


United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Much of the Midwest will continue to see favorable conditions for crops through the next two weeks with rain advertised for this weekend into next week important to crops in the driest reas from southeastern South Dakota and eastern Nebraska through western Iowa, eastern Kansas, Missouri, and southern Illinois.


o A lack of heat for at least the next ten days along with adequate to favorable soil moisture and nultiple rounds of rain in much of the Corn Belt should keep soil conditions favorable in much of the region. Most areas from interior northeastern and east-central Nebraska to west-central and outhwestern lowa received rain Wednesday night or will see rain today and immature crops will penefit from the moisture.

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Additional heavy rain and some flooding will occur today from the outhern Delta to southwestern Alabama while lighter rain will fall on surrounding areas into norther Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina. Some low-lying crops may be damaged by flooding while the noisture will induce largely beneficial increases in soil moisture.

Sep. 4-8 should be drier and conditions for fieldwork will improve.


South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Dry weather will be most common through the next two weeks with occasional rounds of howers and thunderstorms in Paraguay and southern Brazil that should induce little more than mporary interruptions to fieldwork p Parts of northeastern Brazil will see light showers on occasion as well.

ARGENTINA: A large part of eastern Argentina will receive rain today into Saturday while today's forecast is drier for central Argentina with little to no rain expected there or in western Argentina during the next ten days to two weeks where greater rain is needed to improve conditions for winter rops

o Rain will increase today through Saturday when Entre Rios and nearby areas in southern Santa Fe to southern Corrientes and north-central and northeastern Buenos Aires receive 0.40-1.50" and locally nore

Bain will surround the region and will extend from the remainder of Corrientes to eastern to southern Buenos Aires where many areas will receive up to 0.75" and locally more. o Showers will return to portions of eastern Argentina Wednesday into next Thursday.



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

Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Pockets of meaningful rainfall are still expected in the next seven days. Much of this rain will occur in southern production areas from northeastern Spain through Italy and into the western Balkan Countrie there some additional topsoil moisture improvement is likely as a result. Unusually warm temperatures with high evaporation rates continues to be an issue helping to worsen the areas of dryness in the region and mperatures are expected to be above average most often the next two weeks.

AUSTRALIA: Wheat, barley and canola are well established in most of the nation and poised to begin the spring growing season quite favorably. Queensland has become a little drier than preferred; however, some timely rain is expected in the first week of the outlook. Southwestern Western Australia had become a little wetter than preferred; though, this part of he region is receiving a needed break from the rain. A favorable mix of rain and sunshine is expected the next two weeks.



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
