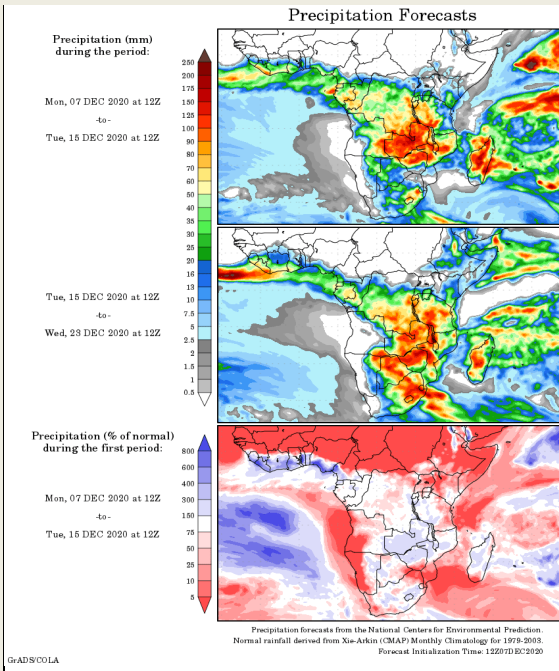
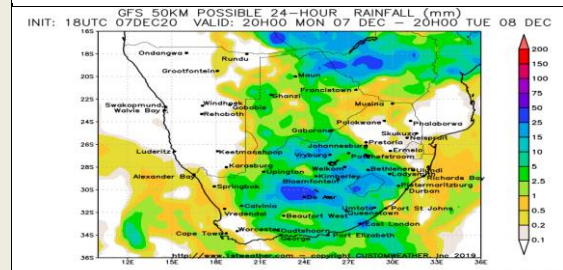
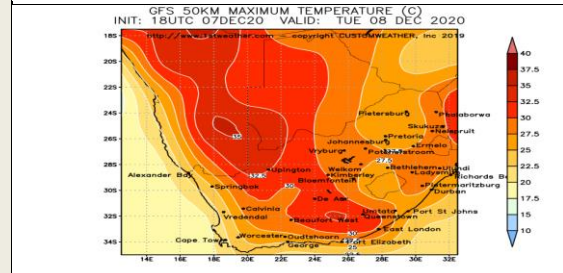
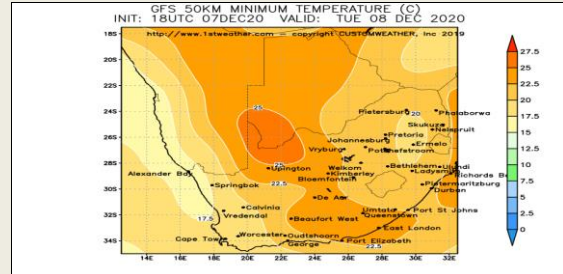
South Africa - Weather

No relief to dryness occurred during the weekend in Central or western Free State, eastern Northern Cape or northwestern portions of Eastern Cape. Significant moisture is needed in these areas to improve summer crop planting, emergence and establishment conditions. This week's rainfall through Wednesday should bring a little relief to a part of that region, but more rain will be needed and drier biased conditions will occur from late this week through much of next week bringing back concern over dryness.

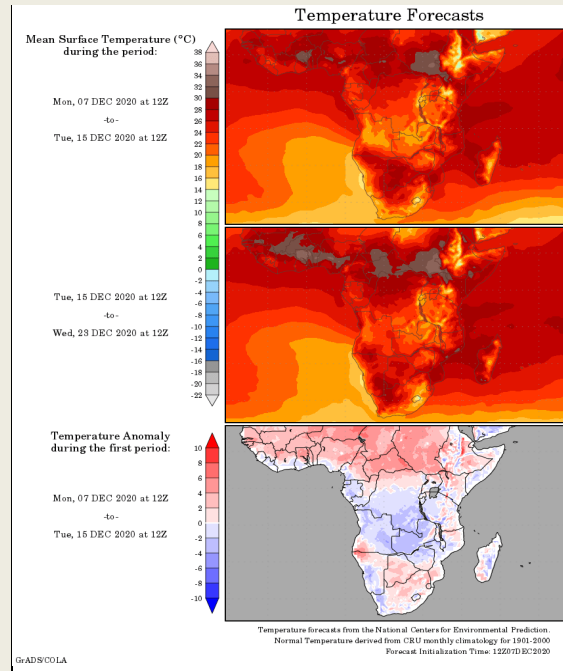
Other areas in South Africa will get sufficient rain to support most summer crop needs. Harvest delays in winter wheat areas are expected to be brief.

