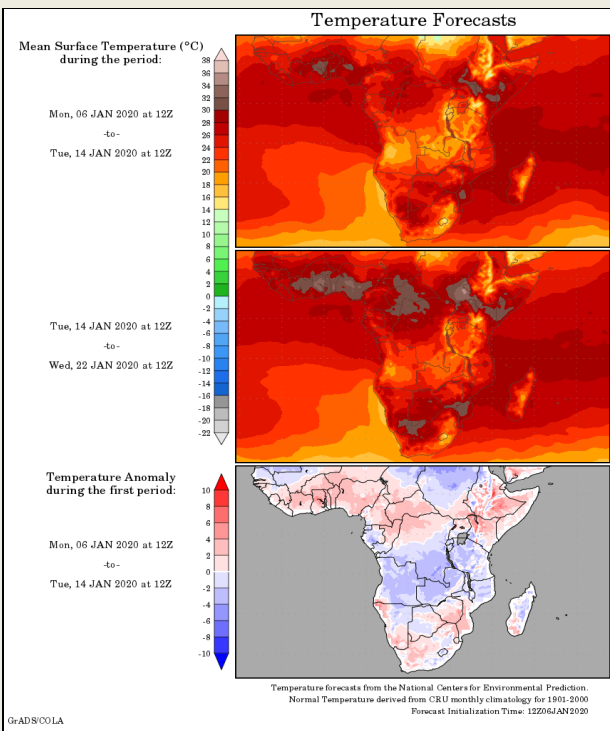
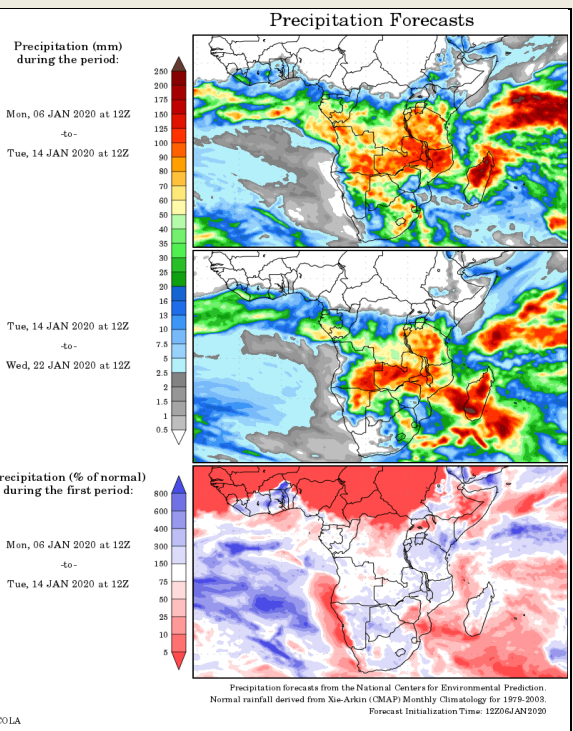
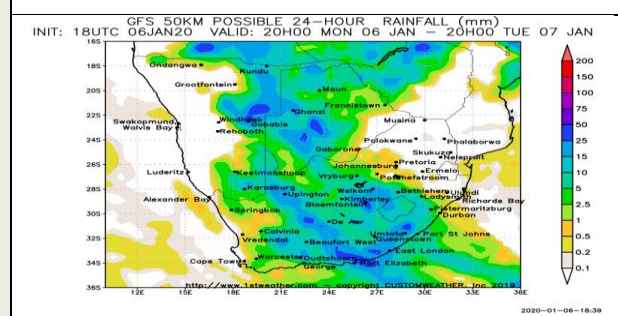
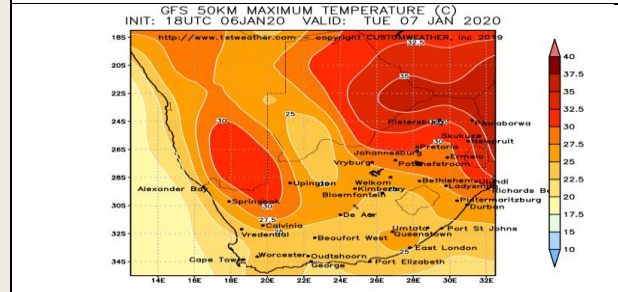
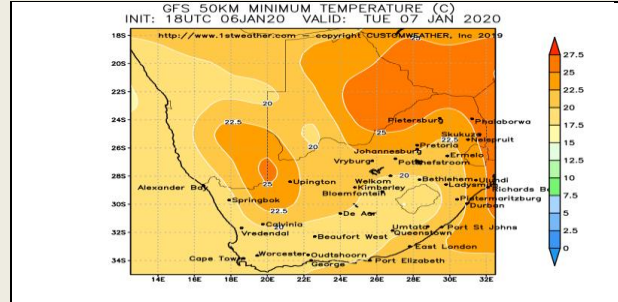
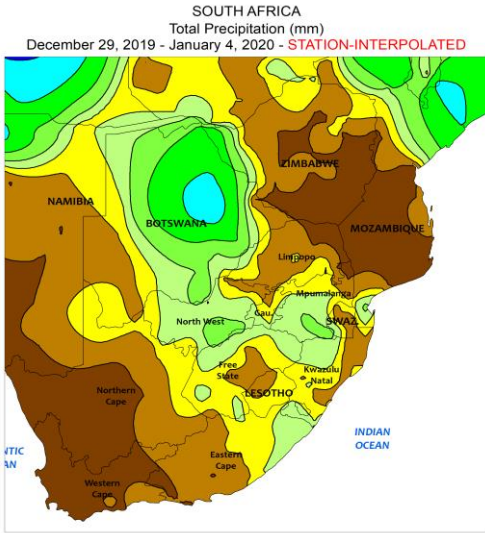




Weather Report

South Africa - Weather

- The moisture profile will continue to increase for a large portion of the production region during the next two weeks
- o Development conditions will either improve or remain favorable for most areas
