

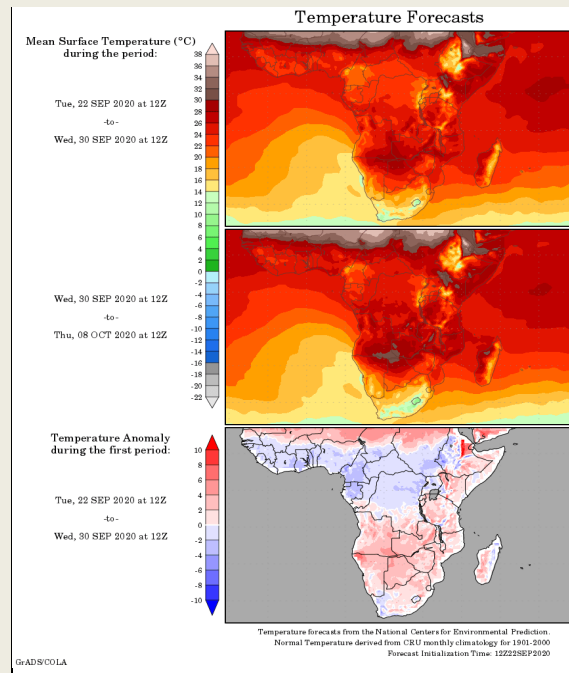
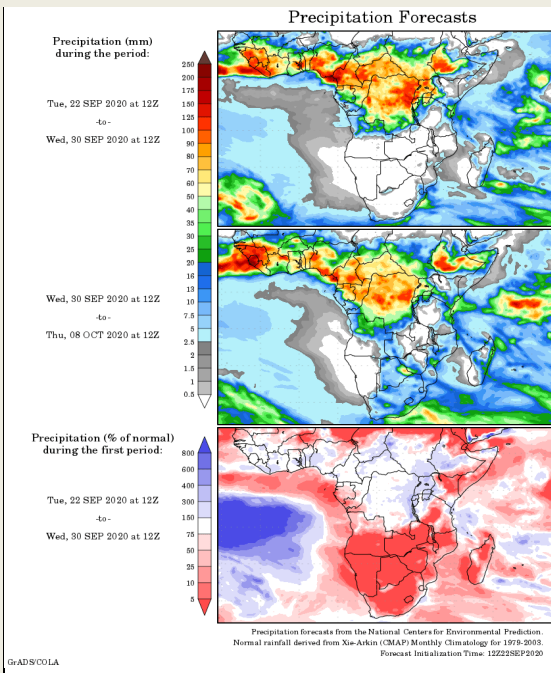
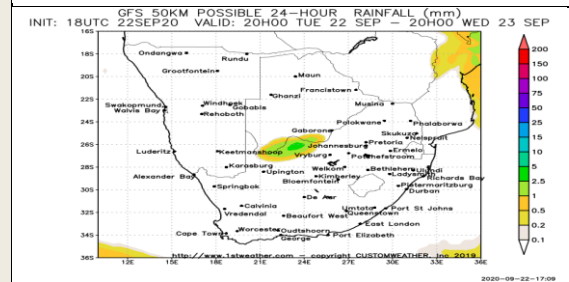
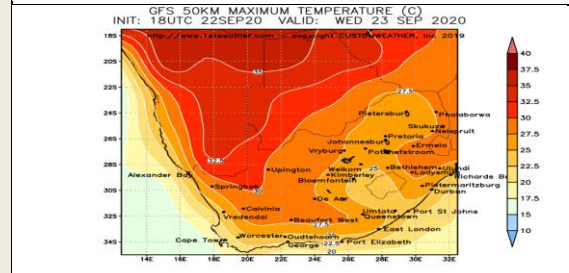
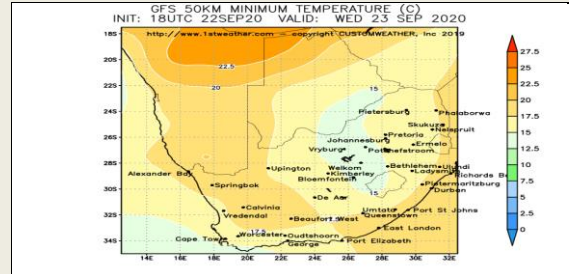
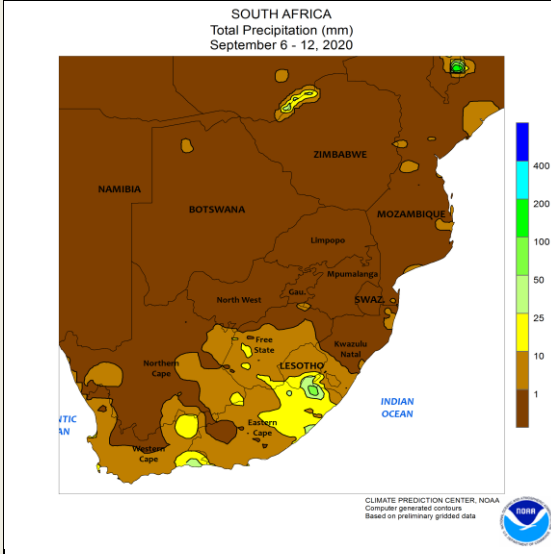


