



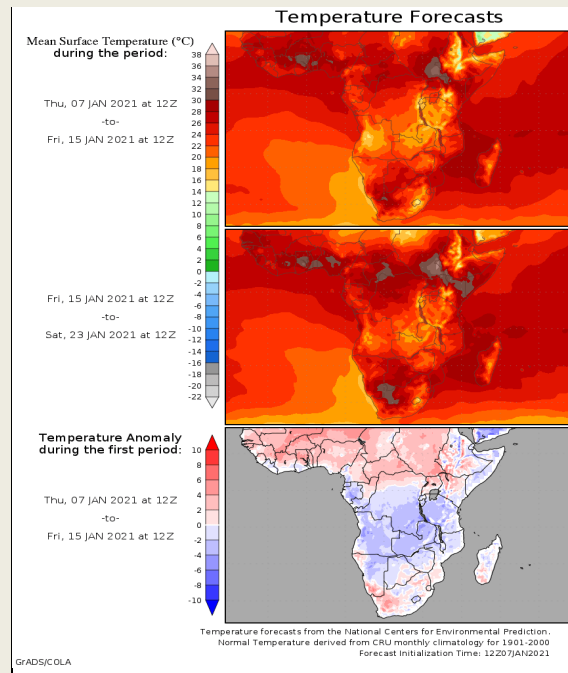
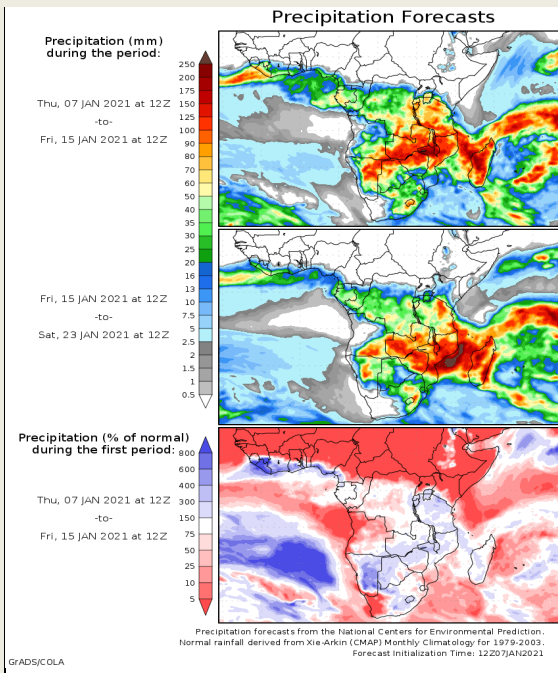
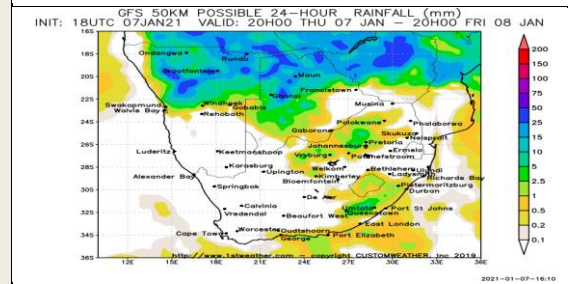
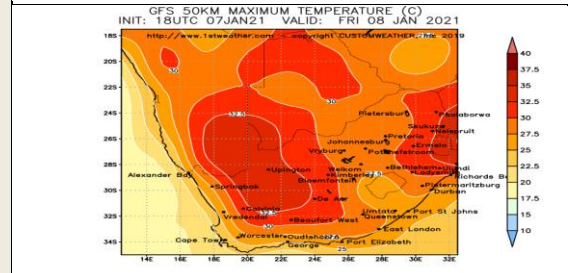
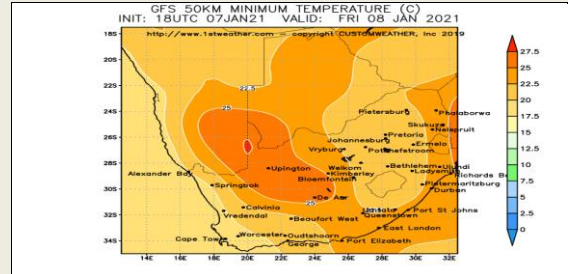
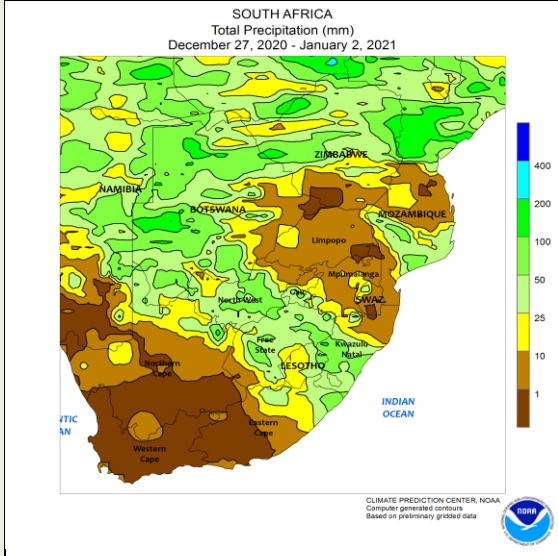
Weather Report

