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


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## **United States of America - Weather**

U.S. MIDWEST: Restricted precipitation is expected this week allowing late season fieldwork to advance. Temperatures will also trend warmer and that should bring on more wheat emergence and stablishmen

U.S. DELTA AND SOUTHEAST: Late season fieldwork will slowly end in the next few weeks. Weather conditions in the next ten days will be mostly good for harvesting of late season crops and for protecting unharvested crop conditions. The period will also be good for wheat emergence and establishment with a little late season planting expected as well.







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
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# Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Significant precipitation is expected in southern production areas, particularly Italy the Balkan Countries, in the first week of the outlook. This will be good for notably increasing topsoil moisture, but could lead to some flooding. Rain fell lightly from the United Kingdom, Netherlands and Belgium through France and part of western and southern Germany to Italy and the Balkan Countries. Moisture totals were not more than 0.75 inch in the U.K. and 0.72 inch in western France while most of the precipitation was not more than 0.60 inch. Many areas reported 0.30 inch or less.

AUSTRALIA: Net drying is expected in a majority of the region the next seven days. Near to below average temperatures will continue to dominate the weather pattern; however, some warming is expected later this week. The environment will be generally favorable for fieldwork and crop development. A rain event in eastern production areas Nov. 28 – 29 could lead to more delays.



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