# **Weather Report**

# South Africa - Weather

- Late season winter wheat development will continue under generally favorable conditions for Western Cape during the next few days
- o However, development may become sluggish later in the forecast period as the ground firms
- o The environment will otherwise be favorable for maturation
- o Yields are expected to be good this year due to timely rain over the growing season
- o The small amount of rain-fed winter wheat in Free State and neighboring areas will be too dry to support favorable conditions during the next two weeks
- o Irrigated crops will develop under more favorable conditions in Free State, Northern Cape, and neighboring areas
- o Maturation conditions will be mostly favorable

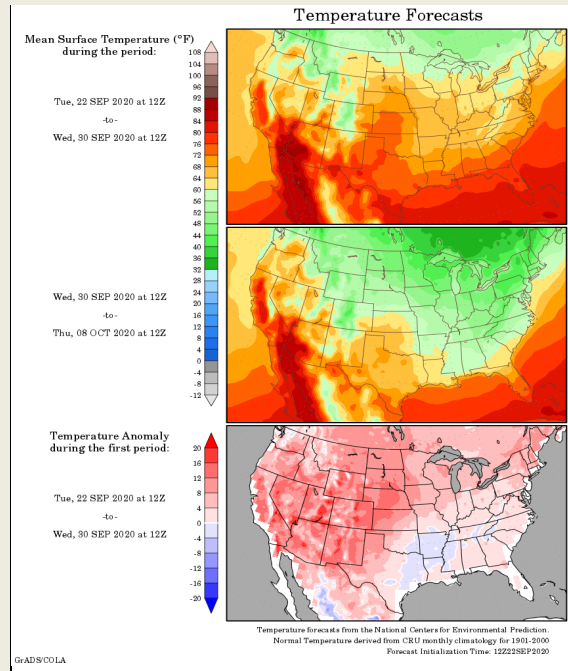
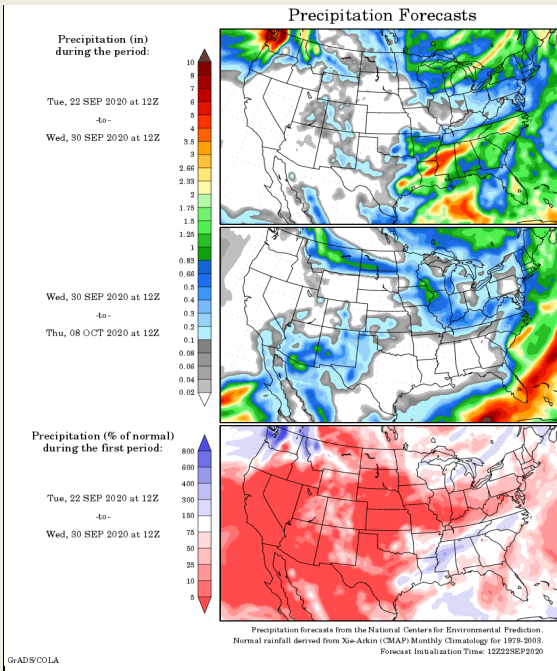
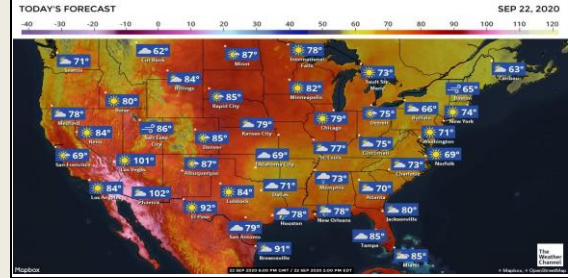
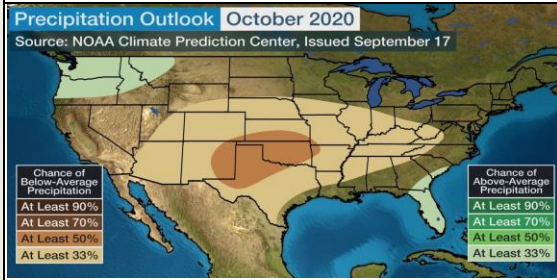

