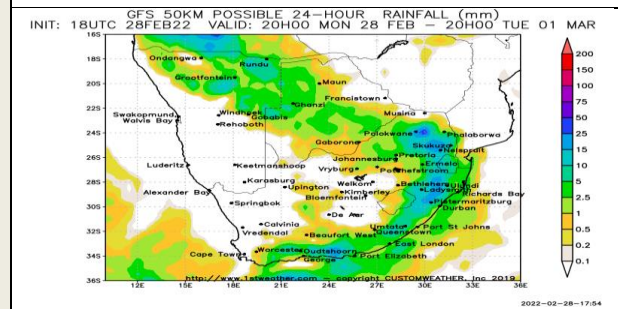
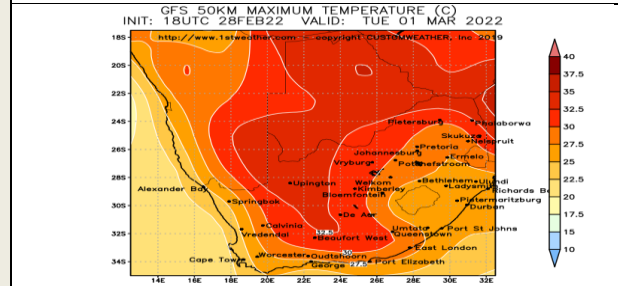
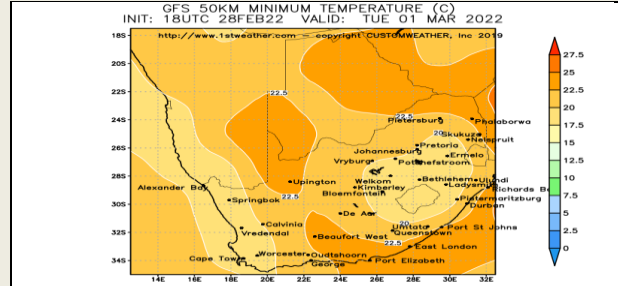
South Africa - Weather

The main production areas in South Africa will see scattered showers evolve on a frequent basis this week. The rain will help bolster soil moisture in Free State and North West while keeping soil moisture at adequate to excessive levels in eastern South Africa. Crop development conditions will remain generally favorable outside the wettest locations. Early season maturation may otherwise be sluggish in eastern South Africa.

