
#### South Africa - Weather

The main production areas in South Africa will see scattered showers evolve on a frequent basis this week. The rain will help bolster soil moisture in Free State and North West while keeping soil moisture at adequate to excessive levels in eastern South Africa. Crop development conditions will remain generally favorable outside the wettest locations. Early season maturation may otherwise be sluggish in eastern South Africa.


## Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather


EUROPE: Precipitation across Europe during the weekend was limited except in the Italian Peninsula where central areas received 1.50 to 3.45 inches of rain. Moisture totals elsewhere were rarely more than 0.16 inch with tentral Spain, the Low Countries, southwestern Poland, Czech Republic and the western Balkans region wettest.


AUSTRALIA: Torrential rain and flooding that occurred from south of Hervey Bay through the Brisbane areas to the upper New South Wales coast during the weekend resulted in

serious flooding. Damage to sugarcane and personal property was suspected along with a few nearby fields of cotton and sorghum. Most of the flooding occurred east of key cotton and sorghum areas, but sugarcane might have been negatively impacted. New South Wales and eastern Queensland will receive more rain later this week and through the weekend to bolster soil moisture for some late season sorghum and cotton. Some of the rain may negatively impact open boll cotton fiber quality. Some western production areas of Queensland will be in need of greater moisture.
