

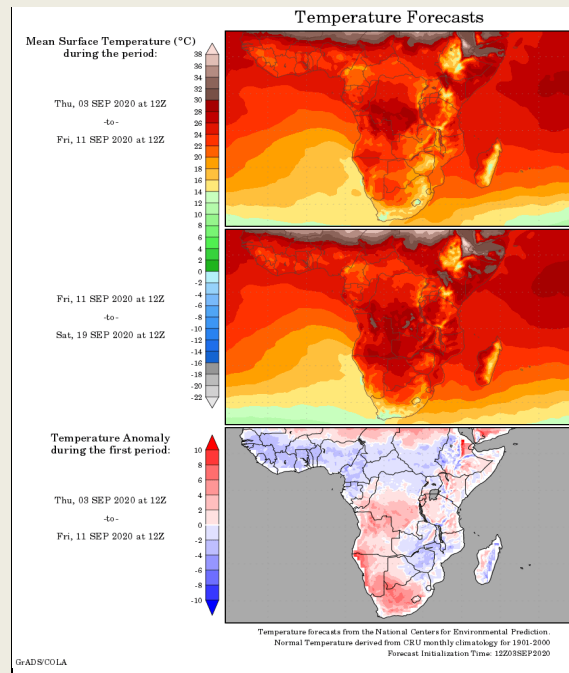
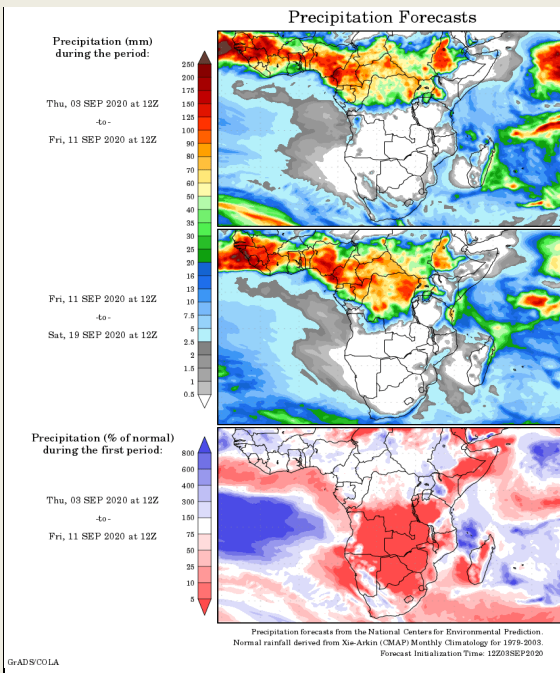
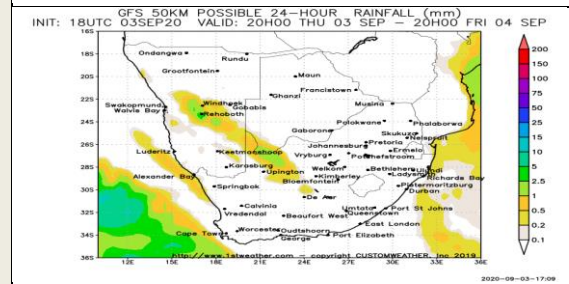
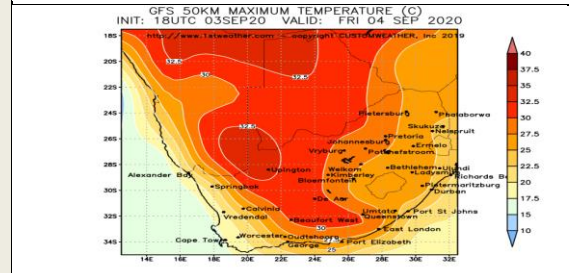
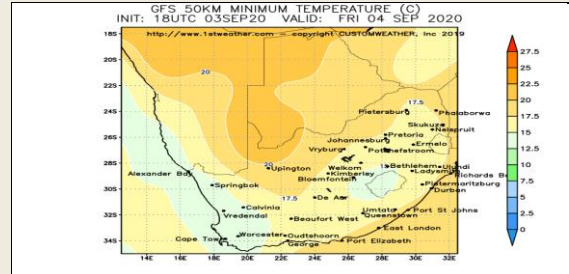
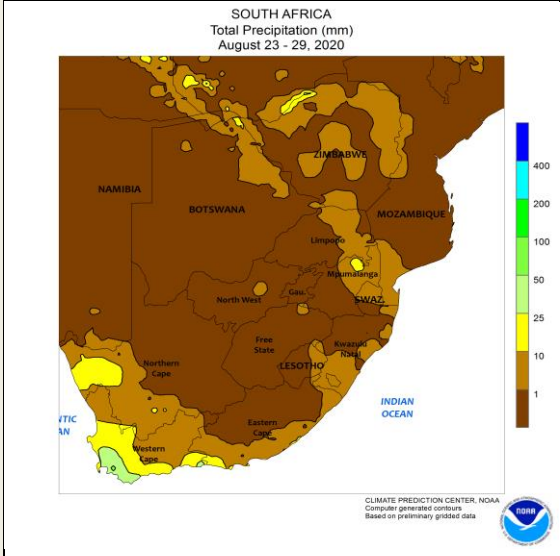