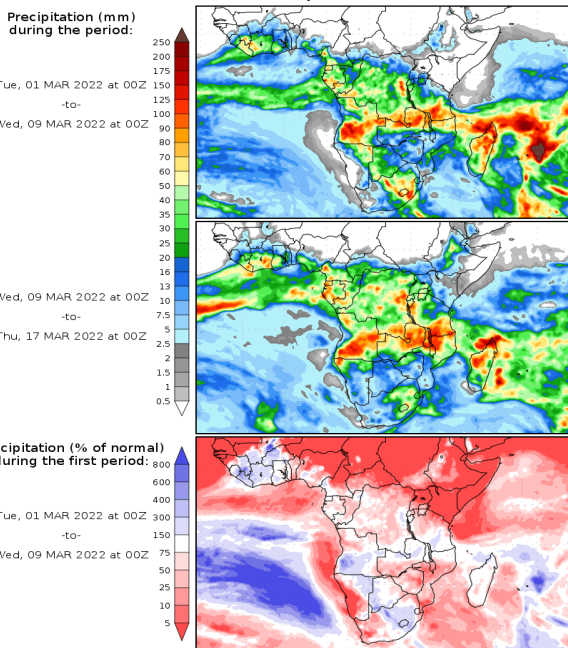
SOUTH AFRICA

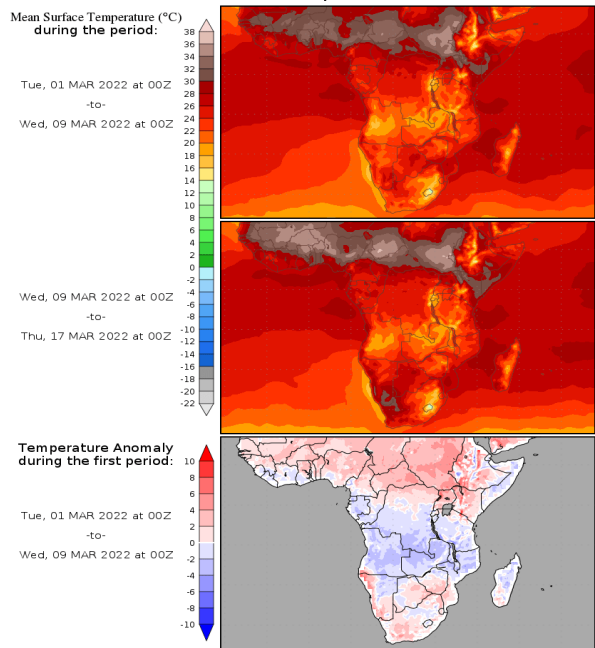
Precipitation Forecasts

Forecast Initialization Time: 00Z01MAR2022

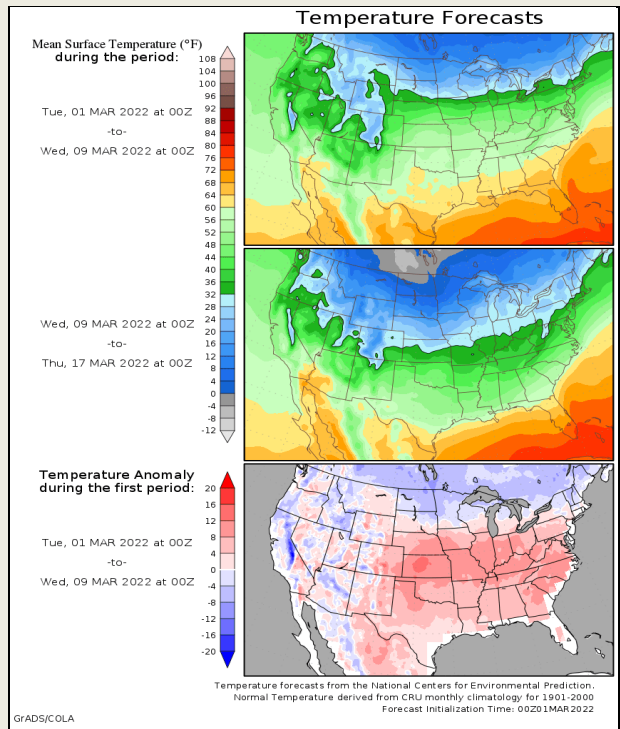
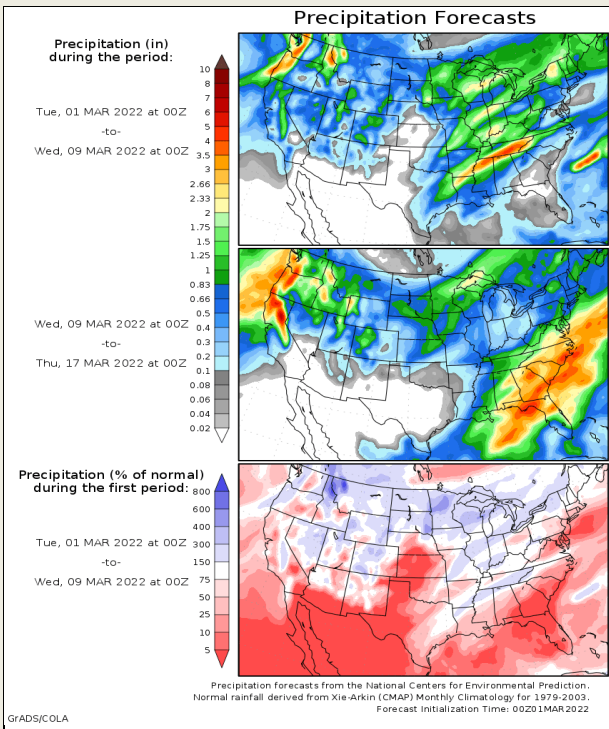
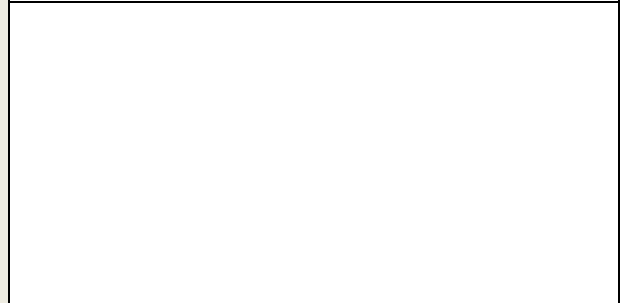
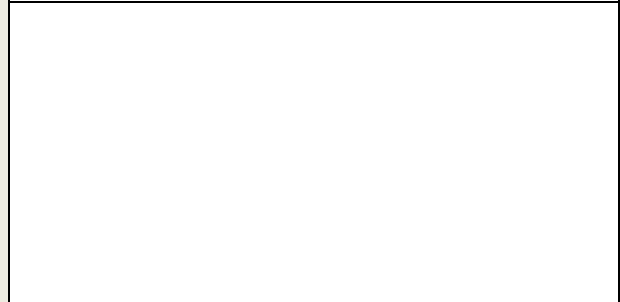
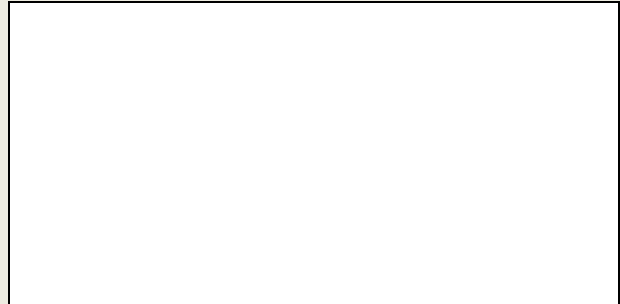
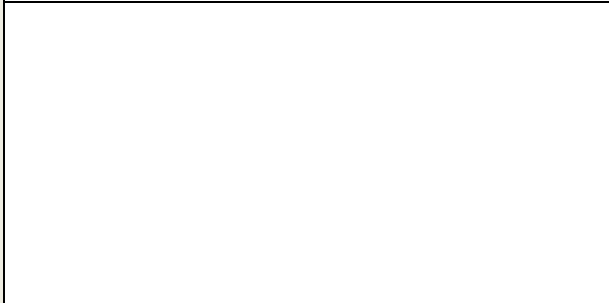
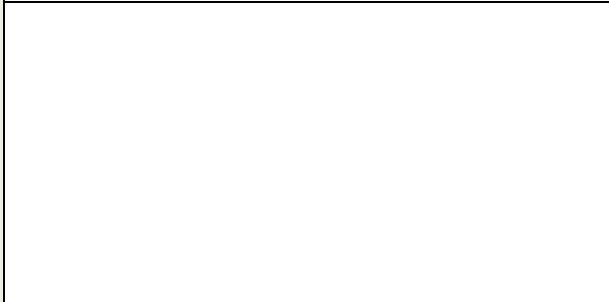
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United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Mostly dry weather will occur through Thursday and flooding in the eastern Corn Belt will decline before three rounds of precipitation from Friday through Mar. 11 leave many eastern areas in need of drier weather to improve conditions for early season fieldwork. A storm system will bring precipitation to most of the Midwest Friday into Saturday with moisture content of 0.30-1.20" and locally more in the north and up to 0.65" and locally more south.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Rain fell from the Delta to northern Georgia to the Carolinas during the weekend with a light wintry mix of precipitation types suspected in parts of the central and northern Delta. The Delta and the Southeast will be mostly dry through Friday and fieldwork will increase in much of the region before three round of precipitation Saturday through March 11 will slow fieldwork.

