South Africa - Weather

Net drying through the weekend will promote unlimited fieldwork including the planting of many crops in areas where rain was sufficient for germination. Next week's weather will trend a little wetter with a daily occurrence of showers and thunderstorms that should lead to improved topsoil moisture. Most of the rain will be erratic, however, benefiting some crop areas much more than others. Wheat harvesting will advance around the brief bouts of rainfall during the next two weeks. No serious threat of grain quality declines is expected.

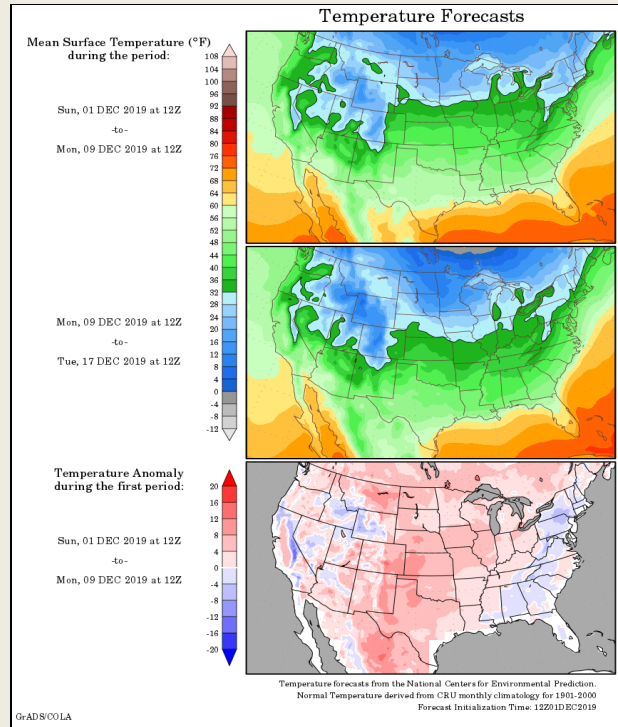
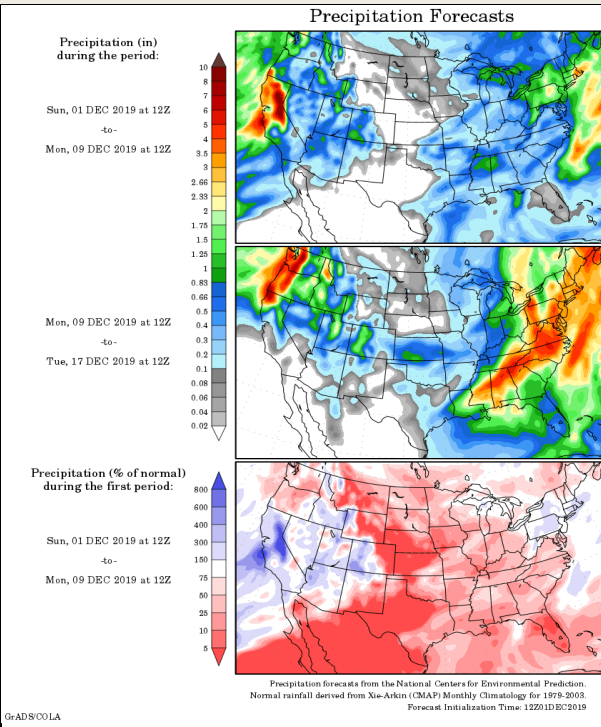
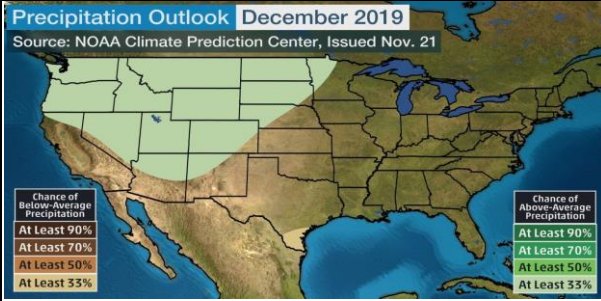
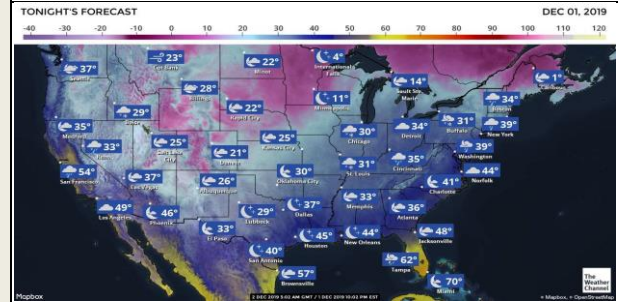
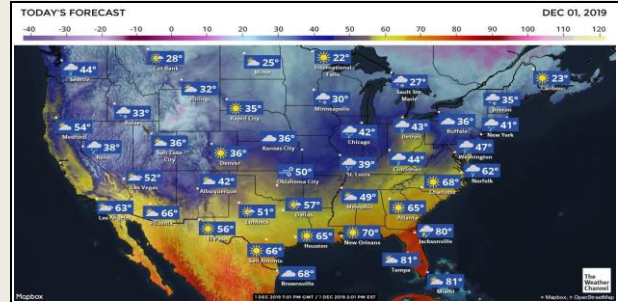