U.S. MIDWEST: A restricted precipitation pattern will continue through the next ten days to two weeks and late-season fieldwork should advance well around the few rounds of organized precipitation expected.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast should see late-season fieldwork advance well overall during the next two weeks, although a few rounds of rain will occur and will cause temporary delays to farming activity.

o Light rain will linger in portions of the Carolinas and southern Virginia today where many areas will see up to 0.15 inch of rain and locally more.

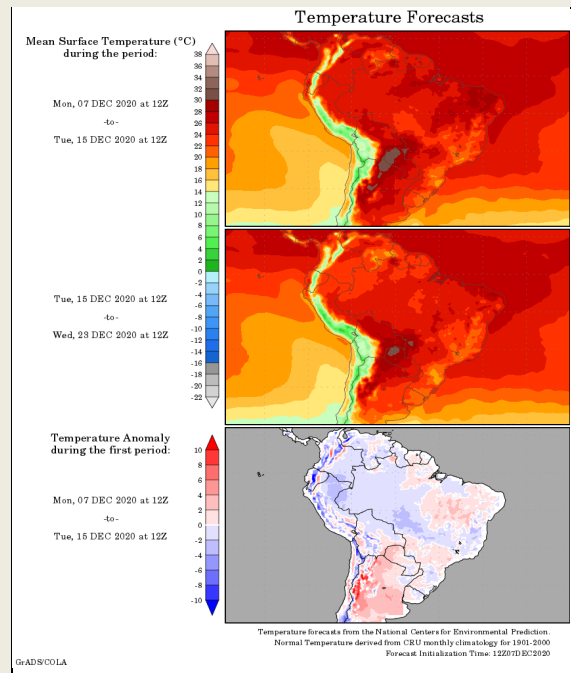
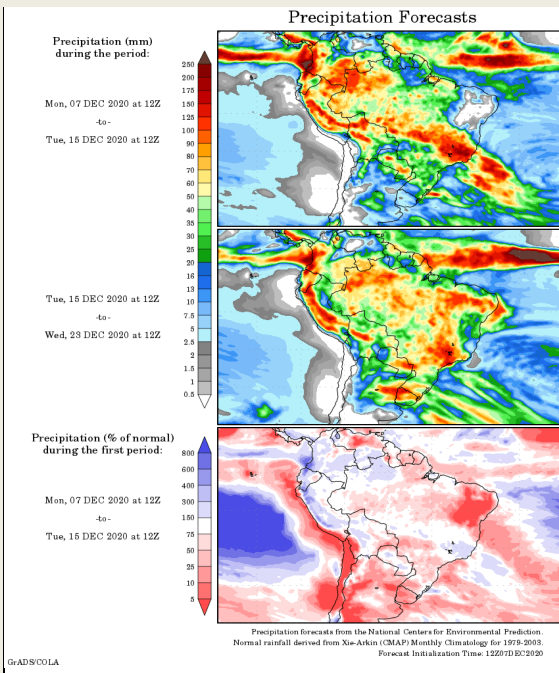
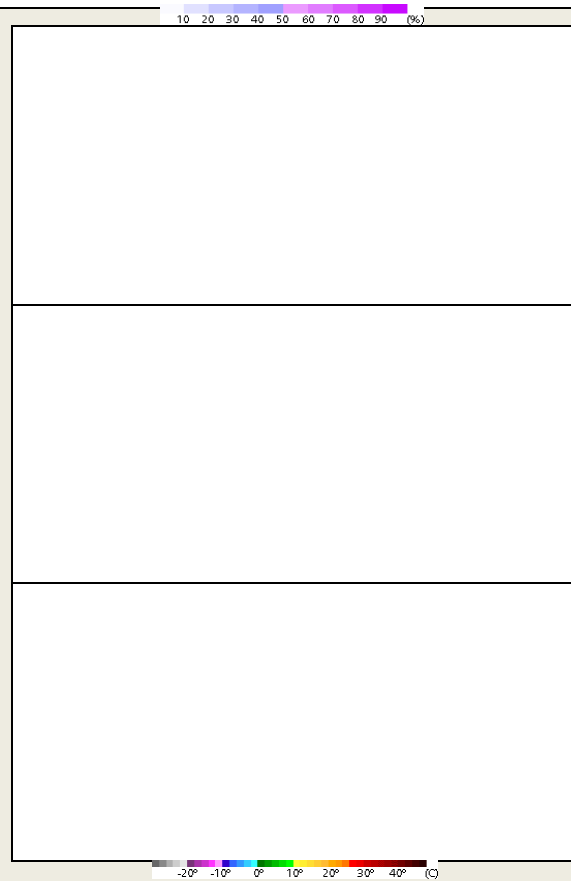
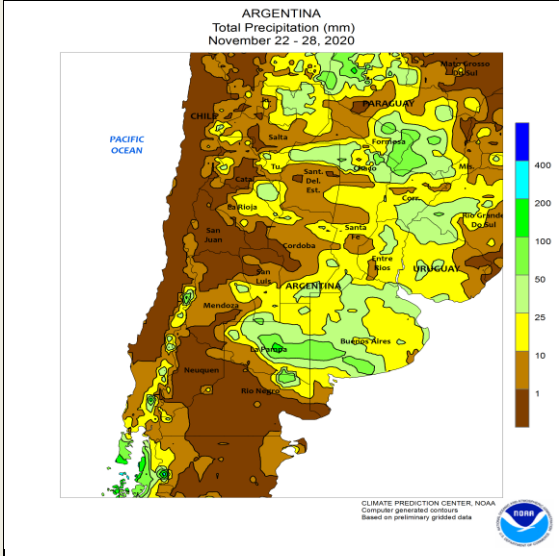

