South Africa - Weather

Soil moisture will either remain near current levels or increase in much of the production region during the next two weeks

- o Development conditions will improve or remain favorable for most areas
- o However, rainfall will be unable to completely reverse the moisture deficits in Limpopo
- o Crop conditions will be generally favorable, though additional rain will still be needed later this month in some of the drier areas
- o Northern Cape and western sections of Free State and North West will also be too dry for ideal crop conditions in the coming weeks
- o Several crops are irrigated and the periods of rain will be beneficial
- o Rain-fed crops will otherwise need to see more frequent rain later this month to support better development

- The most advanced crops may be stressed at times in the drier areas
- Overall, crop prospects remain generally favorable for the coarse grain, oilseed, and cotton outside some of the driest pockets



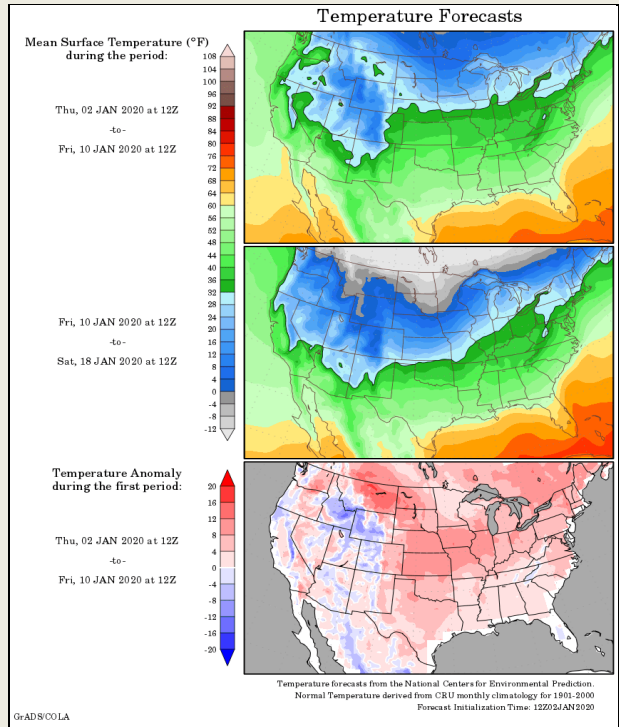
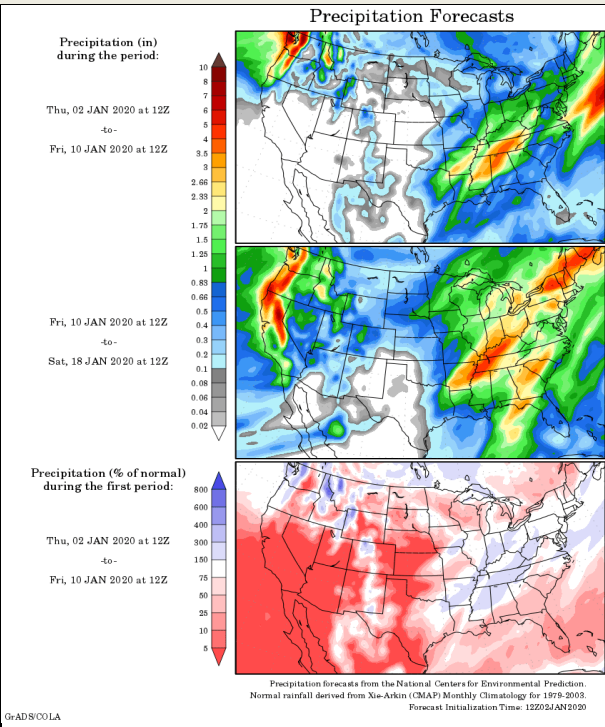
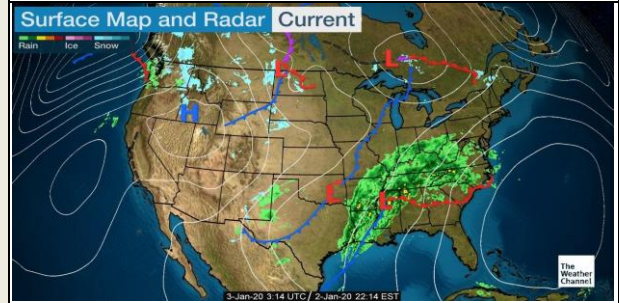
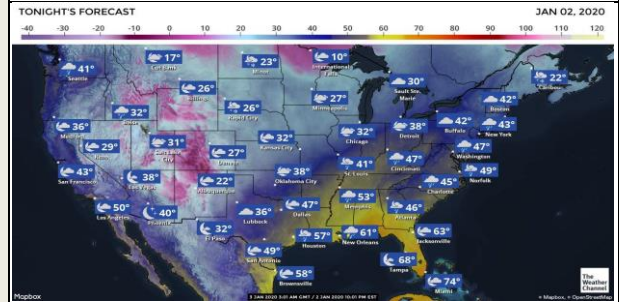
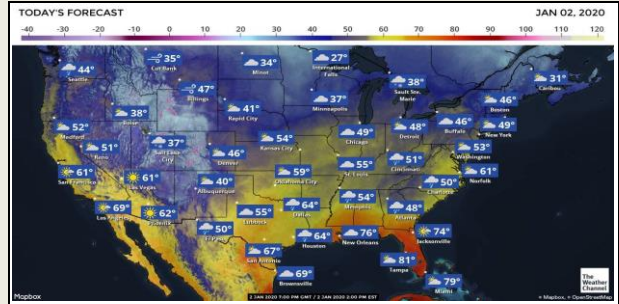
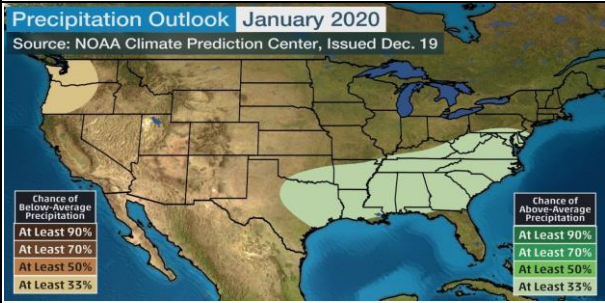
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United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: The Midwest will see two rounds of organized precipitation during the next ten days with the first occurring today into Saturday when southeastern Missouri and Kentucky into Ohio and eastern Michigan sees precipitation while the second storm system will occur Jan. 9-11.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will see only two rounds of precipitation during the next ten days and some fieldwork should advance around the precipitation.

