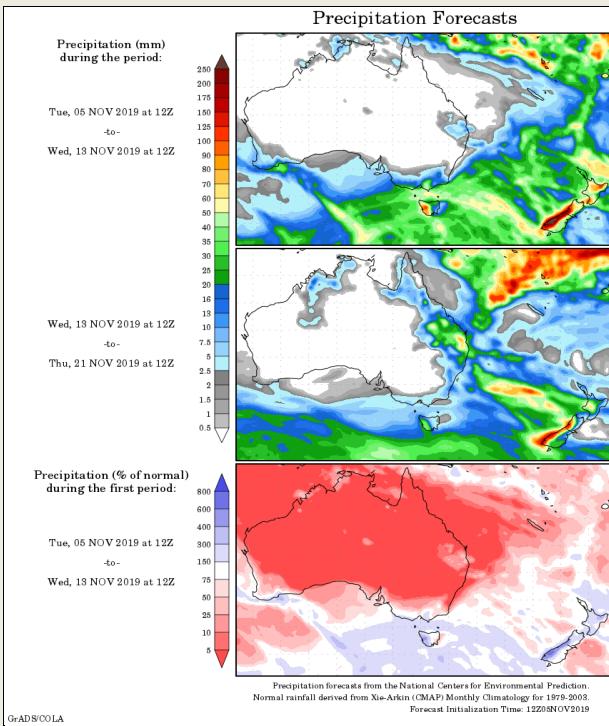
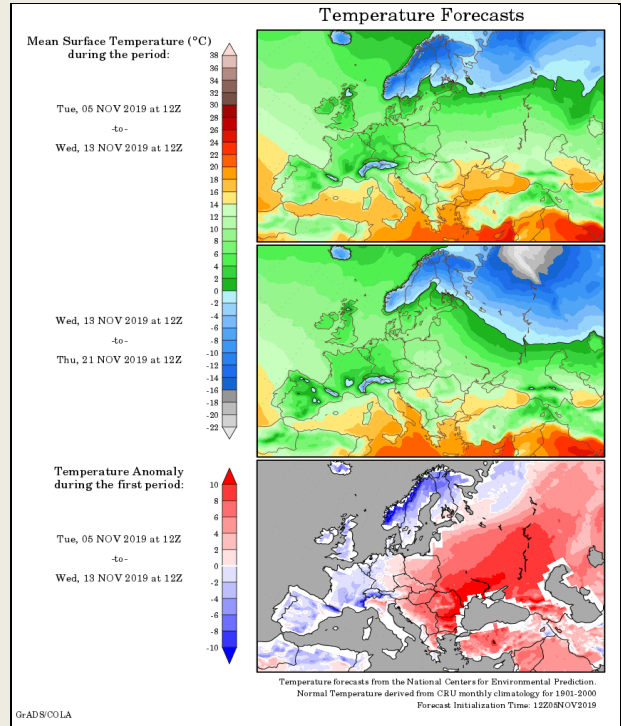
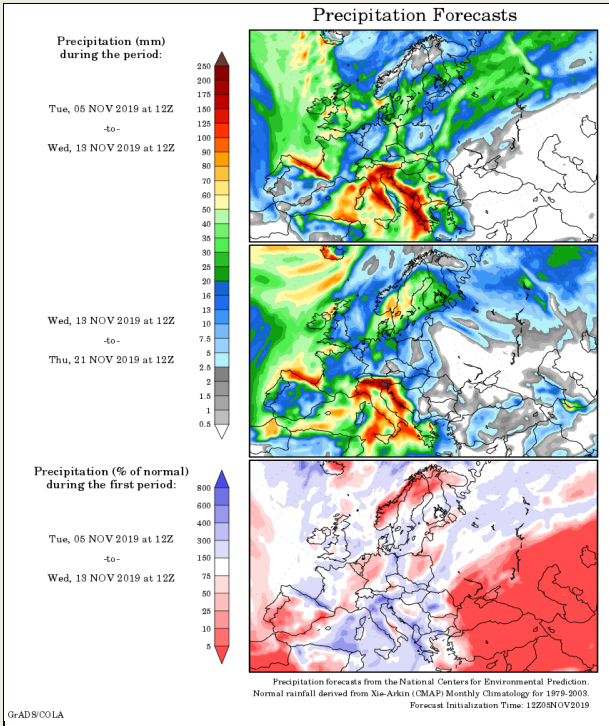
