

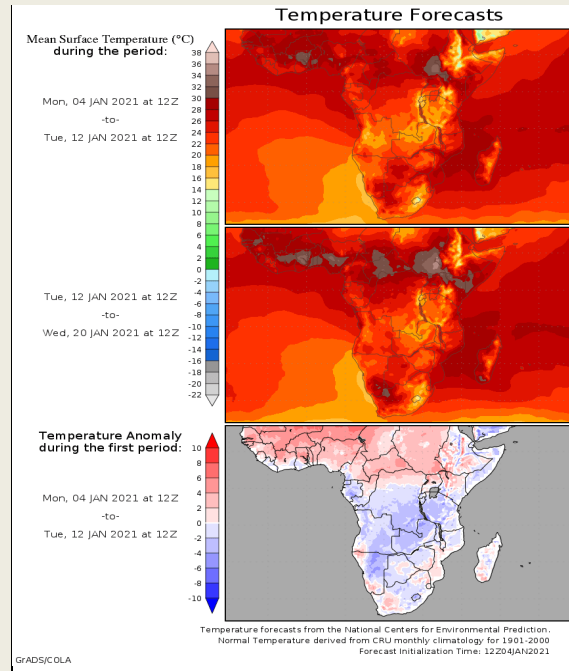
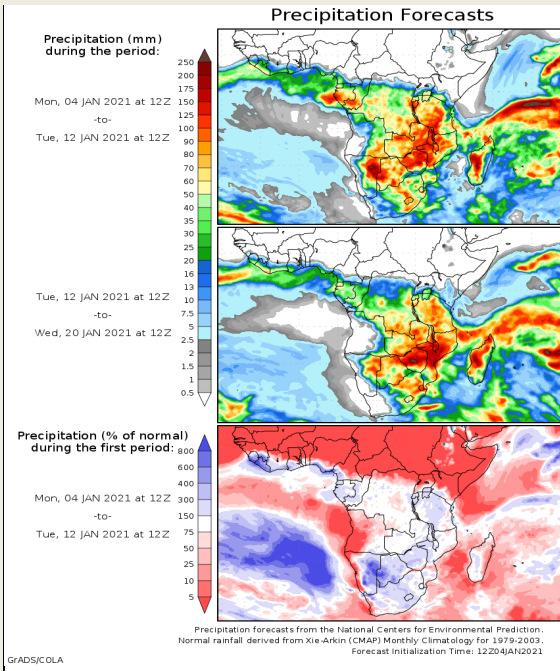
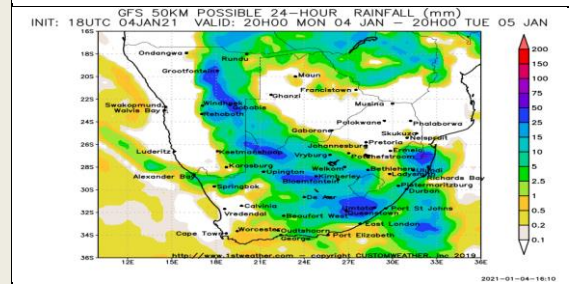
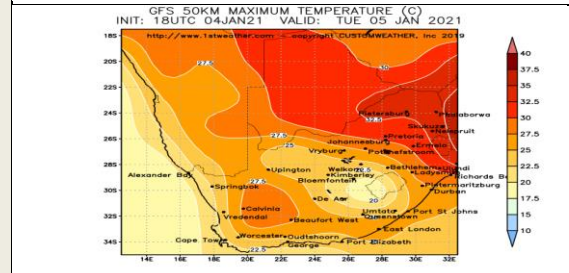
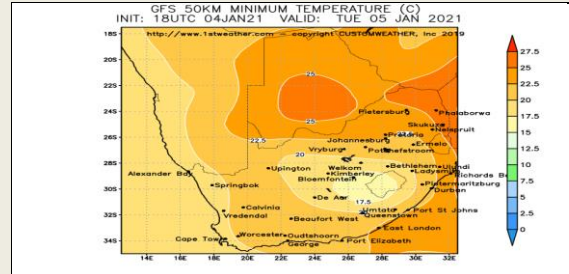
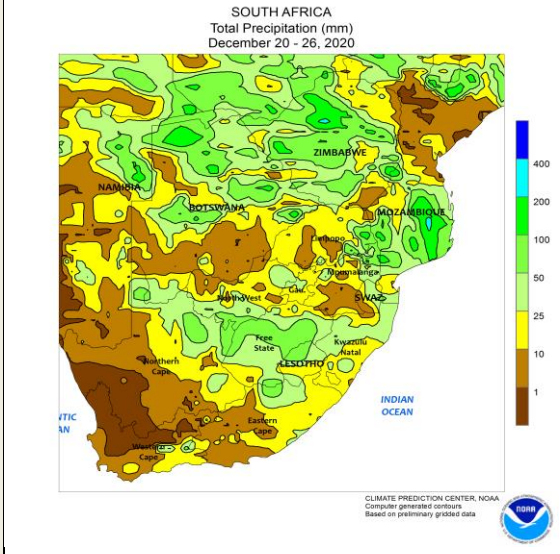


