
#### South Africa - Weather


Eastern and central South Africa will see several waves of erratic rain this week. Rainfall will be enough to gradually bolster soil moisture in most locations. Planting and general fieldwork may be sluggish during the wetter periods, though producers will still have opportunities to get into the fields. Establishment and growth conditions will be mostly good. Western South Africa will be drier biased this week. The lack of rain will be beneficial for aggressive fieldwork. Recent rainfall and irrigation will also promote a mostly good environment for the cotton in Northern Cape. Eastern and central South Africa will often see rain scattered across the region o Light rain will initially be scattered across eastern South Africa today 🏿 More widespread rain will evolve Tuesday into this weekend


Moisture totals by next Monday morning will range from 1.50-4.00" and local amounts of 5.00" or



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#### **United States of America - Weather**


U.S. MIDWEST: Fieldwork will advance well overall during the next two weeks as dry weather will be most common, but showers will occur often enough in some eastern areas that late soybean harvestine will be slowed at times.


o Most of the precipitation will be light and most fieldwork should quickly resume after the precipitation ends, but the few remaining unharvested soybeans may not dry out fast enough to be harvesting to occur for extended periods.


o The most significant storm system to impact the region will occur Dec. 10-12 with confidence for the details of this event low.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Today's forecast is wetter for the Delta and the Southeast and after dry weather ends during the day Friday a period of wet weather will occur Friday night through Dec. 13 and late harvesting will be slowed.

o Most of northern Florida and southern Georgia to southern Virginia will be dry into Tuesday while rain falls regularly further west starting Friday night.







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
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
#### **South America - Weather**


BRAZIL: Central and southern Rio Grande do Sul will see a restricted rainfall pattern through the next two weeks and some newly planted crops may see rising levels of crops stress as the topsoil dries out while subsoil moisture should be high enough to support crops with developed root systems. Subsoil moisture may become short beyond the middle of the month and stress to crops should steadily increase until rain returns. Rain has been increased since late last week for areas from southern Paraguay to northern Rio Grande do Sul and Santa Catarina where significant rain is expected Saturday through next Monday with beneficial rain extending into Mato Grosso do Sul, Parana, and Sao Paulo as well.


ARGENTINA: Much of Argentina will see favorable conditions for planting and development of crops during the next two weeks, but some areas will dry down significantly and will need rain soon with some crop stress possible beyond the middle of the month in some northern and eastern areas. o The best conditions for crops will occur in southwestern Argentina where significant rain is advertised for Tuesdav into Thursdav.

o Most of the remainder of western and portions of central Argentina will see rain Friday through Sunday.









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
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
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
# Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather


EUROPE: Regular rounds of precipitation will continue throughout Europe this week. The most frequent moisture will impact the northern coast of Spain, France into portions of Germany and the Alps as well as Italy into Slovenia, Croatia, Bosnia and Montenegro into Hungary and Slovakia today through the Monday. Moisture will increase over the U.K. and into France Tuesday into Wednesday as well as southeastern portions of

AUSTRALIA: A restricted precipitation pattern will occur through Sunday. Summer crop production potentials will remain good after recent rainfall, but the break in moisture will be welcome for unharvested winter crops and fieldwork. © Conditions will not be completely dry © Rounds of showers will linger over the eastern coast of New South Wales and southeastern Queensland back into the Great Dividing Range on a near daily basis. A few showers will linger over central Victoria and south-central New South Wales today.









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
