South Africa - Weather

Net drying is slated for much of the region ☐ Early season planting will advance swiftly in most locations ☐ Germination and establishment conditions will be mostly favorable for the areas that received significant rain in recent weeks ☐ Free State, North West, and neighboring areas will otherwise be too dry to support favorable establishment and growth ☐ Timely rain is needed in the near future as more widespread planting begins

- The western half of South Africa will also be drier biased this week
- o Any rain that occurs will be lost to evaporation • Western Cape will have enough moisture to support generally favorable late-season winter wheat growth
- o The lack of significant rain will also be beneficial for the crops that are maturing or ready for harvest o Yields are expected to be good this year
- o The small amount of rain-fed winter wheat in Free State and neighboring areas will be too dry to support favorable late-season development
- ☐ Irrigated crop conditions will be more favorable
- ☐ Maturation will advance swiftly

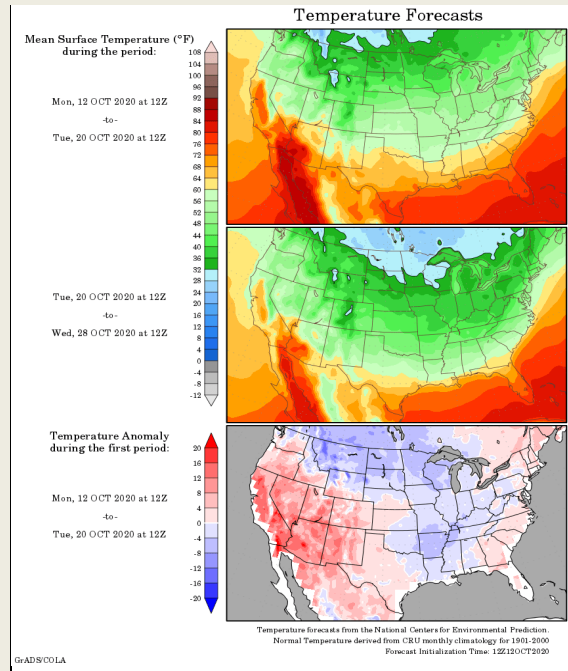
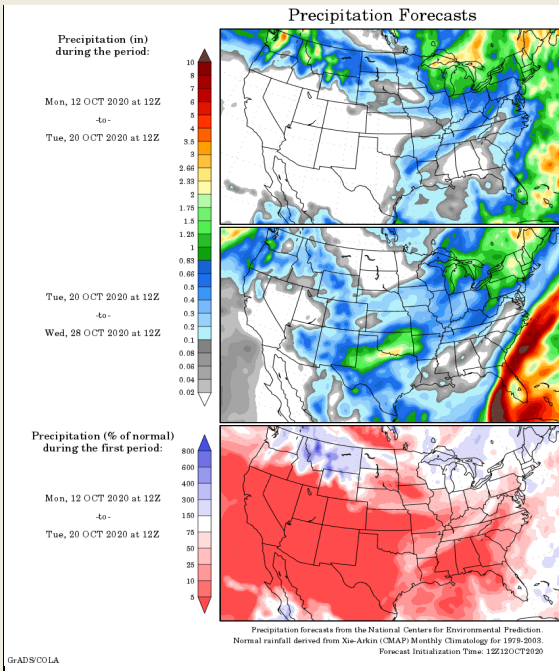
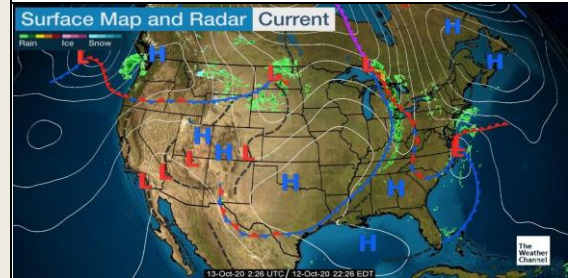
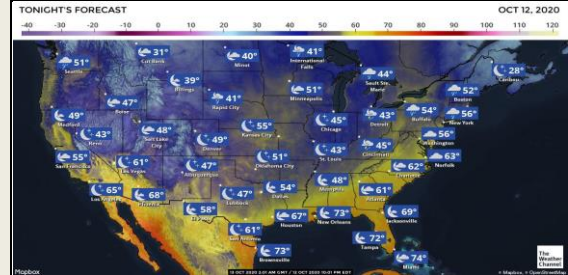
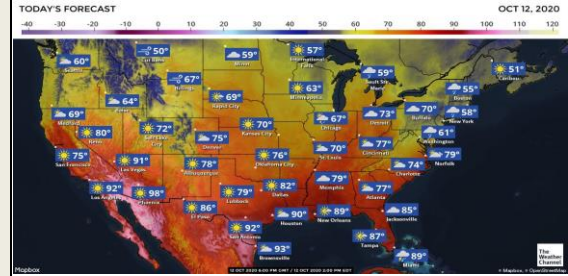
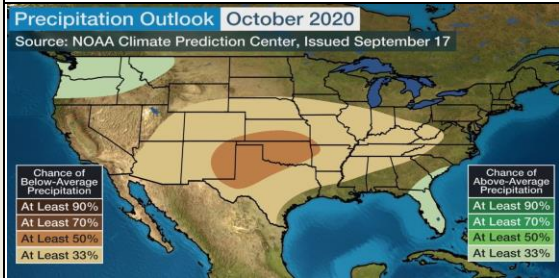


