# South Africa - Weather

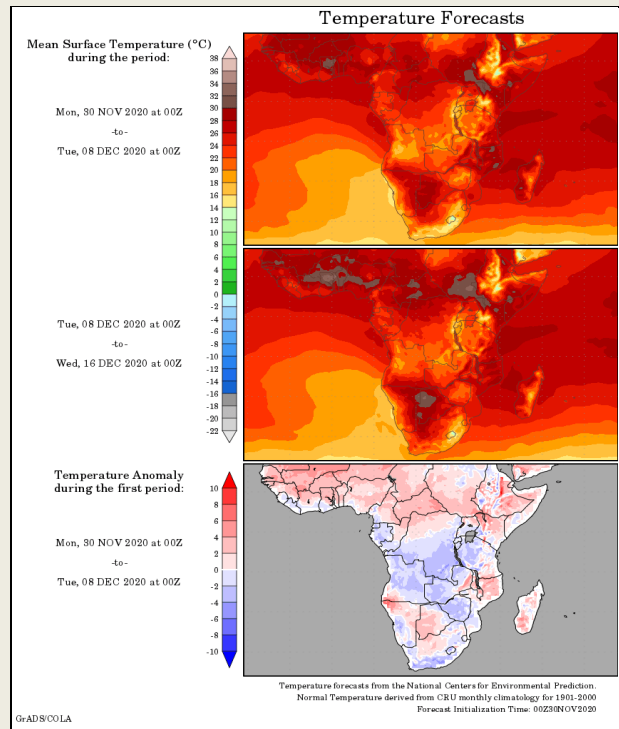
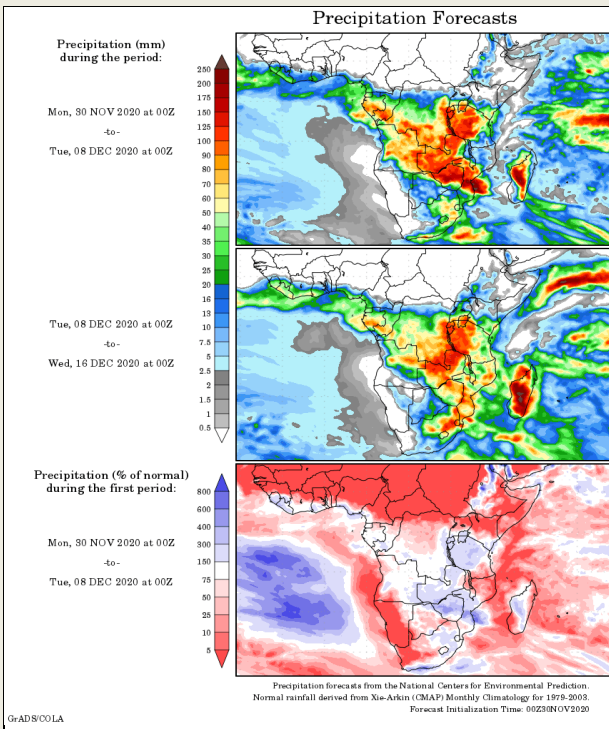
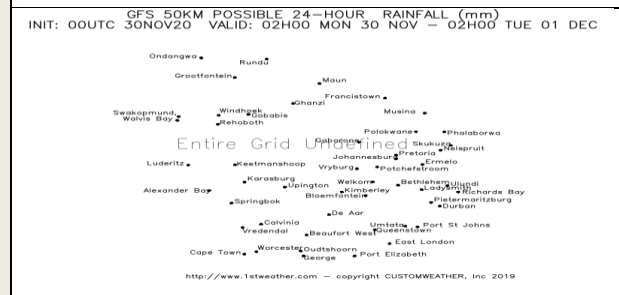
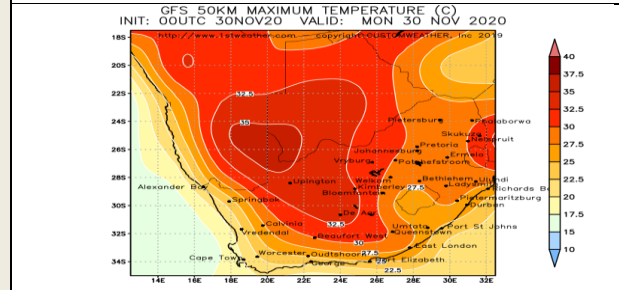
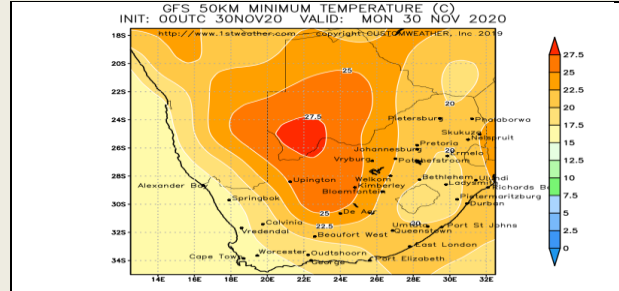
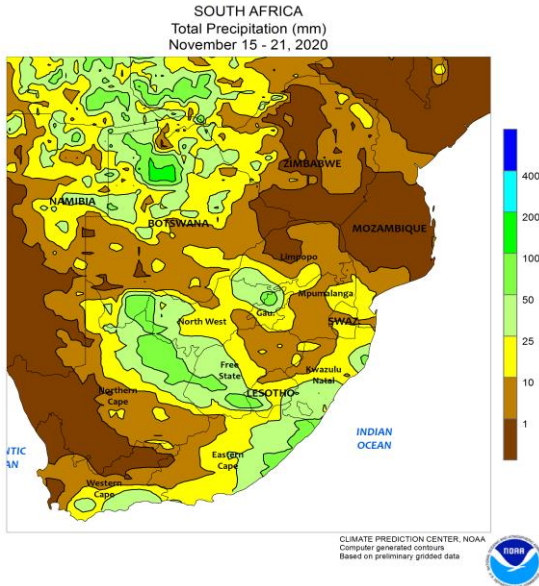
Eastern and central South Africa will see several waves of erratic rainfall through the end of next week. The precipitation will be enough to bolster soil moisture, but will be too light to completely fix the moisture deficits. The environment will still improve for the coarse grains and oilseeds produced this time of year. Planting and general fieldwork will also advance swiftly between rain events. In the meantime, winter wheat harvesting may be slowed at times in Free State, North West, and eastern fringes of Northern Cape.

