South Africa - Weather

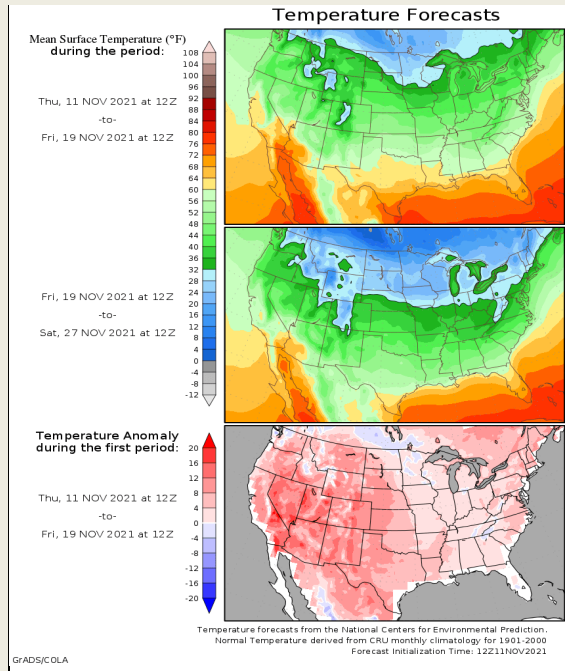
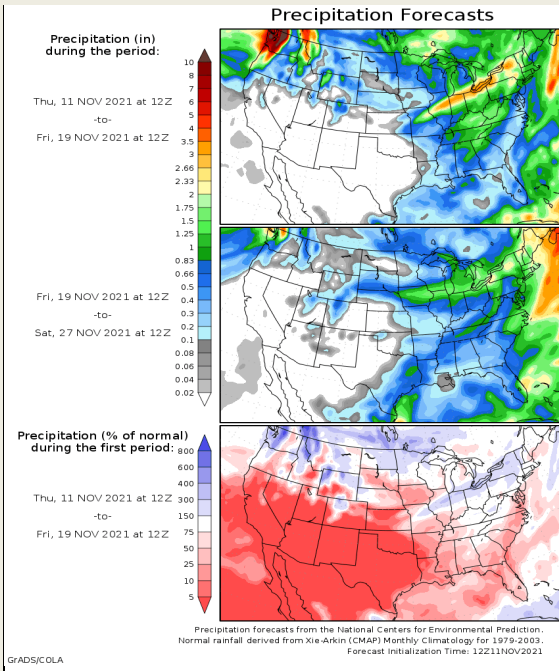
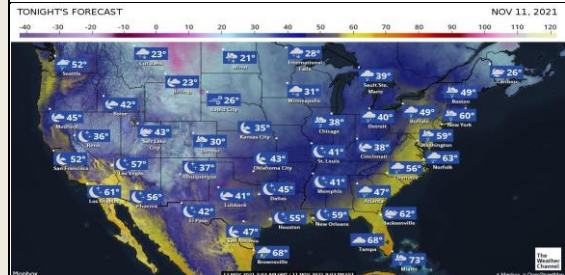
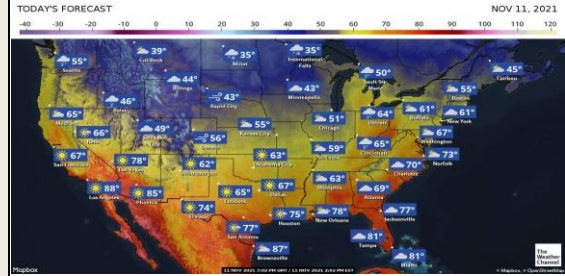
Alternating periods of erratic rain and sunshine will continue for eastern South Africa during the coming week. The rain will slowly bolster soil moisture and support favorable or improving conditions for summer crop planting and establishment. The driest areas will still need additional rain to completely fix the moisture deficits and support ideal long-term crop prospects. Drier biased conditions will persist in central and western South Africa during the coming week. Free State and North West will have a few opportunities for erratic rain, though resulting rainfall will generally be too light to counter evaporation or impact long-term soil conditions. Winter wheat harvesting will advance swiftly in much of Western Cape, Northern Cape, and Free State. However, planting and establishment conditions will remain less than favorable to poor in much of central South Africa.

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: The Midwest will see cooler and wetter weather pattern through the next ten days that will slow fieldwork in the few remaining areas that have yet to be harvested.
 o There will be breaks between rounds of precipitation and some harvesting should advance during the dry days.
 o Some snow will accumulate from the eastern Dakotas into Wisconsin today into Saturday with blizzard conditions in parts of the eastern Dakotas and western Minnesota today.
U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The two-week outlook is a little wetter overall than advertised earlier this week, but good opportunities for fieldwork are still expected with the best conditions for fieldwork Friday into Wednesday when mostly dry weather is expected.