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United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Two more weeks of good harvest progress will occur in the Midwest as dry conditions will continue to be most common with a few rounds of precipitation that will cause temporary interruptions to fieldwork and the west-central and southwestern Corn Belt driest.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Dry conditions will be most common during the next two weeks across the Delta and the Southeast and cotton should bleach white while harvesting should quickly resume in most areas that did not receive heavy rain from Hurricane Delta while multiple days of drying will be needed in areas that did see heavy rain.

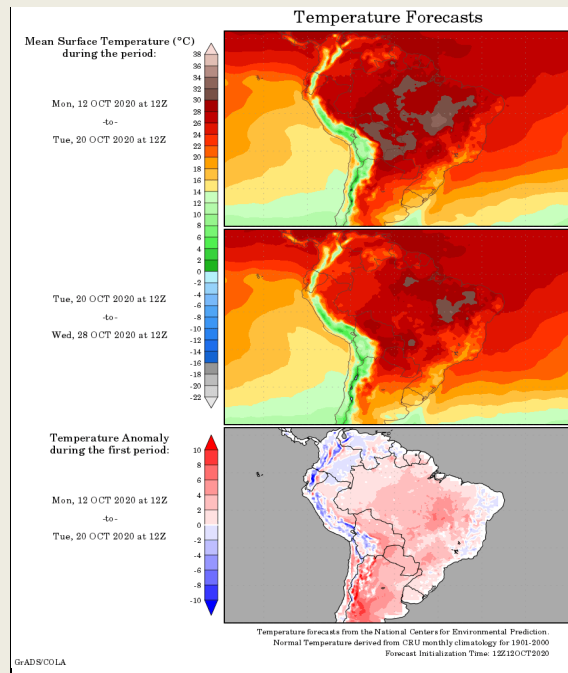
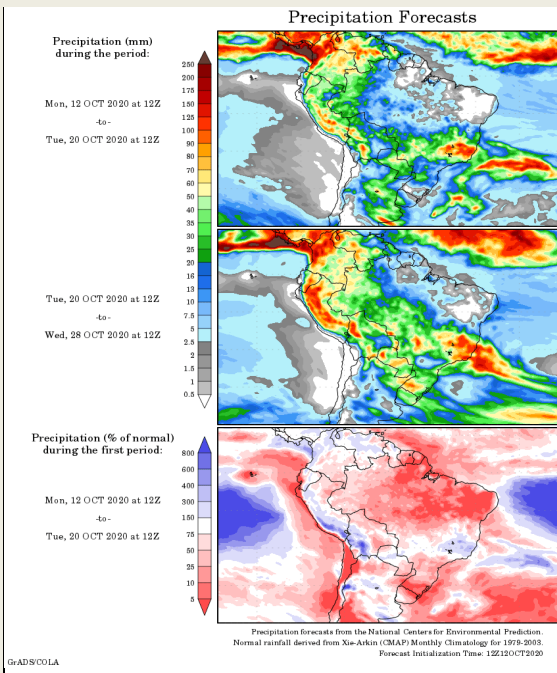
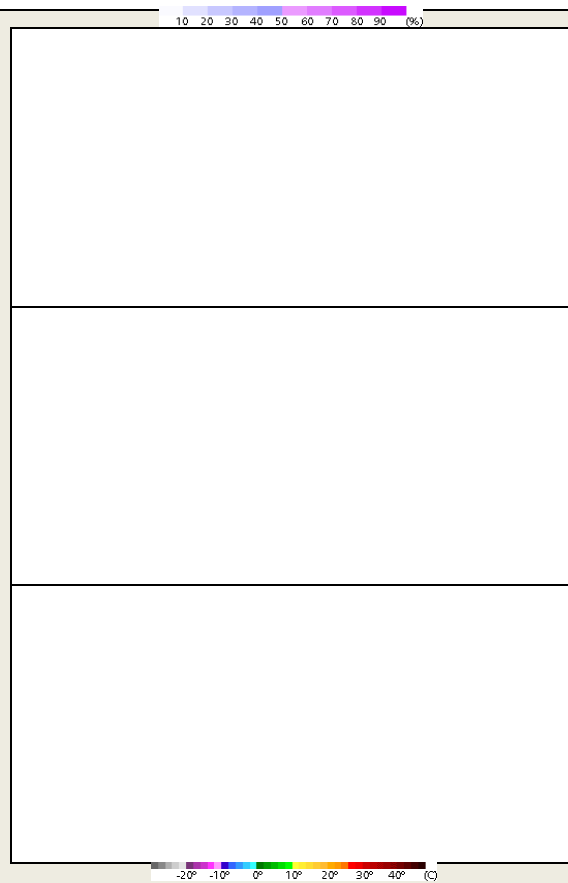
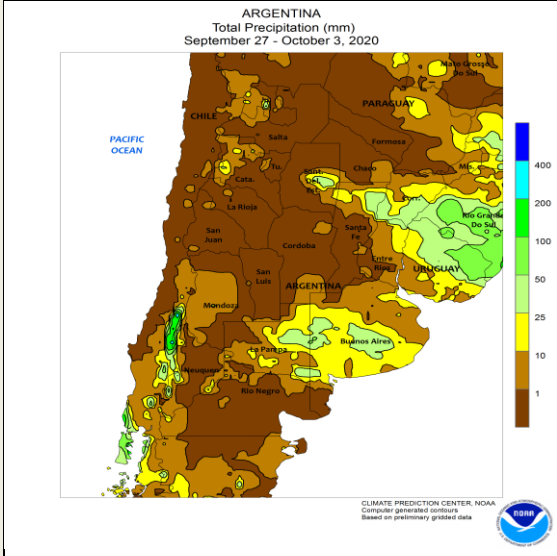