South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Much of Brazil and Paraguay will see a good mix of rain and sunshine through the next two weeks and production potentials should rise in most areas, but dryness earlier this season in parts of Mato Grosso, southern Goias, western Parana, and Paraguay likely stressed crops enough that a full restoration of yield potentials is not possible.

ARGENTINA: Southern and portions of western Argentina will see little rain through the next two weeks and fieldwork should advance well while stress to crops likely increases and may soon become serious if rain does not increase soon. Mostly dry weather will occur through Wednesday before showers and thunderstorms increase in central and most of northern Argentina Thursday into Sunday and again Dec. 14-15 leaving most of those areas with enough soil moisture to favorably support crop development through the next two weeks.

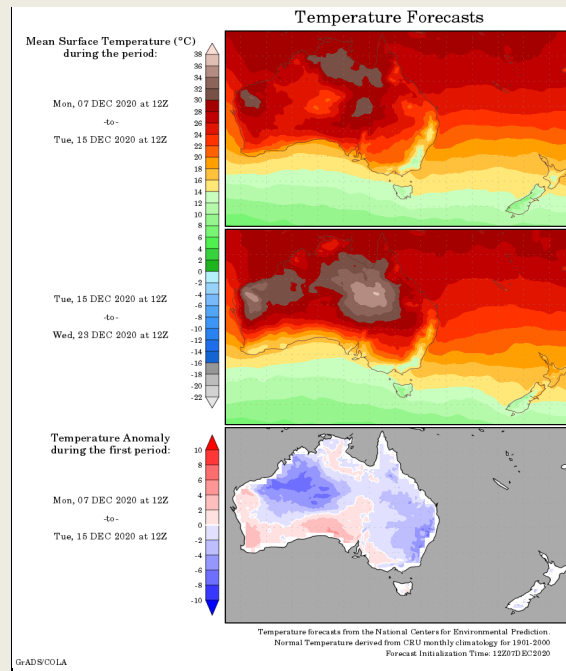
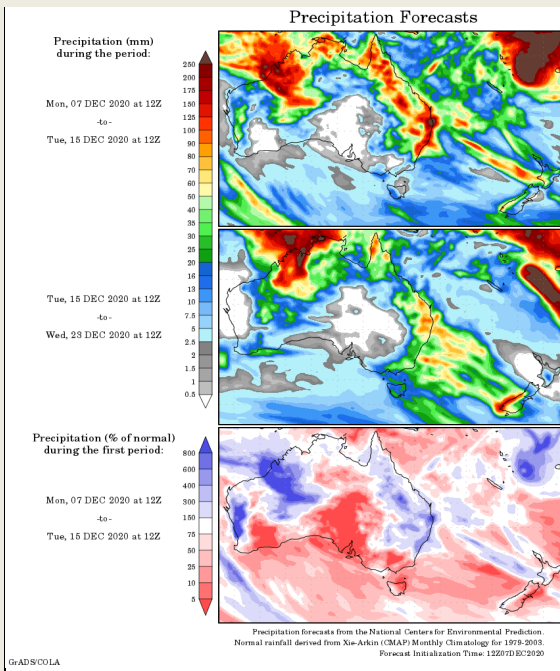
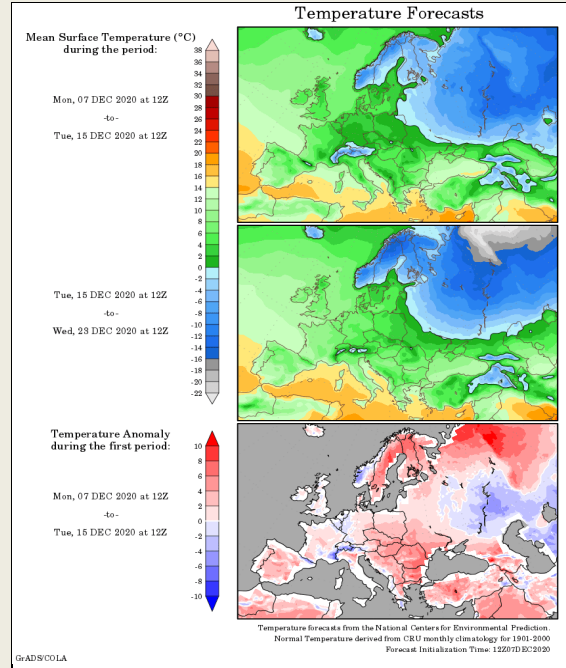
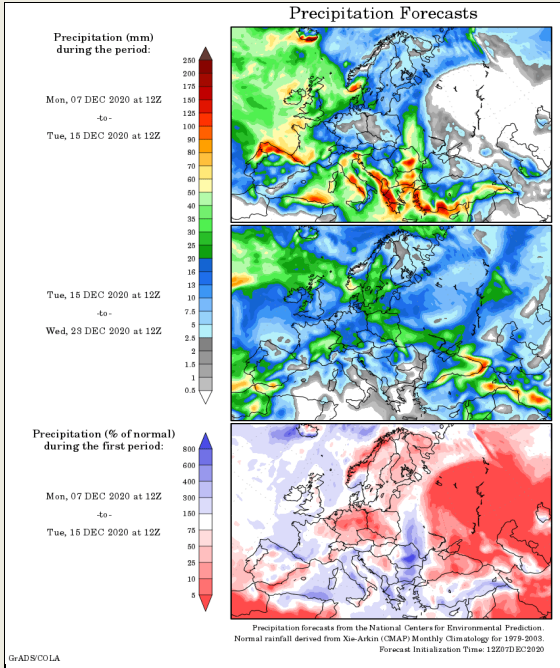

EUROPE: Rounds of precipitation will occur over western and southern portions of the European Continent during the coming week. Enough moisture will occur to continue to support favorable soil moisture conditions. Some improvements will occur in areas of long-term dryness in central Spain as well as parts of Greece, Macedonia into Bulgaria and southern Romania.

AUSTRALIA: Rain will increase over east-central Australia Thursday into next Monday. Rain will be beneficial and help ease crop moisture stress in central to eastern New South Wales and southeastern Queensland.