# United States of America - Weather

**U.S. MIDWEST:** The Midwest will be wetter during the next ten days than that recently noted, but favorable conditions for crop maturation and harvesting will continue to be most common as rain will be light enough that interruptions to fieldwork will be mostly brief.

**U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST:** Tropical Storm Beta will slowly move from near to over southeastern Texas and into the southern Delta this week with winds not likely strong enough to threaten most crops while daily rain will fall to portions of the Delta through Alabama through Thursday with some flooding likely and some at least temporary discoloration to cotton. Light rain will fall on nearby areas while most areas from south-central and southeastern Georgia and nearby Florida to southeastern Virginia are dry through Thursday and see improvements in conditions for harvesting.



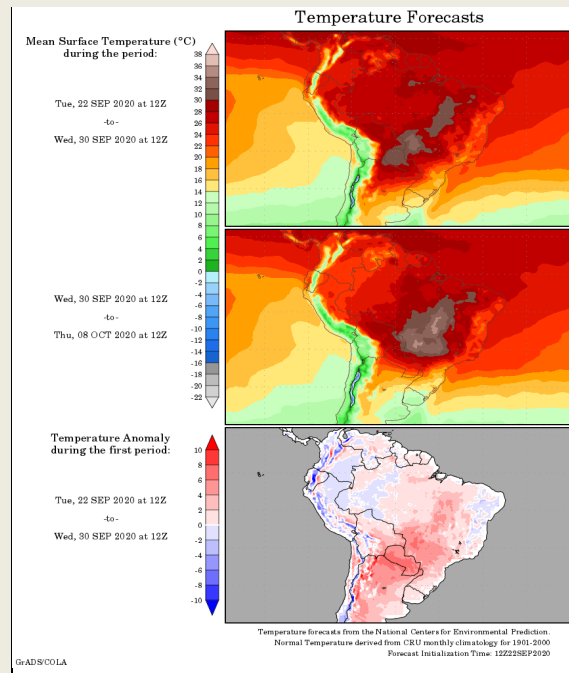
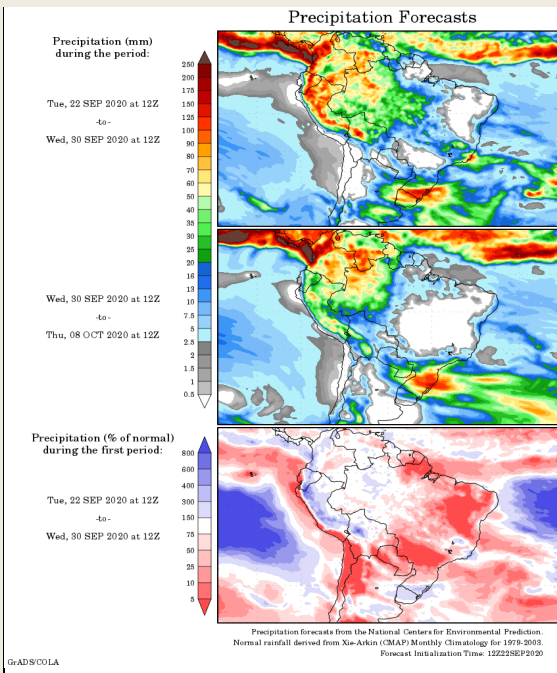
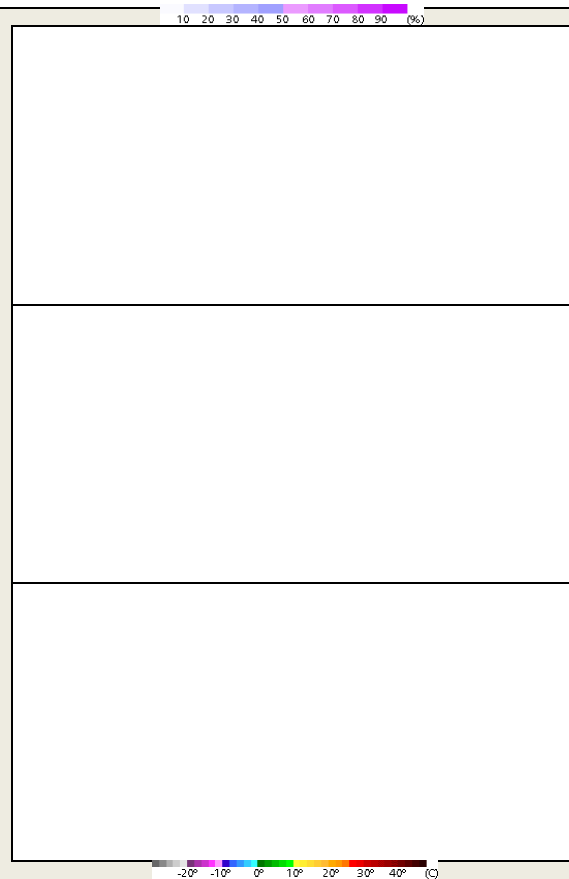
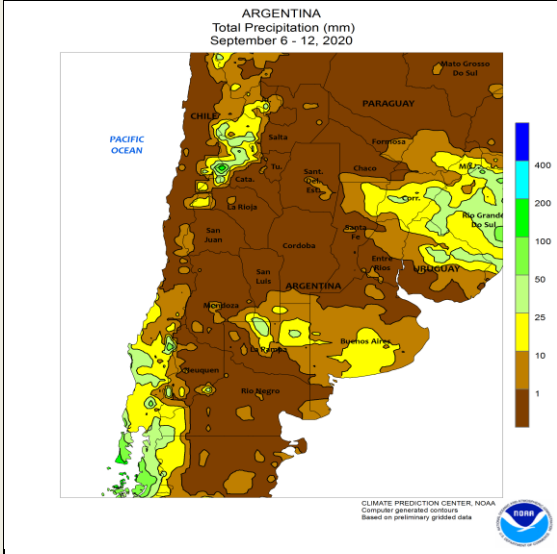