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South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Daily rounds of showers and thunderstorms will continue through the next week across much of Brazil and Paraguay, but a notable exception will occur through this weekend from central and northeastern Mato Grosso to Bahia and northern Minas Gerais where little more than light rain is expected with a few areas dry. Showers and thunderstorms will increase across northern Brazil Oct. 19-26 and enough rain should fall to improve conditions for summer crop planting in areas that miss out on meaningful rain through this weekend while occasional rounds of showers and thunderstorms elsewhere should maintain a good environment for additional planting and crop development.

ARGENTINA: Today's forecast is wetter for northern Argentina Tuesday into Thursday than advertised late last week and the rain should increase soil moisture enough to improve conditions for summer crop planting. Another round of rain will occur Sunday into Wednesday of next week and much of the country will receive at least some welcome rain and will see improvements in conditions for summer crop planting and for winter wheat with rain light enough in some southwestern areas that improvements in soil conditions will be brief.

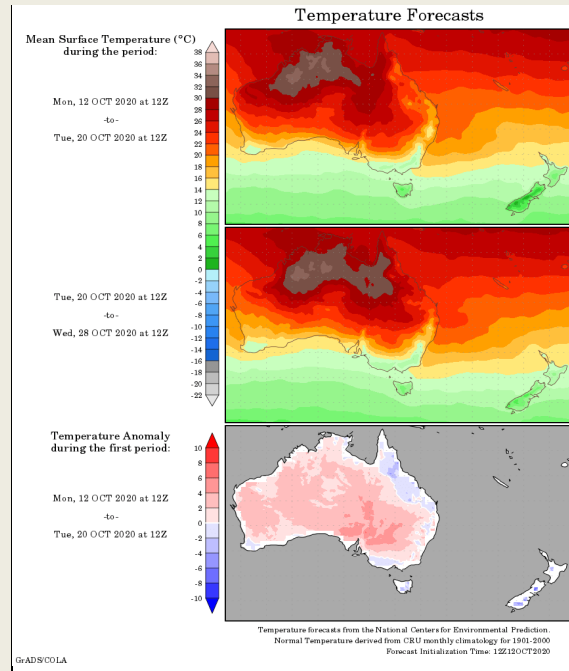
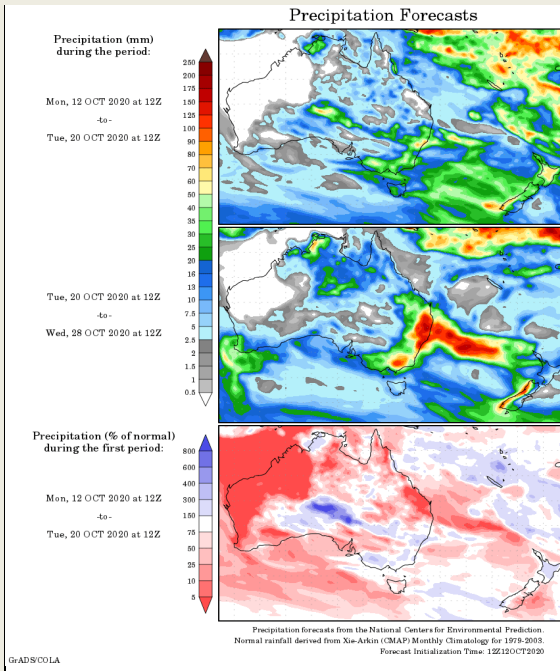
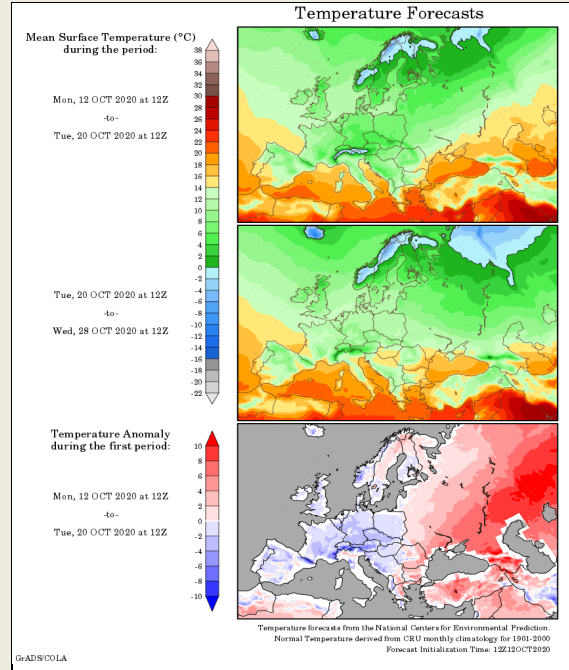