Little to no rain is slated for much of Western Cape during the coming week. Winter wheat harvesting will advance with few disruptions. Eastern and central South Africa will see a mix of erratic rain and sunshine through the end of next week

o A disturbance will bring scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms to most locations today and Saturday

Light rain will be restricted to Natal, Mpumalanga, and Limpopo

Sunday through Tuesday before more widespread rain evolves toward the middle and latter part of next week

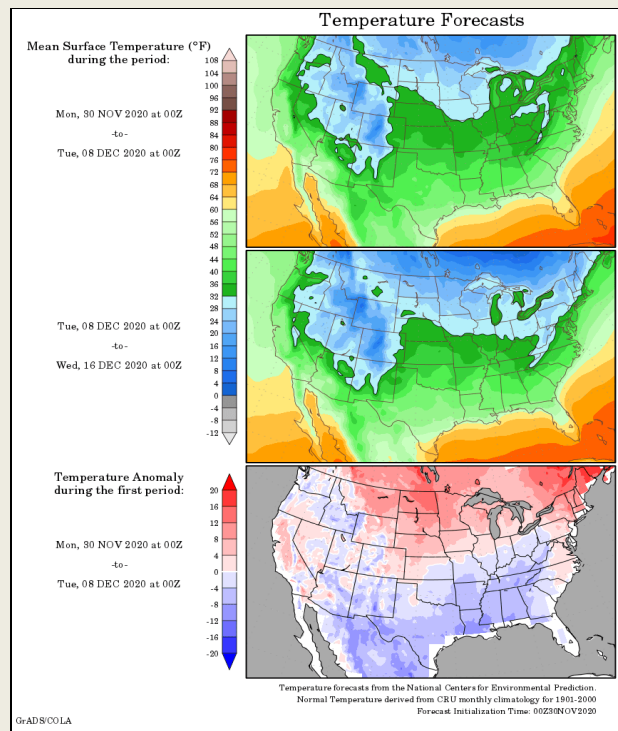
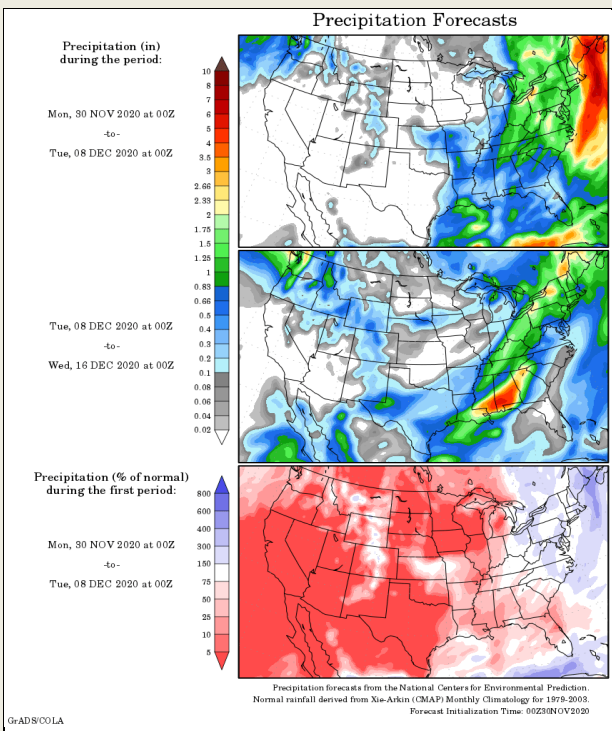
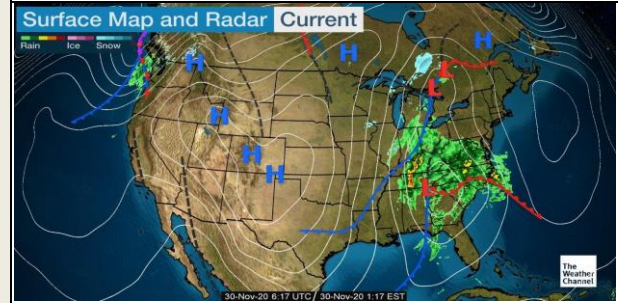
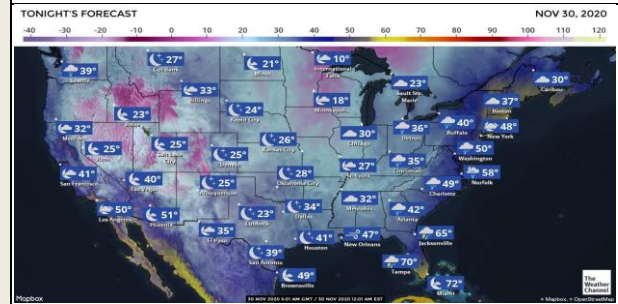
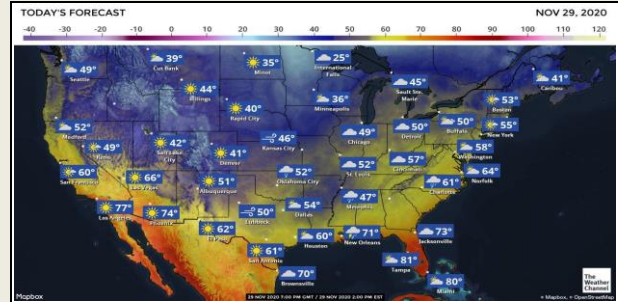
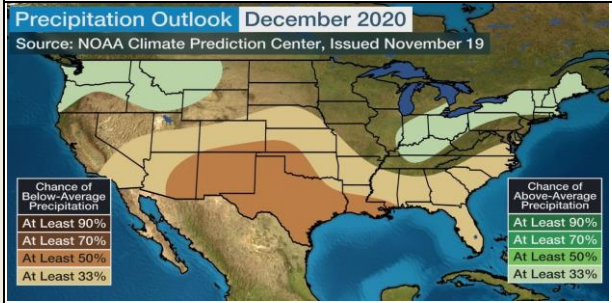


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# United States of America - Weather

**U.S. MIDWEST:** Precipitation continued from parts of the southwestern Corn Belt to most of the eastern Corn Belt and southern Wisconsin Wednesday before Thursday was mostly dry. Temperatures will be cooler and closer to normal during the next two weeks than what has occurred recently while precipitation will be infrequent and late-season fieldwork should advance well.