BRAZIL: The bottom line to the two-week outlook has not changed since Wednesday and much of Brazil and Paraguay will see regular rounds of showers and thunderstorms, including some of the driest areas in northeast, and as long as rain falls as advertised nearly all of Brazil and Paraguay will be left with favorable soil conditions.

ARGENTINA: Argentina will see a drier weather pattern through the next two weeks that will allow for good planting progress while many areas will become short of soil moisture which could eventually cause some crop stress.

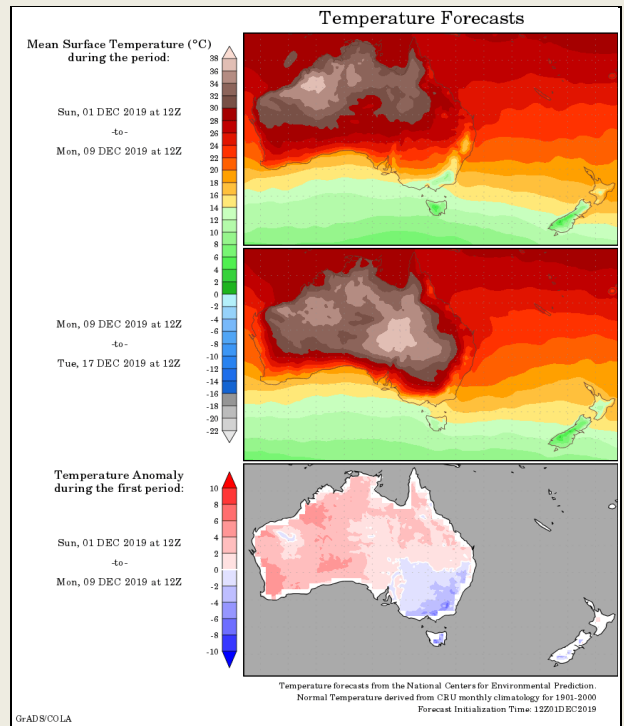
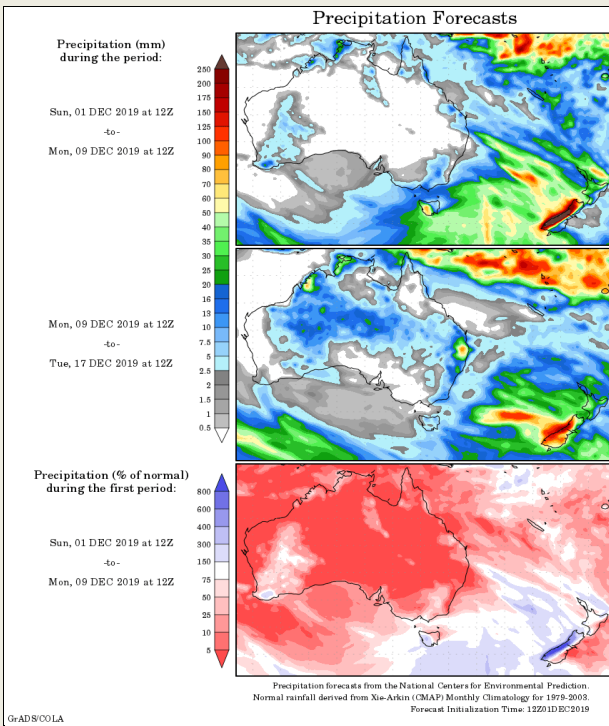
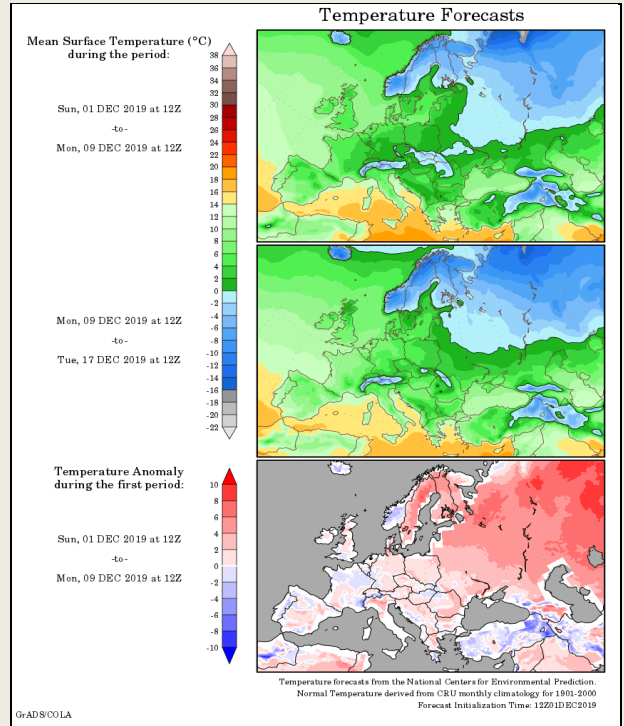
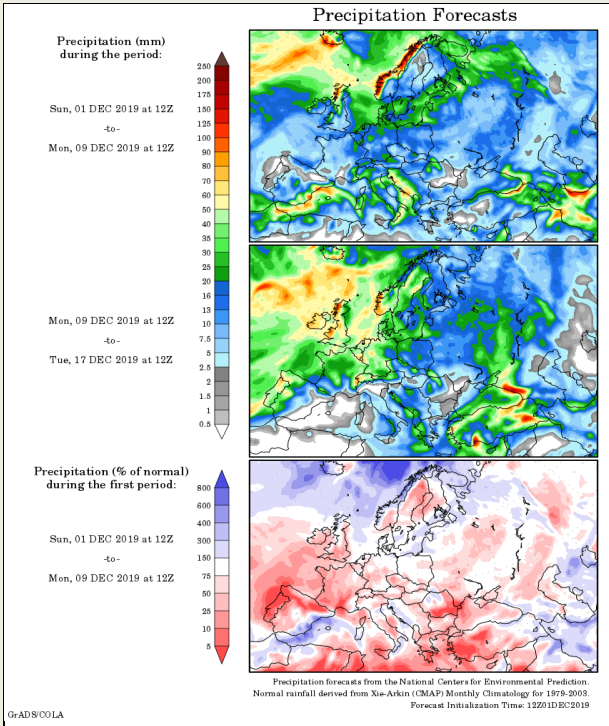

EUROPE: Snow cover is limited to Mountainous regions in Europe and no major change is expected in the next seven to ten days. Frequent precipitation will occur from Italy into the eastern Adriatic Sea Nations and portions of Serbia this week. Some of the greatest totals will also impact surrounding areas of southeast France and Switzerland as well as northern Spain this weekend.

AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation and net drying will continue over Queensland and interior New South Wales into northwest Victoria and interior South Australia during the next couple of weeks. Conditions will not be completely dry, but any rainfall that does occur will be brief and erratic and be lost to evaporation rather quickly.