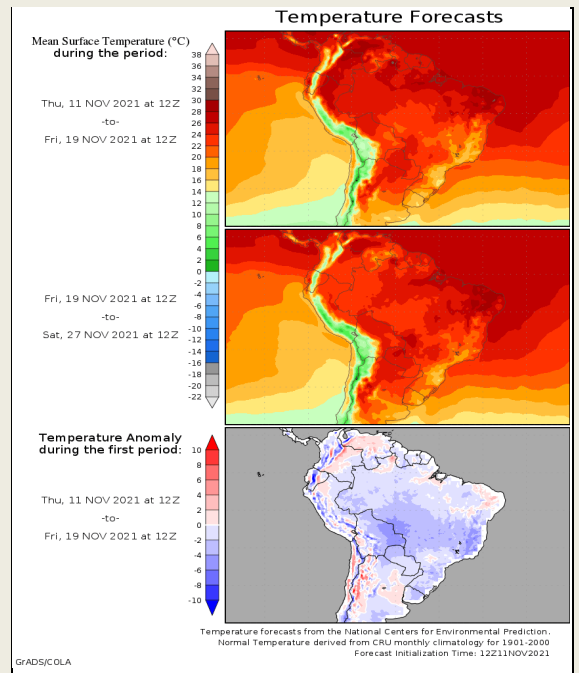
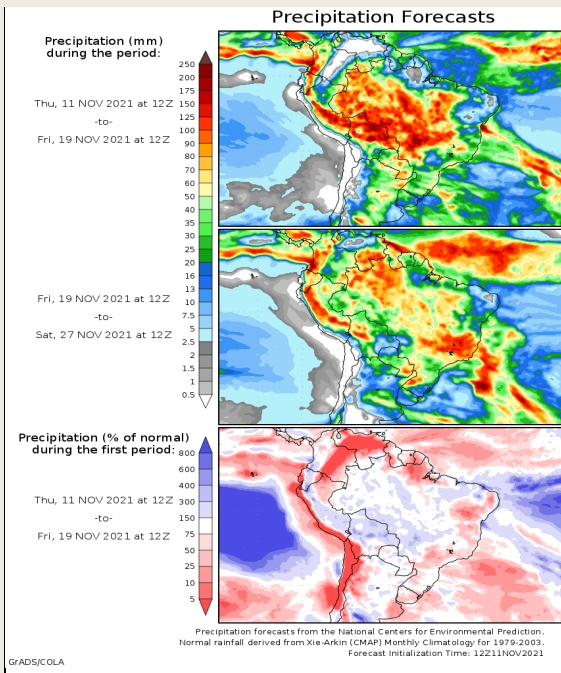
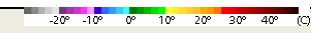
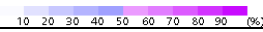
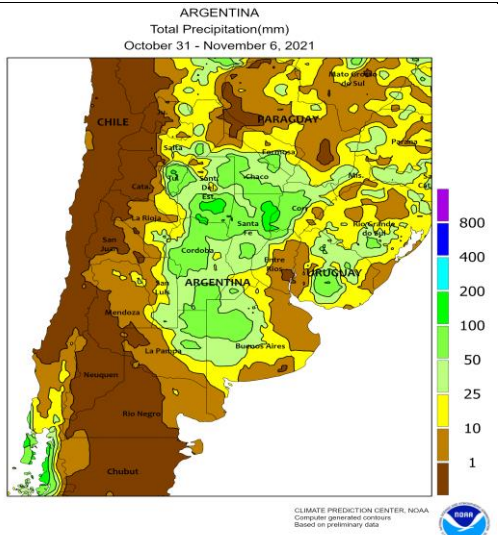
South America - Weather

BRAZIL: A few more days of little to no rain will occur from southern Paraguay and Rio Grande do Sul through Sao Paulo before a timely increase in rain occurs Sunday through Friday of next week. Most of the remainder of Brazil and Paraguay will see regular rounds of rain through the next two weeks and increases in soil moisture are likely in many areas.

o Northern Mato Grosso do Sul to Mato Grosso to central Minas Gerais will be wettest where regular rounds of heavy rain are likely and planting will be slowed at times with some local flooding as well.

ARGENTINA: Argentina will see a favorable environment for planting and crop development through most of the next two weeks with interruptions to fieldwork resulting from beneficial rain expected Friday into Tuesday.

