

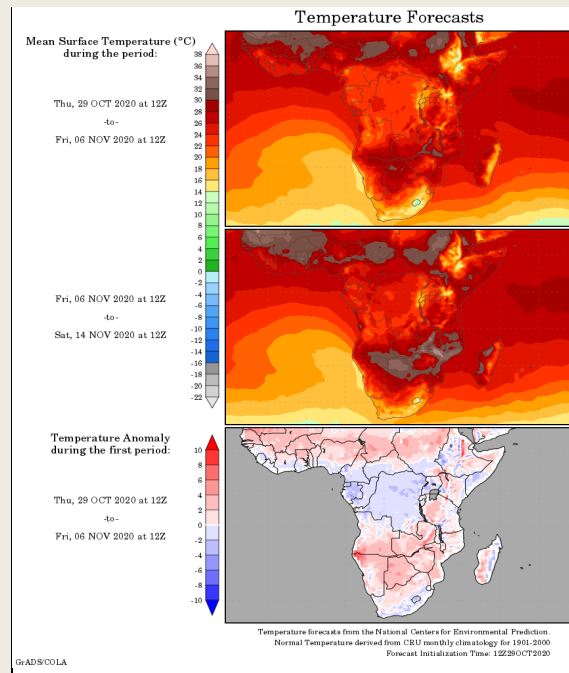
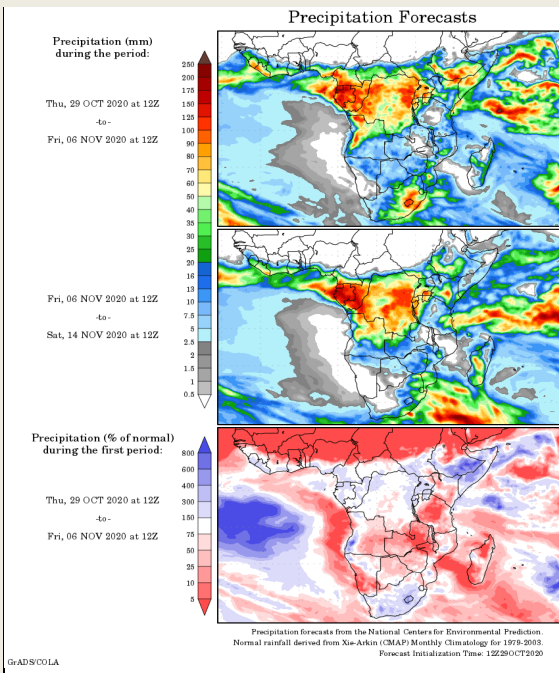
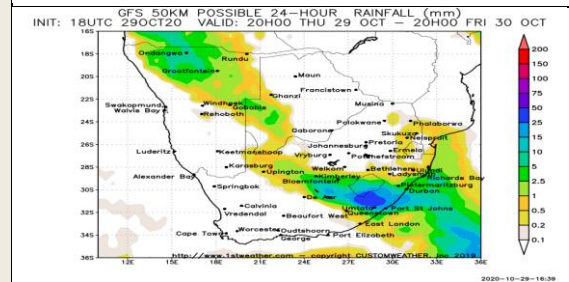
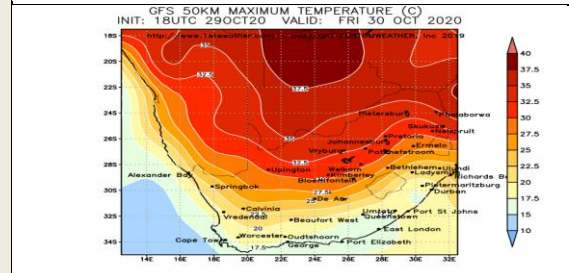
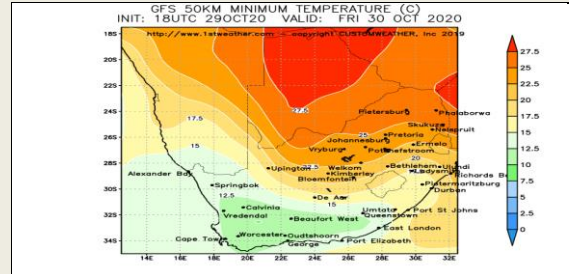
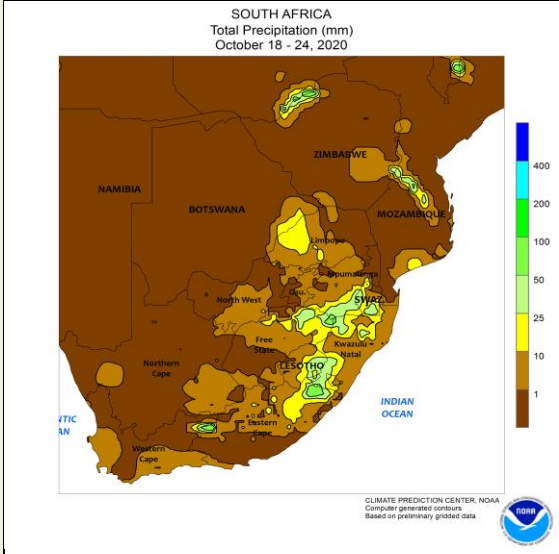