Weather Report

South Africa - Weather

The main coarse grain and oilseed areas in Eastern and central South Africa will continue to see a good mix of rain and sunshine this week. The precipitation will either keep soil moisture rated favorably or bring soil moisture to adequate levels. The environment will remain favorable for aggressive crop development. Fieldwork may otherwise be sluggish during the wettest periods. Late-season winter wheat harvesting will advance swiftly in Western Cape this week. Any harvesting not yet completed in Free State, North West, and Northern Cape will otherwise be slowed during the periods of rain.

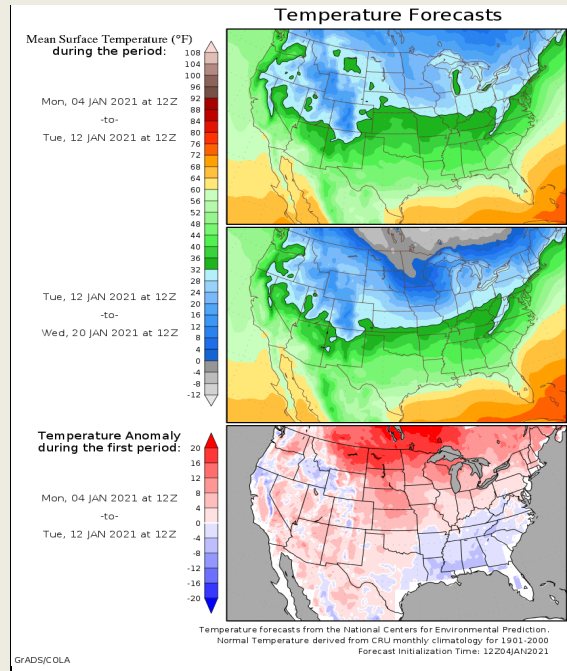
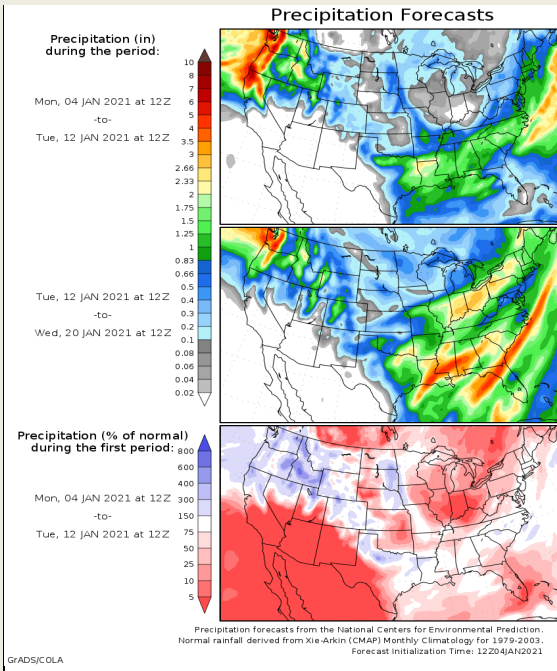
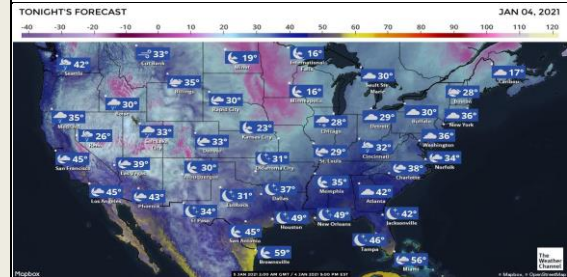
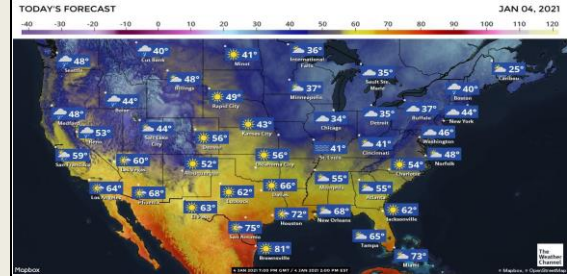
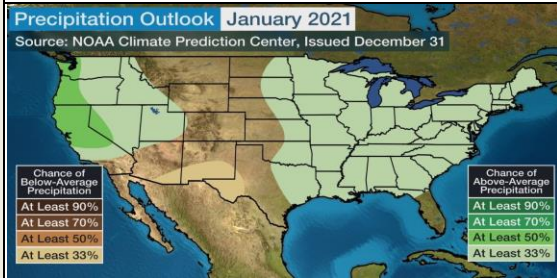
U.S. MIDWEST: A tranquil weather pattern will occur during the next ten days to two weeks with a few rounds of mostly light precipitation on occasion and no significant storm systems expected for at least ten days.