South Africa - Weather

Eastern and central South Africa's main coarse grain and oilseed areas will continue to have several opportunities for rain during the coming week. The precipitation will further bolster soil moisture and maintain generally favorable conditions for aggressive growth. Fieldwork may be sluggish for areas that receive the most rain.

Late-season winter wheat harvesting will advance swiftly in Western Cape during the coming week due to mostly dry weather. Any harvesting not yet complete in Free State, North West, and Northern Cape will otherwise be slowed due to the rain.



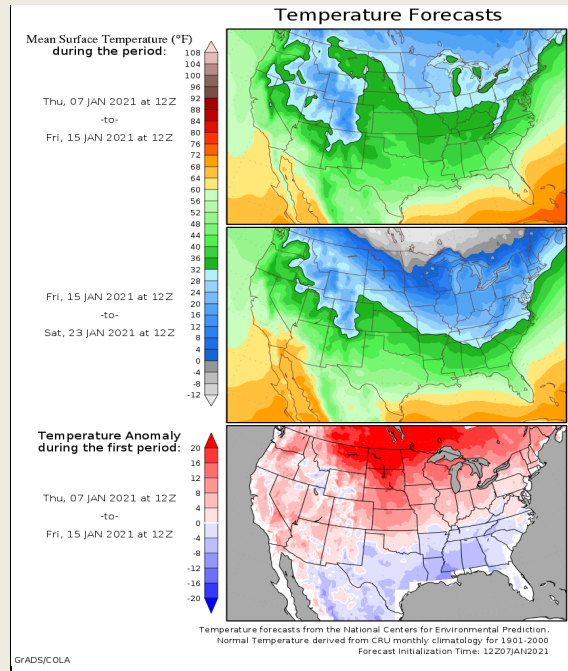
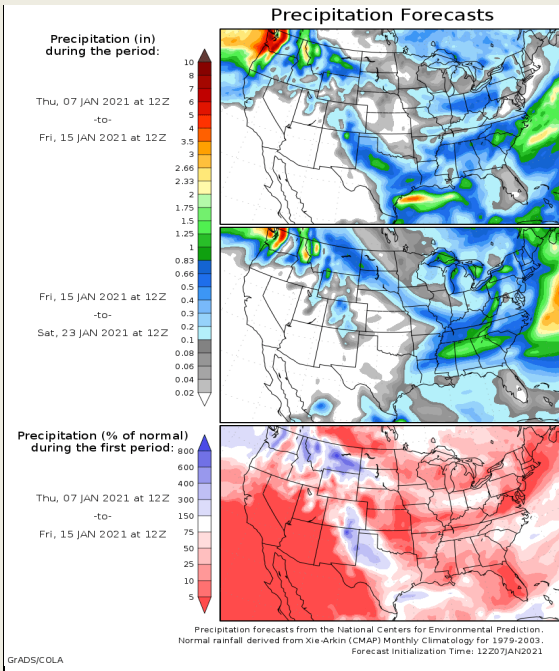
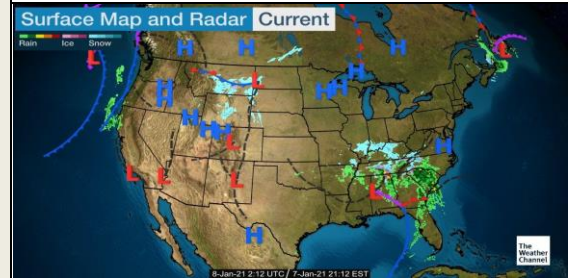
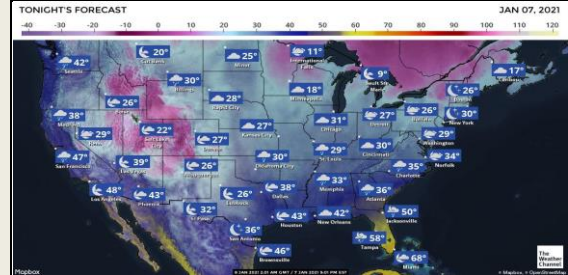
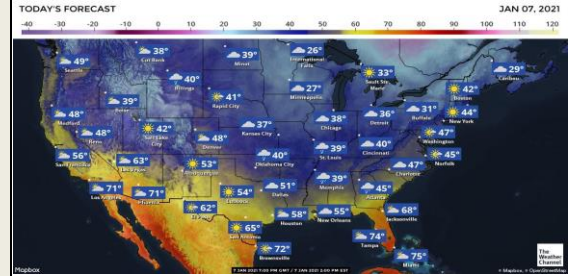
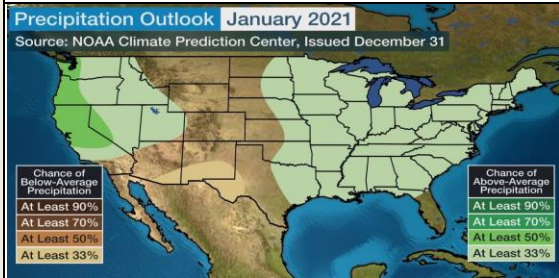