**U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST:** Rain fell from the southern Delta into most of the Southeast Wednesday into Thursday with the central and northern Delta mostly dry. The Delta and the Southeast will see a wet weather pattern through Dec. 5 and late-season fieldwork will be slowed while some cotton will be at least temporarily discolored with less heavy rain in the forecast for the southern Delta than what was advertised earlier this week. Drier weather will return to the Delta and the Southeast Dec. 6-11 and conditions for late-season fieldwork as well as for unharvested cotton will improve.

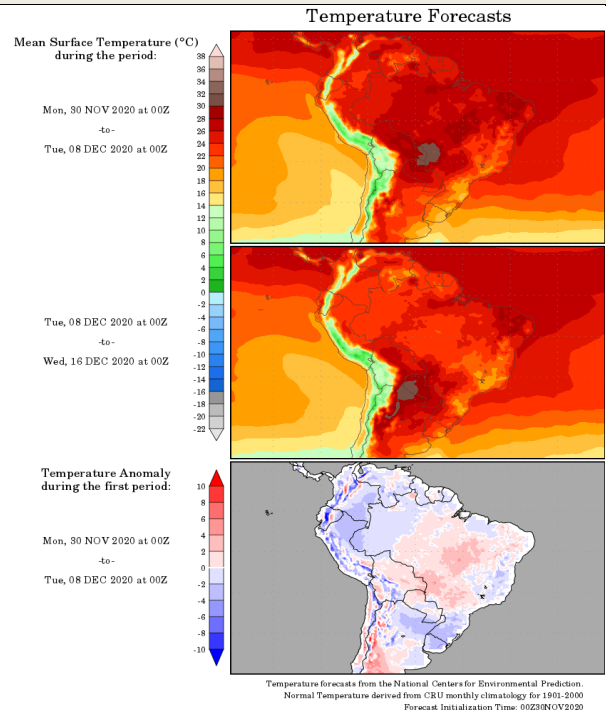
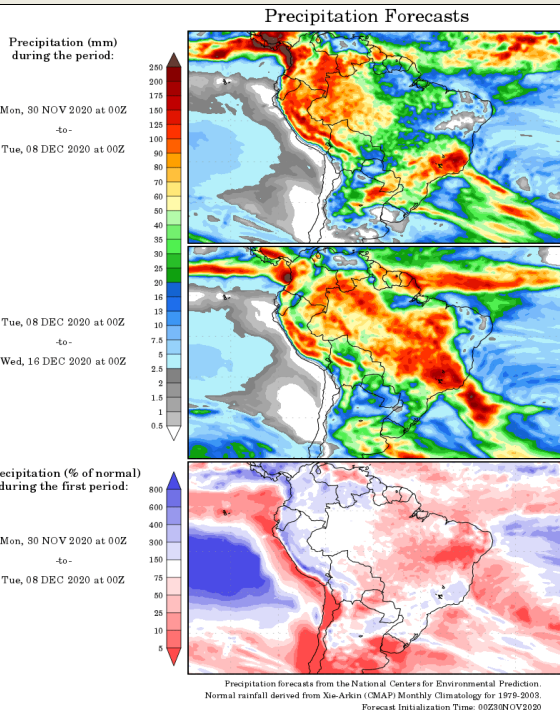
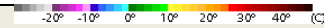
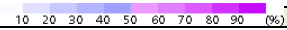
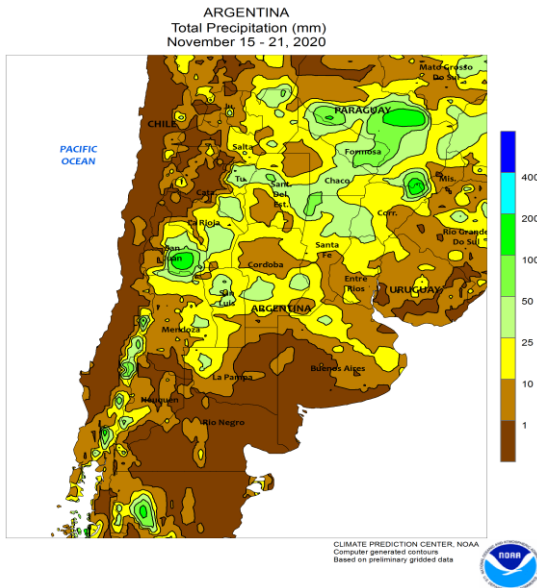


