South Africa - Weather


Harvesting of winter wheat will otherwise be sluggish at times in Free State and neighboring areas o Quality reductions will be a concern in the wettest areas

The rain will help bolster soil moisture across eastern and central South Africa during the coming veek o However, the rain will generally be too light to completely reverse the moisture deficits across vestern production areas


o Planting is behind for a large portion of the country due to dryness earlier in the planting season, but the coming moisture will support more aggressive fieldwork later this month


A minor reduction in planted corn is expected compared to last year due to the late onset rainfall o Overall, the rain will support aggressive coarse grain, oilseed, and cotton establishment and growth in he coming weeks


It Late season planting may be slowed or delayed during periods of heavy rain
Image: Timely rain will still be needed later in the growing season to maintain generally favorable conditions Northern Cape into western sections of Free State and North West will see some improvements in soil moisture, but greater and more frequent rain will still be needed

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: A restricted precipitation pattern will be in place through most of the next two weeks and late harvesting should slowly advance in most areas with the poorest conditions for fieldwork in portions of the northern Midwest where snow cover is in place.


o Temperatures should remain cold enough that the snow melts gradually and when it does melt, fields will be slow to dry down.

© Some fields may be harvested during periods when the ground is frozen, however, and with a significant surge of cold air expected next week harvesting should accelerate where the soil freezes. U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will see a mix of rain and sunshine during the next two weeks that should allow for late harvesting to advance at a slowed pace around the occasional rounds of rain expected.


o Rain will increase today into Friday when much of the Delta through Alabama and parts of Georgia sees up to 0.55" of rain and locally more.





Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Soil temperatures are now cool enough to shut down crop development in many areas in central and Eastern Europe. Crop development is still under way in France, Spain, Portugal, parts of Italy, Greece and the southern Balkan Countries. Portions of the U.K. are still warm enough for some crop development. Autumn fieldwork should be about done, some progress continues in the iberian Peninsula and southern Italy as well as Greece.

eastern Australia for at least the next ten days. Drought conditions will prevail over much of the region and a soaking of rainfall is needed to help ease dryness and crop stress throughout the region. o Very little rainfall will occur through Monday. Any showers will be limited to the southern coast of Victoria and eastern New South Wales where totals will be no more than 0.40 inch.