o The first round of precipitation will occur today into Friday with the southern Delta through northern Alabama seeing 1.0-3.0" of rain and locally more while other areas from the Delta through northern Georgia see 0.50-1.20" and locally more with lighter rain in the remainder of the Southeast.

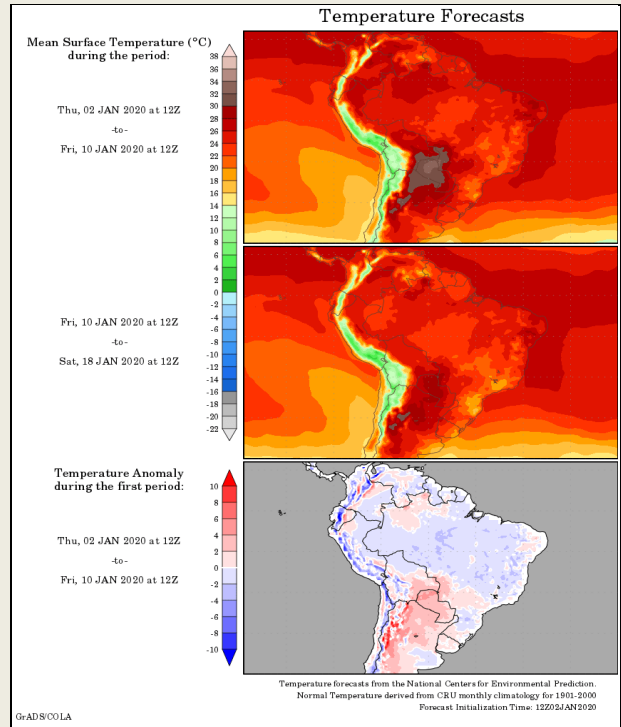
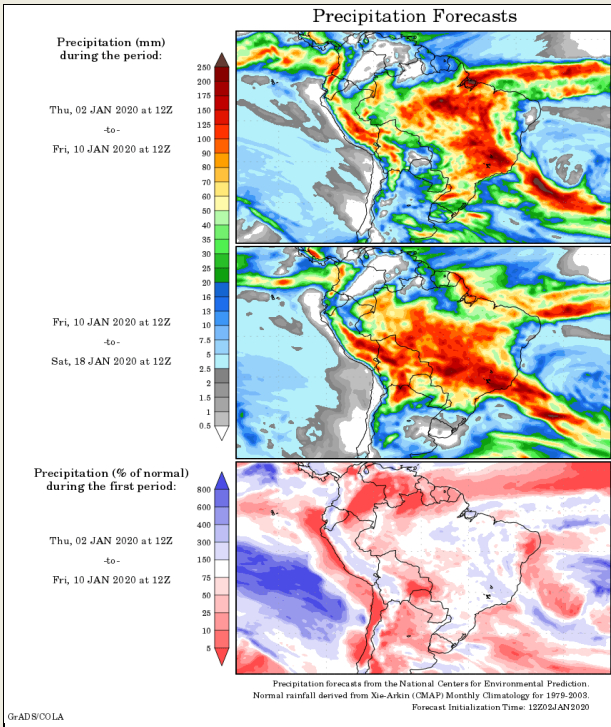
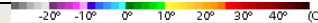
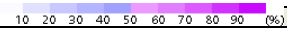
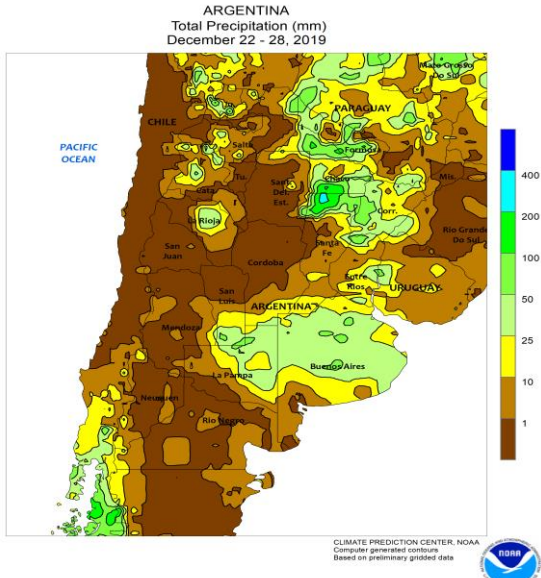


