

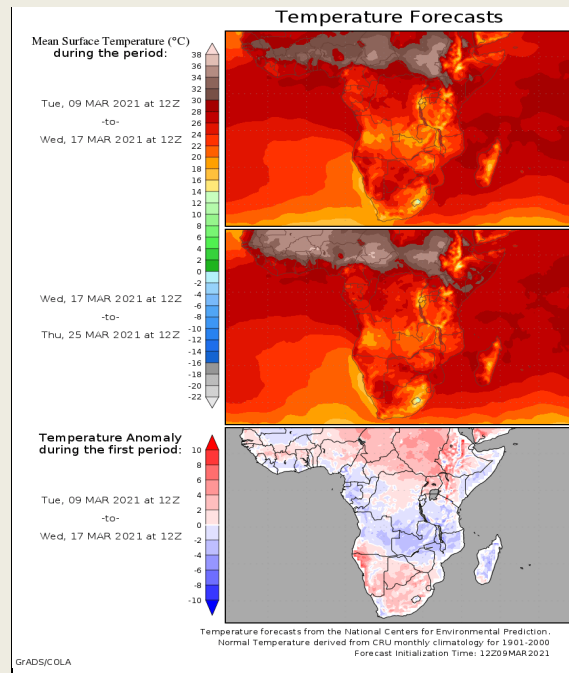
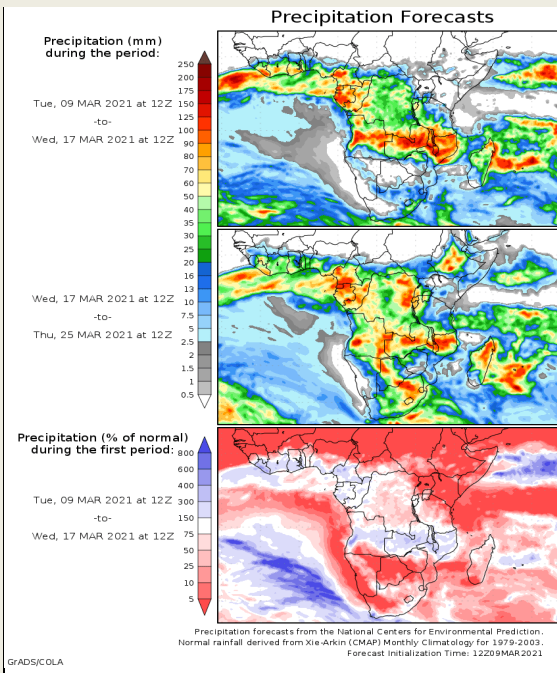
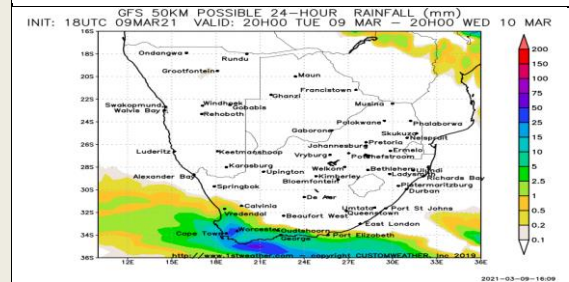
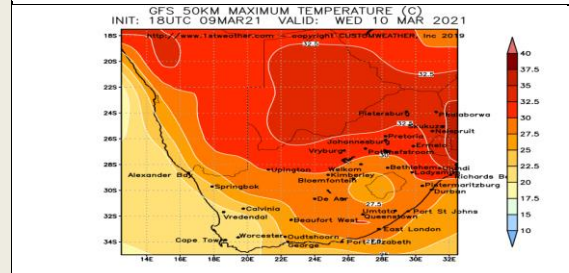
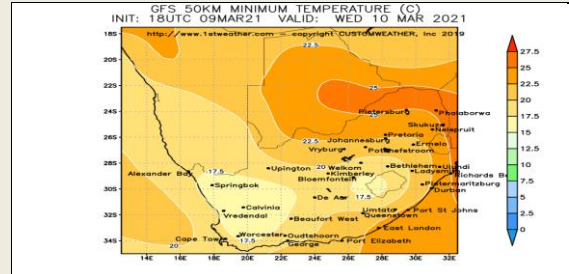
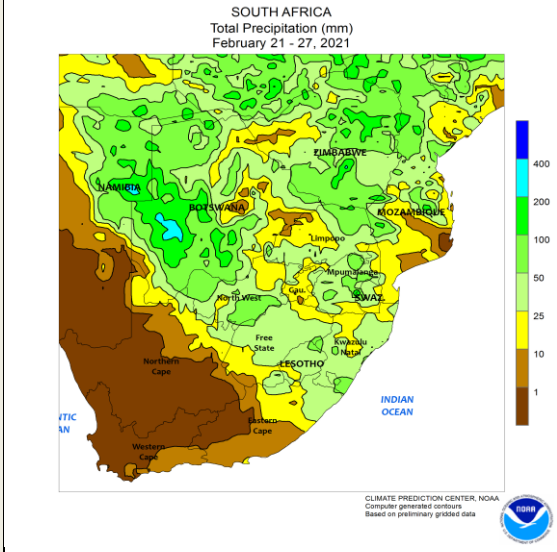