Weather Report

04 September 2020

South Africa - Weather

- Eastern South Africa will generally be drier biased during the next two weeks
 - o Brief periods of light rain will occur, though any rain that does occur will be rapidly lost to evaporation o Soil moisture will remain short to critically short despite recent rainfall
- Western South Africa will have a few opportunities for light and erratic rain during the coming week
 - o Much of the rain that does occur will be too light to counter evaporation or impact long-term soil conditions
- Western Cape's main winter wheat areas will have plenty of moisture to support aggressive growth during the next two weeks despite many areas receiving little to no rain
 - o Yields are expected to be favorable this season
 - o The small amount of rain-fed winter wheat in Free State and neighboring areas will be too dry to support aggressive growth in the next two weeks
 - o Irrigated crops will develop under more favorable conditions in Free State, Northern Cape, and neighboring areas, though most locations would still welcome a good shot of rain

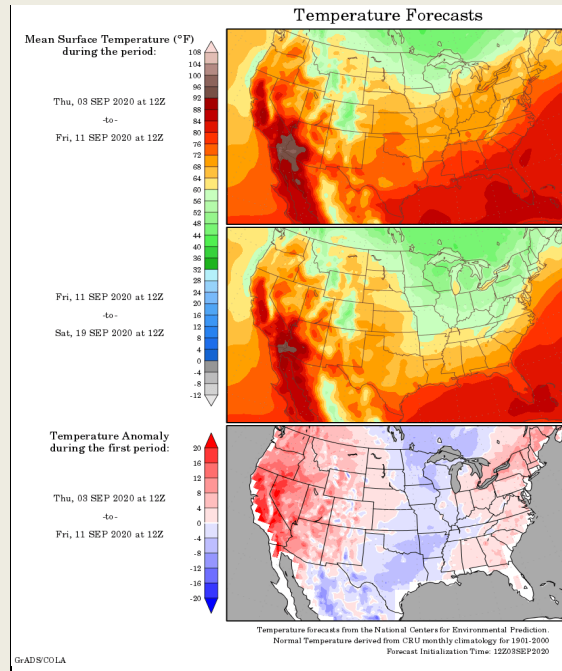
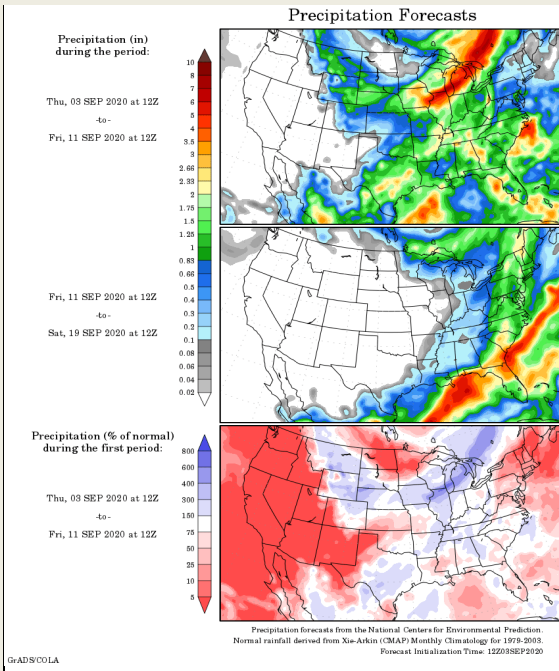
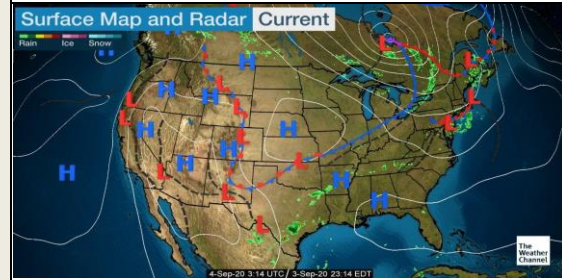
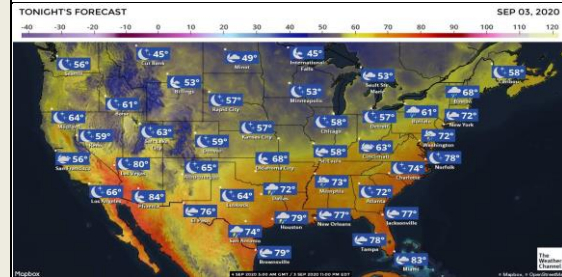
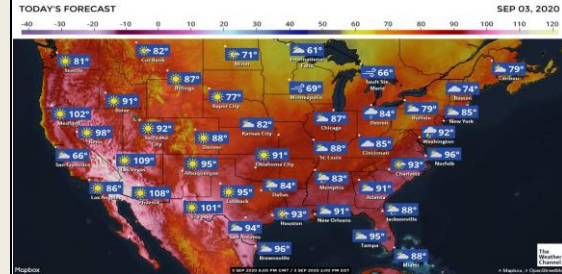
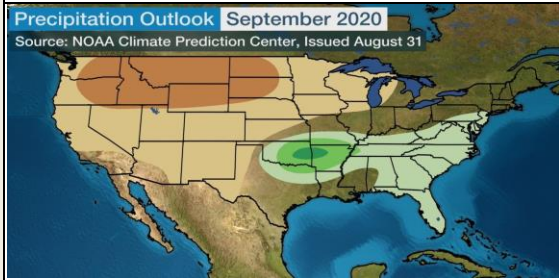


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United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Two more days of dry weather will occur in much of the Midwest before a wetter weather pattern occurs Saturday into next week in most areas outside of the northwest with the rain beneficial for late soybean development in most areas while the rain will come too late to induce improvements in crop yields in the driest areas from southeastern South Dakota and eastern Nebraska into Iowa. Conditions for crop maturation will improve and some harvesting should occur, especially in the drier areas where crops reached maturity earlier than usual. Temperatures will become much cooler than usual next week and a close watch will be made on areas from the eastern Dakotas into Minnesota where there will likely be some frost and possibly a few light freezes.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Dry conditions will be most common through Saturday in the Delta and the Southeast allowing cotton and rice to dry out after recent rain raised concerns over crop quality. An isolated to scattered shower pattern will occur most often from Sunday through Sep. 17 with most areas seeing rain that is infrequent enough to allow for fieldwork to advance while most crops should not become wet enough to raise serious concerns over crop quality.