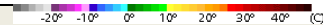
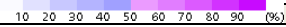
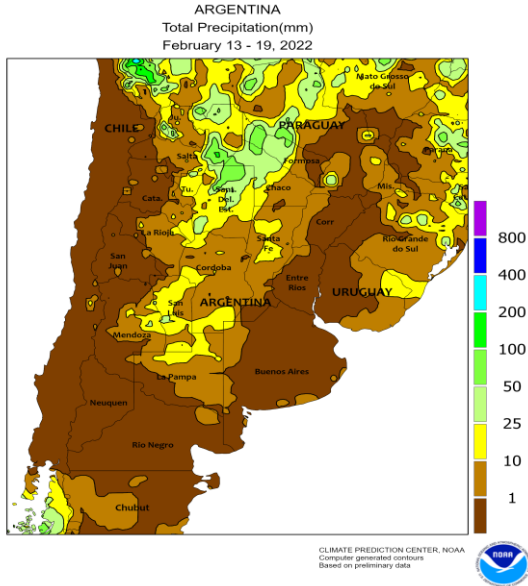


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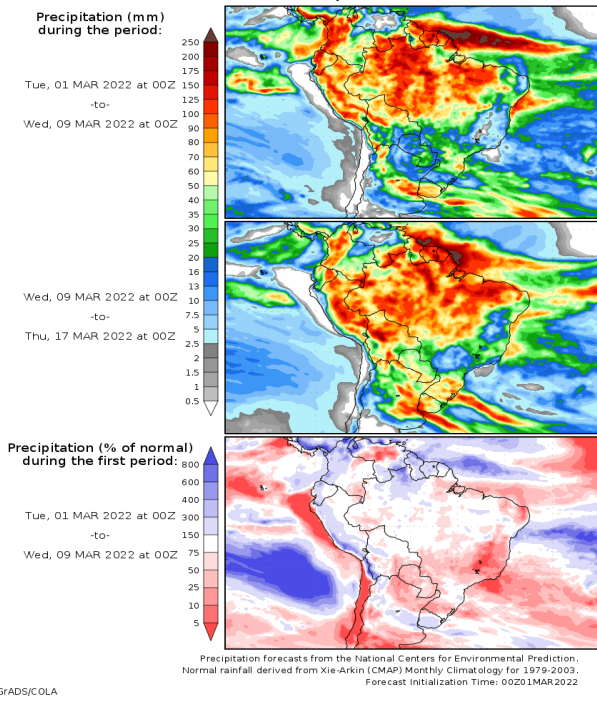
South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Beneficial rain expanded in southern Brazil during the weekend, but outside of a few pockets much of the rain was light while heavy rain fell on a part of central Mato Grosso with most of the remainder of Brazil seeing light to moderate rain or dry weather. Additional improvements in conditions for summer crops and for Safrinha crop planting will occur during the next two weeks in the driest areas from Paraguay and Mato Grosso do Sul to southern Brazil where showers and thunderstorms will occur regularly through the period.