- No major temperature swings will occur during the next week with temperatures gradually cooling starting late this week, but remaining warmer than normal temperatures in most areas and much warmer than normal in the northwest.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will see a few rounds of precipitation during the next ten days to two weeks with dry weather most common overall.

o Today into Wednesday will be mostly dry before precipitation increases Wednesday evening into Friday and is widespread across the Delta and the Southeast.

o Most of the precipitation will be rain and totals will vary from 0.20-1.10" and locally more with a light wintry mix of precipitation types possible in some northern areas.



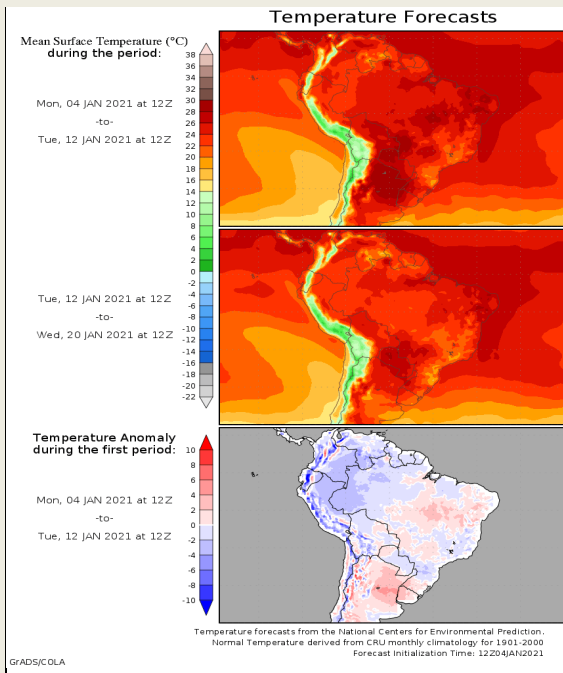
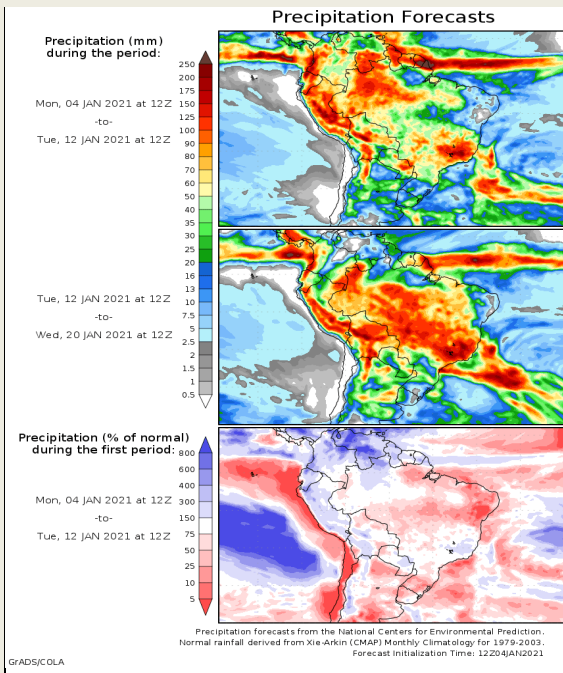
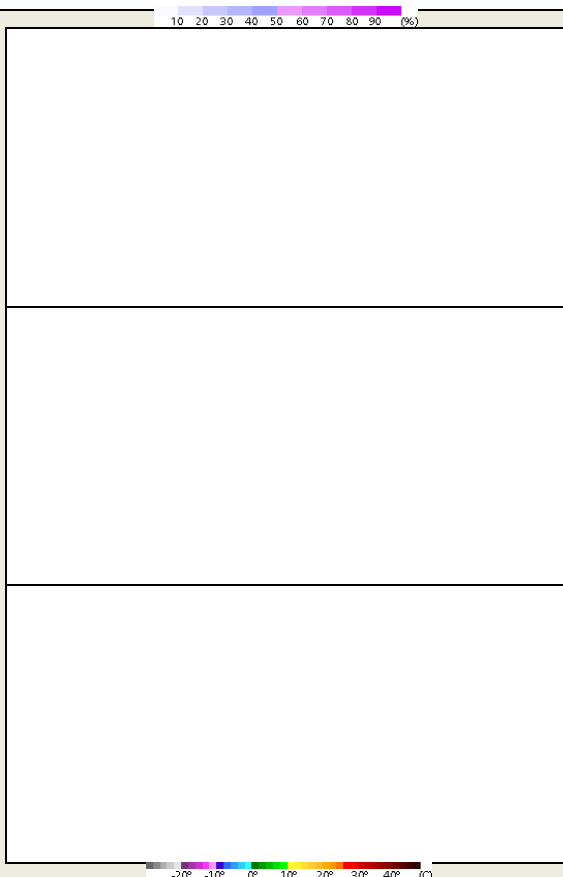
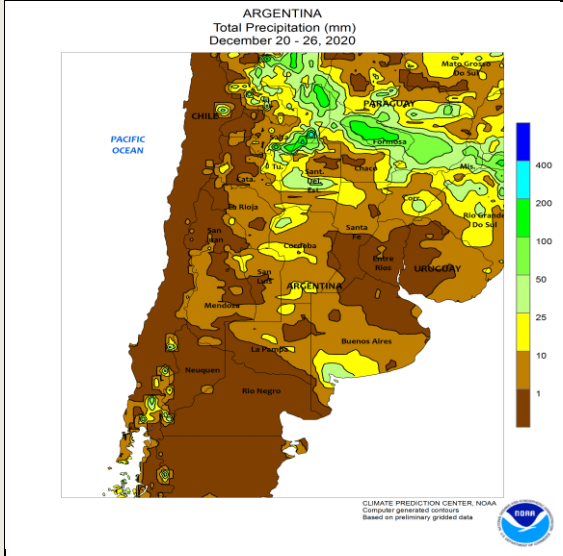