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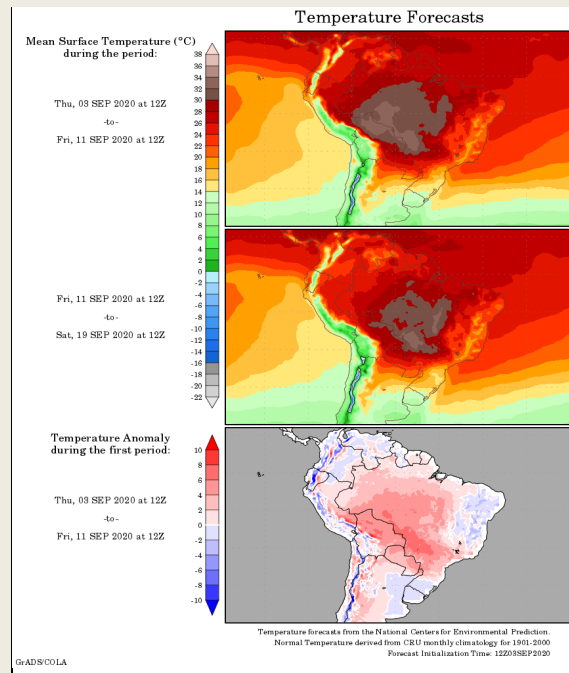
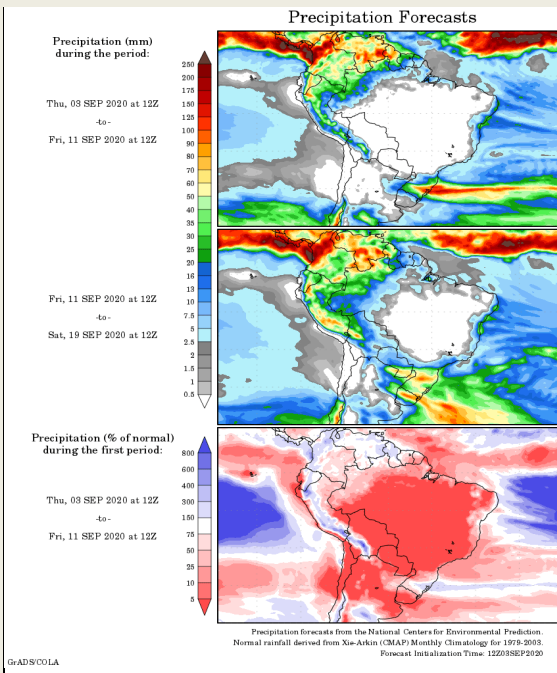
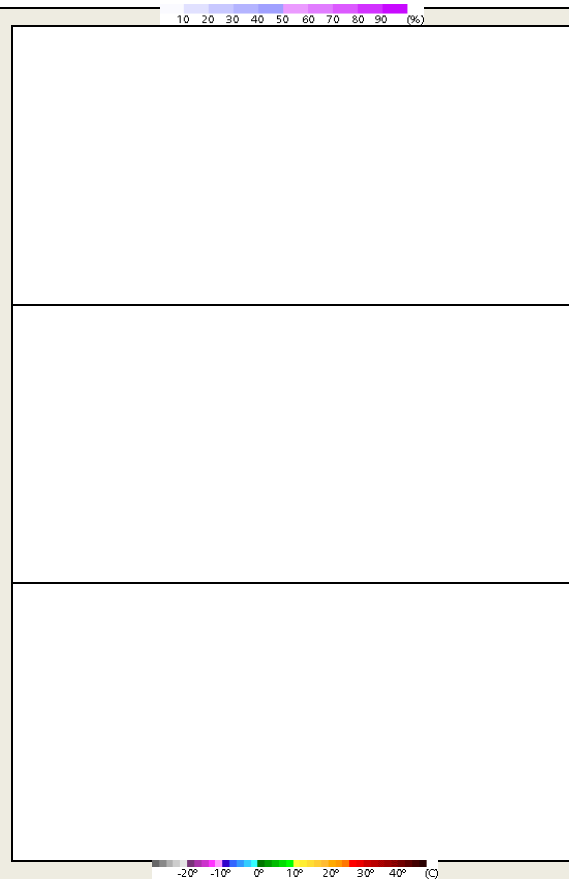
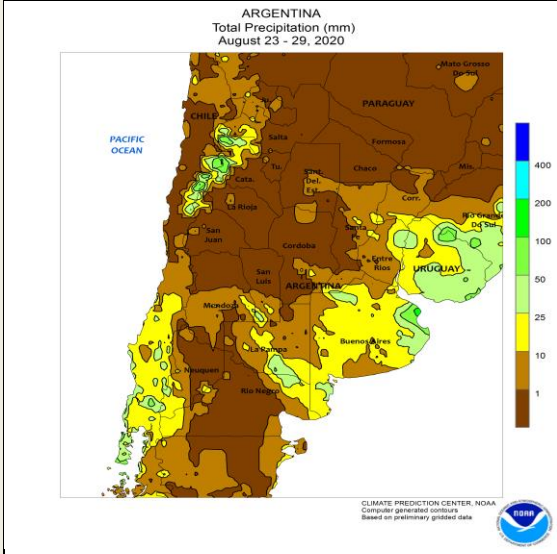
South America - Weather