# South America - Weather

**BRAZIL:** Showers and thunderstorms will continue through Thursday from portions of Mato Grosso and central Mato Grosso do Sul to northern Parana, Sao Paulo, and central and southern Minas Gerais. Enough rain will fall in parts of the region to induce increases in soil moisture and improvements in conditions for summer crop planting while other areas see rain that is too light to have much of an impact on soil conditions. Warmer and drier weather will occur in most of western into central Brazil Friday through Oct. 6 and much of the moisture from rain this week will soon be lost to evaporation.

**ARGENTINA:** Two more days of dry weather will occur before rain increases Thursday through Sunday with enough rain to improve soil moisture and conditions for winter wheat in many southern, central, and eastern parts of the country with the soil dry enough in the southwest that follow-up rain will still be needed soon to maintain improvements in soil moisture that occur.

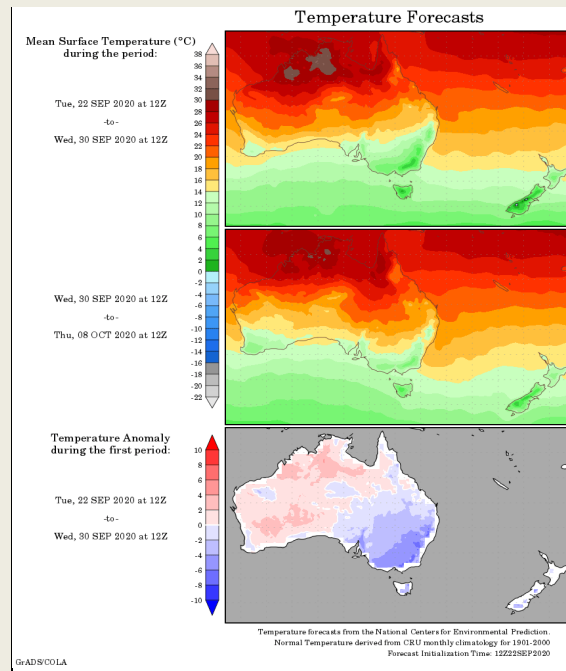