South America - Weather

BRAZIL: A good mix of rain and sunshine and favorable conditions for crop development will occur across much of Brazil and Paraguay during the next two weeks with a beneficial increase in rain beginning this weekend in Bahia and northeastern Minas Gerais. Central into eastern Bahia will continue to see poor conditions for crop development in unirrigated areas until rain increases this weekend.

ARGENTINA: Today's forecast is wetter for Sunday into Jan. 13 than advertised late last week and nearly all of Argentina will receive rain, but many areas will remain dry or will see rain that is too light to prevent rising levels of crop stress before that rain event.

- Rain Sunday into Wednesday of next week will leave nearly all areas with at least temporary improvements in conditions for crops, but in much of the country, the soil will dry enough that the moisture will soon be lost to evaporation without follow-up rain.

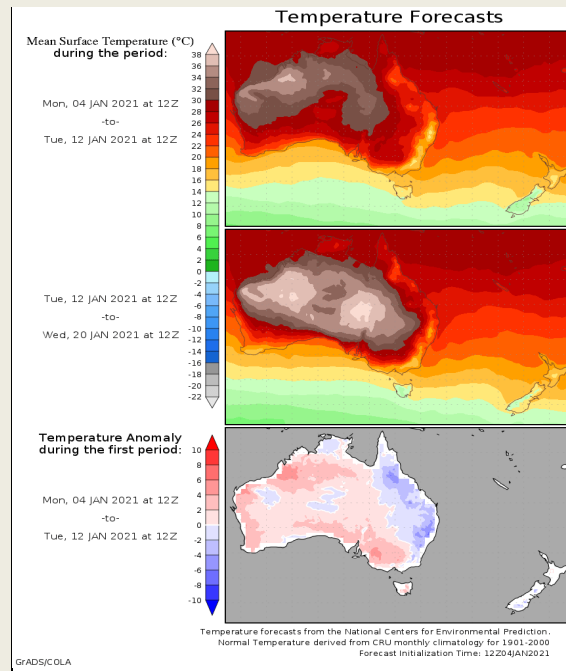