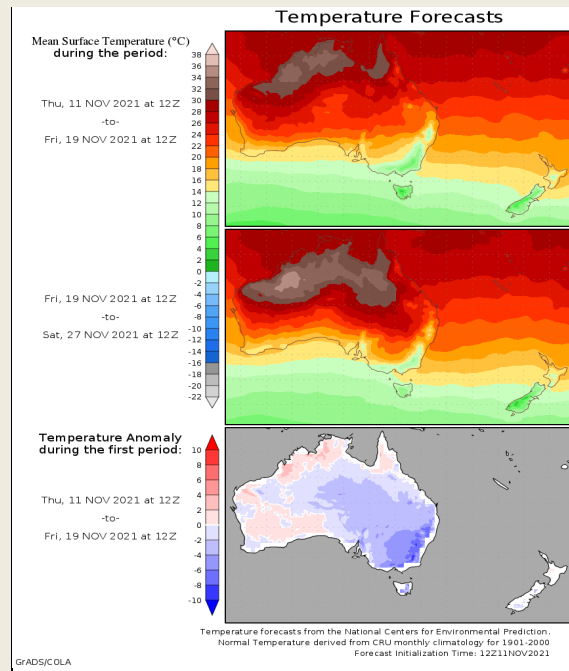
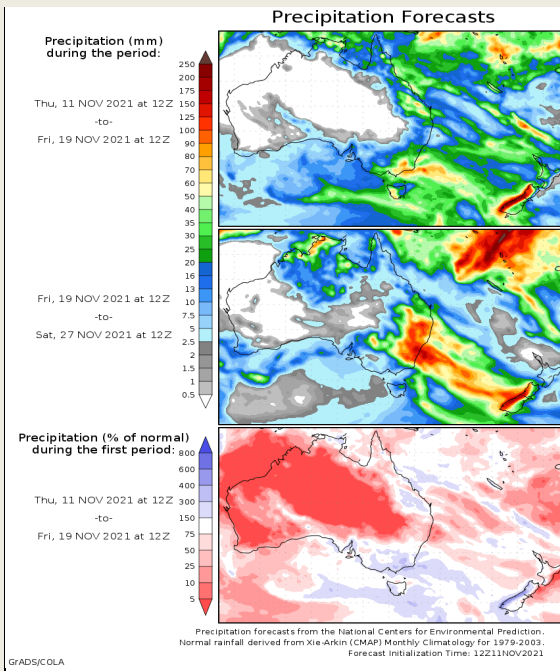
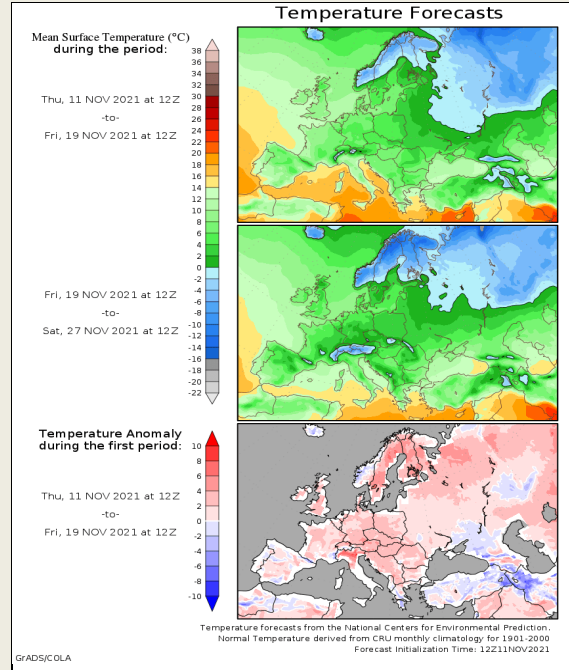
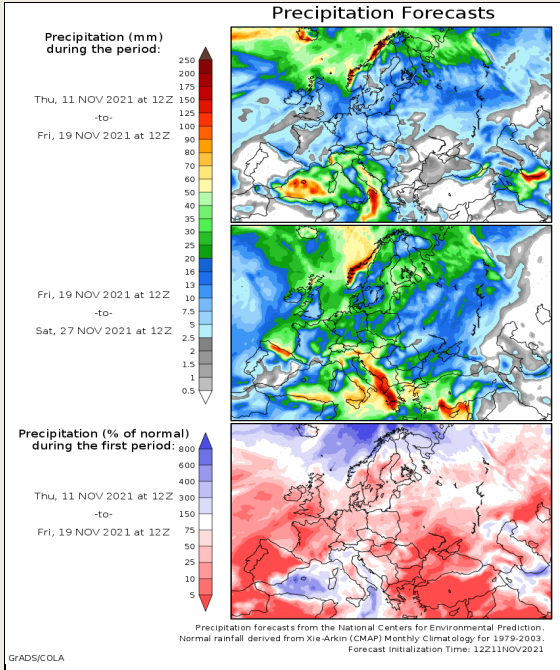
o Widespread significant rain Friday into Sunday and lighter rain Monday into Tuesday will leave soil conditions favorable for crops before drier weather begins Wednesday allowing fieldwork to resume.

EUROPE: A low-pressure system will develop over the Mediterranean Sea this weekend and the storm system will become stronger early next week and heavy rain will develop over southern Italy and is expected to eventually meander over Greece late next week. Flash flooding will occur with the torrential rainfall.
AUSTRALIA: Restricted precipitation will evolve over eastern Australia Saturday into next Thursday, November 18. The drier weather will follow recent rain which allow for improved winter crop maturation and harvest as well as fieldwork and planting of summer crops.