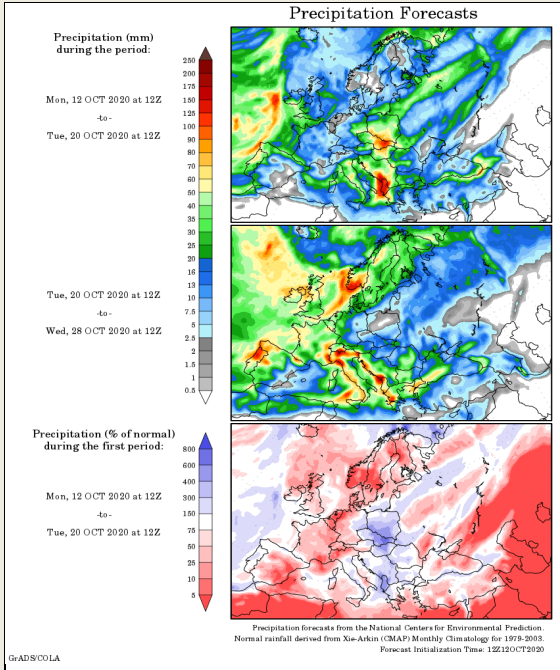


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Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Rounds of rain will continue to impact western and central Europe during the coming week to ten days, although much of the rainfall will not be quite as heavy as this past weekend. Moisture totals will vary from 0.50 to 2.00 inches and locally greater amounts from the U.K., France into northern Italy, western Germany and southern Scandinavia by this time next week. Local totals will vary from 2.00 to 4.00 inches in the North Sea Region of Belgium and the Netherlands and northwestern Germany. Heavy rain and some flooding may return to northeastern Italy, Slovenia and surrounding areas of the northeastern Adriatic Sea region Sunday into early next week. Extreme totals exceeding 4.00 inches may return to the region.

AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation and net drying will prevail over northern New South Wales and southern Queensland for at least the next ten days. Significant rain is still needed for summer crop planting in Queensland. Western Australia is still too dry as well and no significant changes are expected in the next ten days. Increased showers will occur Wednesday into Thursday in southern portions of the state, but greater rain will be needed.



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