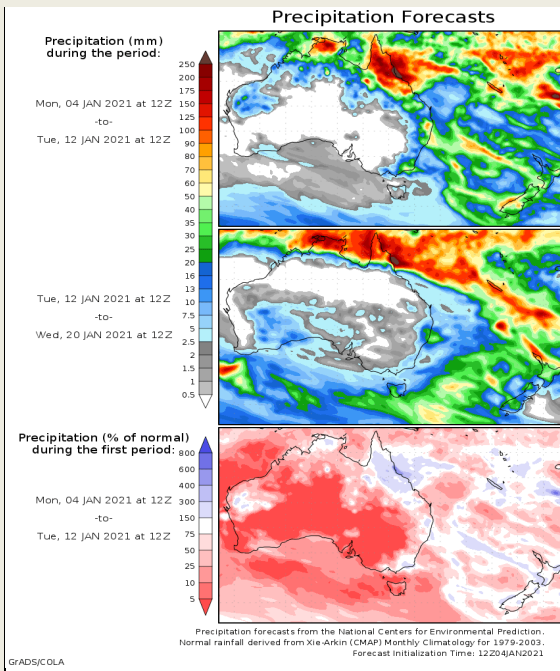
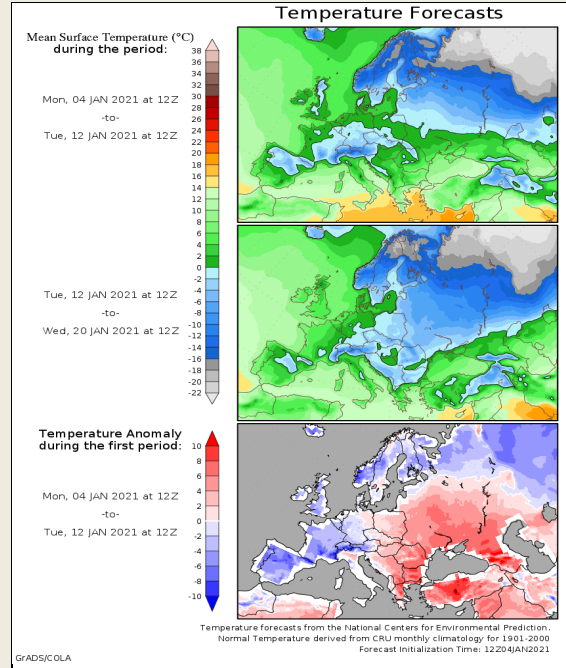
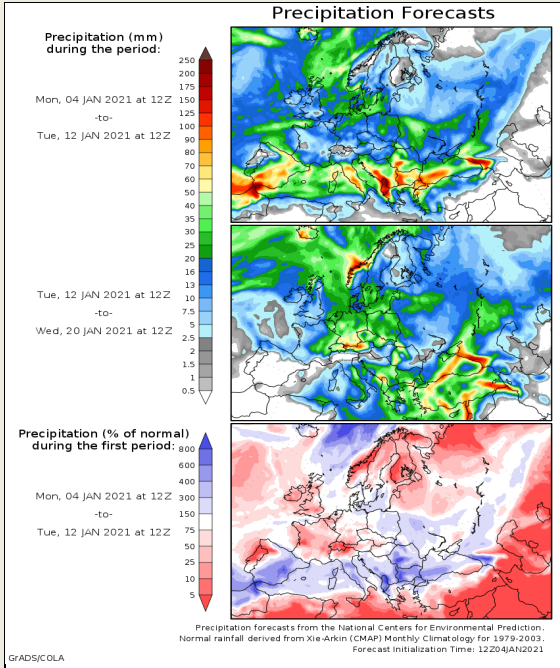
Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Precipitation will be greatest over southern portions of the European Continent this week. Scattered precipitation will occur over south-central to southeastern Europe and Poland early this week and increase over the Iberian Peninsula Wednesday into Friday and return to southeastern Europe this coming weekend.

o Moisture totals by this time next week will range from 1.00 to 3.00 inches in southeastern Spain as well as southeastern France, Italy into the Balkan Nations.

AUSTRALIA: Rain showers and thunderstorms will linger over eastern portions of New South Wales into southeastern Queensland through the middle of the week. A few showers and thunderstorms will linger in southeastern Queensland late this week.

o Moisture totals will vary greatly from western production areas and eastern production areas in east-central Australia.
