

U.S. MDWEST: A restricted precipitation pattern will continue through the next two weeks and lateseason fieldwork should advance well. Totally dry conditions are not expected and a few rounds of mostly light precipitation will occur.


U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Some temporary setbacks to fieldwork will occur in the Delta and the Southeast as rain spreads across the region tonight into Saturday morning before a stretch of mostly dry weather allows fieldwork to increase and cotton to be bleached white Saturday afternoon through Dec.1.1.


o Most of the Delta and the Southeast will be dry today before rain increases tonight through

Saturday morning. @ Precipitation will be nearly widespread and totals of 0.05-0.60" and locally more with a few bands of heavier rain scattered across the region



South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Far southern Brazil will see showers and thunderstorms through Friday with additional rain near the middle of next week while showers and thunderstorms will move out of southern Brazil and into northern Brazil Saturday.

o Once rain shifts in to northern Brazil this weekend, nearly all of Brazil will see a good mix of rain and sunshine through the middle of the month and enough rain should fall to favorably support crop development with some exceptions in parts of the northeast where little rain is expected. ARGENTINA: Additional rain and improvements in soil moisture will occur through Friday in most of west-central through northern Argentina while east-central and southern Argentina greaters. Addrew eather pattern will improve conditions for fieldwork Staurday through Dec. 15 and stress to crops may rise in portions of southern Argentina that missed out on significant rain during the pasts weekend while most other areas should have enough soil moisture to favorably support the needs of crops.

Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: A small band of precipitation will linger through central Ukraine into west-central Russia today and snow totals will vary up to 6 inches. Precipitation will increase over France, the U.K., Belgium and the Netherlands into southern Norway and central Sweden as well as Italy and the eastern Adriatic Sea Region and Greece through Bulgaria and southeastern Romania this week, especially Thursday into the coming weekend. Rounds of precipitation will continue to impact northwestern and west-central into southeastern Europe during the second week of the outlook, December 7-13. AUSTRALIA: Very little change will occur during the coming week and restricted precipitation and very warm hot temperatures will be most common throughout Australia. Increased rain is needed for summer crops in northern New South Wales and southern Queensland. Precipitation chances are expected to increase as December progresses in eastern Australia and an increase in shower and thunderstorm activity is expected over Queensland during the second week of the outlook and the moisture will be welcome.