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# South America - Weather

**BRAZIL:** Beneficial rain fell on the driest areas in Rio Grande do Sul Wednesday into Thursday with rain extending into a large part of Paraguay and nearby Mato Grosso do Sul as well as in portions of northern Brazil. Showers and thunderstorms will continue daily in far southern Brazil through Wednesday inducing significant improvements in soil moisture in the drier areas. West-central into southern Rio Grande do Sul will be an exception and will see little additional rain after Wednesday and a boost in rain will be needed near the middle of December to ensure crops have adequate soil moisture.

**ARGENTINA:** Very light rain fell on parts of southern Argentina Wednesday into Thursday while more significant and beneficial rain spread across northern Argentina with most central areas dry. Argentina will see additional rain through Tuesday and most of the country will be left with enough soil moisture to support crops through the next two weeks after drier weather returns Wednesday with some exceptions in the south where rain through Tuesday will be minimal. Isolated to scattered showers will occur most days Wednesday through Dec. 11 with dry conditions most common and good planting progress likely around the showers.

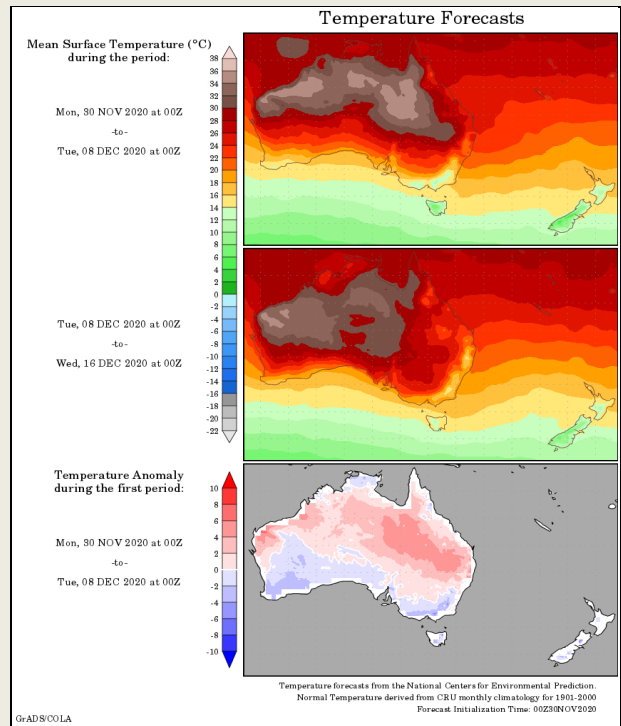