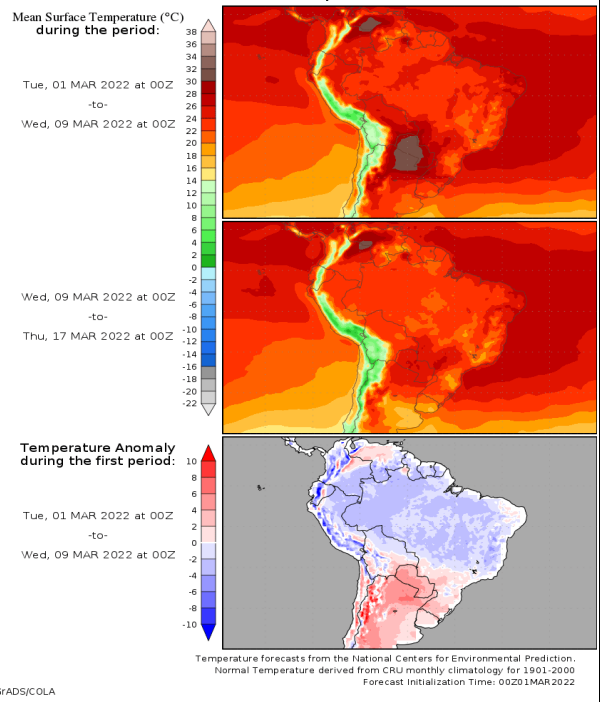
ARGENTINA: Beneficial rain fell on the driest areas from central Santa Fe into Entre Rios during the weekend while crops suffered in most of northern Argentina where little rain fell and temperatures were excessively hot. The driest areas in central and northern Argentina will see regular rain and significant relief from dryness through the next week while key crop areas in southern Argentina also receive rain that will maintain favorable conditions for crop development.