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South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Paraguay into southern Parana, Santa Catarina, and Rio Grande do Sul will continue to dry down and some areas will see rising levels of crop stress during the next ten days and crop stress may become serious if rain does not increase soon.
 o Most of southern Parana and Santa Catarina still have enough subsoil moisture to support the needs of crops during the next ten days while drying takes place, but with the warm to hot temperatures expected and subsoil moisture already low in much of Paraguay and Rio Grande do Sul these areas are likely to see rising levels of crop stress until rain returns.

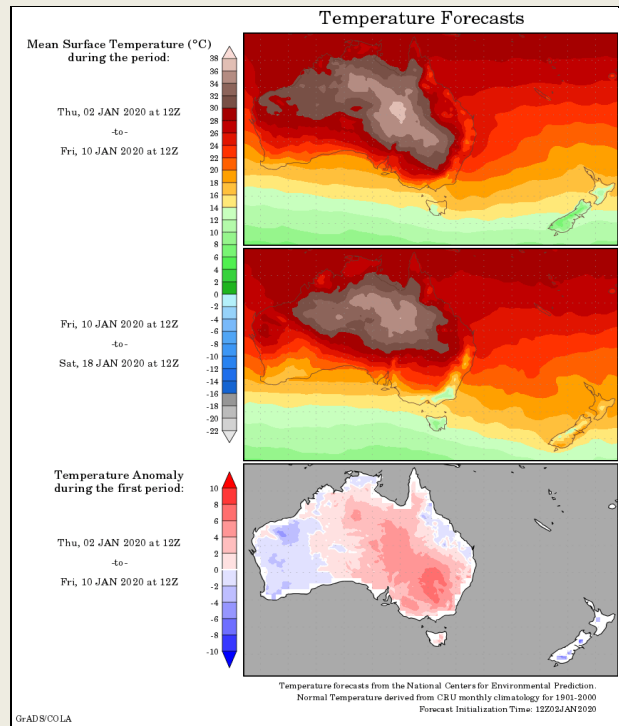
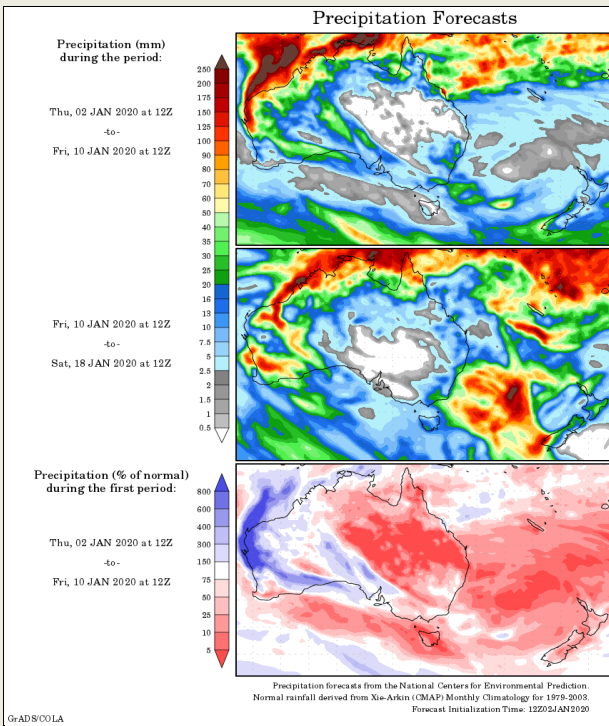
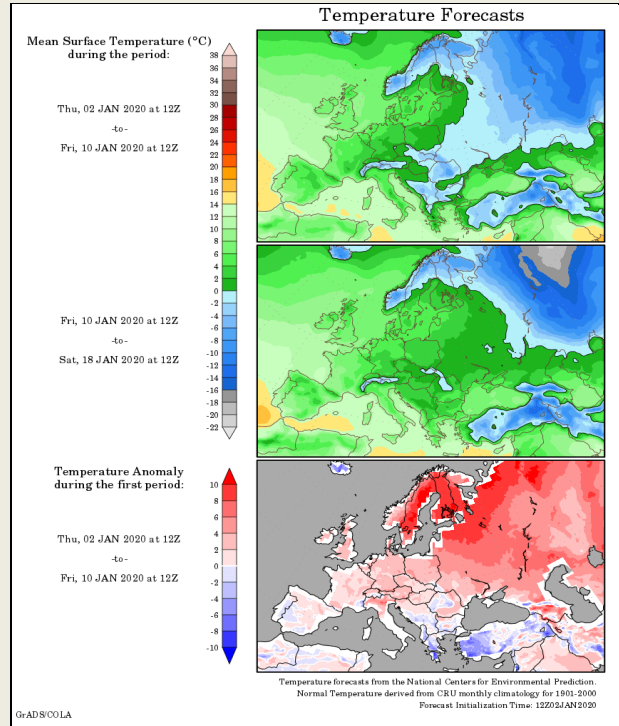
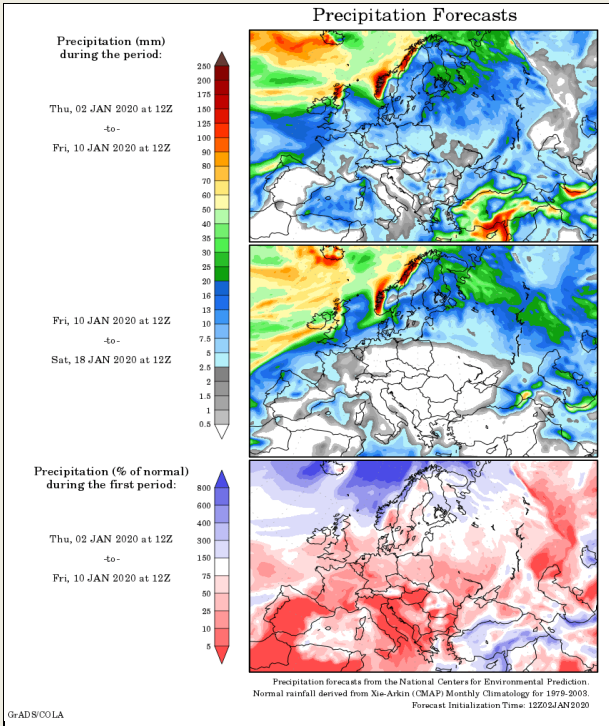
ARGENTINA: Outside of some important rain in southern Argentina Sunday, a restricted rainfall pattern and warm to hot temperatures will be in place through Tuesday causing rapid drying and some crop stress before a critical increase in showers occurs Wednesday through Saturday, Jan. 11.



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Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Frequent precipitation will continue over the Iberian Peninsula, France, the U.K. into the Netherlands west and south Germany, Switzerland and southwest Austria into Slovenia and the eastern Adriatic Sea Nations this week. AUSTRALIA: Persistent heat and drought will not go away anytime soon over Australia. Stress to livestock and crops will continue, but temperatures will not be as extreme in eastern production areas all the time which may help decrease crop stress some. o The hottest temperatures will be most frequent over interior east-central Australia. Daily highs will vary in the 90s up to 115 Fahrenheit most often.



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