Weather Report

30 October 2020

South Africa - Weather

Western Cape, Northern Cape, and Free State's main winter wheat locations will see a mix of rain and sunshine during the coming week. The precipitation will be beneficial for any crops that are still in the reproductive stages. Maturation and early season harvesting will otherwise be sluggish at times. Minor quality reductions will be a growing concern in the wettest locations of Western Cape. Eastern and central South Africa's main summer crop areas will otherwise see a good mix of rain and sunshine through the middle of next week. Most locations outside portions of Limpopo and North West will receive enough rain to gradually bolster soil moisture. Germination and establishment conditions will gradually improve. However, Free State, North West, Limpopo, Northern Cape and neighboring areas will need additional rain to completely fix the moisture deficits.



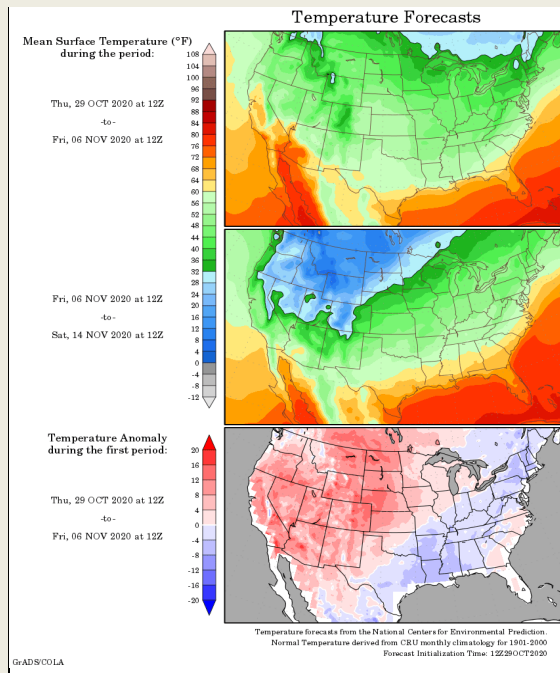
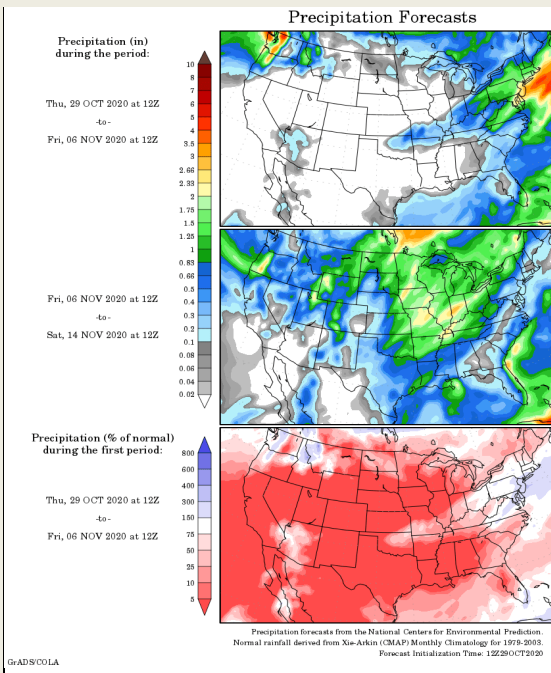
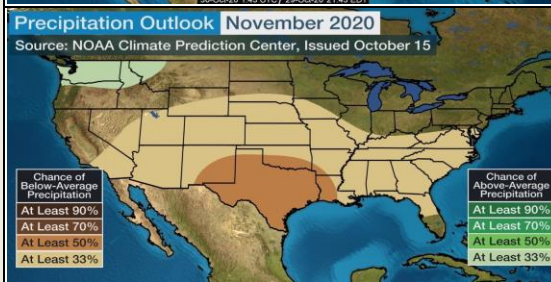
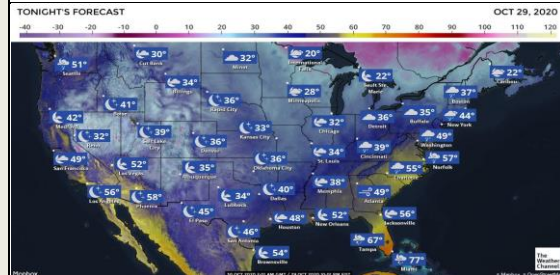
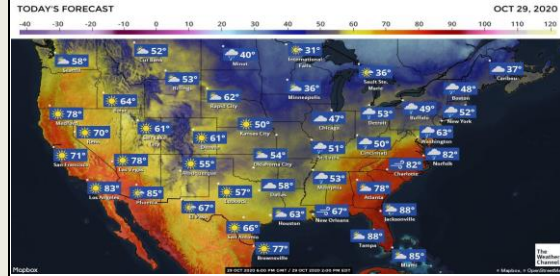

