




South Africa - Weather


Alternating periods of erratic rainfall and sunshine will continue for much of the main coarse grain and oilseed areas in eastern and central South Africa during the coming week. Natal, Mpumalanga, and eastern sections of Free State and North West will see the most frequent and significant rainfall. Soil moisture will gradually increase for these locations. Establishment and development conditions will either improve or remain favorable. Limpopo and western sections of Free State and North West will otherwise only receive light amounts of rain through the middle of next week. Many areas will not receive enough rain to counter evaporation. Crops may establish and development slowly or unevenly until rain potentials increase.

Winter wheat harvesting may also be sluggish at times in the wettest areas of Free State and North West through the middle of next week. Harvesting in Western Cape and Northern Cape will otherwise advance with few disruptions.

U.S. MIDWEST: A restricted precipitation pattern will continue through the next ten days to two weeks and late-season fieldwork should advance well around the few rounds of organized precipitation expected.


U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast should see late-season fieldwork advance well overall during the next two weeks, although a few rounds of rain will occur and will cause temporary delays to farming activity.


o Today through Thursday will be mostly dry before rain increases in the Delta Friday into Saturday and in the Southeast Saturday into Monday.




Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Rounds of precipitation will continue to increase over western and southern Europe during the coming week. In the meantime, restricted precipitation will occur over Poland, the Czech Republic and northeastern Germany. Moisture will be greatest in southern Europe through the middle of the week, but will increase over west-central and northwestern Europe Friday into Monday. AUSTRALIA: Rain and clouds will increase over east-central Australia and some relief to crop stress will tend cooler than the recent extreme heat over east-central Australia and some relief to crop stress will goccur. In the meantime, the rain showers and thunderstorms will also bring some relief, but a greater soaking of rain will still be needed to "significantly" restore soil moisture and reduce crop stress.