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: A tranquil weather pattern will occur during the next ten days to two weeks with a few rounds of mostly light precipitation on occasion and no significant storm systems expected for at least ten days.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will see a few rounds of precipitation during the next two weeks with dry weather most common overall.

- o Precipitation will expand today into Friday and will fall from much of the Delta into the Southeast.
- o Most of the precipitation will be rain and totals will vary from 0.20-1.0" and locally more with a light wintry mix of precipitation types possible in some northern areas.
- o Most of the southern Delta into southeastern Mississippi will be dry.
- o Precipitation will return to areas from the central and southern Delta through the southeastern states Sunday night into Tuesday with moisture totals of 0.20-0.85" and locally more.

South America - Weather

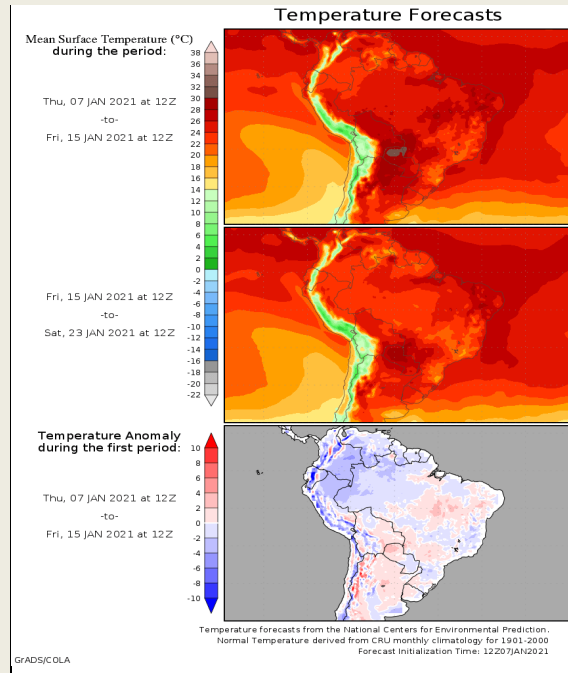
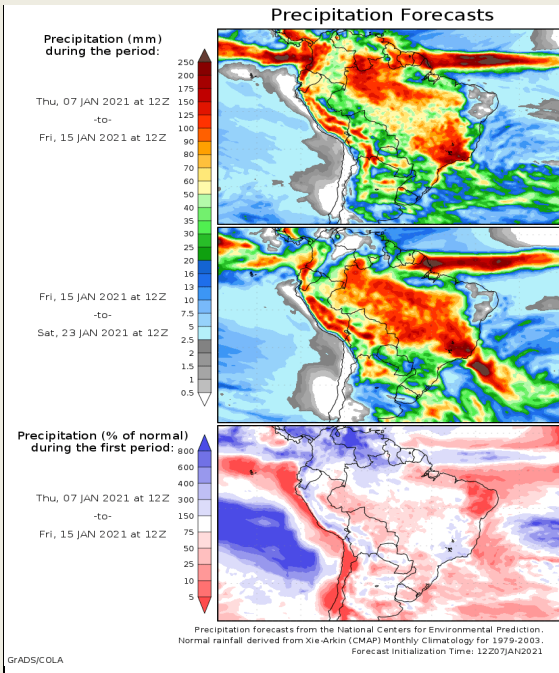
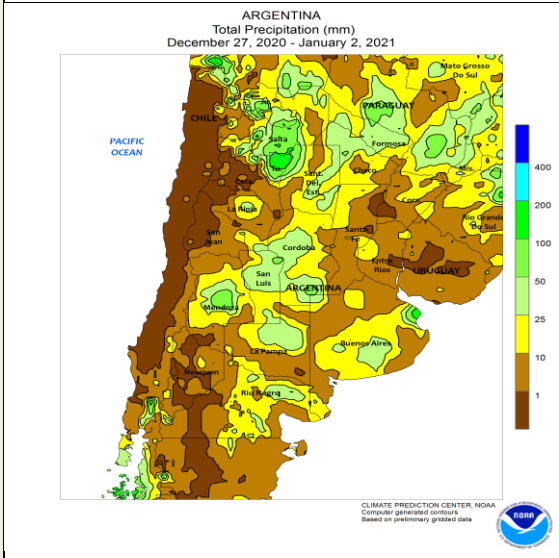
BRAZIL: A good mix of rain and sunshine and favorable conditions for crop development will occur across much of Brazil and Paraguay during the next two weeks with a beneficial increase in rain beginning this weekend in Bahia and northeastern Minas Gerais.

o Central into eastern Bahia and northeastern Minas Gerais will continue to see poor conditions for crop development in unirrigated areas until rain increases this weekend.

ARGENTINA: The two-week outlook has not changed greatly since Wednesday and stress to crops should continue to rise before timely rain events occur Sunday into Monday and Jan. 14-16.

o If both of these rain events occur as advertised, much of Argentina will receive enough rain to stop declines in crop conditions and restore some yield potentials, at least for a while.

o There will be some exceptions as southern Entre Rios and north-central Buenos Aires into nearby Santa Fe should miss much of the Jan. 14-16 rain and with rain Sunday into Monday not great enough to induce a lasting increase in soil moisture, the soil there should quickly dry down again leading to more stress to crops until greater rain falls.