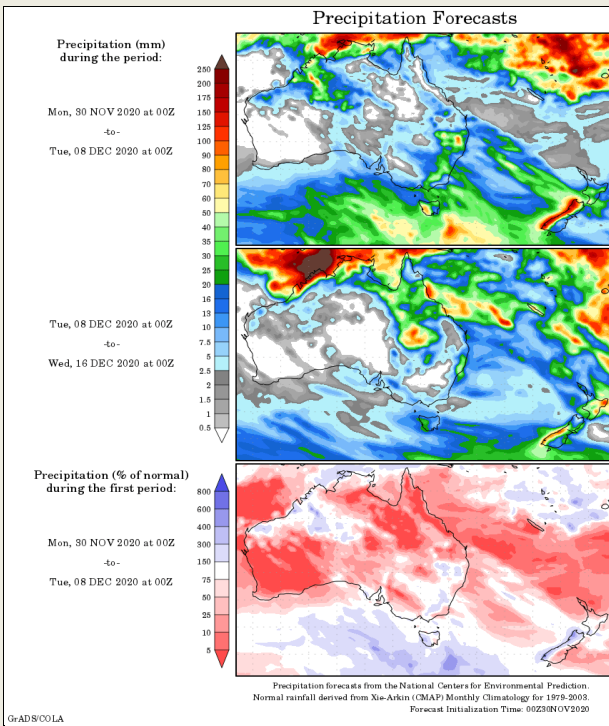
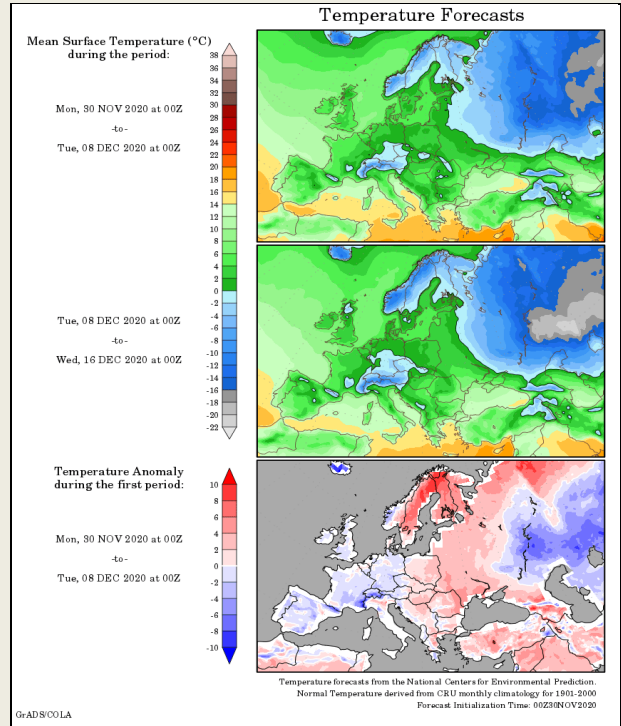
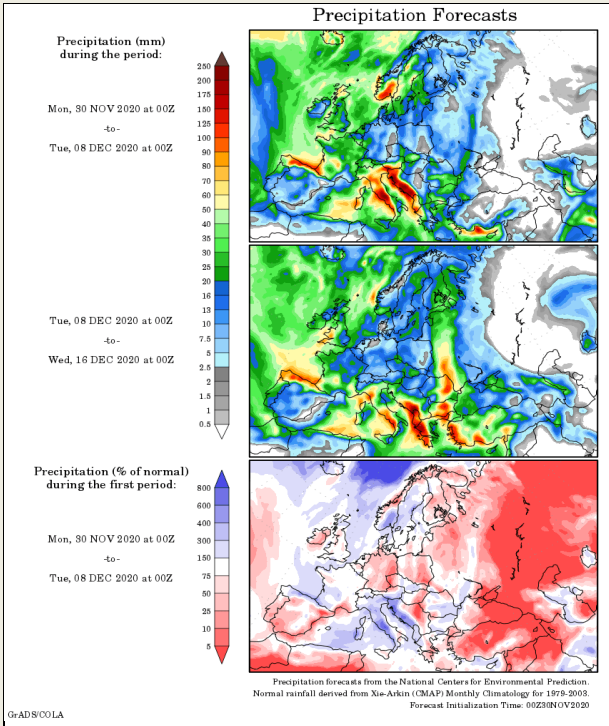


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## Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

**EUROPE:** Scattered showers will occur over western and central Ukraine through Belarus, the Baltic States and into west-central and northwestern Russia through the weekend and into Monday. Restricted precipitation and favorable conditions for fieldwork will occur over northern and central Europe this week while increased precipitation occurs in southern Europe. Precipitation will increase over eastern Europe December 4-7.

**AUSTRALIA:** Hot and dry weather occurred most often Wednesday and Thursday. Very little change will occur during the coming week and restricted precipitation and hot temperatures will be most common throughout Australia. Increased rain is needed for summer crops in northern New South Wales and southern Queensland. Precipitation chances are expected to increase as December progresses in eastern Australia and an increase in shower and thunderstorm will be welcome throughout the region.



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