# **Weather Report**

## **10 March 2021**

South Africa - Weather

South Africa's coarse grain and oilseed areas will only have a few opportunities for mostly light rain during the coming week. Rainfall will be unable to impact long-term soil conditions in most production areas. Dryland fields in Northern Cape and western fringes of Free State and North West will remain too dry to support ideal crop development. However, most crops will continue to develop under generally favorable conditions. The lack of significant rain will also be beneficial for early season crop maturation later this month.



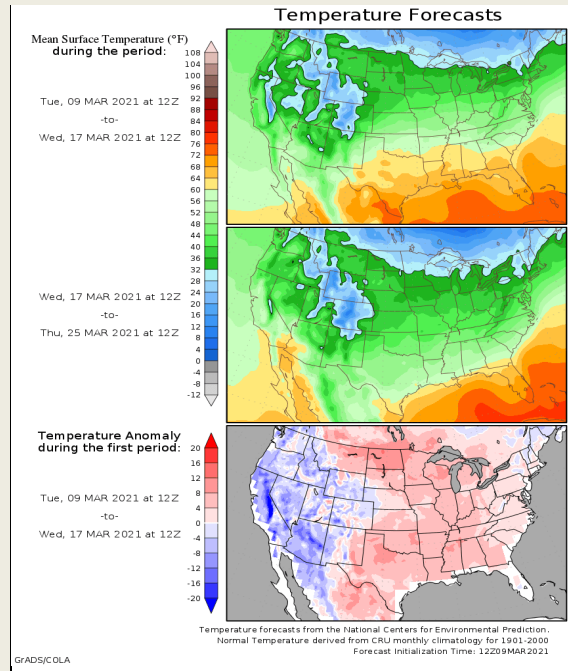
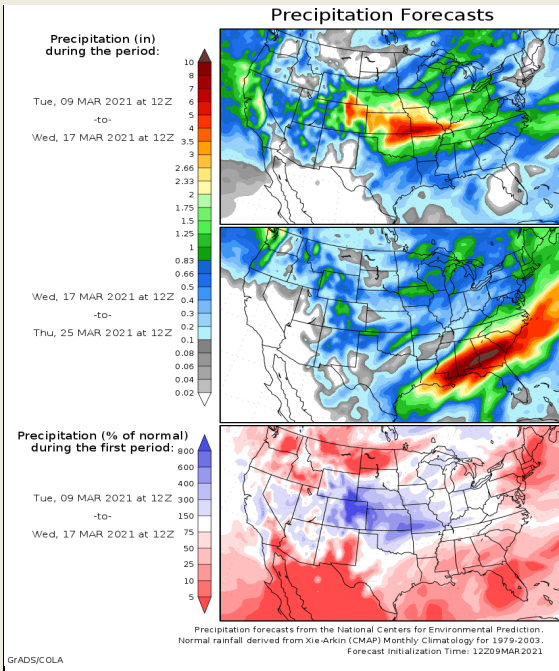
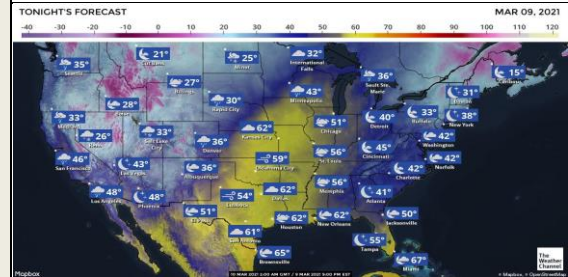
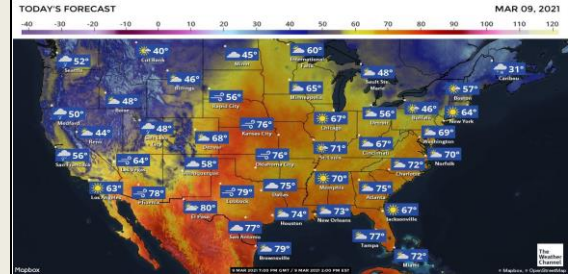
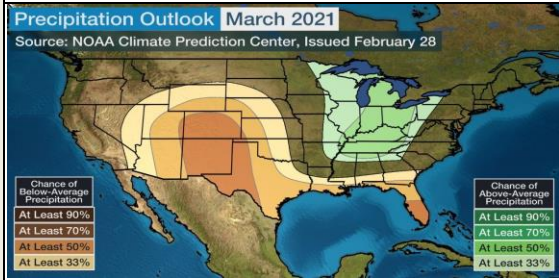

