


South Africa - Weather


Eastern South Africa into Eastern Cape will see a good mix of rain and sunshine this week. Rainfall will be enough to gradually bolster soil moisture in most locations. Planting and general fieldwork will advance swiftly between rain events. The environment will also improve for aggressive establishment and growth. Limpopo and neighboring areas will likely need additional rain to completely fix the moisture deficits.


The remaining portions of South Africa will be drier biased this week. Free State and North West will receive light rain at times, though resulting precipitation will generally be lost to evaporation.
Winter wheat harvesting will advance swiftly in most locations. Planting of summer crops will also occur with few disruptions. However, the ground will remain too dry for aggressive establishment and growth. Eastern South Africa into Eastern Cape and eastern fringes of Free State and North West will see a mix of erratic rain and sunshine this week






United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Much of the Midwest will see two to three more days of dry weather and good harvest progress before a cooler and wetter weather pattern Wednesday into this weekend slows fieldwork in the few remaining unharvested areas. A drier weather pattern will resume Nov. 15-22, but one more round of precipitation expected Nov. 17-18 will slow fieldwork. Today will be much warmer than normal and highs will be in the 50s and 60s most often before cooling occurs and by Saturday highs in the upper 30s to the middle 40s will be most common. Sunday and next Monday will be warmer and by Tuesday of next week the Midwest will be warmer than normal before another round of cooling occurs during the middle to late part of next week.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: The Delta and the Southeast will see two more weeks of mostly favorable harvest weather as only two rounds of precipitation are expected with minor interruption to fieldwork likely to result while the moisture will be good for winter crops.










Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather


EUROPE: A low-pressure system will develop over the Mediterranean Sea this weekend and the storm system will become stronger early next week and heavy rain will develop over southern Italy and is expected to eventually meander over Greece late next week. Flash flooding will occur with the torrential rainfall.

AUSTRALIA: Frequent rounds of rain will impact most of Australia during the coming ten days to two weeks. Drier weather will be needed to improve crop maturation and harvest conditions of winter crops. A few areas may become too wet and quality declines may occur, but many locations will not be wet enough to harm the quality of winter crops. Meanwhile, the moisture will be ideal for summer crop planting, emergence and development and livestock conditions, especially in unirrigated areas where dryness will significantly improve.