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Rain will come to an end in the lower Midwest today before a period of restricted precipitation and good harvest progress occurs across the Midwest during most of the period from Friday through Nov. 12 with harvesting likely to be completed in most areas. Temperatures will be warm enough during the next few days to melt the remaining snow pack in the northwestern Corn Belt.

U.S. DELTA AND

SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will see a restricted rainfall pattern through the next two weeks, once rain from Tropical Storm Zeta moves out of the southeastern states today, and harvesting should steadily accelerate and soon become aggressive.



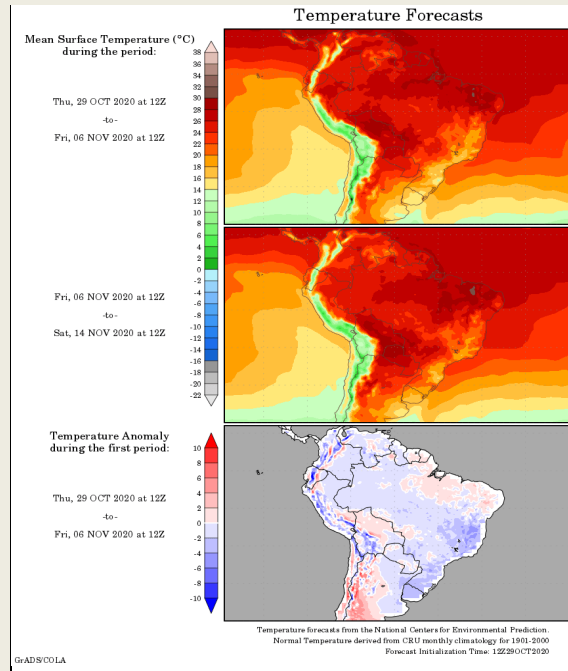
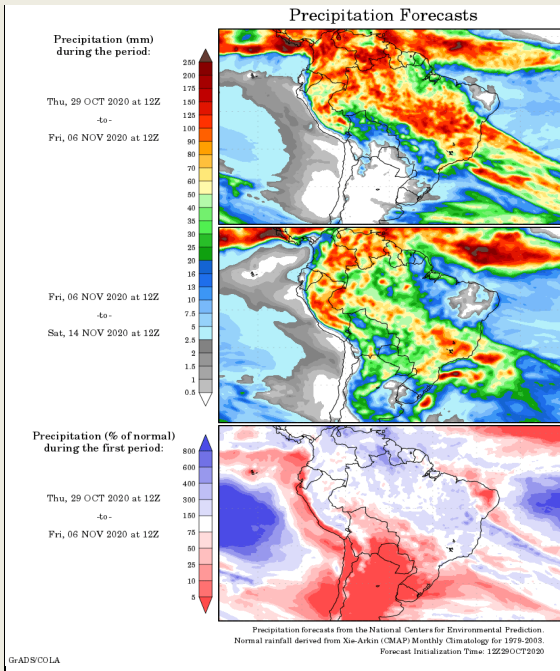
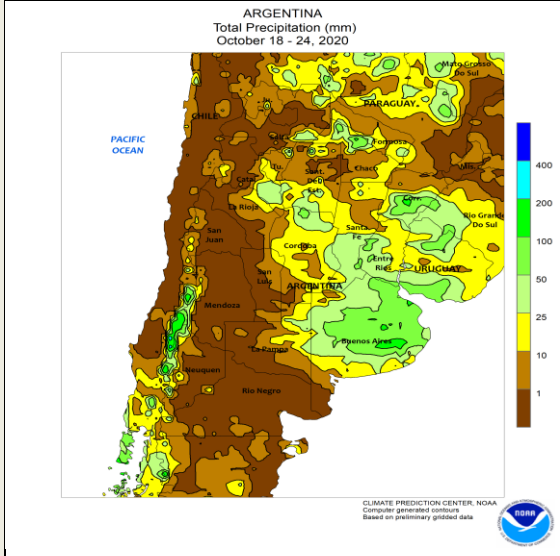

South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Showers and thunderstorms will bring additional rain to Brazil and Paraguay outside of the far south through Friday leaving favorable soil conditions in much of the region before shower activity is confined to northern Brazil most often Saturday through Nov. 12 with an important exception Nov. 5-7 when rain returns to southern Brazil.

ARGENTINA: A restricted rainfall pattern will continue across Argentina through most of the next two weeks and by Nov. 12 most areas will have dried down significantly allowing for good planting progress while many western and northern areas will be left with short soil moisture and could see some crop stress.

o Rain has been reduced for Tuesday through Friday of next week since Wednesday's forecast and although coverage of rain will be high across the country, much of the rain will be light.