# United States of America - Weather

**U.S. MIDWEST:** Today's forecast is wetter than advertised late last week and a ten-day stretch of active weather will begin Tuesday with enough rain in the lower Midwest that concern should increase over flood potentials later this month.  
 o Bands of heavy rain are likely in the lower Midwest late this week into early next week and some local flooding may occur with heavy rain not likely to be widespread enough to cause serious flooding right away. River and stream flows will increase and will be prone to a quick increase in flooding if another round of heavy rain occurs soon.

**U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST:** Much of the Delta and the Southeast will see little to no precipitation of significance into Saturday allowing for fieldwork to steadily increase and become aggressive in some areas before a period of wet weather occurs Sunday into Thursday, Mar. 18. Rain Sunday through Mar. 18 will stall fieldwork in much of the region, but with drying expected before and after the rain delays to fieldwork should not be extended.

o Southern Georgia and nearby Florida will see the least rain and fieldwork should advance well overall.

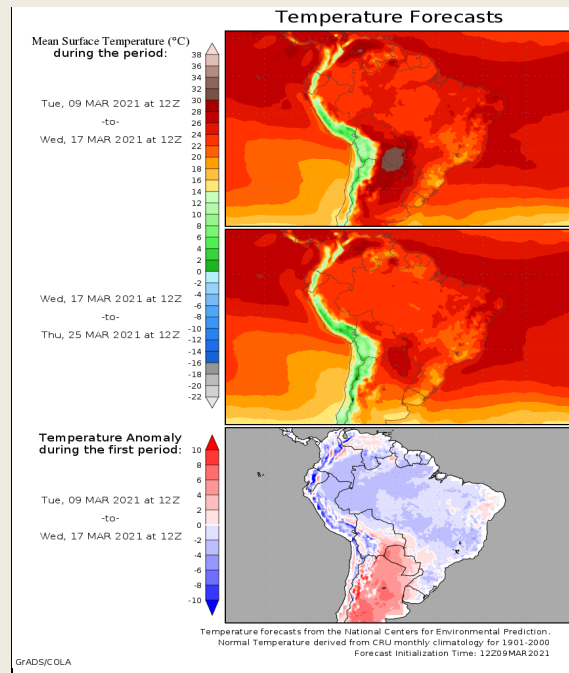
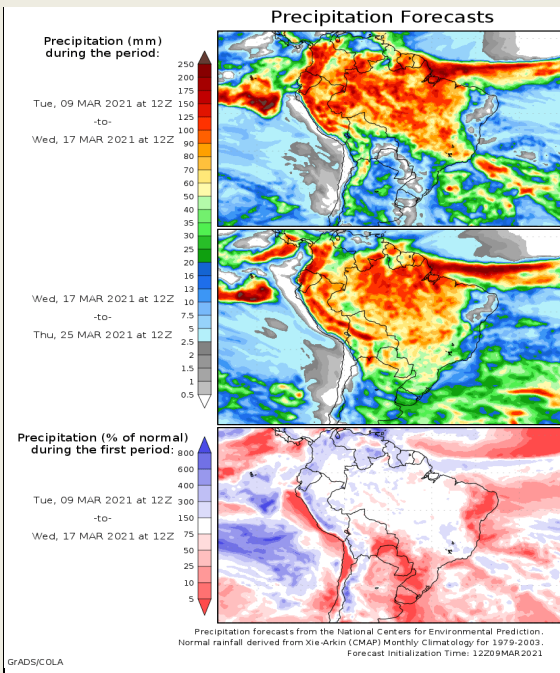
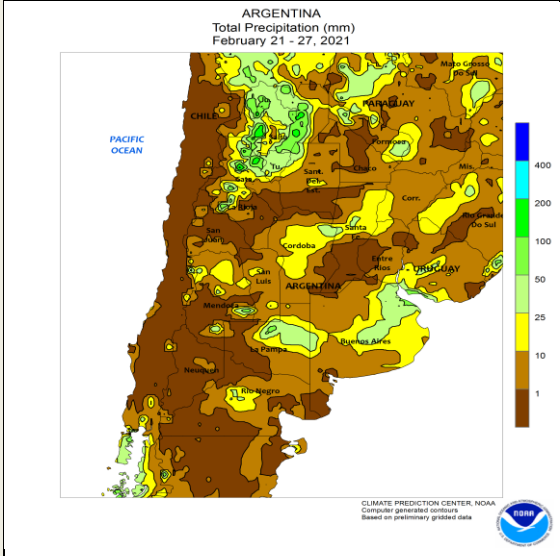

# South America - Weather

**BRAZIL:** Mato Grosso into Goias will continue to see frequent rain and delays to fieldwork during the next two weeks while most other areas see a good mix of rain and sunshine that should allow for fieldwork to advance while rain should be great enough to support developing crops.  
o Some fieldwork should advance around the rain in the wetter areas, but the rain will slow harvesting of soybeans and planting of second season corn as well as threatening some soybeans with quality declines while the moisture is supportive of developing crops.