BRAZIL: A restricted rainfall pattern will continue in much of Brazil and Paraguay through the next two weeks and fieldwork should advance well with exceptions in far southern Brazil where frequent rain will fall through Wednesday and concerns over wet weather diseases in winter wheat may increase.

ARGENTINA: Little rain is expected through the next two weeks and most of the moisture from rain earlier this week in western Argentina will quickly be lost to evaporation.

o A few showers will occur on occasion with southern and northeastern Argentina favored for most of the rain.

o Southern San Luis into La Pampa will see an increase in rain Saturday and most of the region will receive 0.05-0.40" and locally more with some greater totals in central La Pampa.



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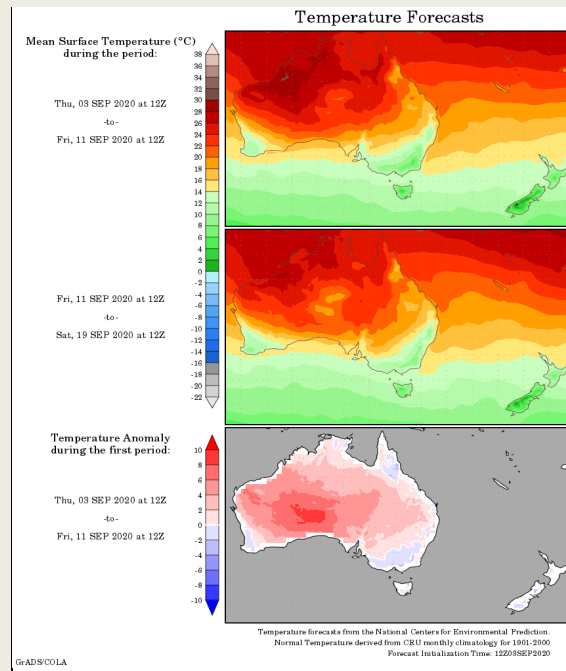
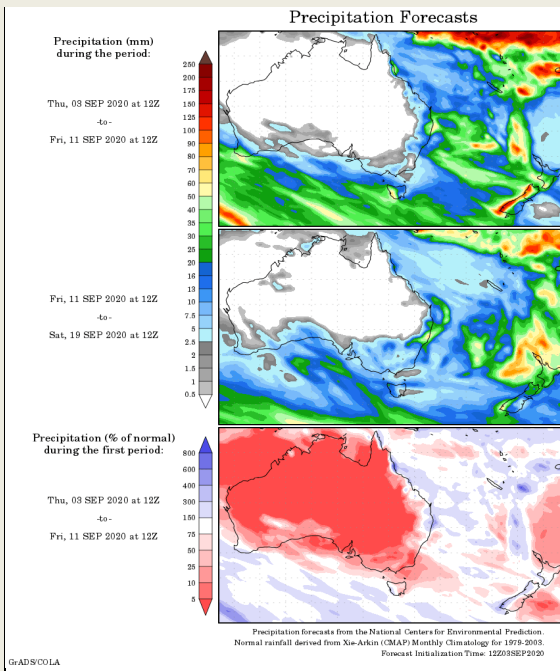
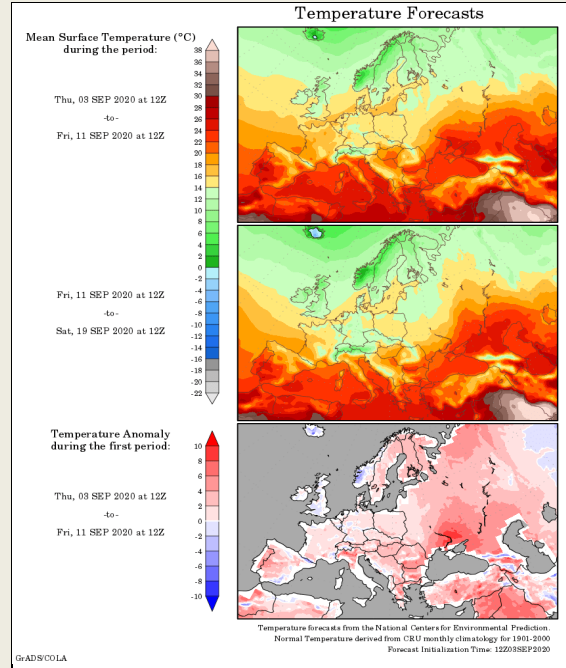
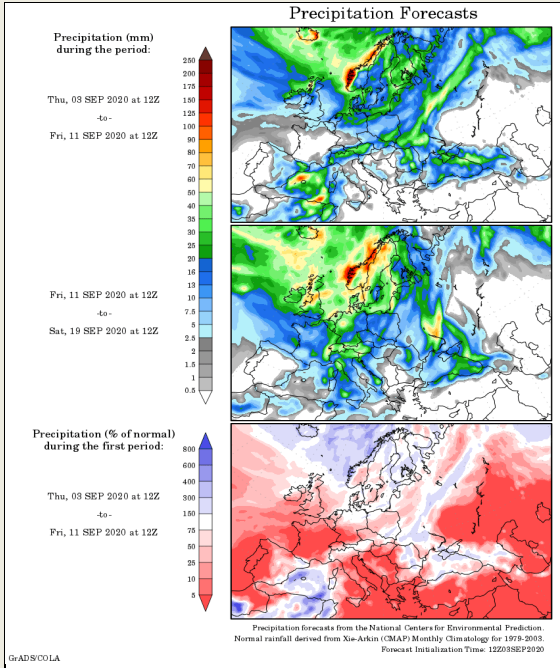
Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Rounds of precipitation will occur from the northern U.K. and the North Sea Region through the Netherlands, northern Germany, southern Scandinavia into the Baltic Sea Region and northern Poland this week.

o Precipitation will linger over the Alps Region the remainder of this week as well.

AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation will prevail over Australia the coming ten days to two weeks. Rain is needed in Queensland immediately to support reproduction that should be starting, but no such rain will occur for at least the next week to ten days.

o A couple rounds of light showers will occur in southeastern to east-central Australia Friday into the middle of next week. Most of the moisture will be light and erratic Friday into Sunday with a chance of increased coverage occurring during the middle of next week.



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