- o However, northeastern Limpopo, Northern Cape, and western sections of Free State and North West may still have a shortage of moisture by the end of the outlook
- o Crop conditions will be generally favorable, though additional rain will still be needed later this month in some of the drier areas
- o Northern Cape and western sections of Free State and North West irrigated crops will be in good shape despite the lack of significant rain in several areas
- o Rain-fed crops may be stressed in the drier areas
- o Overall, crop prospects remain generally favorable for the coarse grain, oilseed, and cotton outside some of the driest pockets

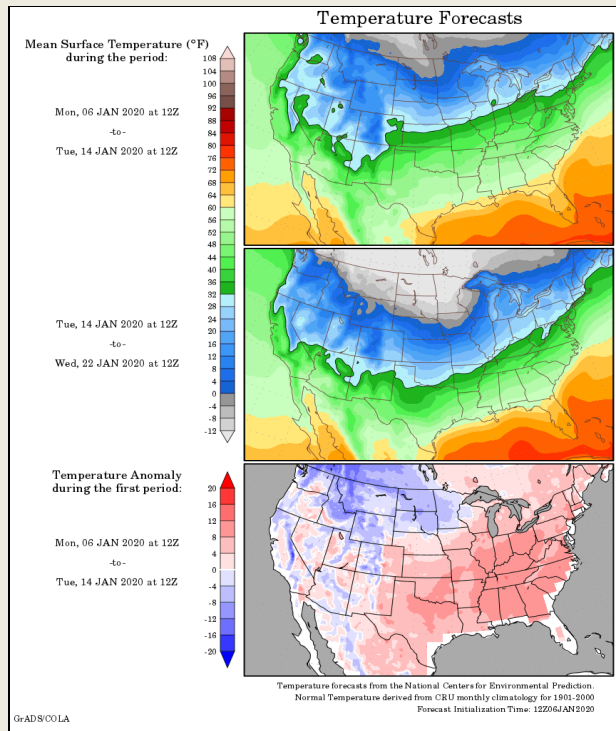
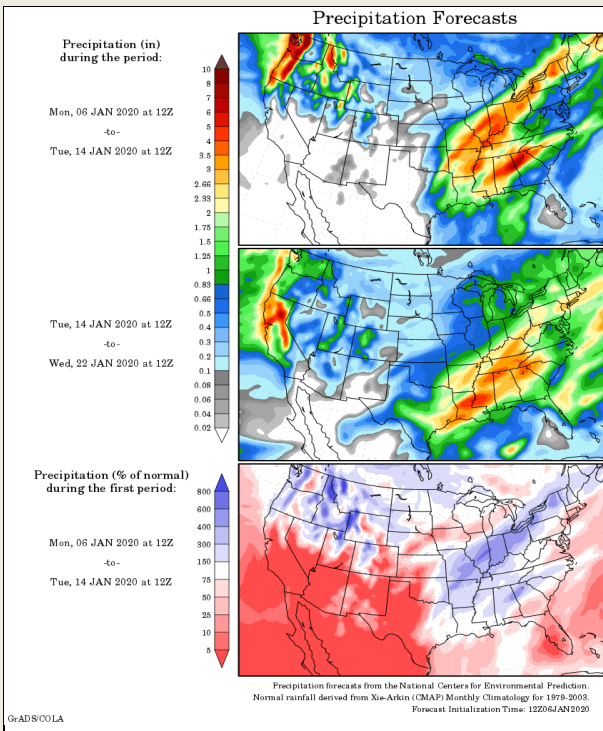
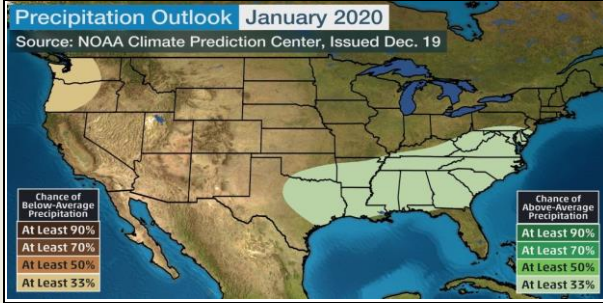
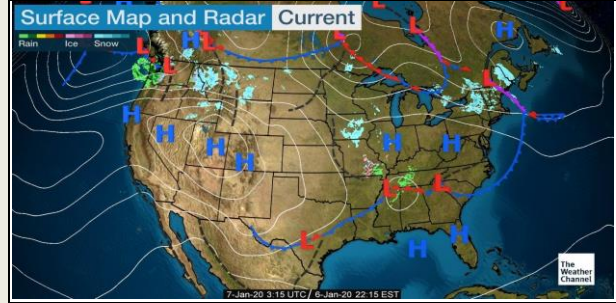
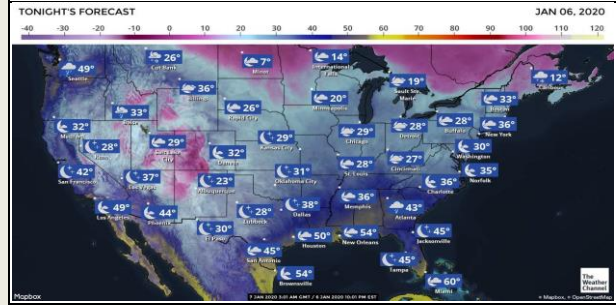
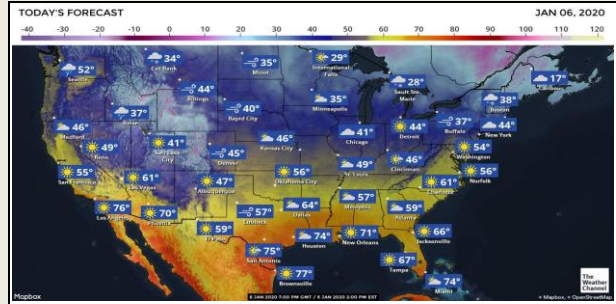

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: The Midwest will see two rounds of organized precipitation during the next ten days with the first continuing into Saturday when Kentucky into Ohio sees precipitation while the second storm system will occur Jan. 9-11.