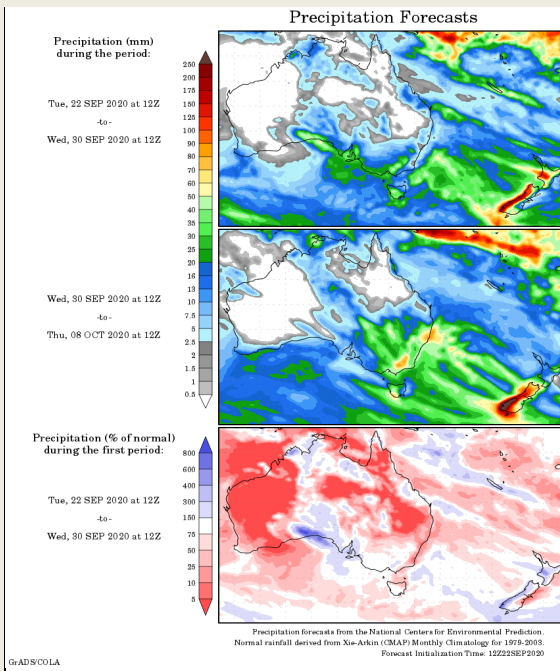
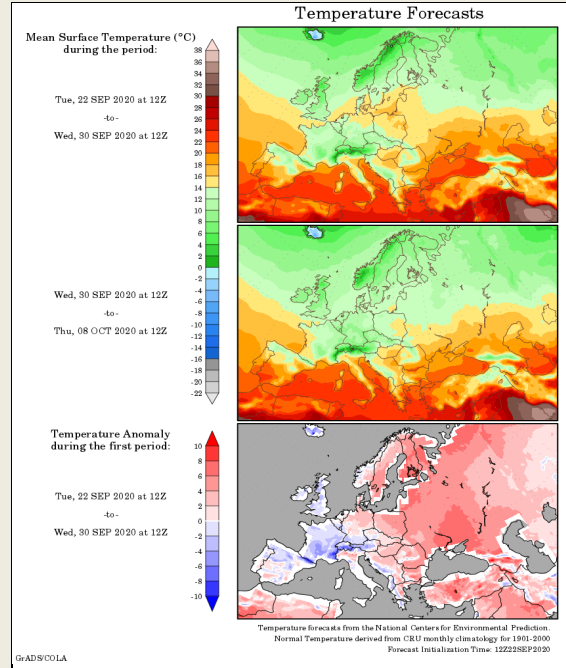
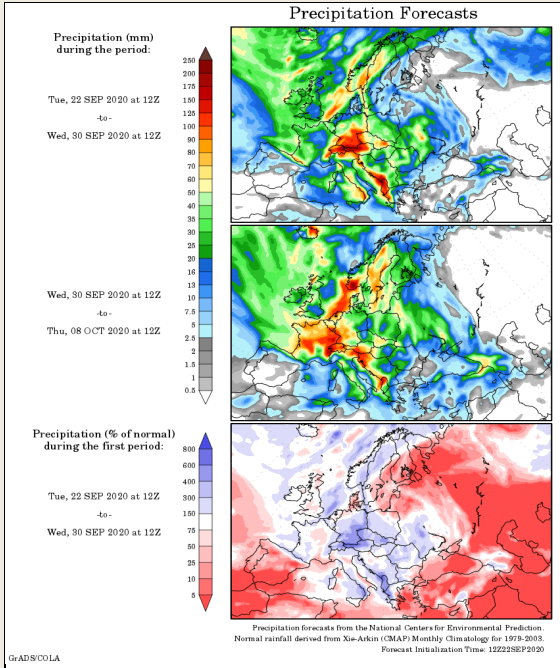

# Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Europe is expected to trend wetter later this week into the second week of the outlook. Southern Spain and Portugal will trend drier through the next ten days and some drying may persist in eastern Bulgaria into southeastern Romania. Next week rounds of precipitation are expected to continue throughout Europe. With that said, drying will return to much of mainland Europe Sep. 29-Oct. 1 and precipitation will be confined to the U.K. and Scandinavia. Rounds of precipitation will return to mainland Europe October 2-5 and further improvements in soil moisture should occur.

AUSTRALIA: Rain will be greatest over southern portions of Australia during the coming ten days and the moisture will be important for winter crop development. The best moisture will fall over Victoria and southeastern South Australia into surrounding southern New South Wales Wednesday into Friday.
