





### **United States of America - Weather**


U.S. MIDWEST: No significant changes have been made to the two-week outlook for the Midwest since Monday and improvements in conditions for crop maturation and harvesting will continue as precipitation will be infrequent and mostly light.


o Conditions for fieldwork will be slow to improve in the wettest areas as colder than normal temperatures will remain in place most often and drying rates will be slowed.


U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast are still expected to see a mostly restricted


precipitation pattern during the next two weeks and conditions for crop maturation and harvesting will continue to improve.





EUROPE: Further improvements in moisture will continue to occur over Western Europe from the U.K. and France this week and spread into central and portions of Eastern Europe. The moisture will be extremely beneficial in portions of the Balkan Nations into the Hungarian Plain where dryness concerns have prevailed most of the fall.

AUSTRALIA: Mostly dry weather will return to east Australia this coming week providing favorable conditions for fieldwork and planting after the recent rain. o With that said rain showers will linger over the southeast corner of the nation this week. The moisture will impact Victoria and immediate surrounding areas.