Temperature Forecasts

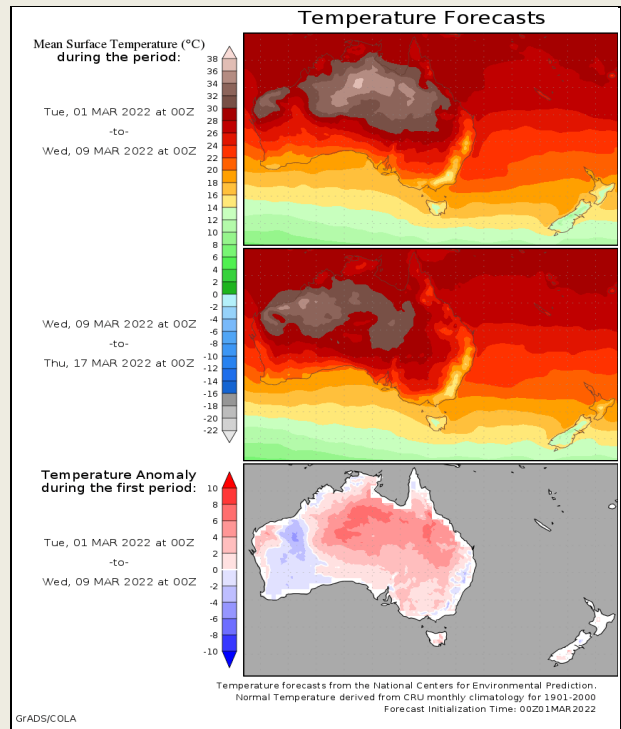
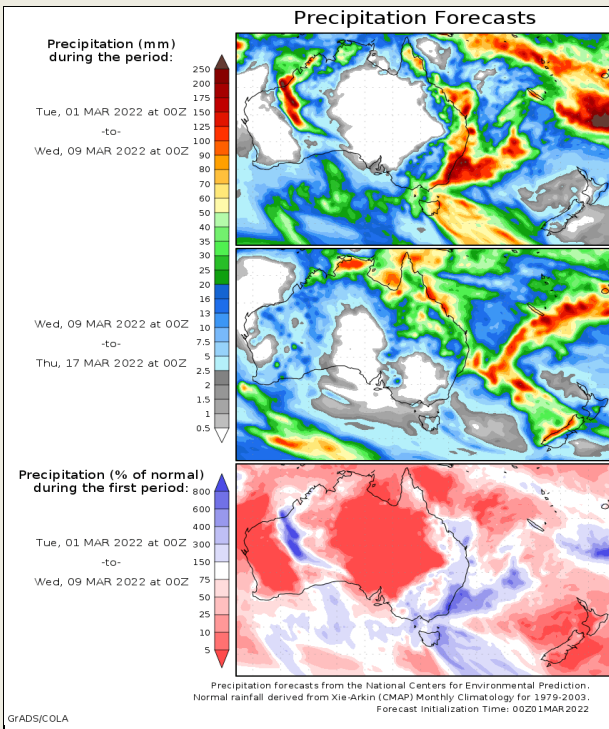
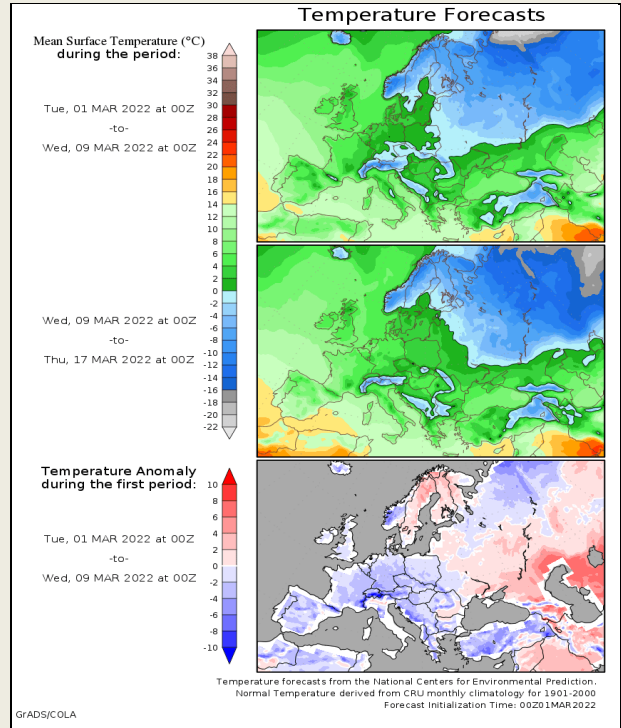
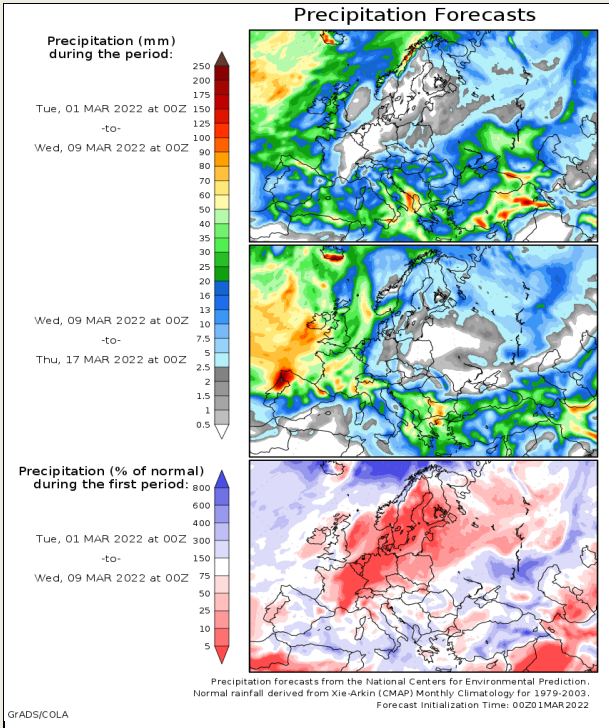


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Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Precipitation across Europe during the weekend was limited except in the Italian Peninsula where central areas received 1.50 to 3.45 inches of rain. Moisture totals elsewhere were rarely more than 0.16 inch with central Spain, the Low Countries, southwestern Poland, Czech Republic and the western Balkans region wettest.

AUSTRALIA: Torrential rain and flooding that occurred from south of Hervey Bay through the Brisbane areas to the upper New South Wales coast during the weekend resulted in serious flooding. Damage to sugarcane and personal property was suspected along with a few nearby fields of cotton and sorghum. Most of the flooding occurred east of key cotton and sorghum areas, but sugarcane might have been negatively impacted. New South Wales and eastern Queensland will receive more rain later this week and through the weekend to bolster soil moisture for some late season sorghum and cotton. Some of the rain may negatively impact open boll cotton fiber quality. Some western production areas of Queensland will be in need of greater moisture.



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