 o Moisture content of the precipitation from today into Saturday will be 0.10-0.75" and locally more with 0.75-1.25" totals common in southern Ohio.
 o Most of the precipitation will fall as rain with some light snow as the precipitation comes to an end.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will see light rain continue today with light rain returning early next week and the next significant storm system expected Thursday into Jan. 11.
 o Temperatures will be warmer than normal through the next week and that will allow the soil to dry down enough for fieldwork in some areas with exception in parts of the region that received heavy rain Thursday.

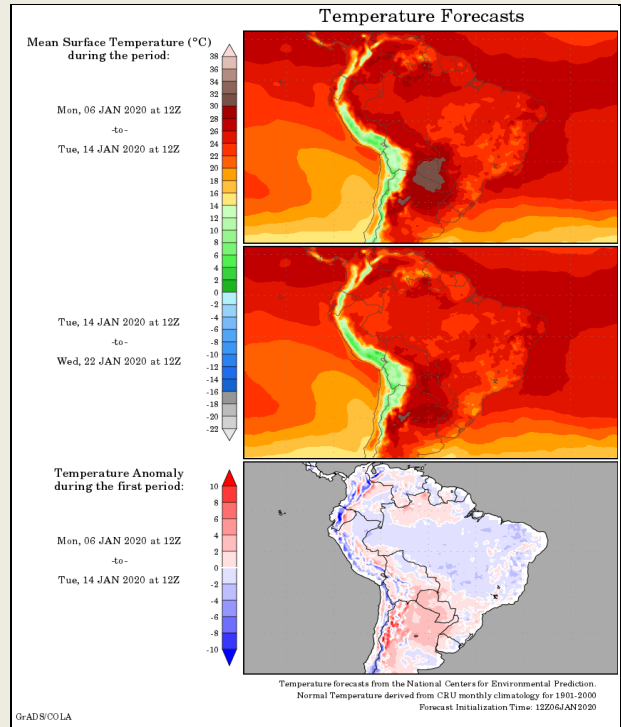
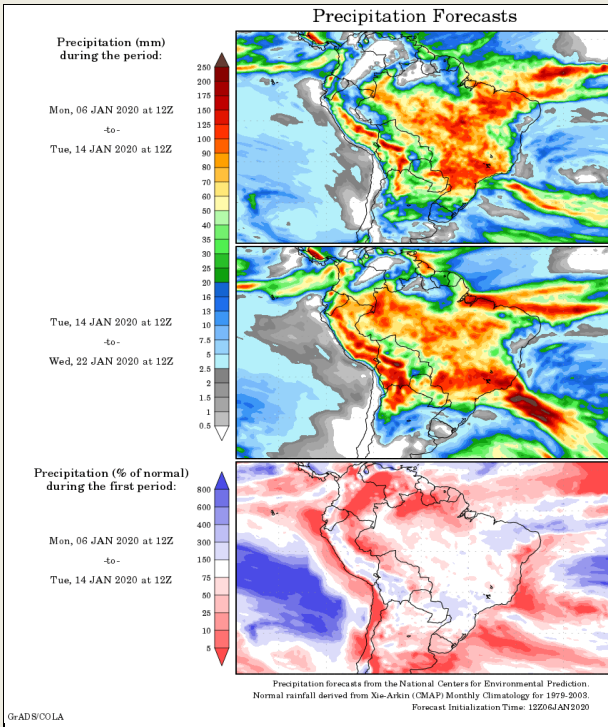
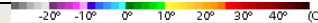
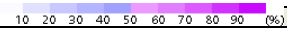
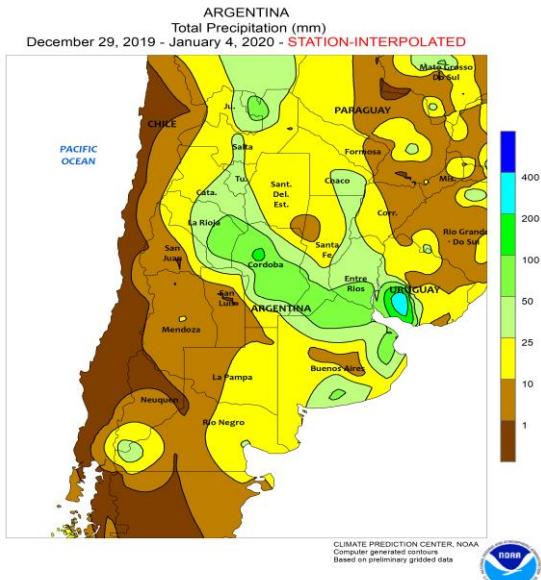

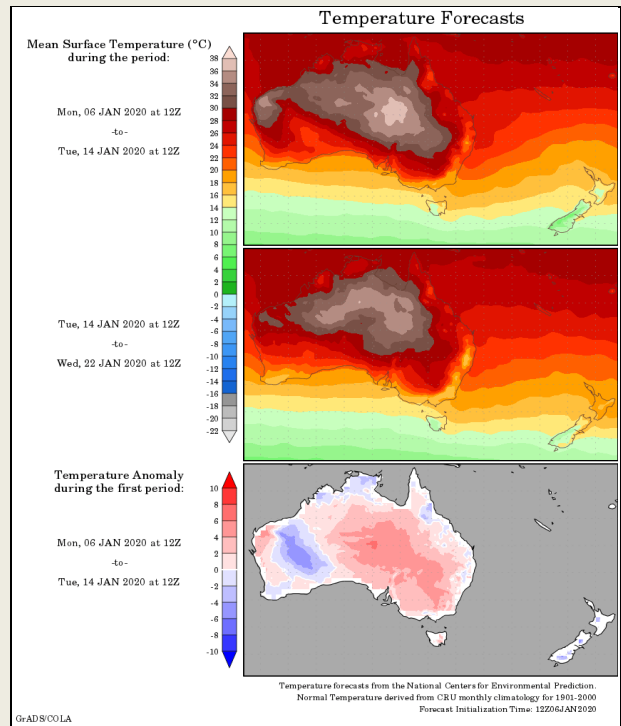
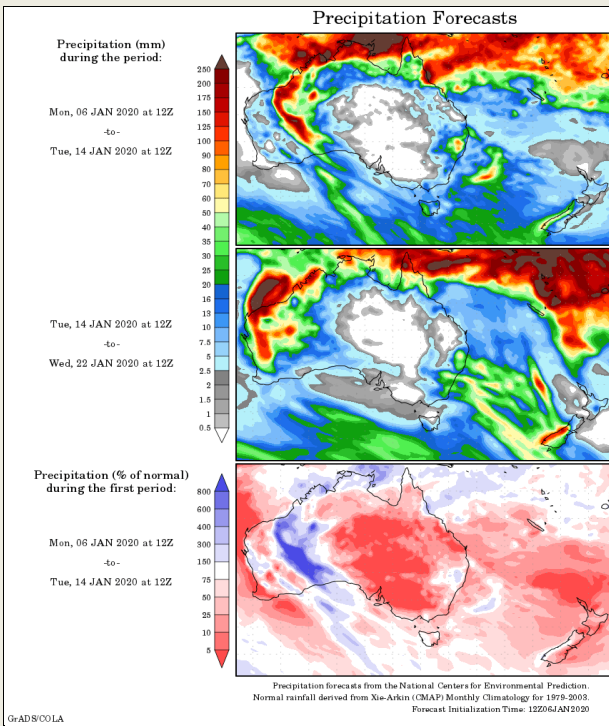
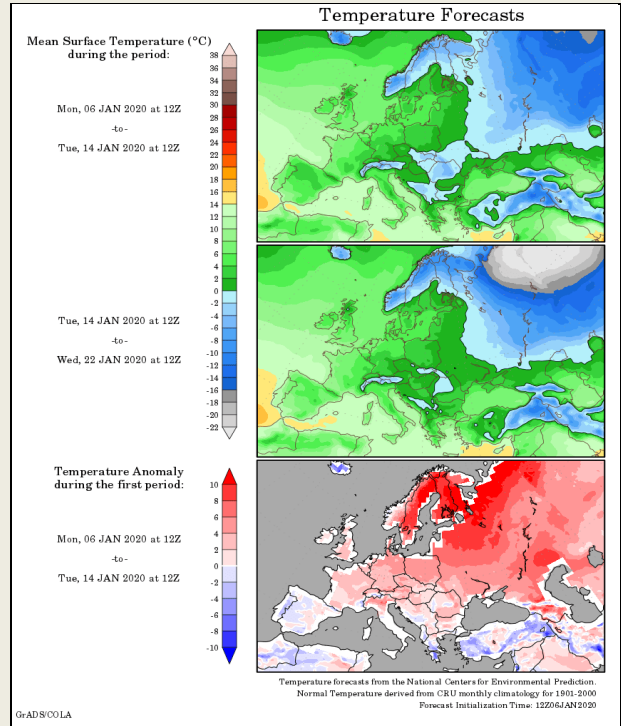
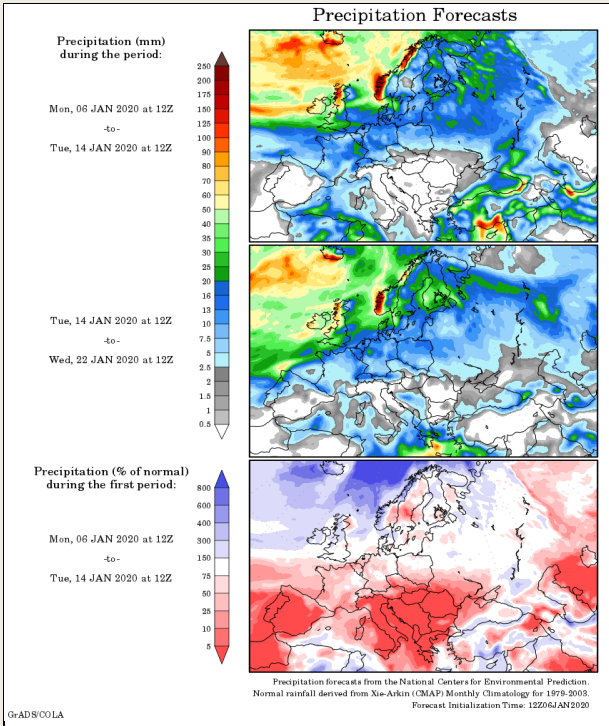
ARGENTINA: Increases in soil moisture from recent rain and at least some showers Wednesday into Thursday should allow crops to develop without serious stress in southern Argentina during the next two weeks as the region dries down, but a boost in rain will be needed later this month to ensure crop stress does not quickly increase.

EUROPE: Frequent precipitation will continue over the Iberian Peninsula, France, the U.K. into the Netherlands west and south Germany, Switzerland and southwest Austria into Slovenia and the eastern Adriatic Sea Nations this week. AUSTRALIA: The heavy rainfall will not have much impact, except in coastal communities. Some experimental cotton and other crops are grown in the region, but the impact on those crops should be low and any damage will not impact Australia's bottom line.