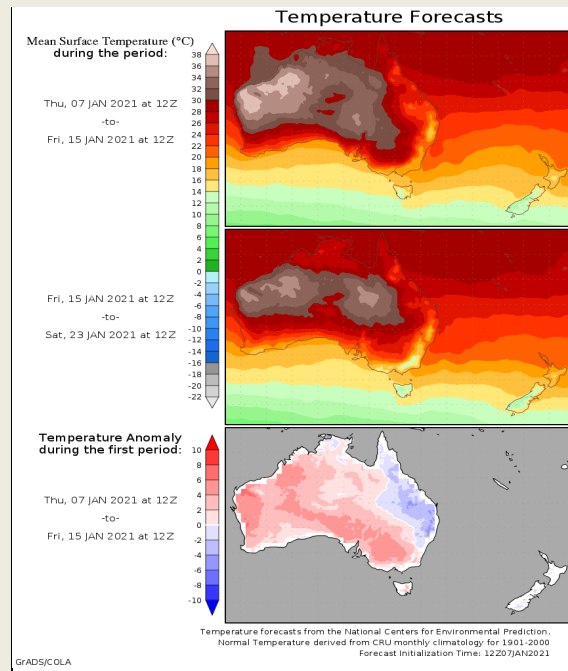
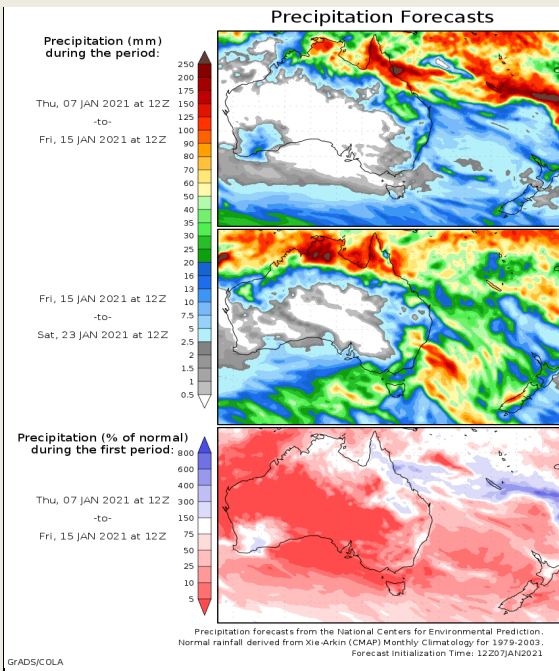
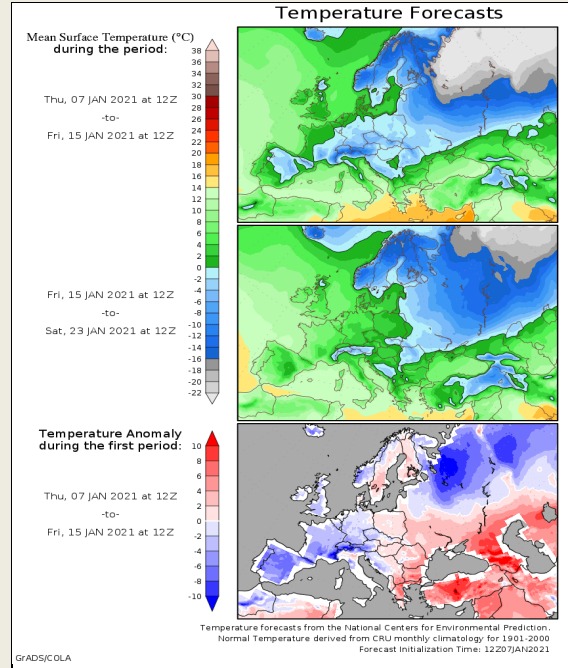
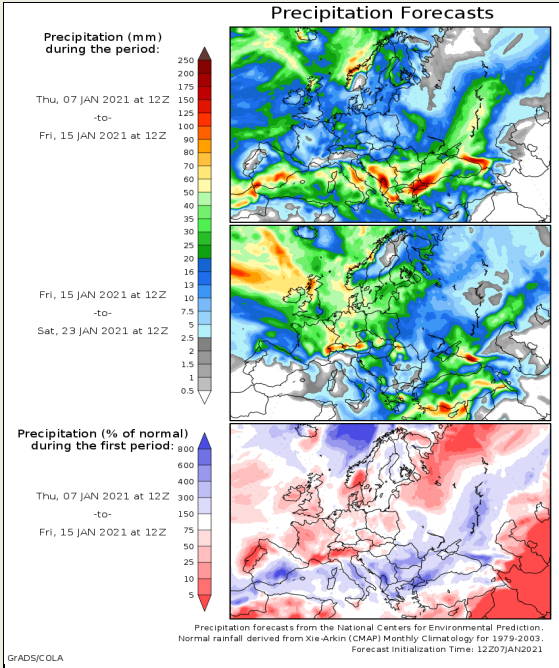

EUROPE: Precipitation will be greatest over southern portions of the European Continent through Tuesday and an increase in snow cover will occur in Spain and as well as northern and central Italy and Slovenia into Serbia as well as Germany through the Czech Republic into Slovakia and Poland. The greatest moisture will occur over the Iberian Peninsula today into Saturday and over southern Italy into the Balkan Nations and Greece Saturday into Monday.

AUSTRALIA: Rain showers and thunderstorms will continue over southeastern Queensland today into Friday and linger over northern sorghum production areas into the weekend.
o Additional moisture totals will range from 0.50 to 1.50 inches and local totals in excess of 2.00 inches over southeastern Queensland's production areas most often. With that said, a pocket of drying will evolve over extreme southeastern Queensland starting today where the heaviest rain occurred Wednesday.