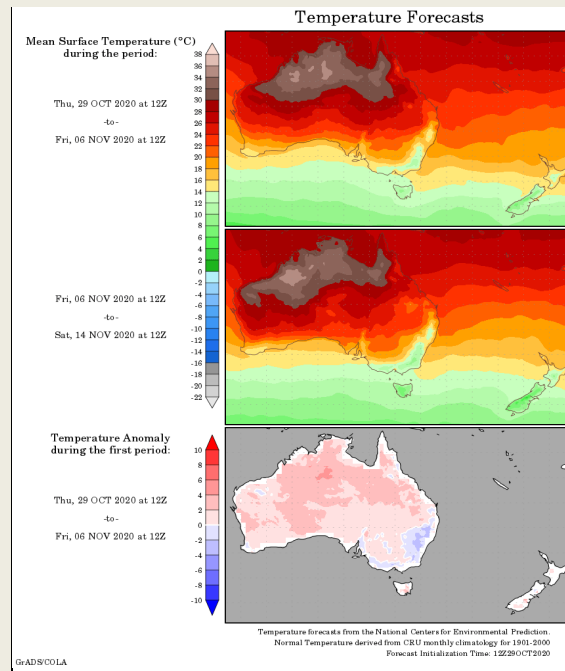
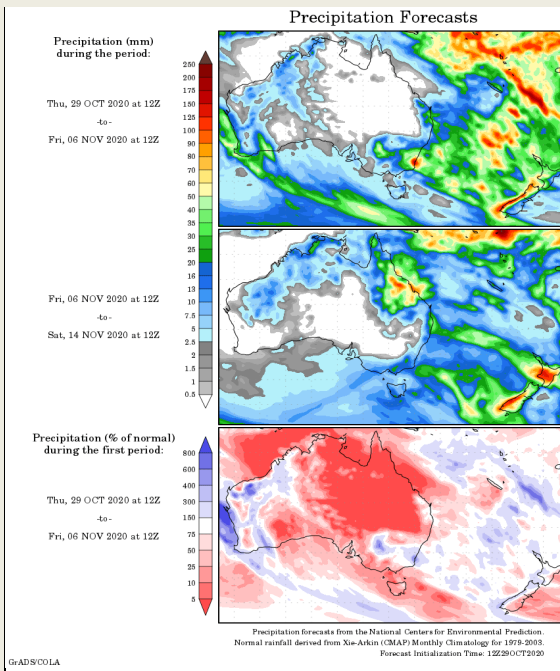
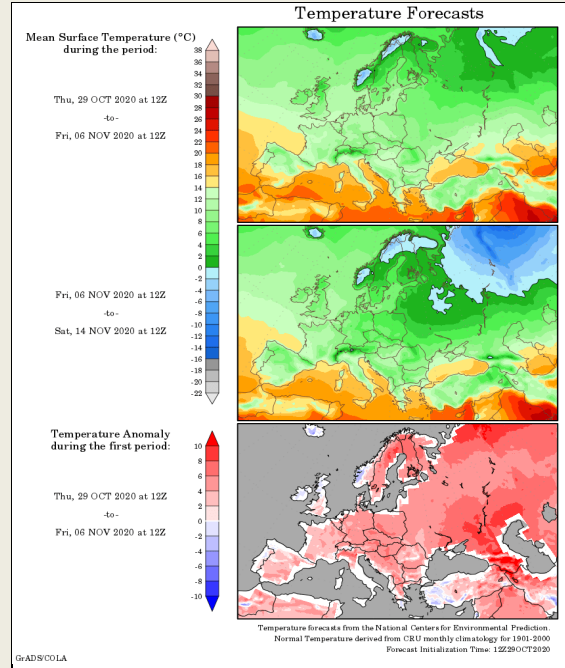
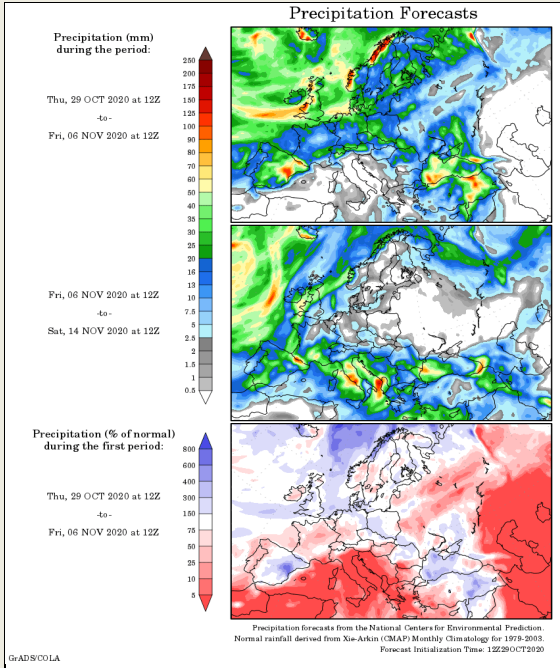

Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Rounds of precipitation will continue to expand over Western Europe the next ten days. Greater rainfall will be confined to southeastern France into Switzerland and surrounding areas as well as a small band from northeastern Germany into northwestern Poland today. Organized and widespread precipitation will return to the U.K., France and northern Spain Saturday into Sunday and shift into Switzerland, southwestern Austria, Italy, Slovenia and the eastern Adriatic Sea Nations early next week.

AUSTRALIA: Rain will continue over southeastern South Australia, Victoria and southern New South Wales today into Saturday. Additional showers will occur in northeastern New South Wales and southeastern Queensland Saturday.

The rainfall will continue to bolster soil moisture for summer crops, but disruption to winter harvest in northern locations will linger into Saturday. The only exception will be interior northern New South Wales and Queensland where some pockets of dryness will prevail.