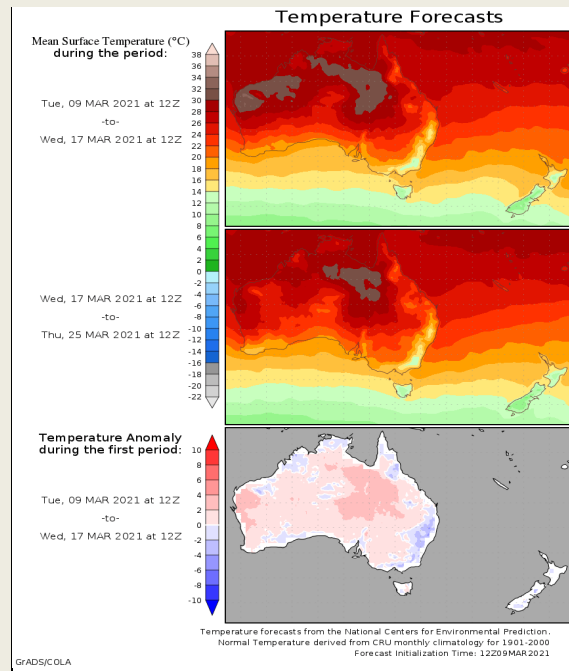
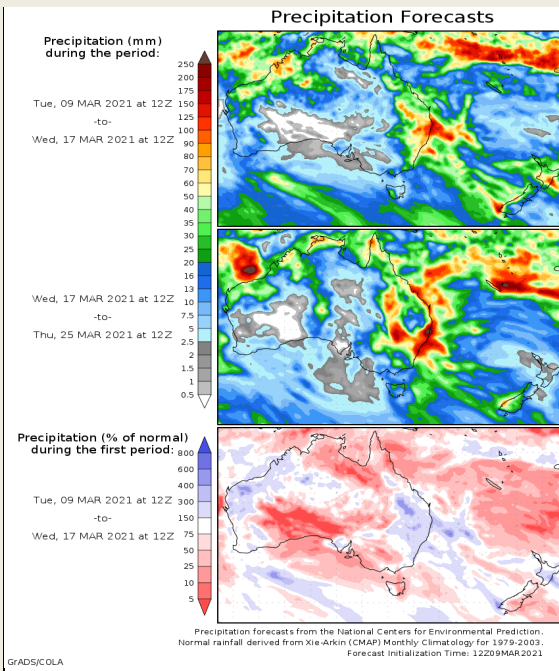
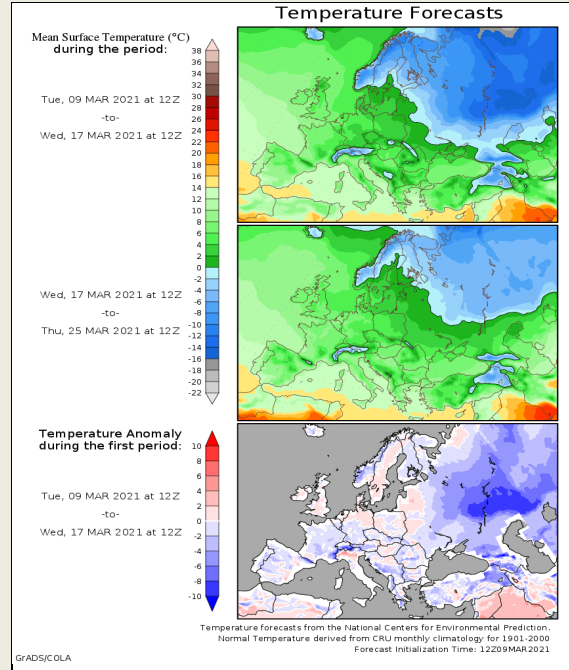
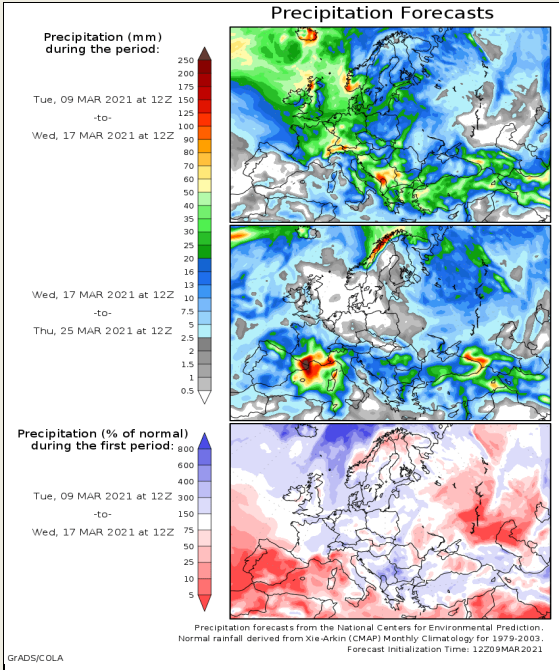
**ARGENTINA:** Rain has been increased in the forecast since late last week with showers beginning Wednesday in the west and south and becoming widespread Friday into next Monday.  
o Some areas will still see increases in crop stress in the warm to hot and dry conditions expected to continue into Saturday in much of the country with relief beginning in the west Friday.

EUROPE: A restricted precipitation pattern will continue today and Tuesday.  
 o However, some heavy rain will occur with isolated to scattered rain showers and thunderstorms over southeastern Spain into central Italy and into Bosnia, Montenegro, Albania and southern Serbia and Macedonia. Moisture totals will vary from 0.75 to 3.00 inches and locally more.  
 AUSTRALIA: Rainfall will increase over key summer crop areas of New South Wales and southeastern Queensland this week and the moisture will be welcome for developing crops and future winter crop planting, but delays in the summer crop maturation and harvest will occur.  
 o Scattered showers will increase over the region today into Tuesday and an increase in organized rainfall will occur Wednesday into Thursday will occur over the region. Scattered showers will linger into the weekend.
